JERUSALEM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) On November 27th 2015, the Israeli army, intensified their restrictions at the entrance to Jerusalem city, set up several flying checkpoints on the main road leading to the city and prevented worshipers under the age of 50 from conducting prayers at Al-Aqsa mosque compound which forced residents to conduct prayers near checkpoints located outside Al-Aqsa mosque compound. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the ‘demarcation area’ along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits. (iii) The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill between Biddu and Beit Iksa villages. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the entrance to Jaba’ village. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to Beit Iksa village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandiya checkpoint. (iii) On October 14th 2015, Israeli forces closed the main road leading to Al-Eisawiya village with cement blocks. (iv) On October 14th 2015, Israeli forces closed the 4 entrances of Jabal Al-Mukabir neighbourhood with cement blocks. (v) On October 14th 2015, Israeli forces closed the three entrances of Sur Bahar with Cement blocks. (vi) On October 14th 2015, Israeli forces closed the entrance of Al-Tur neighbourhood (leading to Al-Za’im village in Jericho and Al-Eizariya) and Suliman French road with cement blocks. (vii) On October 14th 2015, Israeli forces closed the entrance of Wadi Al-Rabaybeh area in Silwan neighbourhood in Jerusalem with cement blocks. • <u>Checkpoints:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli authorities continue to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a “border crossing point” and designate a special crossing lane for holders of Jerusalem IDs and another for those possessing permits to access Jerusalem city. (ii) On September 19th 2012, Israeli forces closed Ras Khamis checkpoint near Shu’fat camp and impeded the free flow of traffic in order to construct the wall. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 12:45, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Hizma. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 15:10 Israeli forces raided Hizma and forced shop owners to shutdown then withdrew at 16:55. (ii) At 05:30, Israeli forces raided Qalandiya camp, stormed and searched several homes and detained a resident • <u>Killing:</u> At 09:50, Israeli forces opened fire towards and killed Fadi Mohammad Mahmoud Khasib (31 years old) {A resident of Arroura village in Ramallah} for alleged running over two Israeli soldiers as alleged by the Israeli military. • <u>Detention:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 22:00, Israeli forces positioned at Jaba’ checkpoint detained Mohammad Husam Al-Faroukh (A resident of Sa’ir) and temporarily

(ii) At 12:45, Israeli forces positioned in the vicinity of Qalandiya checkpoint fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning. (iii) At 13:00, Israeli forces positioned near Anata fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning. (iv) At 13:00, Israeli forces positioned near Al-Quds University junction in Abu Dis fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning. (v) At 15:00, Israeli forces positioned near the entrance of Anata fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning. • <u>Home Demolition:</u> At 12:45, Israeli forces stormed Silwan neighbourhood and served a military order for the demolition of several homes. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the Wall gate in Abu Dis town. (ii) The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate on Al-Shayyah road in the area between Al-Sawahira Al-Sharqiya and Al-Slewahira Al-Gharbiya villages, only allowing civilians holding Jerusalem IDs to cross, after subjecting them to thorough searches using electronic devices.

On October 3rd 2015, Israeli forces closed the main road located near "Bet El" settlement and leading to Al-Jalazoun camp with cement blocks. (iii) On November 24th 2015, Israeli forces closed the main entrance gate leading to Sinjil and the east entrance of Mughier with cement blocks. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 14:40, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Um Safa village then searched residents and vehicles until 17:15. (ii) At 16:20, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Ein Yabroud village then searched residents and vehicles until 17:20. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 18:05, Israeli forces raided Beituniya. (ii) At 21:45, Israeli forces raided Budrous village, clashed with several residents then withdrew at 02:30. • <u>Detention:</u> At 18:10, Israeli forces detained 2 children: Imad Hamad (16 years old) and Sanad Abdallah (16 years old) near Yabroud village. • <u>Attack:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 12:25, Israeli forces positioned at the entrance of "Ofar" military base / prison fired live ammunition, rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents (who were protesting against the continued Israeli Military and Settler assault on Al-Aqsa mosque compound) for alleged stoning and as a result injured 11 residents including 2 children: Wissam Issa (15 years old) and Majdi Salah (17 years old), Yazan TANATRAH, Ali Zawi and Ra'fat Hassan.. (ii) At 13:15, Israeli forces positioned in the vicinity of "Pesagout"

(ii) Since the evening of November 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the western entrance of Ya'bad. • <u>Attack:</u> At 14:15, Israeli forces positioned near the wall gate in Al-Arqa village fired live ammunition; rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> Israeli forces continue to close the wall gate and only allow those holding special permits to enter through it.
TULKAREM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Checkpoint:</u> At 14:50, Israeli forces continue to intensify their restrictions at "Eniv" checkpoint located along the main road connecting Tulkarem and Nablus and impeded the free flow of traffic. • <u>Raid:</u> At 17:25, Israeli forces raided Zieta village until 17:50. • <u>Attack:</u> At 14:40, Israeli forces positioned near "Ghishoury" factories located in west Tulkarem fired rubber coated steel bullets stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents (as they were protesting against Israeli Military and settler assault on Al Alqsa mosque compound) for alleged stoning.

(ii) In addition to closing the gate installed since the outbreak the second Intifada, the Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the eastern entrance to Kafr Qaddum village. (iii) Since 16:55 on December 18th 2014, Israeli forces closed an agricultural road leading to Far'ata village which is located near "Gillad" settlement

	<p>with dirt mounds</p> <p>(iv) Since 10:40 on September 1st 2015, Israeli forces closed an agricultural road leading to Far'ata village which is located near "Gillad" settlement with a steel Gate</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 17:45, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Qalqiliya. • <u>Raid:</u> At 13:40, Israeli forces raided Qalqiliya, clashed with several residents and as a result set fire to a home furniture owned by Wael Daoud after a tear gas grenades canister exploded inside his home during which Palestinian Civil defence forces were able to put out the flames during which Israeli forces fired rubber coated steel bullets towards a Palestinian Red Crescent Ambulance as it carrying injured residents then withdrew at 16:30. • <u>Attack:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 13:30, Israeli forces positioned near the wall gate in West Qalqiliya fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and as a result injured 4 residents including 3 children: Imad Zied (16 years old), Muhanad Muwafi (17 years old), Abdallah Daoud (17 years old), and Ibrahim Daoud: as well as leaving several others suffocated from tear gas inhalation including a 2 week infant: Jawad Daoud. (ii) At 17:30, Israeli forces positioned near "Ayal" crossing located along the Green Line in North Qalqiliya fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning. • <u>Settler Violence:</u> At 19:35, Israeli settlers positioned near Jit village junction stoned residents, vehicles, and as a result injured Dina Khader (60 years old) with injury to the head leaving her hospitalised. • <u>Demonstration:</u> At 12:00, a demonstration took place in Kafr Qaddum against the closure of the east entrance during which they clashed with Israeli forces tried to disrupt the demonstration by firing live ammunition, rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards demonstrators who attempted to reach they demonstration site and as a result left several others suffocated from tear gas inhalation. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to restrict access at 'Azzun 'Atma Wall gate and impeded the free flow of traffic. The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the entrance to the village of Wadi Al- Rasha and to deny civilian access. (ii) The Israeli army allows residents to access the village through Gate #109. Having removed the gate at the entrance to the village of Ras Atiya; the Israeli army only allows students to cross to their schools outside the village through the Habla gate.
NABLUS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> Since December 17th 2013, Israeli forces ordered the closure 500 dunums of land in Qusra village as a closed military area. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the roads of Til-Burin and Beit Furik-Salem; the settler bypass road connecting the village of Deir al Hatab to the settlement of Alon Moreh; the road connecting the town of 'Aqraba to the village of Osrin; and the detour road between the town of Qabalan and the village of Osrin. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the northern entrance to Qabalan town; the southern entrances to the town of Jamma'in and the villages of Duma and Qaryut. (iii) At 22:00 on October 3rd 2015, Israeli forces closed the North entrance of Awarta village with dirt mounds. • <u>Checkpoint:</u> At 13:30, Israeli forces closed Beit Furiq checkpoint {because of the alleged presence of Israeli settlers in the area, impeded the free flow of traffic then reopened it at a later time.

(ii) At 21:45, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Yatma village junction then searched residents and vehicles until 22:45. • <u>Raid:</u> At 23:45, Israeli forces raided Jama'in, clashed with several residents then withdrew at 00:10. • <u>Attack:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 15:05, Israeli forces positioned near Qusra village fired live ammunition, rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents and farmers for alleged stoning and as a result drove them from their agricultural land located near "Ayish Qodosh" settlement and injured 2 residents including a child: Khalil Khattabah (17 years old) and Salah Hanini and also temporarily seized an Ambulance as it was carrying wounded civilians then withdrew at 17:45. • <u>Confiscation of Property:</u> At 18:00, Israeli forces positioned near Beit Dajan village confiscated a bulldozer owned by Ashraf Hassuneh (A resident of Assirah Al-Shimaliya) for allegedly levelling a plot of land owned by Zidan Zaghlan (a resident of Beit Dajjan) located in area C which is under Israeli Military and administrative control.
SALFIT	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the entrance to two detour roads connecting Marda village to its farmland. (ii) On 15.04.2012, the Israeli army has opened the northern entrance to Salfit city to civilian which was closed since the year 2000 and prevented access from 08:00 until 09:20. (iii) Since 11:00 on July 30th 2012, Israeli forces have closed two roads leading to Abu Nasar and Qatan Al-Jama' located in western area of Deir Istiya with cement blocks. • <u>Checkpoint:</u> Israeli forces intensified their restrictions at Za'tara checkpoint and impeded the free flow of traffic. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 13:30, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Al-Zawiya then searched residents and vehicles. (ii) At 19:40, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Deir Ballout and confiscated a vehicle owned by Ayman Abdel Raziq. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 15:00, Israeli forces raided Kafr Al-Dik until 16:00. (ii) At 15:10, Israeli forces raided Deir Istiya, occupied a home owned by Yasser Abu Zied and converted its rooftop into a Military post and again at 01:00 stormed a home then withdrew at a later time. (iii) At 24:00, Israeli forces raided Iskaka village. • <u>Attack:</u> At 13:35, Israeli forces positioned at the North entrance of Salfit fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.
JERICHO	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Checkpoints:</u> Israeli forces continue to intensify its restrictions at Al-Hamra checkpoint set up along the road connecting Jericho and Nablus District. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 08:30, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the south entrance of Jericho then searched residents and vehicles until 10:00. • <u>Raid:</u> At 02:00, Israeli forces raided Jericho and Ein Al-Sultan camp, detained a resident and summoned 3 residents: Mohammad Wajih Abu Lawi, Musa Ibrahim Mash'al and Basil Hussini Al-Wazir then withdrew at 03:20.

BETHLEHEM

- **Closure:**
 - (i) The Israeli army continues to close roads to An Nu'man village, with the exception of the road leading to the Wall gate in the south-eastern area of the village.
 - (ii) Since 15 September 2007, the Israel army has prevented civilians from accessing or staying on 22 dunums of confiscated land in Al Mazmuriya area in Beit Sahur and Bethlehem cities.
- **Closure of Main Roads:**
 - (i) The Israeli army continues to close the Beit Jala-Wadi Ahmed road; a road between Um Tuba and Al-Jass ; a road between Um Tuba and Khilat Nu'man: a road between Um Tuba and the wall; a road between Al-Khas village and the wall; the 2 by pass roads located south of Al-Walaja; a road between Talita Qumi and Nazlat Al-Sider in Beit Jala; the eastern road of Al-Khader; the road between Al-Khader and Beit Jala ; Wadi Rahal road near "Ifrat" settlement ,the road between Al-Khader and road #60 which lead to the eastern neighbourhoods of Bethlehem; a road leading to Wadi Rahal, and a road east of Beit Fajjar town with dirt mounds.
 - (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the road leading to "Newe Daniyyel" settlement and agricultural land in Al-Khader; a road between Um Tuba and Wadi Al-Hums: Wadi Fukin, Al-Jaba, the Green Line; a road between Za'tara and a detour road, and a road between Taqou and Khirbet Al-Deir with cement blocks.
 - (iii) Since August 2nd 2012, Israeli forces closed a road leading to Beit Jalla.
 - (iv) Since May 8th 2013, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Carmisan area in Beit Jalla and Al-Walaja with a steel gate and barbed wires.
 - (v) Since June 3rd 2013, the Israeli army closed the road connecting Nihalin and road 60 with dirt mounds.
 - (vi) Since 13:20 on September 29th 2013, the Israeli army closed a road leading to 50 acres of agricultural land in Wadi Salem area in Al-Khadr with dirt mounds.
 - (vii) Israeli forces closed the main road connecting Surif and Al-Jub'a village with dirt mounds.
 - (viii) On January 28th 2014, Israeli forces closed the steel gate at the entrance of Nihalin { replacing the dirt mounds placed at the entrance since the year 2002} and placed time schedule for opening the gate from 06:00 until 14:00 on a daily bases.
 - (ix) Since 10:45 on September 8th 2015, Israeli forces closed the agricultural road located in Arab Al-Rashaydeh village located near "Malee Amous" settlement with dirt mounds.
 - (x) Since 15:30 on November 20th 2015, Israeli forces closed the east entrance of Jinata with dirt mounds.
 - (xi) At 13:10 on November 22nd 2015, Israeli forces closed the entrance of Marah Rabah village with dirt mounds.
 - (xii) At 18:00 on November 27th 2015, Israeli forces closed Barrarat junction located in Al-Ras area in Beit Jalla with cement blocks.
- **Flying Checkpoint:**
 - (i) At 09:45, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Beit Fajjar then searched residents and vehicles.
 - (ii) At 13:30, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint near "Kafr Itsiyon" settlement and impeded the free flow of traffic from both directions going to and from Hebron city and then redirected traffic towards Beit Fajjar then allowed vehicles to pass through at a later time.
 - (iii) At 17:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the North entrance of Taqou' then searched residents and vehicles.
- **Raid:** At dawn on November 27th 2015, Israeli forces raided Al-Ayda camp and

detained a resident after storming his home.

- **Attack:**

- (i) At 12:30, Israeli forces positioned in the vicinity of Billal Bin Rabah mosque located in North Bethlehem, in Al-Ayda camp located in North Bethlehem and in Um Al-Rakaba in Al-Khader fired live ammunition, rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and as a result injured Ibrahim Mohammad Ibrahim Jabarin as well as suffocating the infant leaving several others suffocated from tear gas inhalation.
- (ii) At 13:15, Israeli forces positioned in Ush Al-Ghurab area located in east Beit Sahuor fired; rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and detained two children.
- (iii) At 14:30, Israeli forces positioned at the entrance of Beit Fajjar fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.
- (iv) At 14:30, Israeli forces positioned at the entrance of Taqou' fired , rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and as a result injured Ahmad Abu Mafraj and occupied 3 homes owned by Musa Abu Mafraj, Riyad Al-Amour and Saleem Abu Mafrah.
- (v) At 15:30, Israeli forces positioned near Um Raqaba area in Khader fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.

- **Detention:**

- (i) Israeli forces detained Fathi Abu Sarour in Al-Ayda camp in Bethlehem.
- (ii) Israeli forces detained 2 children: Abdel-Raheem Mahmoud Al-Samarin (14 years old) and Abdel-Rahaman Mahmoud Al-Samarin (13 years old) in Ush Al-Ghurab area in east Beit Sahur.

HEBRON

- **Closure:**
 - (i) The Israeli army continues to close Khuzq Al-Far areas, as well as the old gold market in Hebron's Old City. In addition to closing the entrance to Al-Qeisi neighbourhood, the Israeli army continues to close the entrances to the area of Al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) with an electronic gate; Al-Laban Market also remains closed.
 - (ii) Since 05 January 2009, the Israeli army has closed the area located along the Green Line south of the town of Yatta. Having seized land for Wall construction, the Israeli army evicted the Palestinian residents and denied them access to the area.
- **Closure of Main Roads:**
 - (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Al-Karmil villages.
 - (ii) The Israeli army continues to prohibit Palestinian vehicles from travelling along the old Al-Shalala Street leading to Hebron's Old City.
 - (iii) The Israeli army continues to close all roads leading to Road # 60 as well as detour roads along the settler bypass road leading to Yatta town.
 - (iv) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds a detour road leading to e to Al-Simiya village, the southern entrance of Al-Samou' and the entrance of Beit Annun with cement blocks.
 - (v) At 05:50 on November 5th 2015, Israeli forces closed the entrance leading Farsh Al-Hawa area in Hebron with Cement blocks.
 - (vi) At 10:30 on November 8th 2015, Israeli forces closed the junction located near "Hagi" settlement located in south Hebron with cement blocks.
 - (vii) At 21:00 on November 11th 2015, Israeli forces closed the main road connecting Beit Awwa and Al-Majd village with cement block and dirt mounds.
 - (viii) At 15:00 on November 10th 2015, Israeli forces closed the north entrance of Al-Thahriya.
 - (ix) At 14:00 on November 20th 2015, Israeli forces closed the entrance of Obadat, Beit Amrah, Deir Al-Assil, Razeh, and Qorma villages with cement blocks.
 - (x) At 22:30, Israeli forces closed the entrance of Tal'at Abu Hadid area located in the old city of Hebron with cement blocks.
- **Flying Checkpoint:**
 - (i) At 09:40, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the north entrance of Hebron (located at bypass road (35) near Halhoul Bridge) then searched residents and vehicles.
 - (ii) At 14:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint near Al-Adasiya in south Sa'ir then searched and resident's vehicles.
 - (iii) At 14:30, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint near Khursa village junction then searched residents and vehicles.
 - (iv) At 23:55, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Halhoul Bridge then searched residents and vehicles.
- **Raid:**
 - (i) At dawn on November 27th 2015, Israeli forces raided Beit Ummar then stormed and searched 2 homes.
 - (ii) At 15:30, Israeli forces raided Beit Awwa and detained a resident after storming his home.
