All West Bank Districts

- On November 29th 2012, demonstrations took place in all districts of the West Bank in support President Mahmoud Abbas decision to apply Palestine as a non-member state in the United Nations.
- On November 29th 2012, Palestine was voted as a non-member state by the United Nations General Assembly with 138 countries voting for, 41 countries abstained from voting and 9 countries voting against and the Palestinian flag was raised as soon as the chair of the General Assembly announced Palestine as a non-member state in the United Nations.

The Israeli army continues to close the ‘demarcation area’ along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits. The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill between Biddu and Beit Iksa villages. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the entrance to Jaba’ village. The Israeli army continues to close the gate along the Wall section separating the area of Dahiyat Al-Bareed from Al-Ram town. The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to Beit Iksa village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandia checkpoint. • <u>Checkpoints:</u> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> Israeli authorities continue to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a “border crossing point” and designate a special crossing lane for holders of Jerusalem IDs and another for those possessing permits to access Jerusalem city. On September 19th 2012, Israeli forces closed Ras Khamis checkpoint near Shu’fat camp and impeded the free flow of traffic in order to construct the wall. At 09:00, Israeli forces intensified its restrictions at Jaba’ checkpoint and impeded the free flow of traffic.

(ii) At 20:40, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of A-Eizariya near Male Adumim settlement and detained a resident. • <u>Detention:</u> Israeli forces detained an unidentified individual in AL-Eizariya. • <u>Settler Violence:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 16:30, Israeli settlers torched the Palestinian flag in front of the United Nations building in Jabal Mukabbir neighbourhood Jerusalem. (ii) At 19:40, Israeli settlers stoned vehicles at Male Adumim settlement junction located on the main road connecting Jerusalem and Bethlehem. • <u>Demonstration:</u> At 18:00, a demonstration took place in Al-Isawiya in Jerusalem; in solidarity with Palestinian detainees and demanding their release from Israeli jails. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the Wall gate in Abu Dis town. (ii) The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate on Al-Shayyah road in the area between Al-Sawahira Al-Sharqiya and Al-Sleavawahira Al-Gharbiya villages, only allowing civilians holding Jerusalem IDs to cross, after subjecting them to thorough searches using electronic devices. • <u>Wall Construction:</u> Wall construction continued in the areas north and south of Qalandiya village; south of Al-Za'ayem village; and in Wadi Al-Eizariya west of the illegal settlement Ma 'ale Adumim.

(ii) At 17:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint near Ein Yabrud Village Bridge. (iii) At 22:10, Israeli forces set up 4 checkpoints at the entrance of Aboud, Al-Nabi Saleh, Deir Nathim and Deir Abu Mash'al. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At dawn on November 29th 2012, Israeli forces raided Beit Liqya and stormed several homes. (i) Since the evening of November 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the western entrance of Ya'bad. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 10:30, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Zubaba village until 11:30. • <u>Raid:</u> At 21:00, Israeli forces raided Rumana village, clashed with residents, fired

	<p>tear gas grenades towards several residents leaving them suffocated from tear gas inhalation then withdrew at 21:30.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Attack: At 13:00, Israeli forces positioned at Al-Jamala checkpoint near the green line in North Jenin fired tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and detained 2 residents. • Detention: Israeli forces detained Abdallah Sabarna and FoadAbahra in Jenin. • Wall Gates: Passage through the Wall gates is restricted to civilians granted special Israeli permits, which undercuts the access to education and health services for civilians living behind the Wall.

TULKAREM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure of Main Roads: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the road connecting Kafr Al-Labad town to Shufa village. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the detour road leading to Ramin village along the Tulkarem-Nablus main road. • Checkpoints: At 14:15, the Israeli army intensified its restrictions at Einav checkpoint on the Tulkarem-Nablus main road and impeded the free flow of traffic. • Flying Checkpoint: At 20:50, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the west entrance of Tulkarem until 21:45. • Detention: At 22:10, Israeli forces detained Osama Abdel Hamid, a resident of Baqa Al-Sharqiya as he was reporting to Israeli Intelligence for questioning. • Wall Gates: Land leveling for adjustment of the Wall route resumed in the area surrounding Jubara village. According to an Israeli High Court decision, the new Wall route is to be constructed west of the village.

(ii) In addition to closing the gate installed since the outbreak the second Intifada, the Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the eastern entrance to Kafr Qaddum village. • Raid: At 23:30, Israeli forces raided Kafr Qaddum village. • Attack: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 12:00, Israeli forces positioned at the entrance of Azzun fired tear gas grenades towards several children for alleged stoning. (ii) At 19:00, Israeli forces positioned at Immatin village junction fired tear gas grenades towards residents for alleged stoning. • Wall Gates: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to restrict access at 'Azzun 'Atma Wall gate and to search civilians, including students, using a metal detector. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the entrance to the village of Wadi Al-Rasha and to deny civilian access. The Israeli army allows residents to access the village through Gate #109. Having removed the gate at the entrance to the village of Ras Atiya; the Israeli army only allows students to cross to their schools outside the village through the Habla gate. • Wall Construction: Wall construction continued in Kafr Laqif village north of Karnei Shomron settlement; in Immatin village northeast of Immanuel settlement; and east of Kafr Thulth town near Ma 'ale Shomron settlement.

(iii) Since 11:00 on July 30th 2012, Israeli forces have closed two roads leading to Abu Nasar and QatanAl-Jama' located in western area of Deir Istiya with cement blocks. • <u>Checkpoints:</u> Israeli forces continue to intensify their restrictions at Za'tara checkpoint and impeded the free flow of traffic. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 11:30, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint between Salfit and Iskaka village until 12:00. (ii) At 19:40, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Kafr Al-Dik. • <u>Wall Construction:</u> Wall construction continued in the area north of Deir Istiya town southeast of the illegal settlement.

(ii) At 00:20, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Al-Oja village • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 20:10, Israeli forces raided Jericho. (ii) At 20:30, Israeli forces raided Al-Oja village. • <u>Settler Violence:</u> At 19:40, Israeli settlers stormed Al-Khan Al-Ahmar area and stoned vehicles passing along the road connecting Jericho and Jerusalem.

(ii) Since 15 September 2007, the Israel army has prevented civilians from accessing or staying on 22 dunums of confiscated land in Al Mazmuriya area in Beit Sahur and Bethlehem cities. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the Beit Jala-Wadi Ahmed road; a road

In addition to closing the entrance to Al-Qeisi neighbourhood, the Israeli army continues to close the entrances to the area of Al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) with an electronic gate; Al-Laban Market also remains closed. (ii) Since 05 January 2009, the Israeli army has closed the area located along the Green Line south of the town of Yatta. Having seized land for Wall construction, the Israeli army evicted the Palestinian residents and denied them access to the area. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Al-Thahiriya and Al-Samoa' towns, Al-'Arrub refugee camp, and Al-Tuwani and Al-Karmil villages. (ii) The Israeli army continues to prohibit Palestinian vehicles from travelling along the old Al-Shalala Street leading to Hebron's Old City. (iii) The Israeli army continues to close all roads leading to Road # 60 as well as detour roads along the settler bypass road leading to Yatta town. (iv) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds a detour road leading to the entrance to Al-Simiya village, the southern entrance of Al-Samou' and the entrance of Beit Annun with cement blocks. (v) On July 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Safa and Al-Dirat and also closed the entrance of south Yatta with cement blocks. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 08:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Al-Fuwar junction. • <u>Raid:</u> At 02:20, Israeli forces raided Hebron, stormed a home and withdrew at 06:00. • <u>Detentions:</u> At dawn on November 30th 2012, Israeli forces detained Anas and Ahamd Qwiek in the old city of Hebron H2 Area. • <u>Wall Construction:</u> Wall construction continued in the area surrounding

	the illegal settlement Eshkolot, west of Al-Thahiriya town.

ALL DISTRICTS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • At 21:00 on November 21st 2012, the unilateral ceasefire declared by Israel came into effect. At a later time on the same day, armed Palestinian groups announced an agreement to cease fire. • On 14.12.2011, Israeli forces placed floating marks 3 miles from Gaza's seashore and warned fishermen against passing beyond the mark. • Israeli forces broke the cease fire agreement by opening fire towards North Gaza. • Israeli forces broke the cease fire agreement towards Palestinian fishermen off the shores of North Gaza killing 2 gunmen, injuring 2 residents after a mortar shell exploded in Beit Lahiya.
NORTHERN GAZA	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure of Crossing Point: Beit Hanun (Erez) is open for international access only. • Attack: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 10:15, Israeli Naval vessels opened fire towards Palestinian fishermen off the shores Beit Lahiya, temporarily detained 6 residents Ihab Baker, Ali Baker, Mohammad Baker and Na'im, damaged a fishing boat and released them at a later time. (ii) On the afternoon of November 29th 2012, Israeli forces positioned behind the Green Line opened fire towards several residents near the border fence located near Jabaliya and injured Wahid Al-Fasis. • Killing: At dawn on November 30th 2012, Mustafa Hijazi died of injuries sustained during Israeli airstrikes on Gaza were a missile exploded and injured 6 residents.
GAZA	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure of Crossing Points: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Al-Muntar (Karni) Crossing is closed. Beginning on 02 March 2011, the Crossing has been effectively closed following a unilateral Israeli decision. (ii) Al-Shija'iyah (Nahal 'Oz) Crossing is closed. Beginning on 04 January 2010, the Crossing has been closed following a unilateral Israeli decision. • Attack: At 12:00 on November 28th 2012, Israeli naval vessels opened fire towards Palestinian fishing boats off the shores of Gaza and damaged 2 boats owned by Mohammad Baker and Tal'at Baker. • Detention: On the evening of November 29th 2012, Israeli forces detained Sameh Hassanin as he was in his agricultural land in Kafr Al-Dik near the border fence. • Demonstration: On November 29th 2012, demonstration took place in Gaza city in support of President Mahmoud Abbas's decision to apply Palestine as a non-member state in the United Nations.
RAFAH	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure of Crossing Points : • Yasser 'Arafat International Airport remains closed. • Rafah (<i>Al 'Awdah</i>) Crossing is open for the exit of patients, students, passengers with permits and International aid. • Sufa Crossing is closed. • Karm Abu Salem (Karem Shalom) Crossing is open for the entry of humanitarian supplies, cooking gas, truckloads of wheat and Livestock feed, fuel supplies and construction material for internationally funded projects. • Killing: On the morning of November 29th 2012, Husam Al-Hums died of injuries sustained during Israeli airstrikes on Rafah on November 17th 2012
