WEST BANK

JERUSALEM

- **Closure:**
 - (i) On November 22nd 2013 Israeli army, intensified their restrictions at the entrance to Jerusalem city, set up several flying checkpoints on the main road leading to the city and prevented worshipers under the age of 50 from conducting prayers at Al-Aqsa mosque compound.
 - (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the ‘demarcation area’ along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits.
 - (iii) The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill between Biddu and Beit Ikksa villages.
- **Closure of Main Roads:**
 - (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the entrance to Jaba’ village.
 - (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to Beit Ikksa village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandiya checkpoint.
- **Checkpoints:**
 - (i) Israeli authorities continue to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a “border crossing point” and designate a special crossing lane for holders of Jerusalem IDs and another for those possessing permits to access Jerusalem city and at 06:00, Israeli forces closed the checkpoint impeding the free flow of traffic.
 - (ii) On September 19th 2012, Israeli forces closed Ras Khamis checkpoint near Shu’fat camp and impeded the free flow of traffic in order to construct the wall.
- **Flying Checkpoint:** At 16:10, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Anata.
- **Attack:**
 - (i) At 11:55, Israeli forces positioned at Al-Ram junction fired rubber coated steel bullets and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.
 - (ii) At 13:00, Israeli forces positioned at Qalandiya checkpoint fired rubber coated steel bullets and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and as a result injured 5 residents including 3 children : Anas Al-Mimi (16 years old), Layth Sha’ban (17 years old), Mohammad Hashim (17 years old), Ibrahim Hamdi Ibrahim and Ibrahim Yaqoub.
 - (iii) At 16:30, Israeli forces positioned near the wall gate in Ras Al-Kabsa area in Abu Dis, fired rubber coated steel bullets and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning near the wall gate and as a result injured 2 residents including 1 critically injured: Khalil Al-Ilmani (critically injured after being struck with live ammunition in the chest) and Omar Aliyan.
- **Wall Gates:**
 - (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the Wall gate in Abu Dis town.
 - (ii) The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate on Al-Shayyah road in the area between Al-Sawahira Al-Sharqiya and Al-Slewahira Al-Gharbiya villages, only allowing civilians holding Jerusalem IDs to cross, after subjecting them to thorough searches using electronic devices.

(ii) Since September 3rd 2013, Israeli forces closed the north east entrance of Al-Mughier village with dirt mounds. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 20:55, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint between Turmus'ayya and Khirbit Abu Falah village until 21:20. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 02:30, Israeli forces raided Turmyus'aya until 21:00. (ii) At 20:55, Israeli forces raided Khirbeit Abu Falah village and positioned near Palestinian Police headquarters then withdrew at 21:20. (iii) At 01:10, Israeli forces raided Safa village, stormed a home and summoned Nassim Karaja to report to Israeli intelligence for questioning. • <u>Attack:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 14:45, Israeli forces positioned at the entrance of Silwad fired rubber coated steel bullets and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning, temporarily detained Mohammad Hamad (15 years old) then released him at 18:00. (ii) At 16:45, Israeli forces positioned at Ofar prison fired rubber coated steel bullets and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and as a result injured Omar Ibrahim. • <u>Settler Violence:</u> At 02:15, Israeli settlers positioned near "Bet El " settlement junction stoned vehicles passing along the main road near Al-Jalazoun camp and as a result injured Shuqi Hamayel , a resident of Kafr Malik leaving him hospitalised with head wounds. • <u>Demonstration:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 12:50, a demonstration took place in Al-Nabi Saleh village protesting against land confiscation for the purpose of settlement construction, demonstrators clashed with Israeli forces and left several demonstrators suffocating from tear gas inhalation and detained 2 residents. (ii) At 12:50, a demonstration took place in Nil'in village protesting against the construction of the wall, clashed with demonstrators' as a result injured 2 residents: Ismail Rahmeh and Ashraf Al-Khatib as well as leaving several demonstrators suffocated from tear gas inhalation and detained a resident. • <u>Detention:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli forces detained 2 residents: Rifat Al-Tamimi and Mohammad Al-Tamimi in Al-Nabi Saleh village. (ii) Israeli forces detained Mohammad Khatib in Ni'lin. • <u>Wall Construction:</u> Wall construction continued in the area west of 'Abud town in the area surrounding the illegal settlement 'Ofarim and north of Al-Lubban Al-Gharbi and Rantis villages.

(ii) Since the evening of November 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the western entrance of Ya'bad. • <u>Checkpoint:</u> Israeli forces closed "Movo Dotan" checkpoint which is located along the main road connecting Jenin and Tulkarem and impeded the free flow of traffic. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> Passage through the Wall gates is restricted to civilians granted

	<p>special Israeli permits, which undercuts the access to education and health services for civilians living behind the Wall.</p>
TUBAS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 08:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Al-Aqba village and temporarily detained Ghanam Abu Muh'sien and stormed and searched a home near the checkpoint then withdrew at 16:00. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 01:00, Israeli forces raided Tubas, stormed a home then withdrew at 02:30. (ii) At 02:00, Israeli forces raided Tamoun, stormed 2 homes, summoned 2 residents: Jamil Basharat and Moath Basharat to report to Israeli intelligence for questioning then withdrew at 02:20. • <u>Temporary Detention:</u> At 16:35, Israeli forces positioned near Ein AlBayda village temporarily detained Yusef Abu Mutalai' then released him at a later time.
TULKAREM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the road connecting Kafr Al-Labad town to Shufa village. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the detour road leading to Ramin village along the Tulkarem-Nablus main road. • <u>Raid:</u> At 12:15, Israeli forces raided Zeita until 15:30. • <u>Settler Violence:</u> At 09:00, Israeli settlers positioned near Beit Lid junction and closed the main road then withdrew under the protection of Israeli forces at 10:20. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> Passage through the Wall gates is restricted to civilians granted special Israeli permits, which undercuts the access to education and health services for civilians living behind the Wall.
QALQILIYA	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli forces continue to close with cement blocks agricultural roads east of Azzun town. (ii) In addition to closing the gate installed since the outbreak the second Intifada, the Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the eastern entrance to Kafr Qaddum village. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 09:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Hajja village junction. • <u>Demonstration:</u> At 12:10, a demonstration took place in Kafr Qaddum against the closure of the east entrance, clashed with Israeli forces as they attempted to disrupt demonstrators and as a result injured Mansour Obied after tear gas grenade canisters struck them leaving him hospitalised with contusions also left several demonstrators suffocating from tear gas inhalation and assaulted 2 residents: Mohammad Ammar and Abdel Razaq Amar. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to restrict access at 'Azzun 'Atma Wall gate closed the steel gate at 11:55 and to search civilians, including students, using a metal detector. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the entrance to the village of Wadi Al- Rasha and to deny civilian access. The Israeli army allows residents to access the village through Gate #109. Having removed the gate at the entrance to the village of Ras Atiya; the Israeli army only allows students to cross to their schools outside the village through the Habla gate. • <u>Wall Construction:</u> Wall construction was continued in Kafr Laqif village north of Karnei Shomron settlement; in Immatin village northeast of Immanuel settlement; and east of Kafr Thulth town near Ma 'ale Shomron settlement.

(ii) At 14:30, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Beit Furiq until 15:50. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 08:00, Israeli forces raided Al-Bithan village as they escorted several Israeli settlers as they stormed the area then withdrew at 08:10. (ii) At 14:40, Israeli forces raided Beit Dajan village as they escorted several Israeli settlers as they stormed the area then withdrew at later time. (iii) At 02:20, Israeli forces raided Nablus, clashed with several residents then withdrew at 03:40. • <u>Demonstration:</u> At 11:00, a demonstration took place in Khirbiet Al-Tawil area in Aqraba protesting against Israeli demolition orders to demolish a mosque.

(ii) On 15.04.2012, the Israeli army has opened the northern entrance to Salfit city to civilian which was closed since the year 2000 and prevented access from 08:00 until 09:20. (iii) Since 11:00 on July 30th 2012, Israeli forces have closed two roads leading to Abu Nasar and Qatan Al-Jama' located in western area of Deir Istiya with cement blocks. • <u>Checkpoints:</u> Israeli forces continue to intensify their restrictions at Za'tara Al-checkpoint and impeded the free flow of traffic. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 22:10, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the west entrance of Kafr Al-Dik. • <u>Wall Construction:</u> Wall construction continued in the area north of Deir Istiya town southeast of the illegal settlement.
<p style="text-align: center;">JERICHO</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Checkpoints:</u> Israeli forces continue to intensify its restrictions at Al-Hamra checkpoint set up along the road connecting Jericho and Nablus District. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 10:40, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint along road 90 near Al-Nu'emeh village located at the north entrance of Jericho until 12:20.
<p style="text-align: center;">BETHLEHEM</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close roads to An Nu'man village, with the exception of the road leading to the Wall gate in the south-eastern area of the village. (ii) Since 15 September 2007, the Israel army has prevented civilians from accessing or staying on 22 dunumes of confiscated land in Al Mazmuriya area in Beit Sahur and Bethlehem cities. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the Beit Jala-Wadi Ahmed road; a road between Um Tuba and Al-Jass ; a road between Um Tuba and Khilat Nu'man: a road between Um Tuba and the wall; a road between Al-Khas village and the wall; the 2 by pass roads located south of Al-Walaja; a road between Talita Qumi and Nazlat Al-Sider in Beit Jala; the eastern road of Al-Khader; the road between Al-Khader and Beit Jala ; Wadi Rahal road near "Ifrat" settlement

(ii) At 03:30, Israeli forces raided Bethlehem until 04:35. • <u>Detention:</u> Israeli forces detained 2 residents: Mahdi Taqatqa and Ali Taqatqa in Beit Fajjar. • <u>Attack:</u> At 14:00, Israeli forces positioned near Al-Ayda camp in Bethlehem fired rubber coated steel bullets and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and as a result injured 4 residents including a child: Amir Issa (17 years old), Mohammad Abu Bakr, Khalid Abiyat and Muhanad Abu Suwi. • <u>Settler Violence:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 11:00, Israeli settlers stormed Ush Al-Ghurab area in Beit Sahur then withdrew at 12:20. (ii) At 11:50, Israeli settlers the west entrance of Taqou’ then withdrew at 12:20. • <u>Demonstration:</u> At 12:30, a demonstration took place in Al-Ma’asra village protesting against the construction of the wall and against the prevention of protestors from reaching the demonstration site. • <u>Wall Construction:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Wall construction has continued in North West of Beit Jala town. (ii) On May 1st 2103, an Israeli court ordered the halt of wall construction near Betar village. (iii) On July 21st 2013, Israeli courts ordered the halt of construction of the wall in Al-Carmisan area in the west area of Beit Jalla.
HEBRON	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close Al-Shuhada’ Street, Al-Sahleh and Khuzq Al-Far areas, as well as the old gold market in Hebron’s Old City. In addition to closing the entrance to Al-Qeisi neighbourhood, the Israeli army continues to close the entrances to the area of Al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) with an electronic gate; Al-Laban Market also remains closed. (ii) Since 05 January 2009, the Israeli army has closed the area located along the Green Line south of the town of Yatta. Having seized land for Wall construction, the Israeli army evicted the Palestinian residents and denied them access to the area. . • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Al-Thahiriya and Al-Samoa’ towns, Al-‘Arrub refugee camp, and Al-Tuwani and Al-Karmil villages.

- (ii) The Israeli army continues to prohibit Palestinian vehicles from travelling along the old Al-Shalala Street leading to Hebron's Old City.
 - (iii) The Israeli army continues to close all roads leading to Road # 60 as well as detour roads along the settler bypass road leading to Yatta town.
 - (iv) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds a detour road leading to e to Al-Simiya village, the southern entrance of Al-Samou' and the entrance of Beit Annun with cement blocks.
 - (v) Since July 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Safa and Al-Dirat and also closed the entrance of south Yatta with cement blocks.
 - (vi) Since December 27th 2012, Israeli forces closed the west entrance of Swiesiya village which connects Yatta and Al-Samou' village with cement blocks.
 - (vii) Since 09:45 on September 23rd 2013, Israeli forces closed the main road leading to "Haji" settlement and impeded the free flow of traffic
- **Flying Checkpoint:**
 - (i) At 14:10, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Al-Fa'hs area located in south Hebron.
 - (ii) At 14:15, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Zif village junction and impeded the free flow of traffic.
 - (iii) At 14:45, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Beit Awwa.
 - (iv) At 16:25, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint along Halhul bridge.
 - **Raid:**
 - (i) At 00:40, Israeli forces raided Tarqumiya
 - (ii) At 04:00, Israeli forces Hebron until 05:50.
 - **Detention:** at 19:55, Israeli forces positioned in Bab Al-Zawiya area near the entrance of Bab Al-Shuhada road in the old city of Hebron detained Ali Shuhadeh (17 years old) and Yahya Salhab.
 - **Attack:**
 - (i) At 12:00, Israeli forces positioned near Al-Shuhada' road in the old city of Hebron fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and as a result injured 2 residents: Ahmad Al-Muhtasib and Yazan Shawar.
 - (ii) At 14:40, Israeli forces positioned near Al-Tabaqa village fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.
 - **Wall Construction:** Wall construction continued in the area surrounding the illegal settlement Eshkolot, west of Al-Thahriya town.

At a later time on the same day, armed Palestinian groups announced an agreement to cease fire. • On November 14th 2011 Israeli forces placed floating marks 3 miles from Gaza's seashore and warned fishermen against passing beyond the mark and on November 24th 2012, Israeli forces imposed floating marks of 6 miles and on March 21st 2013 re imposed fishing restrictions of 3 miles. • Israeli forces broke the cease fire agreement by opening fire from their positions behind the Green Line towards North Gaza and Khan Yunis and as a result injured a resident.

Beginning on 04 January 2010, the Crossing has been closed following a unilateral Israeli decision. •
