## JERUSALEM

- **Closure:**
  - (i) The Israeli army, intensified their restrictions at the entrance to Jerusalem city, set up several flying checkpoints on the main road leading to the city and prevented worshipers under the age of 40 from conducting prayers at Al-Aqsa mosque compound.
  - (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the ‘demarcation area’ along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits.
  - (iii) The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill between Biddu and Beit Iksa villages.
- **Closure of Main Roads:**
  - (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the entrance to Jaba’ village.
  - (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to Beit Iksa village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandiya checkpoint.
  - (iii) At 08:00, Israeli forces closed the entrance of Al-Thuri neighbourhood with cement blocks.
  - (iv) At 09:00, Israeli forces closed the entrance of Sur Bahar village with cement blocks.
  - (v) At 09:55, Israeli forces closed the entrance of Jabal Al-Mukabir neighbourhood with cement blocks.
  - (vi) At 22:00, Israeli forces closed the entrance of North Al-Ram junction with dirt mounds.
- **Checkpoints:**
  - (i) Israeli authorities continue to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a “border crossing point” and designate a special crossing lane for holders of Jerusalem IDs and another for those possessing permits to access Jerusalem city.
  - (ii) On September 19<sup>th</sup> 2012, Israeli forces closed Ras Khamis checkpoint near Shu’fat camp and impeded the free flow of traffic in order to construct the wall.
- **Raid:** At 10:40, Israeli forces raided Anata and stormed and searched a home.
- **Detention:**
  - (i) On the morning of November 27<sup>th</sup> 2014, Israeli forces detained two residents: Ahmad Awisat and Mahmoud Awisat in Jabal Al-Mukabir.
  - (ii) On the morning of November 27<sup>th</sup> 2014, Israeli forces detained two residents: Sa’ed Abu Snieneh and Radwan Amro in Silwan neighbourhood.
  - (iii) At 18:35, Israeli forces positioned near Al-Majlis gate (A main entrance gate leading to Al-Aqsa mosque compound in the old city of Jerusalem) detained Nabil Sader (A resident of the old city of Jerusalem).
  - (iv) At 05:00, Israeli forces detained three residents: Foad Rawadi, Khaldoun Sarhan and Sa’id Abu Sanad after storming their homes in Silwan neighbourhood.
- **Assault on Places of Worship:** On the morning of November 27<sup>th</sup> 2014, Israeli settlers under the protection of Israeli forces stormed Al-Aqsa mosque compound in the old city of Jerusalem and provoked worshipers.
- **Wall Gates:**
  - (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the Wall gate in Abu Dis town.
  - (ii) The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate on Al-Shayyah road in the area between Al-Sawahira Al-Sharqiya and Al-Slewahira Al-Gharbiya villages, only allowing civilians holding Jerusalem

	IDs to cross, after subjecting them to thorough searches using electronic devices.

<b>ALL DISTRICTS</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• At 19:00 on August 26<sup>th</sup> 2014, Palestinian Gunmen and the Israeli military agreed to a cease fire agreement (brokered by the Arab Republic of Egypt) which includes the opening of border crossings to allow the entry of emergency supplies and humanitarian goods as well as construction material and agreed to increase the fishing limit to 6 nautical miles with possibility of increase to 12 nautical miles by the end of the year and to decrease the Military area to 100 meters, allow freedom of movement and a halt to targeted killings and assassinations and negotiations will be held for discussion on rebuilding the sea port and airports in the coming month.</li> <li>• Israeli forces broke the cease-fire agreement by firing tank artillery shells from their positions behind the Green Line towards Central Gaza, Khan Yunis and Rafah.</li> <li>• Palestinian gunmen broke the cease-fire agreement by opening fire towards an Israeli Military jeep passing along the border fence.</li> </ul>
<b>NORTHERN GAZA</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b><u>Closure of Crossing Point:</u></b> Beit Hanun (Erez) is open for the passage of critical patients, journalists, NGO staff, businesspersons and passengers travelling abroad through Al-Karama crossing with previous coordination.</li> </ul>
