WEST BANK

• Closure:

- (i) Israeli forces continue to intensify their restrictions at checkpoints located at the entrance to Jerusalem city.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the 'demarcation area' along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits.
- (iii) The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill between Biddu and Beit Iksa villages.

• Closure of Main Roads:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the entrance to Jaba' village.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to Beit Iksa village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandiya checkpoint.

JERUSALEM

• Checkpoints:

- (i) Israeli authorities continue to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a "border crossing point" and designate a special crossing lane for holders of Jerusalem IDs and another for those possessing permits to access Jerusalem city and at 06:00, Israeli forces closed the checkpoint impeded the free flow of traffic.
- (ii) On September 19th 2012, Israeli forces closed Ras Khamis checkpoint near Shu'fat camp and impeded the free flow of traffic in order to construct the wall.

Killing:

- (i) At 02:30, the child Nour Afana (14 years old), a resident of Abu Dis in Jerusalem died waiting at a checkpoint after Israeli forces intensified restrictions and would not allow the ambulance transporting her to a hospital in Bethlehem to pass through the checkpoint.
- (ii) At 21:00, Mahmoud Awad, a resident of Qalandiya camp died of a serious head injury sustained after a tear gas grenade struck him during confrontations with Israeli forces near Qalandiya camp on March 2nd 2013.

Attack:

(i) At 19:20, Israeli forces positioned in Sur Bahar village fired rubber coated steel

- bullets and tear gas grenades towards residents for alleged stoning after Israel; forces stormed a home and detained 3 residents including 2 children.
- (ii) At 22:30, Israeli forces positioned at Qalandiya checkpoint fired rubber coated steel bullets and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and as a result injured 2 residents including a child: Zakariya Hamad (17 years old) and Omar Shihadeh.
- <u>Detention:</u> Israeli forces detained 3 residents: Oday Atwan (17 years old), Mohammad Atwan (16 years old) and Ahmad Atwan in Sur Bahur village.
- **Physical Assault:** At 20:30, Israeli forces assaulted Omar Al-Anin, a guard at Al-Aqsa mosque compound as he attempted to close the main gate leading to Al-Aqsa mosque to prevent settlers from storming the area.

• Assault on Places of Worship:

- (i) At 08:30, Israeli settlers under the protection of Israeli forces stormed Al-Aqsa Mosque compound in the old city of Jerusalem and provoked worshipers.
- (ii) At 05:10, on November 29th 2013, an Israeli settler dressed in an Islamic prayer gown attempted to storm Al-Aqsa mosque before mosque guards prevented he from entering the mosque.
- <u>Settler Violence</u>: At 16:30, Israeli settlers stormed Mukhmas village and attempted to steal 70 heads of livestock (goats) owned by Mohammad Ka'abneh then withdrew under the protection of Israeli forces.

• Wall Gates:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the Wall gate in Abu Dis town.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate on Al-Shayyah road in the area between Al-Sawahira Al-Sharqiya and Al-Slewahira Al-Gharbiya villages, only allowing civilians holding Jerusalem IDs to cross, after subjecting them to thorough searches using electronic devices.
- Wall Construction: Wall construction continued in the areas north and south of Qalandiya village; south of Al-Za'ayyem village; and in Wadi Al-Eizariya west of the illegal settlement Ma 'ale Adumim.

• Closure of Main Roads:

(i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Sinjil village well as the junction to Kafr Malik and 'Ein Samiya villages.

• Flying Checkpoint:

- (i) At 16:30, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint near Al-Haramiya area junction located along the main road connecting Ramallah and Nablus.
- (ii) At 21:15, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Al-Taybeh junction located along the main road connecting Ramallah and Jericho until 24:00.
- (iii) At 21:55, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Sinjil junction and detained 2 residents.

RAMALLAH & AL BIREH

• Raid:

- (i) At 16:00, Israeli forces raided Turmus'aya and detained the child Muhanad Abu Aliya (13 years old) then released him at a later time.
- (ii) At 01:00, Israeli forces raided Al-Bireh city, stormed and searched a home after damaging the main entrance of Mohammad Matariyas home then withdrew at 02:30.
- (iii) At 03:00, Israeli forces raided Qubar village.
- **<u>Detention</u>**: Israeli forces detained Fadi Muharib and Amir Alawi near Sinjil junction.
- Attack: At 18:00, Israeli forces positioned at the entrance of Al-Mazra'a Al-Gharbiya fired rubber coated steel bullets and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.
- Wall Construction: Wall construction continued in the area west of 'Abud town in the area surrounding the illegal settlement 'Ofarim and north of Al-Lubban Al-Gharbi and Rantis village.

JENIN	 Closure of Main Road: The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the road leading to the town of 'Arraba east of the illegal settlement Dotan. Since the evening of November 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the western entrance of Ya'bad. Flying Checkpoint: At 13:50, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Al-Yamoun. Raid: At 10:10, Israeli forces raided Barta'a Al-Sharqiya village located behind the wall gate, served demolition orders to demolish 8 home and 7 barrack owned by Abdel Karim Tu'meh {A home under construction and a barracks}, Ayus Qubha {A home}, Raed Qubha {a home}, Anas Qubha {a home under construction}, Yahya Qubha {a 3 floor home}, Ayman Al-Baqi {a home and 2 barracks}, Yusuf Qubha {a home}, Raed Qubha {a home}, Bassam Qubha {2 barracks}, Abdallah Qubha and Suhiel Qubha {2 barracks} then withdrew at 12:30. At 18:00, Israeli forces raided Al-Yamoun. At 18:00, Israeli forces raided Al-Arqa village. At 03:50, Israeli forces raided Silat Al-Thaher, stormed a home and detained a resident. Detention: At 22:00, Israeli forces detained Yusuf Abu Shamaleh at the entrance of Ya'bad. Israeli forces detained Raed Musa in Silat Al-Thaher. Wall Gates: Passage through the Wall gates is restricted to civilians granted special Israeli permits, which undercuts the access to education and health services for civilians
TUBAS	 <u>Checkpoints:</u> At 13:20, Israeli forces intensified their restrictions at Tayasir checkpoint and impeded the free flow of traffic. <u>Temporary Detention:</u> At 18:00, Israeli forces positioned at Tayasir checkpoint temporarily detained Mahmoud Daraghmeh and released him after summoning him to report to Israeli intelligence for questioning. At 21:40, Israeli forces positioned at Tayasir checkpoint temporarily detained Eyed Eyegho (A Pelestinian Police officer) then released him at a later time.
TULKAREM	 Eyad Fuqaha (A Palestinian Police officer) then released him at a later time. Closure of Main Roads: The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the road connecting Kafr Al-Labad town to Shufa village. The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the detour road leading to Ramin village along the Tulkarem-Nablus main road. Wall Gates: Passage through the Wall gates is restricted to civilians granted special Israeli permits, which undercuts the access to education and health services for civilians living behind the Wall.
QALQILIYA	 Closure of Roads: (i) Israeli forces continue to close with cement blocks agricultural roads east of Azzun town. (ii) In addition to closing the gate installed since the outbreak the second Intifada, the Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the eastern entrance to Kafr Qaddum village. Flying Checkpoint:

- (i) At 08:55, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint along the main road leading to Qadumim settlement.
- (ii) At 09:15 and again at 23:50, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the east entrance of Qalqiliya.
- (iii) At 16:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Izbit Al-Tabib village.
- (iv) At 21:15, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint between Azzun and Kafr Thulth.

• Raid:

- (i) At 19:00, Israeli forces raided Wadi Al-Rasha.
- (ii) At 01:40, Israeli forces raided Qalqiliya until 02:50.
- (iii) At 02:55, Israeli forces raided Azzun, stormed several homes, detained 3 residents including a child then withdrew at 03:40.

• Detention:

- (i) Israeli forces detained Adnan Nazal at the east entrance of Qalqiliya.
- (ii) Israeli forces detained 3 residents: Hamza Radwan (17 years old), Ibrahim Hassan and Ehab Mash'al.
- <u>Land Levelling:</u> At 08:30, Israeli forces stormed Khilat Al-Ashra area located between Ras Al-Tireh and Ras Atiyeh and levelled 25 dunums (acres) of agricultural land and as a result uprooted several Olive trees owned by Marouf Al-Zahran, Ihsan Odeh, Jamal Arrar, Nasr Shawahneh and Khalid Shawahneh.

• Wall Gates:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to restrict access at 'Azzun 'Atma Wall gate and to search civilians, including students, using a metal detector impeded the free flow of traffic and at 11:55 closed the main entrance gate and impeded the free flow of traffic.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the entrance to the village of Wadi Al-Rasha and to deny civilian access. The Israeli army allows residents to access the village through Gate #109. Having removed the gate at the entrance to the village of Ras Atiya; the Israeli army only allows students to cross to their schools outside the village through the Habla gate.

• Wall Construction:

(i) Wall construction continued in Kafr Laqif village north of Karnei Shomron settlement; in Immatin village northeast of Immanuel settlement; and east of Kafr Thulth town near Ma 'ale Shomron settlement.

• Closure of Main Roads:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close the roads of Til-Burin and Beit Furik-Salem; the settler bypass road connecting the village of Deir al Hatab to the settlement of Alon Moreh; the road connecting the town of 'Aqraba to the village of Osrin; and the detour road between the town of Qabalan and the village of Osrin.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the northern entrance to Qabalan town; the southern entrances to the town of Jamma'in and the villages of Duma and Qaryut.
- Raid: At 03:15, Israeli forces raided Burqa village, stormed a home and detained a resident.
- **Detention:** Israeli forces detained Mustafa Haja in Burqa village.

• Settler Violence:

- (i) At 09:35, Israeli settlers stormed Al-Mas'oudiya area located near Burqa village, and sprayed racist graffiti at the entrance sign of the village then withdrew at 10:00.
- (ii) At 11:30, Israeli settler stormed agricultural land in Yanoun village as they herded their goats then withdrew at 12:00.

• Closure of Main Roads:

NABLUS

(i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the entrance to two detour roads connecting Marda village to its farmland.

	(ii) On 15.04.2012, the Israeli army has opened the northern entrance to Salfit city to civilian which was closed since the year 2000 and prevented access from 08:00
	until 09:20. (iii) Since 11:00 on July 30 th 2012, Israeli forces have closed two roads leading to Abu Nasar and Qatan Al-Jama' located in western area of Deir Istiya with cement
	 blocks. <u>Checkpoints:</u> Israeli forces continue their restrictions at Za'tara Al-checkpoint. <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 20:45, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Kafil
	 Harris. Provocation of Palestinian Security Forces: At 20:25, Israeli forces positioned at Za'atara checkpoint seized and searched a Palestinian Police vehicle then allowed it to pass through at 20:55.
	Wall Construction: Wall construction continued in the area north of Deir Istiya town southeast of the illegal settlement.
	 <u>Checkpoints:</u> At 16:45, Israeli forces intensified its restrictions at Al-Hamra checkpoint set up along the road connecting Jericho and Nablus District. <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 08:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint along road 90 near Al-Nu'emeh village located at the north entrance of Jericho.
JERICHO	 Temporary Detention: (i) At 17:20, Israeli forces positioned at Al-Humra checkpoint temporarily detained 3 residents: Tarik Abu Muhsien, Rami Daraghmeh and Sami Fuqaha then released them at a later time. (ii) At 21:20, Israeli forces positioned at Allenby bridge temporarily detained Ahmad Saleh as he was travelling to Jordan.
	 Closure: The Israeli army continues to close roads to An Nu'man village, with the exception of the road leading to the Wall gate in the south-eastern area of the village. Since 15 September 2007, the Israel army has prevented civilians from accessing or staying on 22 dunumes of confiscated land in Al Mazmuriya area in Beit Sahur and Bethlehem cities. Closure of Main Roads: The Israeli army continues to close the Beit Jala-Wadi Ahmed road; a road between Um Tuba and Al-Jass; a road between Um Tuba and Khilat Nu'man: a road between Um Tuba and the wall; a road between Al-Khas village and the wall; the 2 by pass roads located south of Al-Walaja; a road between Talita Qumi and Nazlat Al-Sider in Beit Jala; the eastern road of Al-Khader; the road between Al-Khader
BETHLEHEM	 and Beit Jala; the road between Al-Khader and road #60 which lead to the eastern neighbourhoods of Bethlehem; a road leading to Wadi Rahal, and a road east of Beit Fajjar town with dirt mounds. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the road leading to "Newe Daniyyel" settlement and agricultural land in Al-Khader; a road between Um Tuba and Wadi Al-Hums: Wadi Fukin, Al-Jaba, the Green Line; a road between Za'tara and a detour road, and
	a road between Taqou and Khirbet Al-Deir with cement blocks. (iii) Since August 2 nd 2012, Israeli forces closed a road leading to Beit Jalla. (iv) Since May 8 th 2013, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Carmisan area in Beit Jalla and Al-Walaja with a steel gate and barbed wires. (v) Since June 3 rd 2013, the Israeli army closed the road connecting Nihalin and road 60
	with dirt mounds. (vi) Since 13:20 on September 29th 2013, the Israeli army closed a road leading to 50 acres of agricultural land in Wadi Salem area in Al-Khadr with dirt mounds.
	 (vii) Since 14:00 on October 18th 2013, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Surif and Al-Jab'a village with dirt mounds Flying Checkpoint: At 23:30, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the west entrance of

Tagou until 01:15.

- <u>Raid:</u> At 04:00, Israeli forces raided Ayda camp and summoned Ahmad Swelim to report to Israeli Intelligence for questioning.
- <u>Detention:</u> At 18:55, Israeli forces detained Mohammad Khalaf, a resident of Bethlehem as he was reporting to Israeli intelligence for questioning based on a prior summon
- Attack: At 14:25, Israeli forces positioned near Al-Ayda camp fired rubber coated steel bullets and tears gas grenades towards residents for alleged stoning and as a result injured 4 residents: Mahmoud Mashayikh, Abdel Rahman Al-Aza, Omar Al-Ma'ali and Mohammad Al-Ja'idi.
- <u>Settler Violence:</u> At 11:20, Israeli settlers under the protection of Israeli forces stormed Al-Khadr and stoned the home Al-Musnie' Al-Mukarar then withdrew at 13:15.
- <u>Demonstration</u>: At 16:00, a demonstration took place near the Church of Nativity in Bethlehem protesting against Israeli Authority claims that Bethlehem is part of Israel.

• Wall Construction:

- (i) Wall construction continued in North West of Beit Jala town.
- (ii)On May 1st 2103, an Israeli court ordered the halt of wall construction near Betar village.
- (iii) On July 21st 2013, Israeli courts ordered the halt of construction of the wall in Al-Carmisan area in the west area of Beit Jalla.

• Closure:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close Al-Shuhada' Street, Al-Sahleh and Khuzq Al-Far areas, as well as the old gold market in Hebron's Old City. In addition to closing the entrance to Al-Qeisi neighbourhood, the Israeli army continues to close the entrances to the area of Al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) with an electronic gate; Al-Laban Market also remains closed.
- (ii) Since 05 January 2009, the Israeli army has closed the area located along the Green Line south of the town of Yatta. Having seized land for Wall construction, the Israeli army evicted the Palestinian residents and denied them access to the area.

• Closure of Main Roads:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Al-Thahiriya and Al-Samoa' towns, Al-'Arrub refugee camp, and Al-Tuwani and Al-Karmil villages.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to prohibit Palestinian vehicles from travelling along the old Al-Shalala Street leading to Hebron's Old City.
- (iii) The Israeli army continues to close all roads leading to Road # 60 as well as detour roads along the settler bypass road leading to Yatta town.
- (iv) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds a detour road leading to e to Al-Simiya village, the southern entrance of Al-Samou' and the entrance of Beit Annun with cement blocks.
- (v) Since July 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Safa and Al-Dirat and also closed the entrance of south Yatta with cement blocks.
- (vi) Since December 27th 2012, Israeli forces closed the west entrance of Swiesiya village which connects Yatta and Al-Samou' village with cement blocks.

• Flying Checkpoint:

- (i) At 15:30, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Al-Fuwar junction, temporally detained Nabil Al-Qumi (Civil defence officer) then released him after questioning by Israeli Intelligence officers.
- (ii) At 16:20, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Zif village junction.
- (iii) At 19:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Halhul bridge.

Raid:

(i) At dawn on November 28th 2013, Israeli forces raided Deir Sammit and detained a resident.

HEBRON

(ii) At 10:20, Israeli forces raided Al-Thahriya and damaged the main entrance	e to
Al-Hilal (Crescent) hospital.	

- (iii)At 15:30, Israeli forces raided Al-Samou'as they escorted several Israeli settlers as they stormed the area, clashed with several residents and as a result injured 3 children: Hakam Hamoudeh (13 years old), Ahmad Khalayleh (17 years old), Mushieb Abu Karsh (15 years old) leaving them hospitalised with contusions then withdrew at 17:25
- **Detention:** Israeli forces detained Issa Masalmeh in Deir Sammit.

Attack:

- (i) At 14:25, Israeli forces positioned near Al-Ayda camp in Bethlehem fired rubber coated steel bullets and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and as a result injured 4 residents: Mahmoud Mashayekh, Abdel Rahman Al-Aza, Omar Malee and Mohammad Al-Ju'eidi.
- (ii) At 18:15, Israeli forces positioned near Al-Urub camp fired tear gas grenades towards residents inside the camp for alleged stoning.
- <u>Settler Violence:</u> At 14:25, Israeli settlers stormed the old city of Hebron and attacked the home of Al-Rajabi family.
- <u>Wall Construction:</u> Wall construction continued in the area surrounding the illegal settlement Eshkolot, west of Al-Thahriya town.

At 21:00 on November 21st 2012, the unilateral ceasefire declared by Israel came into effect. At a later time on the same day, armed Palestinian groups announced an

agreement to cease fire. ALL On November 14th 2011 Israeli forces placed floating marks 3 miles from Gaza's **DISTRICTS** seashore and warned fishermen against passing beyond the mark and on November 24th 2012, Israeli forces imposed floating marks of 6 miles and on March 21st 2013 re imposed fishing restrictions of 3 miles. Closure of Crossing Point: Beit Hanun (Erez) is open for the passage of critical **NORTHERN** patients, journalists, NGO staff, businessmen and passengers travelling abroad **GAZA** through Al-Karama crossing with previous coordination. **Closure of Crossing Points:** (i) Al-Muntar (Karni) Crossing is closed. Beginning on 02 March 2011, the **GAZA** Crossing has been effectively closed following a unilateral Israeli decision. (ii) Al-Shija'iya (Nahal 'Oz) Crossing is closed. Beginning on 04 January 2010, the Crossing has been closed following a unilateral Israeli decision.

	• Rafah (<i>Al 'Awdah</i>) Crossing is open the entry and exit of residents, tourists' medical patients and International funded projects.
	 Sufa Crossing is closed.
RAFAH	 Karm Abu Salem (Karem Shalom) Crossing is open for the passage of critical patients, journalists, NGO staff, businessmen and passengers travelling abroad through Al-Karama crossing with previous coordination, diesel fuel, truckloads of construction material for Internationally funded projects as well as several shipment of agricultural crops.
