JERUSALEM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) On 28 November 2015, the Israeli army, intensified their restrictions at the entrance to Jerusalem city, set up several flying checkpoints on the main road leading to the city and prevented worshipers under the age of 50 from conducting prayers at Al-Aqsa mosque compound which forced residents to conduct prayers near checkpoints located outside Al-Aqsa mosque compound. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the ‘demarcation area’ along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem according to Military Order 09/02S and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits. (iii) The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill between Biddu and Beit Ikka villages. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the entrance to Issawiyye village. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to Beit Ikka village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandiya checkpoint. (iii) On 16 November 2015, Israeli forces closed the southern entrance of Jabal Al-Mukabir neighbourhood leading to Armon Hanatsif settlement with cement blocks. (iv) At 15:15 on 29 November 2015, Israeli forces closed road near Panorama Hotel in Ras Al-Amud in Jerusalem with cement blocks. • <u>Checkpoints:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli authorities continue to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a “border crossing point” and designate a special crossing lane for holders of Jerusalem IDs and another for those possessing permits to access Jerusalem city. (ii) On 19 September 2012, Israeli forces closed Ras Khamis checkpoint near Shu’fat camp and impeded the free flow of traffic in order to construct the wall. • <u>Flying Checkpoints:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 13:55, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Qalandia and searched civilians and vehicles. (ii) At 22:20, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint in front of Maqassed Hospital on Mt. of Olives and searched civilians and vehicles. • <u>Raids:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 15:20 Israeli forces raided and patrolled Al-Ram town and clashed with civilians. (ii) At 22:30, Israeli forces raided and patrolled Isawiyye village and clashed with civilians. (iii) At 02:40, Israeli forces raided Anata town and searched 3 civilian homes. • <u>Arrests:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 18:30, Israeli forces arrested in Ras Al-Amud neighbourhood in Jerusalem a child called Malik Mohammad Abu Swayy, 15. (ii) At 22:30, Israeli forces arrested a child called Wajeeh Mohammad Haitham Al-Khatib, 14, from Qalandia refugee camp. • <u>Killing:</u> The martyr from Silwan neighbourhood in Jerusalem is Ayman Samih Hassan Al-Abassi, 17. • <u>Attacks:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 15:00, Israeli forces in Ras Khamis neighbourhood in Jerusalem fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning. (ii) At 20:30, Israeli forces near the entrance of Hizma fired stun and tear gas

(ii) The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate on Al-Shayyah road in the area between Al-Sawahira Al-Sharqiya and Al-Slewahira Al-Gharbiya villages, only allowing civilians holding Jerusalem IDs to cross, after subjecting them to thorough searches using electronic devices.

On 3 October 2015, Israeli forces closed the main road located near “Bet El” settlement and leading to Al-Jalazoun camp with cement blocks. (iii) On 24 November 2015, Israeli forces closed the main entrance gate leading to Sinjil and the east entrance of Mughier with cement blocks. • <u>Flying Checkpoints:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 11:40, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Silwad town near Ofra settlement and searched residents and vehicles until 17:20. (ii) At 15:50, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint near Attara Bridge north of Birzeit and impeded flow of traffic until 18:00. (iii) At 16:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the roundabout of Ein Sinya village and searched civilians and vehicles until 17:15. (iv) At 17:20, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Nabi Saleh village, closed steel gate and impeded flow of traffic. (v) At 20:55, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Sinjil town and searched civilians and vehicles until 00:30 (vi) At 20:55, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Lubban Gharbi village and searched civilians and vehicles until 00:30. (vii) At 21:30, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint under Ein Yabroud Bridge, clashed with civilians and arrested two civilians. • <u>Raids:</u> At 23:15, Israeli forces raided Silwad town, clashed with civilians and injured 3 civilians (one is called Ghalib Sami Warda) and withdrew at 01:00. • <u>Arrests:</u> The 2 civilians arrested in at the flying checkpoint under Yabroud Bridge are: Hanna Wadi Kazouah and Khader Hanna Qawwas, both from Jifna village. • <u>Temporary Detention:</u> At 08:00, Israeli forces detained 4 children from Jalazon refugee camp who were on the way to school: Muath Sufyan Al-Rimhi, 13, Muath Mamoun Al-Ribhi, 13, Zeidan Ahmad Khattab, 12, and Omar Hussam Farraj 13. They were released at a later time. • <u>Attacks:</u> At 13:45, Israeli forces positioned in the vicinity of Al-Mahkama checkpoint near Bet El settlement north of Al-Bireh fired live ammunition, rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents (who were protesting against the continued Israeli Military and Settler assault on Al-Aqsa mosque compound) for alleged stoning and as a result injured 1 elderly

	<p>civilian called Hassan Ibrahim Al-Najjar, 76, from Jalazon refugee camp, a civilian from Bourin village in Nablus called Abdlah Rustum Nimer Issa who was passing in his car, and 14 other civilians were suffocated as a result of gas inhalation.</p>
JENIN	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure of Main Road: The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the road leading to the town of ‘Arraba east of the illegal settlement Dotan. • Flying Checkpoints: At 11:30, Israeli force set up a checkpoint at the junction of Arraba town and searched civilians and vehicles until 12:10. • Raids: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 02:20, Israeli forces raided Al-Yamun town, arrested 1 university student and withdrew at 03:20. (ii) At dawn on 30 November 2015, Israeli forces raided Ya’bud town and arrested 2 civilians. • Arrests: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The civilian arrested in Al-Yamun is a university student called Aweis Mazin Sadeq Nawahda. (ii) The 2 civilians arrested in Ya’bud town are: Adnan Yassin Hamarsheh and his brother Ala’. • Temporary Detention: At 19:20, Israeli forces at Bartaa checkpoint detained a female civilian called Intisar Mahmoud Shalabi from Silet Al-Harithiyyeh for allegedly possessing a knife, and released her at 20:50. • Wall Gates: Israeli forces continue too close the wall gate and only allow those holding special permits to enter through it.
TUBAS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Raids: At 19:30, Israeli forces raided and patrolled Bardala village in the northern valley. • Confiscation of Property: At 07:00, Israeli forces confiscated in Khirbet al-Deir area east of Ein Al-Beda village in the northern valley 4 irrigation water pumps and 7 tents used to shelter 3 families in Al-Hadiddiye village and Khirbet Al-Deir area, and detained 2 civilians: Aref Daraghme and Mu’taz Bisharat.
TULKAREM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Checkpoints: At 23:45, Israeli forces continue to intensify their restrictions at “Eniv” checkpoint located along the main road connecting Tulkarem and Nablus and impeded the free flow of traffic. • Flying Checkpoints: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 08:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint between Irtha suburb and Faron village and searched civilians and vehicles until 09:35. (ii) At 12:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the junction of Bazaria village east of Anabta town and searched civilians and vehicles until 13:00. (iii) At 21:35, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the junction of Beit Led town and searched civilians and vehicles. • Raids: At dawn on 30 November 2015, Israeli forces raided Zeita village and arrested 1 civilian. • Arrests: The civilian arrested in Zeita village is Rabah Mohammad Abdelfattah Al-Labadi. • Attacks: At 10:10, Israeli forces positioned Israeli forces positioned near “Ghishoury” factories located in west Tulkarem fired rubber coated steel bullets stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents (as they were protesting against Israeli Military and settler assault on Al Alqsa mosque compound) for alleged stoning, injuring 8 civilians (including 2 children): Mahmoud Shukri Mahajneh, 16, and Fadi Mohammad Hamad, 16, Jamal Kamal Hamad, Amer Jamal Ardah, Akram Bassam Sahrim, Mustafa Samer Baransi, Anas Hassan Amro and Mohammad Imad Abdel Hadi. The following civilian was suffocated as a result of gas inhalation: Ahmad Khaled Khader.

<p>QALQILIYA</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli forces continue to close with cement blocks agricultural roads east of Azzun town. (ii) In addition to closing the gate installed since the outbreak the second Intifada, the Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the eastern entrance to Kafr Qaddum village. (iii) Since 10:40 on 1 September 2015, Israeli forces closed an agricultural road leading to Far'ata village which is located near "Gillad" settlement with a steel gate. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Flying Checkpoints:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 09:35, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Jit junction and impeded flow of traffic in both directions. (ii) At 17:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Jayyous town and searched civilians and vehicles until 18:00. (iii) At 18:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint between Jayyous town and Kafr Jamal village and searched civilians and vehicles. (iv) At 19:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Azzun town and searched civilians and vehicles. • <u>Raids:</u> At 23:20, Israeli forces raided and patrolled Qalqilya city. • <u>Arrests:</u> At 19:50, Israeli forces near Azzun Itmeh village arrested 3 civilians from Irtah suburb in Tulkarem city while they were trying to get into the Green Line: Imran Tawfiq Azami, Tamer Tayseer Mohammad Khalid and his brother Ahmad. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to restrict access at 'Azzun 'Atma Wall gate and impeded the free flow of traffic. The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the entrance to the village of Wadi Al- Rasha and to deny civilian access. (ii) The Israeli army allows residents to access the village through Gate #109. Having removed the gate at the entrance to the village of Ras Atiya; the Israeli army only allows students to cross to their schools outside the village through the Habla gate.
<p>NABLUS</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> Since 17 December 2013, Israeli forces ordered the closure 500 dunumes of land in Qusra village as a closed military area. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the roads of Til-Burin and Beit Furik-Salem; the settler bypass road connecting the village of Deir al Hatab to the settlement of Alon Moreh; the road connecting the town of 'Aqraba to the village of Osrin; and the detour road between the town of Qabalan and the village of Osrin. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the northern entrance to Qabalan town; the southern entrances to the town of Jamma'in and the villages of Duma and Qaryut. (iii) At 06:30 on 22 November 2015, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Aqraba town with Yanun village with dirt mounds. (iv) On 29 November 2015, Israeli forces closed the entrances of Bourin, Awarta and Osrin villages and the agricultural road connecting the towns of Aqraba and Qabalan with dirt mounds. • <u>Checkpoints:</u> At 19:00, Israeli forces closed Beit Fourik checkpoint before traffic and reopened it at 19:15. • <u>Flying Checkpoints:</u> At 15:40, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint near the junction of Deir Sharaf village (on Nablus-Tulkarem main road) and denied civilians access to Tulkarem except residents there. • <u>Raids:</u> At 00:15, Israeli forces raided Nablus city and Askar refugee camp, stormed into several civilian homes, arrested 1 civilian and withdrew at 06:00. • <u>Arrests:</u>

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 12:00, Israeli forces arrested 1 civilian called Iyad Bassam Abdel Rahim Darwish, a bus school driver from Awarta village, for allegedly running over an Israeli soldier who was riding a motorbike. (ii) The civilian arrested in Nablus is Baha' Tayseer Abdel Haq. • <u>Settler Violence:</u> At 09:20, Israeli settlers physically attacked 1 civilian called Baha' Bashir Mohammad Najjar from Yitma village and seriously injured him.
SALFIT	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the entrance to two detour roads connecting Marda village to its farmland. (ii) Since 11:00 on 30 July 2012, Israeli forces have closed two roads leading to Abu Nasar and Qatan Al-Jama' located in western area of Deir Istiya with cement blocks. • <u>Checkpoints:</u> Israeli forces intensified their restrictions at Za'tara checkpoint and impeded the free flow of traffic. • <u>Flying Checkpoints:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 16:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Al-Zawiya town and searched residents and vehicles. (ii) At 16:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the northern entrance of Marda village and searched civilians and vehicles until 16:35. (iii) At 21:50, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Kafal Haris and searched civilians and vehicles. (iv) At 21:50, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Deir Ballout and searched civilians and vehicles.

BETHLEHEM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close roads to An Nu'man village, with the exception of the road leading to the Wall gate in the south-eastern area of the village. (ii) Since 15 September 2007, the Israel army has prevented civilians from accessing or staying on 22 dunumes of confiscated land in Al Mazmuriya area in Beit Sahur and Bethlehem cities. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the Beit Jala-Wadi Ahmed road; a road between Um Tuba and Al-Jass ; a road between Um Tuba and Khilat Nu'man: a road between Um Tuba and the wall; a road between Al-Khas village and the wall; the 2 by pass roads located south of Al-Walaja; a road between Talita Qumi and Nazlat Al-Sider in Beit Jala; the eastern road of Al-Khader; the road between Al-Khader and Beit Jala ; Wadi Rahal road near "Ifrat" settlement ,the road between Al-Khader and road #60 which lead to the eastern neighbourhoods of Bethlehem; a road leading to Wadi Rahal, and a road east of Beit Fajjar town with dirt mounds. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the road leading to "Newe Daniyyel" settlement and agricultural land in Al-Khader; a road between Um Tuba and Wadi Al-Hums: Wadi Fukin, Al-Jaba, the Green Line; a road between Za'tara and a detour road, and a road between Taqou and Khirbet Al-Deir with cement blocks (iii) Israeli forces continue to close the road connecting Cremisan area north of Beit Jala and Walaja village with barbed wires and steel gate, and the road connecting Surif town with Jabaa village with cement blocks. (iv) Since 10:45 on 8 September 2015, the Israeli army agricultural road in Arab Rashaydeh near Ma'ale Amos settlement with dirt mounds. (v) At 15:30 on 20 November 2015, Israeli forces closed the eastern entrance of Jinana town with dirt mounds.

- (vi) At 13:10 on 22 November 2015, Israeli forces closed the entrance of Marah Rabah with dirt mounds.
- (vii) At 18:00 on 27 November 2015, Israeli forces closed Barbara junction in Beit Jala with cement blocks.
- (viii) At 14:50, on 28 November 2015, Israeli forces closed the entrance of Um Rukba in Al-Khader town with cement blocks.
- **Checkpoints:** At 23:00, Israeli forces intensified restrictions at al-kontener checkpoint and impeded traffic.
- **Flying Checkpoints:**
 - (i) At 07:50 and 20:15 on 29 November 2015, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint near Deir Salah village on the eastern entrance of Beit Sahour and searched residents and vehicles until 23:15.
 - (ii) At 08:35, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the north-western entrance of Beit Fajjar town and prohibited civilians under 35 to leave the town. Israeli forces withdrew at 17:00.
 - (iii) At 15:25, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the north-western entrance of Beit Jala and searched residents and vehicles until 17:00.
 - (iv) At 18:30, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint between Beit Fajjar town and Marah Rabah village and searched civilians and vehicles until 18:50.
- **Raids:**
 - (i) At 10:20, Israeli forces raided Jabal Hindaza area south of Bethlehem, stormed the home of Adnan Abu Khashaba and confiscated his car.
 - (ii) At 20:10, Israeli forces raided Marah Rabah village, clashed with civilian Hamza Abdalla Al-Sheikh after storming his home and withdrew at 20:45.
 - (iii) At 22:50, Israeli forces raided Teqoa town and Khirbet Al-Deir village and patrolled them until 14:00.
 - (iv) At 01:35, Israeli forces raided Doha town, arrested 1 civilian and withdrew at 02:00
 - (v) At 02:30, Israeli forces raided Aida refugee camp in Bethlehem city and delivered notifications to report to the Israeli military intelligence to 2 civilians: Mohammad Ibrahim Al-Ak and Khader Lutfi Daamseh.
- **Arrests:**
 - (i) At 11:50, Israeli forces arrested a female civilian called Nada Ahmad Youssef Saqer, 52, from Aida refugee camp during a visit to her sons in Negev prison.
 - (ii) The civilian arrested in Doha is Ashraf Al-Qadi.
- **Temporary Detention:** At 19:30, Israeli forces detained near the junction of Kfar Itzyon settlement three civilians from teqoa and released them later: Zaki Daoud Rizek, Youssef Mohammad Jiobril and Jalil Daoud Ahmad Hmeid.
- **Attacks:** At 14:45, Israeli forces positioned in the vicinity of Aida refugee camp located in North Bethlehem fired live ammunition and rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.
- **Settler Violence:** at 19:40, Jewish settlers raided Khilet Sikaria village and wrote racist slogans on the civilian car of Ahmad Hatem Saed and hang Israeli flags on olive trees.

HEBRON

- **Closure:**
 - (i) The Israeli army continues to close Khuzq Al-Far areas, as well as the old gold market in Hebron's Old City. In addition to closing the entrance to Al-Qeisi neighbourhood, the Israeli army continues to close the entrances to the area of Al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) with an electronic gate; Al-Laban Market also remains closed.
 - (ii) Since 05 January 2009, the Israeli army has closed the area located along the Green Line south of the town of Yatta. Having seized land for Wall construction, the Israeli army evicted the Palestinian residents and denied them access to the area.
- **Closure of Main Roads:**
 - (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Al-Karmil villages.
 - (ii) The Israeli army continues to prohibit Palestinian vehicles from travelling along the old Al-Shalala Street leading to Hebron's Old City.
 - (iii) The Israeli army continues to close all roads leading to Road # 60 as well as detour roads along the settler bypass road leading to Yatta town.
 - (iv) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds a detour road leading to e to Al-Simiya village, the southern entrance of Al-Samou' and the entrance of Beit Annun with cement blocks.
 - (v) On 15 November 2015, Israeli forces closed the entrances of Khilet Al-Mayye and Al-Deirat villages with dirt mounds.

 - (v) At dawn on 30 November 2015, Israeli forces raided Bani Naim town and arrested 1 civilian.
