| JERUSALEM | Activity not yet reported. | |

| RAMALLAH & EL BIREH | Checkpoint: At 09:00, an Israeli jeep set up a flying checkpoint at the entrance of the village of Al Nabi Salih, where Israeli soldiers searched vehicles and passengers. Raids: At 16:00, the Israeli army, including 2 jeeps, raided the towns of Deir Ghassana and Kafr 'Ein. At 22:15 and again at 06:25, the Israeli army raided the village Kafr 'Ein. 02:15, the Israeli army, including 3 jeeps, raided the towns of Deir Ghassana, Beit Rima and Kafr 'Ein, where they fired sound bombs before withdrawing at 03:15. At 05:30, the Israeli army raided the town of Beit Rima and withdrew at 06:30. | |

| BETHLEHEM | <u>Closures</u>: The Israeli army announced the opening of the southern entrance. The Bethlehem/Hebron entrance remains closed. <u>Arrest</u>: Israeli soldiers located at checkpoint 300, on the Bethlehem/Jerusalem road, arrested Mahmoud Al Deiri, a resident of Al 'Aza refugee camp in Bethlehem. | |
| TULKAREM | Checkpoints: The Israeli army set up several flying checkpoints, preventing civilians from traveling in the area during the Eid holiday, in the following areas: (i) On the junction of the settlement of Enav. (ii) On the junction of Iktaba, north east of the city of Tulkarem. (iii) On the junction of Beit Lid, east of Tulkarem city. | |

| | <u>Injuries</u>: At 15:30, the Israeli army located at the entrance to the town of Baqa ash Sharqiya fired a sound bomb at the vehicle of Ra'fat Mufid 'Asas'a, a 28 year old resident of the village of 'Illar, causing burns to his face and leading to his transfer to the Tulkarem Hospital for treatment. <u>Attack</u>: At 02:00, an Israeli jeep chased a civilian vehicle near the village of Beit Lid, opening heavy fire at the vehicle which escaped. |

| NABLUS | <u>Closure</u> : Nablus remains a closed military area. |
| HEBRON | Activity not yet reported. |
| QALQILYA | <u>Closure</u>: The southern entrance to the city from the DCO checkpoint is open to civilians from 22:00 until 05:00. <u>Separation Wall Gates</u>: Only civilians granted Israeli permits are allowed through the separation wall gates. <u>Separation Wall Construction</u>: Israeli survey teams continue surveying the land enclosed between the villages of Kafr Laqif, the town of 'Azzun and the town of Kafr Thulth. Construction is anticipated in the coming week. |
| SALFIT | Checkpoint: At 11:15, the Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint at the entrance of the village of Iskaka, where they detained and searched vehicles and examined the IDs of passengers. Attack: At 20:00, the Israeli army fired flares above the city and opened fire sporadically from a tank located east of the city towards the area of Wadi Abdul Rahman. Raids: At 23:15, the Israeli army, including 3 jeeps, raided the town of Deir Istiya. At 04:10, Israeli troops raided the town of Kafr al Dik, where they fired sound bombs, raided several houses and arrested 2 civilians—one of whom is a minor. At 05:00, the troops were then reinforced by 2 APC's and 4 jeeps that remained present until 07:00. Arrests: the Israeli army arrested 2 civilians from Kafr ad Dik: Nimer Muhammad Shamma, 16 years old; and Yusif Raja ad Dik, 26 years old. |

| NORTHERN GAZA | <u>Closure</u>: The Erez crossing is partially open to workers. <u>Attack</u>: At 09:10 and again at 11:10, the Israeli army opened heavy fire from Point 34 towards civilian houses north Beit Hanoun. |

| GAZA CITY | Closures: Al Shuhada' junction (Nitsareem) remains closed. Al Mintar crossing (Karni) remains closed. Land Leveling: At 14:30, Israeli bulldozers, supported by a tank, leveled land in Wadi Gaza, 200 meters inside Palestinian territory near Point 95. Attack: At 16:45, the Israeli army opened fire at a civilian vehicle traveling on the eastern line, injuring a civilian. Injury: The Israeli army injured Dowlat Malaka, a female civilian. |
| CENTRAL GAZA | Activity not yet reported. |
| KHAN YUNIS | Closures: Abu Ajin road and the western road remain closed. Abu Holi road was partially opened. Attacks: At 17:30, the Israeli army opened fire from Point 5 towards nearby civilian houses. At 19:40, the Israeli army opened fire from Points 9, 10, 11 and 12 towards the east and Al Namsawi neighborhood. |
| RAFAH | Closures: The Gaza International Airport remains closed. Sufa crossing is closed. Rafah crossing is partially open. Attacks: At 10:10, the Israeli army opened heavy fire from the settlement of eastern Morag towards the south. At 17:30, the Israeli army opened fire sporadically from its location in Tel Zu'rob, injuring 1 civilian. Injury: The Israeli army injured Ahmad Hijazi. |
