- (iii) At 08:30, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Al-Urub camp.
- (iv) At 11:20, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Beit Ummar.
- (v) At 16:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Al-Fuwar camp, temporarily detained 3 residents: Nabil Qumi, Hassan Hillis and Jamal Shawabqeh and released them after summoning them to report to Israeli intelligence for questioning.
- (vi) At 16:50, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the south entrance of Dura.

- **Raid:**

- (i) At 08:30, Israeli forces raided Beit Ummar and detained 2 children.
- (ii) At 08:50, Israeli forces raided Hebron and set up a checkpoint.
- (iii) At 11:45, Israeli forces raided Zif village detained a child, temporarily detained 3 residents including 2 children: Mu'tasim Al-Aroui (14 years old), Amir Dawahidat (16 years old) and Haytham Al-Amour then released them at a later time.
- (iv) At dawn on November 28<sup>th</sup> 2013, Israeli forces raided Tafuh and detained resident.
- (v) At dawn on November 28<sup>th</sup> 2013, Israeli forces raided Beit Awa and detained a resident.

- **Detention:**

- (i) At 19:35 on November 26<sup>th</sup> 2013, Israeli forces detained 2 residents: Anas Al-Ajouri and Nade Al-Rajabi during their raid into Hebron.
- (ii) Israeli forces detained 2 residents: Hani Salibi (17 years old) and Yahya Abu Maria (17 years old) in Beit Ummar.
- (iii) Israeli forces detained Nimr Abu Aram (17 years old) in Zif village.
- (iv) Israeli forces detained Zaki Ghanam in Tafuh village.
- (v) Israeli forces detained Shadi Masalmeh in Beit Awa.

- **Attack:**

- (i) At 08:45, Israeli forces positioned in Bab Al-Zawiya area in Hebron fired rubber coated steel bullets and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and as a result injured 7 residents: Mohammad Al-Zir, Musa Amarna, Lu'ay Shadid, Ali Al-Falah, Baha Manasra, Amir Thib and Muhanad Al-Huwarin.
- (ii) At 10:20, Israeli forces positioned at Al-Tabaqa village junction fired rubber coated steel bullets and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.
- (iii) At 16:00, Israeli forces positioned in the vicinity of Tariq Bin Zayed school located in the old city of Hebron fired rubber coated steel bullets and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.
- (iv) At 17:50, Israeli forces positioned near Halhul bridge fired rubber coated steel bullets and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.
- (v) At 20:15, Israeli forces positioned at Khursa village junction fired rubber coated steel bullets and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.

- **Obstruction of Education Sector:** At 09:10, Israeli forces closed a school in the old city of Hebron after 3 residents were killed as mentioned in the previous report.

- **Wall Construction:** Wall construction continued in the area surrounding the illegal settlement Eshkolot, west of Al-Thahriya town.
