Flying checkpoints: At 19:50, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Izzbat Al-Tabib. (i) (ii) At 19:50, Israeli forces set up a flying checkpoint at Jit village junction. Raid: (i) At 09:10, Israeli forces raided Azzoun town At 10:15, Israeli forces raided Habla village (ii) At 15:45, Israeli forces raided Sanirya village. (iii) **QALQILYA Detentions:** At 14:00, Israeli forces manning the checkpoint near the Green Line detained Rami Raddad, a resident of Al-Zawia town in Salfit, while trying to obtain an Israeli work permit. Settler Violence: At 15:05, a group of Israeli settlers hurled stones towards Palestinian cars driving near the entrance of Azzoun town on the Oalqilva-Nablus road. Three cars were damaged, including one owned by Abed Al-Khaleg Samha from Jayyous village. Wall Gates: (i) The Israeli army continues to restrict access at 'Azzun 'Atma Wall gate and to search civilians, including students, using a metal detector. The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the entrance to the (ii) village of Wadi Al-Rasha and to deny civilian access. The Israeli army allows residents to access the village through Gate #109. Having removed the gate at the entrance to the village of Ras 'Atiya; the Israeli army only allows students to cross to their schools outside the village through the Habla gate. Wall Construction: Wall construction continued in Kafr Lagef village north of Karnei Shomron settlement; in Immatin village northeast of Imanuel settlement; and east of Kafr Thulth town near Ma'ale Shomron settlement and between Azzoun Atma and Oriniet settlement.. **Closure of Main Roads:** The Israeli army continues to close the roads of Till-Burin and Beit Furik-(i) Salem; the settler bypass road connecting the village of Deir al Hatab to the settlement of Alon Moreh; the road connecting the town of 'Agraba to the village of Osrin; and the detour road between the town of Qabalan and the village of Osrin. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the northern entrance to Qabalan town; the southern entrances to the town of Jamma'in and the villages of Duma and Qaryut. **Checkpoints:** (i) Al-Tur neighbourhood checkpoint (set up on Jerzim Mount) is closed on Fridays and Saturdays as well as during Jewish holidays. On all other days, it **NABLUS** is open between 07:00 and, 02:00 At 'Awarta commercial checkpoint, civilians are only allowed to cross (ii) between 05:00 and 20:00, and between 05:00 and 15:00 on Fridays. All vehicles can access the city of Nablus, but only commercial vehicles and ambulances can leave the city through the checkpoint. At 13:10, the Israeli army increased restrictions at Shave Shomron checkpoint (iii) and impeded the free flow of traffic. Flying checkpoint: At 12:50, Israeli forces setup a checkpoint at Al-Maslakh junction, which (i) leades to the eastern neighbourhoods in Nablus. (ii) At 15:30, Israeli forces setup a checkpoint on Al-Bathan road, the eastern entrance to Nablus.

Closure of Main Roads: The Israeli army continues to close the Beit Jala-Wadi **BETHLEHEM** Ahmed road; a road east of Beit Fajjar town; the road connecting Tuqu' town to Khirbet al Bag'a village; and the detour road connecting Wadi Fukin and Al Jab'a villages. **Checkpoint:** At 10:45, Israeli army continues to restrict access at the "Container" checkpoint and impeded the free flow of traffic and at 22:55, Israeli forces closed the checkpoint and denied entry of residents and reopened it at a later time. **Flying Checkpoint:** At 12:55, Israeli forces set up a flying checkpoint at Al-Nashash junction (at (i) the northern entrance of Bethlehem). (ii) At 13:35 and again at 19:25, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Taqou village. At 20:10, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint near Dar Salah village. (iii) At 21:20, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the eastern entrance of Beit Fajar (iv) town. Raids: (i) On 28.11.2011 at 06:00, Israeli forces raided Al-Walajah village and detained 2 brothers. Between 18:05 and 19:25, Israeli forces raided Marah Rabah villageand (ii) clashed with residents. At 18:10, Israeli forces raided east of Beit Fajar town and searched several (iii) quarries in the area before withdrawing at 19:25 At 03:30, Israeli forces raided Al-Khader town, searched a home and detained (iv) 2 residents. **Arrests:** Israeli forces detained Sager and Ahmad Al-Araj during their raid on Al-(i) Walajah. Israeli forces detained Mohammed Salah and Alaa Daadou during their raid (ii) on Al-Khader town. Wall Construction: Wall construction continued northwest of Beit Jala town. **Closure:** (i) The Israeli army continues to close Al-Shuhada' Street, Al-Sahleh and Khuzq Al-Far areas, as well as the old gold market in Hebron's Old City. In addition to closing the entrance to Al-Oeisi neighbourhood, the Israeli army continues to close the entrances to the area of Al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) with an electronic gate; Al-Laban Market also remains closed. Since 05 January 2009, the Israeli army has closed the area located along the (ii) Green Line south of the town of Yatta. Having seized land for Wall construction, the Israeli army evicted the Palestinian residents and denied them access to the area. **Closure of Main Roads:** The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Al-Dhahiriya and Al-(i) Samoa' towns, Al-'Arrub refugee camp, and Al-Tuwani and Al-Karmil

villages.

- <u>Wall Construction</u>: Wall construction continued in the area surrounding the illegal settlement Eshkolot, west of Al-Thahiriya town.

GAZA STRIP

ALL DISTRICTS • At 02:00 on 18 January 2009, the unilateral ceasefire declared by Israel came into effect. At a later time on the same day, armed Palestinian groups announced an agreement to cease fire. The ceasefire has been further renewed on 30 October 2011 at 22:00. • Israeli forces broke the cease fire agreement by raiding and opening fire towards fishermen boats off the shores of Gaza and detained 2 fishermen and confiscated their boat.
