WEST BANK**JERUSALEM**

- **Closure:**
 - (i) On November 28th 2014 The Israeli army, intensified their restrictions at the entrance to Jerusalem city, set up several flying checkpoints on the main road leading to the city and prevented worshipers under the age of 35 from conducting prayers at Al-Aqsa mosque compound.
 - (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the ‘demarcation area’ along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits.
 - (iii) The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill between Biddu and Beit Ikksa villages.
- **Closure of Main Roads:**
 - (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the entrance to Jaba’ village.
 - (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to Beit Ikksa village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandiya checkpoint.
 - (iii) At 20:15, Israeli forces closed Wadi Al-Hilweh road in Silwan neighbourhood and impeded the free flow of traffic.
- **Checkpoints:**
 - (i) Israeli authorities continue to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a “border crossing point” and designate a special crossing lane for holders of Jerusalem IDs and another for those possessing permits to access Jerusalem city and closed the checkpoint at 01:20 and impeded the free flow of traffic until 04:05.
 - (ii) On September 19th 2012, Israeli forces closed Ras Khamis checkpoint near Shu’fat camp and impeded the free flow of traffic in order to construct the wall.
 - (iii) At 23:15, Israeli forces closed Shu’fat checkpoint then reopened it later.
- **Detention:**
 - (i) At 14:30, Israeli forces positioned at Salah Al-Din road in the old city of Jerusalem detained Wahid Shabaaneh .
 - (ii) At 17:15, Israeli forces positioned in Jerusalem detained two residents: Abdallah Salah and Hisham Salah (two residents of Bethlehem).
 - (iii) At 23:00, Israeli forces positioned near Al-Sahara gate (A main entrance leading to Al-Aqsa mosque compound) in the old city of Jerusalem.
- **Attack:**
 - (i) At 12:30, Israeli forces positioned at Qalandiya checkpoint fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and as a result injured Odah Yacoub.
 - (ii) At 15:40 and again at 17:00, Israeli forces positioned at Al-Ram North junction fired live ammunition; rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and as a result injured Hazim Al-Rajabi.
 - (iii) At 16:40, Israeli forces positioned near the wall gate in Abu Dis fired live ammunition; rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.
- **Wall Gates:**
 - (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the Wall gate in

	<p>Abu Dis town.</p> <p>(ii) The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate on Al-Shayyah road in the area between Al-Sawahira Al-Sharqiya and Al-Slewahira Al-Gharbiya villages, only allowing civilians holding Jerusalem IDs to cross, after subjecting them to thorough searches using electronic devices.</p>
<p>RAMALLAH & AL BIREH</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Sinjil village well as the junction to Kafr Malik and ‘Ein Samiya villages. (ii) Since September 3rd 2013, Israeli forces closed the north east entrance of Al-Mughier village with dirt mounds. (iii) Since 11:30, on October 27th 2014, Israeli forces closed the main road leading to Bet El Settlement located near Al-Jalazoun camp with cement blocks. (iv) At 22:30, Israeli forces closed the entrance of Beit Illu with dirt mounds. • <u>Raid:</u> At 01:25, Israeli forces raided Al-Bireh city until 03:30. • <u>Detention:</u> At 17:30, Israeli forces positioned near “Bet El” settlement detained Bara’ Salim. • <u>Attack:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 13:05, Israeli forces positioned at the entrance of Abboud fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and as a result injured five residents: Bakr Al-Barghouthi, Mohammad Al-Barghouthi, Mohammad Salah, Mahmoud Abu Hussien and Hamza Mazaher. (ii) At 13:45, Israeli; forces positioned at the entrance of Al-Jalazoun camp fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and as a result injured 3 children: Ibrahim Hassan (15 years old), Omar Zied (15 years old) and Ahmad Rahmah (15 years old). (iii) At 15:40, Israeli forces positioned at the entrance of Silwad fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning. • <u>Demonstrations:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 12:20, a demonstration took place in Ni’lin protesting against the construction of the wall during which they clashed with Israeli forces and as a result suffocated several residents from tear gas inhalation. (ii) At 12:20, a demonstration took place in Bil’in protesting against the construction of the wall during which they clashed with Israeli forces and left several others suffocated several residents from tear gas inhalation and as a result injured the child : Mo’taz Abu Rahmeh (16 years old) after being struck by a tear gas grenade canister in the leg. (iii) At 12:40, a demonstration took place in Al-Nabi Saleh village protesting against land confiscation for the purpose of Israeli settlement construction during which they clashed with Israeli forces and as result injured the child :Ahmad Al-Barghouthi (14 years old){ A resident of Al-Nabi Saleh} and as a result suffocated several residents from tear gas inhalation.

(ii) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the detour road leading to Ramin village along the Tulkarem-Nablus main road. • Checkpoint: Israeli forces intensified their restrictions at "Eniv" checkpoint. • Raid: At 16:05, Israeli forces raided Tulkerem.

(ii) In addition to closing the gate installed since the outbreak the second Intifada, the Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the eastern entrance to Kafr Qaddum village. (iii) At 12:10 on September 2nd 2014, Israeli forces closed the main road connecting Qalqiliya and Nablus near Al-Nabi Eliyas village with cement blocks. • Flying Checkpoint: At 08:40 and again at 14:35, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Azzun and impeded the free flow of traffic after closing the checkpoint then reopened it at 19:55. • Raid: At 23:50, Israeli forces raided Qalqiliya until 00:50. • Demonstration: At 12:00, a demonstration took place in Kafr Qaddum against the closure of the east entrance during which they clashed with Israeli forces who tried to disrupt the demonstration and as a result injured 6 residents including 4 children and an International Peace Activist: Abdel-Rahman Taha (4 years old), Yusef Aqel (13 years old), Sami Aqel (16 years old). Mohammad Barham (17 years old), Mustafa Eishtewi and Patrik Korsi (an Italian citizen) well as leaving several demonstrators suffocated from tear gas inhalation. • Wall Gates: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to restrict access at 'Azzun 'Atma Wall gate and impeded the free flow of traffic. The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the entrance to the village of Wadi Al- Rasha and to deny civilian access. (ii) The Israeli army allows residents to access the village through Gate #109. Having removed the gate at the entrance to the village of Ras Atiya; the Israeli army only allows students to cross to their schools outside the village through the Habla gate.

(ii) The Israeli army continues to close the northern entrance to Qabalan town; the southern entrances to the town of Jamma'in and the villages of Duma and

(iii) Since 11:00 on July 30th 2012, Israeli forces have closed two roads leading to Abu Nasar and Qatan Al-Jama’ located in western area of Deir Istiya with cement blocks. • <u>Checkpoints:</u> Israeli forces intensified their restrictions at Za’tara checkpoint and impeded the free flow of traffic.

In addition to closing the entrance to Al-Qeisi neighbourhood, the Israeli army continues to close the entrances to the area of Al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) with an electronic gate; Al-Laban Market also remains closed. (ii) Since 05 January 2009, the Israeli army has closed the area located along the Green Line south of the town of Yatta. Having seized land for Wall construction, the Israeli army evicted the Palestinian residents and denied them access to the area. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Al-Thahiriya and Al-Samoa’ towns, Al-‘Arrub refugee camp, and Al-Tuwani and Al-Karmil villages. <p style="text-align: center;">ALL DISTRICTS</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • At 19:00 on August 26th 2014, Palestinian Gunmen and the Israeli military agreed to a cease fire agreement (brokered by the Arab Republic of Egypt) which includes the opening of border crossings to allow the entry of emergency supplies and humanitarian goods as well as construction material and agreed to increase the fishing limit to 6 nautical miles with possibility of increase to 12 nautical miles by the end of the year and to decrease the Military area to 100 meters, allow freedom of movement and a halt to targeted killings and assassinations and negotiations will be held for discussion on rebuilding the sea port and airports in the coming month. • Israeli forces broke the ceasefire agreement by opening fire from their positions behind the Green Line towards North Gaza and Khan Yunis and as a result injured a resident.
