<p style="text-align: center;">JERUSALEM</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army, intensified their restrictions at the entrance to Jerusalem city, set up several flying checkpoints on the main road leading to the city and prevented worshipers under the age of 50 from conducting prayers at Al-Aqsa mosque compound. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the ‘demarcation area’ along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits. (iii) The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill between Biddu and Beit Ikksa villages. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the entrance to Jaba’ village. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to Beit Ikksa village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandiya checkpoint. • <u>Checkpoints:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli authorities continue to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a “border crossing point” and designate a special crossing lane for holders of Jerusalem IDs and another for those possessing permits to access Jerusalem city and closed the checkpoint at 01:20 and impeded the free flow of traffic until 04:05. (ii) On September 19th 2012, Israeli forces closed Ras Khamis checkpoint near Shu’fat camp and impeded the free flow of traffic in order to construct the wall. • <u>Detention:</u> At dawn on November 30th 2014, Israeli forces detained five residents: Fadi Oko, Darwish Da’na, Tarik Shuwiky and Abdel-Rahim Al-Abbassi in Jerusalem. • <u>Settler Violence:</u> At dawn on November 29th 2014, a group of Israeli settlers assaulted Majdi Najib (A resident of Ras Al-Amoud neighbourhood) and as a result left him hospitalised with contusions. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the Wall gate in Abu Dis town. (ii) The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate on Al-Shayyah road in the area between Al-Sawahira Al-Sharqiya and Al-Slewahira Al-Gharbiya villages, only allowing civilians holding Jerusalem IDs to cross, after subjecting them to thorough searches using electronic devices.
<p style="text-align: center;">RAMALLAH & AL BIREH</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Sinjil village well as the junction to Kafr Malik and ‘Ein Samiya villages. (ii) Since September 3rd 2013, Israeli forces closed the north east entrance of Al-Mughier village with dirt mounds. (iii) At 22:30 on November 28th 2014, Israeli forces closed the entrance of Beit Illu village with dirt mounds. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 13:55, Israeli forces set up two checkpoint at the entrance of Deir Ammar village until 14:10. (ii) At 13:55, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Beit Illu

	<p>village until 19:00.</p> <p>(iii) At 17:25, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Al-Nabi Saleh village.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 16:10, Israeli forces raided Beit Illu, stormed several homes, detained a resident then withdrew at 19:00. (ii) At 01:20, Israeli forces raided Bir Zeit and Beituniya summoned two residents: Karim Daraha and Mohammad Zayed to report to Israeli Intelligence for questioning then withdrew at 04:40. (iii) At 02:00, Israeli forces raided Silwad and summoned Anwar Hamad to report to Israeli Intelligence for questioning then withdrew at 02:30. • <u>Detention:</u> Israeli forces detained Abdallah Abu Zaydeh in Beit Illu. • <u>Attack:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 22:30, Israeli forces positioned near Atarah bridge in North Bir Ziet fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning. (ii) On the evening of November 29th 2014, Israeli forces positioned at the entrance of Beit Illu fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning after closing the main entrance and as a result injured six residents and left several other suffocated from tear gas inhalation. • <u>Settler Violence:</u> At 14:35, Israeli settlers positioned near “Pesagout” settlement stoned several homes located near the settlement located in east Al-Bireh city.
JENIN	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Road:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the road leading to the town of ‘Arraba east of the illegal settlement Dotan. (ii) Since the evening of November 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the western entrance of Ya’bad. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 20:45, Israeli forces positioned near Araba until 22; 50. • <u>Temporary Detention:</u> At 16:30, Israeli forces positioned at “Movo Dotan” settlement junction temporarily detained Mohammad Al-Arada and Anads Al-Aradeh then released them at 17:20.
TULKAREM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the road connecting Kafr Al-Labad town to Shufa village. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the detour road leading to Ramin village along the Tulkarem-Nablus main road. • <u>Checkpoint:</u> Israeli forces continue to intensify their restrictions at “Eniv” checkpoint and impeded the free flow of traffic. • <u>Attack:</u> At 13:35, Israeli forces positioned on the north side of Zieta fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.
QALQILIYA	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli forces continue to close with cement blocks agricultural roads east of Azzun town. (ii) In addition to closing the gate installed since the outbreak the second Intifada, the Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the eastern entrance to Kafr Qaddum village. (iii) At 12:10 on September 2nd 2014, Israeli forces closed the main road connecting Qalqiliya and Nablus near Al-Nabi Eliyas village with cement blocks. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 09:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Azzun until 10:00. (ii) At 10:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint the entrance of Izbit Al-Tabib

	<p>and impeded the free flow after closing the checkpoint then reopened it later.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Raid:</u> At 24:00, Israeli forces raided Azzun until 00:45. • <u>Temporary Detention:</u> At 16:15, Israeli forces positioned in Al-Muntar area in North Azzun, temporarily detained 2 residents: Murad Salim and Mohammad Salim (both residents of Azzun) then released them at 17:15. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to restrict access at ‘Azzun ‘Atma Wall gate and impeded the free flow of traffic. The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the entrance to the village of Wadi Al- Rasha and to deny civilian access. (ii) The Israeli army allows residents to access the village through Gate #109. Having removed the gate at the entrance to the village of Ras Atiya; the Israeli army only allows students to cross to their schools outside the village through the Habla gate.
NABLUS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> Since December 17th 2013, Israeli forces ordered the closure 500 dunumes of land in Qusra village as a closed military area. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the roads of Til-Burin and Beit Furik-Salem; the settler bypass road connecting the village of Deir al Hatab to the settlement of Alon Moreh; the road connecting the town of ‘Aqraba to the village of Osrin; and the detour road between the town of Qabalan and the village of Osrin. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the northern entrance to Qabalan town; the southern entrances to the town of Jamma’in and the villages of Duma and Qaryut. • <u>Raid:</u> At 01:00, Israeli forces raided Madma and Assirah Al-Qibliya until 02:30. • <u>Detention:</u> At 21:35, Israeli forces detained the child Omar Al-Shami (16 years old) {a resident of Nablus} near Jabal Al-Tur in Nablus for allegedly carrying a knife.
SALFIT	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the entrance to two detour roads connecting Marda village to its farmland. (ii) On 15.04.2012, the Israeli army has opened the northern entrance to Salfit city to civilian which was closed since the year 2000 and prevented access from 08:00 until 09:20. (iii) Since 11:00 on July 30th 2012, Israeli forces have closed two roads leading to Abu Nasar and Qatan Al-Jama’ located in western area of Deir Istiya with cement blocks. • <u>Checkpoints:</u> Israeli forces intensified their restrictions at Za’tara checkpoint and impeded the free flow of traffic.
JERICHO	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Checkpoints:</u> Israeli forces intensified its restrictions at Al-Hamra checkpoint set up along the road connecting Jericho and Nablus District. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 07:30 on November 29th 2014, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the Dead Sea junction until 08:20. (ii) At 15:10, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Al-Fasayil village junction until 15:55. (iii) At 16:15, Israeli force set up a checkpoint along road (90) near Al-New’meh village in North Jericho until 17:20. (iv) At 21:15, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Al-Oja village junction until 22:30.
BETHLEHEM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close roads to An Nu’mān village, with the

exception of the road leading to the Wall gate in the south-eastern area of the village.

- (ii) Since 15 September 2007, the Israel army has prevented civilians from accessing or staying on 22 dunums of confiscated land in Al Mazmuriya area in Beit Sahur and Bethlehem cities.

- **Closure of Main Roads:**

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close the Beit Jala-Wadi Ahmed road; a road between Um Tuba and Al-Jass ; a road between Um Tuba and Khilat Nu'man: a road between Um Tuba and the wall; a road between Al-Khas village and the wall; the 2 by pass roads located south of Al-Walaja; a road between Talita Qumi and Nazlat Al-Sider in Beit Jala; the eastern road of Al-Khader; the road between Al-Khader and Beit Jala ; Wadi Rahal road near "Ifrat" settlement ,the road between Al-Khader and road #60 which lead to the eastern neighbourhoods of Bethlehem; a road leading to Wadi Rahal, and a road east of Beit Fajjar town with dirt mounds.

- (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the road leading to "Newe Daniyyel" settlement and agricultural land in Al-Khader; a road between Um Tuba and Wadi Al-Hums: Wadi Fukin, Al-Jaba, the Green Line; a road between Za'tara and a detour road, and a road between Taqou and Khirbet Al-Deir with cement blocks.

- (iii) Since August 2nd 2012, Israeli forces closed a road leading to Beit Jalla.

- (iv) Since May 8th 2013, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Carmisan area in Beit Jalla and Al-Walaja with a steel gate and barbed wires.

- (v) Since June 3rd 2013, the Israeli army closed the road connecting Nihalin and road 60 with dirt mounds.

- (vi) Since 13:20 on September 29th 2013, the Israeli army closed a road leading to 50 acres of agricultural land in Wadi Salem area in Al-Khadr with dirt mounds.

- (vii) Israeli forces closed the main road connecting Surif and Al-Jub'a village with dirt mounds.

- (viii) On January 28th 2014, Israeli forces closed the steel gate at the entrance of Nihalin { replacing the dirt mounds placed at the entrance since the year 2002} and placed time schedule for opening the gate from 06:00 until 14:00 on a daily bases.

- **Flying Checkpoint:** At 21:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Al-Nashash area located at the south entrance of Bethlehem until 22:10.

- **Raid:**

- (i) At 05:00, Israeli forces raided Harmalah, stormed several homes, summoned 3 residents: Kamal Al-Zir, Khaled Al-Zir and Lou'ay Asakra to report to Israeli Intelligence for questioning.

- (ii) At 01:40, Israeli forces raided Taqou', detained a child then withdrew at 02:15.

- **Detention:**

- (i) At 20:00, Israeli forces detained Bashar Al-Mi'awi (A resident of Al-Duhisheh camp) as he was reporting to Israeli Intelligence for questioning based on a prior summon.

- (ii) Israeli forces detained Ahmad Al-Amour (17 years old) in Taqou'.

- **Attack:**

- (i) At 14:50, Israeli forces positioned in Al-Ayda camp fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.

- (ii) At 17:20, Israeli forces positioned near Dar Salah village fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and as a result, left four residents suffocated from tear gas inhalation.

- **Settler Violence:** At 16:20, Israeli settlers stoned residents and vehicles near the main road connecting Husan and Nihalin villages.

HEBRON	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close Al-Shuhada' Street, Al-Sahleh and Khuzq Al-Far areas, as well as the old gold market in Hebron's Old City. In addition to closing the entrance to Al-Qeisi neighbourhood, the Israeli army continues to close the entrances to the area of Al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) with an electronic gate; Al-Laban Market also remains closed. (ii) Since 05 January 2009, the Israeli army has closed the area located along the Green Line south of the town of Yatta. Having seized land for Wall construction, the Israeli army evicted the Palestinian residents and denied them access to the area. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Al-Thahiriya and Al-Samoa' towns, Al-'Arrub refugee camp, and Al-Tuwani and Al-Karmil villages. (ii) The Israeli army continues to prohibit Palestinian vehicles from travelling along the old Al-Shalala Street leading to Hebron's Old City. (iii) The Israeli army continues to close all roads leading to Road # 60 as well as detour roads along the settler bypass road leading to Yatta town. (iv) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds a detour road leading to e to Al-Simiya village, the southern entrance of Al-Samou' and the entrance of Beit Annun with cement blocks. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 09:50, Israeli forces raided Hebron, stormed a home and summoned Hazim Al-Houmani to report to Israeli Intelligence for questioning. (ii) At 02:30, Israeli forces raided Beit Awa until 03:00. (iii) At 03:40, Israeli forces raided Al-Fuwar camp , stormed and searched several homes and detained a child. (iv) At dawn on November 30th 2014, Israeli forces raided Beit Ummar, clashed with several residents as they stormed and searched a home and detained a resident. (v) At dawn November 30th 2014, Israeli forces raided Surif, stormed and searched several homes, detained two residents and confiscated a computer from Ayman Bardi's home. • <u>Detention:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli forces detained Faris Al-Titi (16 years old) in Al-Fuwar camp. (ii) Israeli forces detained Muntassir Akhalil in Beit Ummar. (iii) Israeli forces detained Abed Abu Farah in Surif. • <u>Attack:</u> At 13:00, Israeli forces positioned at Bab Al-Zawiya area in Hebron fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning as they protested the closure of Al-Shuhada road and as a result injured 2 residents including a child: Mohammad Abu (17 year sold) and Mustafa Al-Atwanah

ALL DISTRICTS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • At 19:00 on August 26th 2014, Palestinian Gunmen and the Israeli military agreed to a cease fire agreement (brokered by the Arab Republic of Egypt) which includes the opening of border crossings to allow the entry of emergency supplies and humanitarian goods as well as construction material and agreed to increase the fishing limit to 6 nautical miles with possibility of increase to 12 nautical miles by the end of the year and to decrease the Military area to 100 meters, allow freedom of movement and a halt to targeted killings and assassinations and negotiations will be held for discussion on rebuilding the sea port and airports in the coming month. • Israeli forces broke the ceasefire agreement by opening fire from their positions behind the Green line towards North Gaza and as a result critically injured a resident.

NORTHERN GAZA	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Closure of Crossing Point: Beit Hanun (Erez) is closed. Attack: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> On the afternoon of November 29th 2014, Israeli forces positioned behind the Green Line opened fire towards several residents located in North West Beit Lahiya and as a result critically injured Samed Al-Sharafi. At 17:20, Israeli forces Naval vessels opened fire towards Palestinian fishing boats off the shores of Al-Sudaniya beach in west Beit Lahiya.
GAZA	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Closure of Crossing Points: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> Al-Muntar (Karni) Crossing is closed. Beginning on 02 March 2011, the Crossing has been effectively closed following a unilateral Israeli decision. Al-Shija'iya (Nahal 'Oz) Crossing is closed. Beginning on 04 January 2010, the Crossing has closed following a unilateral Israeli decision.
