JERUSALEM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) On 28 November 2015, the Israeli army, intensified their restrictions at the entrance to Jerusalem city, set up several flying checkpoints on the main road leading to the city and prevented worshippers under the age of 50 from conducting prayers at Al-Aqsa mosque compound which forced residents to conduct prayers near checkpoints located outside Al-Aqsa mosque compound. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the ‘demarcation area’ along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem according to Military Order 09/02S and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits. (iii) The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill between Biddu and Beit Iksa villages. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the entrance to Jaba’ village. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to Beit Iksa village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandiya checkpoint. (iii) On 16 November 2015, Israeli forces closed the southern entrance of Jabal Al-Mukabir neighbourhood leading to Armon Hanatsif settlement with cement blocks. (iv) At 21:30 on 28 November 2015, Israeli forces closed the entrances of Bir Nibala with cement blocks. • <u>Checkpoints:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli authorities continue to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a “border crossing point” and designate a special crossing lane for holders of Jerusalem IDs and another for those possessing permits to access Jerusalem city. (ii) On 19 September 2012, Israeli forces closed Ras Khamis checkpoint near Shu’fat camp and impeded the free flow of traffic in order to construct the wall. • <u>Flying Checkpoints:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 10:30, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Qalandia junction and searched civilians and vehicles. (ii) At 11:05, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Bir Nibala junction and Rafat village and searched civilians and vehicles. (iii) At 12:40, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the roundabout of Jabaa village and searched civilians and vehicles. (iv) At 23:10, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Beit Hanina and searched civilians and vehicles. • <u>Raids:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 19:30 Israeli forces raided Bir Nibala, clashed with civilians, stormed into and searched the hoouse of martyr Fadi Al-Khasib and withdrew at 23:10. (ii) At 22:00, Israeli forces raided and patrolled Al-Ram town and clashed with civilians. • <u>Arrests:</u> At 08:00, Israeli forces arrested at Shufat checkpoint a civilian called Ana Ibrahim Khalife. • <u>Killing:</u> In the morning of 29 November 2015, civilian Bassim Abdelrahman Mustafa Salah, 38, from Nablus, was shot dead by Israeli forces in Al-Wad Street

	<p>in the Old City of Jerusalem for allegedly stabbing an Israeli soldier.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Attacks:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 17:05, Israeli forces in Abu Dis fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning. (ii) At 20:30, Israeli forces near the entrance of Hizma fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning. (iii) At 20:30, Israeli forces guarding the Separation Wall alongside Qatanna village fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning. (iv) At 22:00, Israeli forces in Silwan neighbourhood in Jerusalem fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning. • <u>Injuries:</u> At 12:45 on 27 November 2015, a child called Wissam Raed Zuheir Issa, 15, was injured in the eye by a rubber coated steel bullet near Qalandia checkpoint during clashes (as mentioned in the previous report). • <u>Wall Gates:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the Wall gate in Abu Dis town. (ii) The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate on Al-Shayyah road in the area between Al-Sawahira Al-Sharqiya and Al-Slewahira Al-Gharbiya villages, only allowing civilians holding Jerusalem IDs to cross, after subjecting them to thorough searches using electronic devices.
<p>RAMALLAH & AL BIREH</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Sinjil village well as the junction to Kafr Malik and 'Ein Samiya villages (ii) . On 3 October 2015, Israeli forces closed the main road located near "Bet El" settlement and leading to Al-Jalazoun camp with cement blocks. (iii) On 24 November 2015, Israeli forces closed the main entrance gate leading to Sinjil and the east entrance of Mughier with cement blocks. • <u>Flying Checkpoints:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 15:20, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint near Beit Ur village and searched residents and vehicles until 17:15. (ii) At 18:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint near Attara Bridge north of Birzeit and searched residents and vehicles. (iii) At 18:20, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint under the bridge of Deir Diwan town and searched civilians and vehicles until 21:00. (iv) At 18:20, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint under the bridge of Ein Yabroud village and searched civilians and vehicles until 21:00. • <u>Raids:</u> At 01:25, Israeli forces raided Ramallah city, clashed with civilians and stormed into the home of the martyr Shadi Al-Khasib, took measures and withdrew at 03:15. • <u>Attacks:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 17:25, Israeli forces positioned near Budrus village fired live ammunition, rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents (who were protesting against the continued Israeli Military and Settler assault on Al-Aqsa mosque compound) for alleged stoning and as a result injured 1 civilian called Qaisar Marar. (ii) At 20:30, Israeli forces positioned near the entrance of Sinjel town fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning. • <u>Demonstrations:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 12:25 November 27th, a demonstration took place in Nabi Saleh village protesting against the construction of the wall during which they clashed with Israeli forces and as a result left several residents suffocated from tear gas inhalation.

JENIN	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure of Main Road: The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the road leading to the town of ‘Arraba east of the illegal settlement Dotan. • Raids: At 02:15, Israeli forces raided Qabatia town, stormed into several civilian homes and served 2 notifications to report to the Israeli military intelligence to 2 civilians called Izzedin Mohammad Kamil and Samaan Fadel Nazzal, and withdrew at 04:35. • Wall Gates: Israeli forces continue too close the wall gate and only allow those holding special permits to enter through it.
TUBAS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Checkpoints: at 13:30, Israeli forces intensified restrictions at Tayasir checkpoint and impeded flow of traffic. • House Demolition: At 19:00, Israeli forces in Khirbet Al-Makhoul village demolished a tenet used as residence owned by Burhan Hussein Al-Asmar and another two tents in Al-Hadiddiye village owned by Abdelrahman Bisharat.
TULKAREM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Checkpoints: At 23:45, Israeli forces continue to intensify their restrictions at “Eniv” checkpoint located along the main road connecting Tulkarem and Nablus and impeded the free flow of traffic. • Flying Checkpoints: At 07:00 on 28 November 2015, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint between Shofa and Izbat Shofa villages and searched civilians and vehicles until 08:20. • Raids: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> At 15:00, Israeli forces raided Zieta village and stormed into 1 civilian home. At 17:15, Israeli forces raided Faron village, clashed with civilians during patrol and detained a child called Ismail Khalil Atir, 17, released him later and withdrew at 00:35. At 04:20, Israeli force raided Tulkarem city and patrolled it until 05:40.
QALQILIYA	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure of Roads: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> Israeli forces continue to close with cement blocks agricultural roads east of Azzun town. In addition to closing the gate installed since the outbreak the second Intifada, the Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the eastern entrance to Kafr Qaddum village. Since 10:40 on 1 September 2015, Israeli forces closed an agricultural road leading to Far’ata village which is located near “Gillad” settlement with a steel gate. • Flying Checkpoints: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> At 10:15, 15:30 and 23:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the eastern entrance of Qalqilya and searched civilians and vehicles. At 10:15, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Azzun and searched civilians and vehicles. At 15:40, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Azzun Itmeh village and searched civilians and vehicles. At 16:20, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Jit village and searched civilians and vehicles. • Raids: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> At dawn on 28 November 2015, Israeli forces raided Azzun town and arrested 2 civilians. At 15:15, Israeli forces raided Kar Qaddoum village, clashed with civilians and injured 3 civilians: Ayman Rafiq Mustafa Ishteiwi, Majid Abdel Mumen Youssef Jumaa and Mohammad Saleh Youssef Ishteiwi, and then withdrew at 16:00. • Arrests: The 2 civilians arrested in Azzun town are: Hamzeh Salim Dirar Radwan and Mutasem Mohammad Abdel Aziz Salim. • Attacks: At 16:45, Israeli forces guarding the Separation Wall alongside the west

	<p>side of Qalqilya city fire rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Wall Gates:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to restrict access at ‘Azzun ‘Atma Wall gate and impeded the free flow of traffic. The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the entrance to the village of Wadi Al- Rasha and to deny civilian access. (ii) The Israeli army allows residents to access the village through Gate #109. Having removed the gate at the entrance to the village of Ras Atiya; the Israeli army only allows students to cross to their schools outside the village through the Habla gate.
NABLUS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> Since December 17th 2013, Israeli forces ordered the closure 500 dunumes of land in Qusra village as a closed military area. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the roads of Til-Burin and Beit Furik-Salem; the settler bypass road connecting the village of Deir al Hatab to the settlement of Alon Moreh; the road connecting the town of ‘Aqraba to the village of Osrin; and the detour road between the town of Qabalan and the village of Osrin. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the northern entrance to Qabalan town; the southern entrances to the town of Jamma’in and the villages of Duma and Qaryut. (iii) At 22:00 on 3 October 2015, Israeli forces closed the North entrance of Awarta village with dirt mounds. (iv) At 06:30 on 22 November 2015, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Aqraba town with Yanun village with dirt mounds. • <u>Checkpoints:</u> At 18:40, Israeli forces intensified restrictions at Beit Furiq checkpoint and impeded the free flow of traffic until 23:00. • <u>Flying Checkpoints:</u> At 22:15, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint on Al-Badhan Road (the eastern entrance to Nablus) and searched residents and vehicles until 23:30. • <u>Raids:</u> At 02:45, Israeli forces raided Nablus city, clashed with civilians, stormed into 1 civilian home, arrested 1 military from the NSF and withdrew at 04:30. • <u>Attacks:</u> At 11:30, Israeli forces positioned in the vicinity of Huwara checkpoint fired live ammunition and rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents during a protest against settlers’ attacks on the Al-Aqsa Mosque and demanding the delivery of the dead bodies of martyrs. 2 children were injured in the clashes: Mohammad Jumaa Fayiz Jumaa, 17, Khalid Abdel Qader Youssef Sharqawi, 16. • <u>Settler Violence:</u> At 10:25, Israeli settlers raided agricultural land in Bourin and in the villages of Madama and Aira Al-Qabaliyye. Settlers were forced to leave by Israeli forces at 12:30.
SALFIT	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the entrance to two detour roads connecting Marda village to its farmland. (ii) Since 11:00 on 30 July 2012, Israeli forces have closed two roads leading to Abu Nasar and Qatan Al-Jama’ located in western area of Deir Istiya with cement blocks. • <u>Checkpoints:</u> Israeli forces intensified their restrictions at Za’tara checkpoint and impeded the free flow of traffic. • <u>Flying Checkpoints:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 19:30, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Qarawa bani Hasa town and searched residents and vehicles. (ii) At 22:05, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Kafal Haris

The checkpoint was reopened at 09:20. At 17:00, Israeli forces intensified restrictions at the checkpoint and impeded traffic. • Flying Checkpoints: At 14:50, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the south entrance of Jericho then searched residents and vehicles until 17:20. • Raids: At 18:05, Israeli forces raided Jericho city and patrolled it until 19:20. • Arrests: The female civilians arrested at Al-Hamra checkpoint is Miriam Khalid Arafat Sawafta from Tubas. • Provocation of Security Forces: At 20:50, Israeli forces detained and searched on the road to Ma'ale Ephraim settlement a Palestinian Police vehicle.
BETHLEHEM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close roads to An Nu'man village, with the exception of the road leading to the Wall gate in the south-eastern area of the village. (ii) Since 15 September 2007, the Israel army has prevented civilians from accessing or staying on 22 dunums of confiscated land in Al Mazmuriya area in Beit Sahur and Bethlehem cities. • Closure of Main Roads: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the Beit Jala-Wadi Ahmed road; a road between Um Tuba and Al-Jass ; a road between Um Tuba and Khilat Nu'man: a road between Um Tuba and the wall; a road between Al-Khas village and the wall; the 2 by pass roads located south of Al-Walaja; a road between Talita Qumi and Nazlat Al-Sider in Beit Jala; the eastern road of Al-Khader; the road between Al-Khader and Beit Jala ; Wadi Rahal road near "Ifrat" settlement ,the road between Al-Khader and road #60 which lead to the eastern neighbourhoods of Bethlehem; a road leading to Wadi Rahal, and a road east of Beit Fajjar town with dirt mounds. <p>HEBRON</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close Khuzq Al-Far areas, as well as the old gold market in Hebron's Old City. In addition to closing the entrance to Al-Qeisi neighbourhood, the Israeli army continues to close the entrances to the area of Al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) with an electronic gate; Al-Laban Market also remains closed. (ii) Since 05 January 2009, the Israeli army has closed the area located along the Green Line south of the town of Yatta. Having seized land for Wall construction, the Israeli army evicted the Palestinian residents and denied them access to the area. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Al-Karmil villages. (ii) The Israeli army continues to prohibit Palestinian vehicles from travelling along the old Al-Shalala Street leading to Hebron's Old City. (iii) The Israeli army continues to close all roads leading to Road # 60 as well as detour roads along the settler bypass road leading to Yatta town. (iv) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds a detour road leading to e to Al-Simiya village, the southern entrance of Al-Samou' and the entrance of Beit Annun with cement blocks. (v) At 05:50 on 5 November 2015, Israeli forces closed the entrance leading Farsh Al-Hawa area in Hebron with Cement blocks. (vi) On 11 November 2015, Israeli forces closed the main road connecting Beit Awwa and Al-Majd village with cement block and dirt mounds. (vii) At 15:00 on November 10th 2015, Israeli forces closed the north entrance of Al-Thahriya. (viii) At 15:45 on 11 November 2015, Israeli forces closed junction of Ein Simya village (western entrance of Sammou) with dirt mounds. (ix) On 15 November 2015, Israeli forces closed the entrances of Khilet Al-Mayye and Al-Deirat villages east of Yatta with cement blocks.

- (x) At 14:00 on 20 November 2015, Israeli forces closed the entrances of Abdo, Beit Omra, Deir Al-Asal, Deir Razih and Karma villages with dirt mounds.
- (xi) At 14:10 on 23 November 2015, Israeli forces closed of Al-Kom village north of Beit Awwa with cement blocks.
- (xii) At 12:50 on 28 November 2015, Israeli forces closed the junction of Al-Joljol area (entrance to Bani Naim town) with dirt mounds.
- (xiii) At 14:40 on 28 November 2015, Israeli forces closed the entrance of Beit Ummar town with dirt mounds.
- **Flying Checkpoints:**
 - (i) At 08:40, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Sa'ir junction and denied civilian access. The checkpoint was removed at a later time.
 - (ii) At 09:15, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the eastern entrance to Hebron (near bypass road no. 35) and impeded traffic in both directions.
 - (iii) At 09:25, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Edna town and searched residents and vehicles.

 - (iv) At 02:00, Israeli forces raided Beit Ummar town, stormed into and searched civilian homes and measured the home of martyr Omar Zaaqiq, and arrested 3 civilians (including 2 brothers, one child).
