<p>JERUSALEM</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army, intensified their restrictions at the entrance to Jerusalem city, set up several flying checkpoints on the main road leading to the city and prevented worshipers under the age of 50 from conducting prayers at Al-Aqsa mosque compound. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the ‘demarcation area’ along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits. (iii) The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill between Biddu and Beit Ikksa villages. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the entrance to Jaba’ village. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to Beit Ikksa village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandiya checkpoint. • <u>Checkpoints:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli authorities continue to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a “border crossing point” and designate a special crossing lane for holders of Jerusalem IDs and another for those possessing permits to access Jerusalem city and closed the checkpoint at 01:20 and impeded the free flow of traffic until 04:05. (ii) On September 19th 2012, Israeli forces closed Ras Khamis checkpoint near Shu’fat camp and impeded the free flow of traffic in order to construct the wall. • <u>Raid:</u> At dawn on October 30th 2014, Israeli forces raided Al-Eizariya and detained a resident after storming his home. • <u>Detention:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) On the evening of September 29th 2014, Israeli forces detained two residents: Rania Abu Al-Hawa and Islam Abu Sneh in the old city of Jerusalem. (ii) At 11:00, Israeli forces detained Mu’tasim Al-Shawish asfter storming his home in Silwan neighbourhood in Jerusalem. (iii) Israeli forces detained Ahmad Al-Khatib in Al-Eizariya. • <u>Physical Assault:</u> At 13:00 on September 29th 2014, Israeli forces assaulted and injured several Palestinian Electrical Company workers after smashing their vehicles windshield. • <u>Destruction of Property:</u> At 10:30, Israeli forces stormed the area located between Al-Eizariya and Khan Al-Ahmar area and issued a demolition order for a home used to shelter several Bedouin children. • <u>Assault on Places of Worship:</u> Since the morning of September 28th 2014, Israeli settlers under the protection of Israeli forces stormed Al-Aqsa mosque compound in the old city of Jerusalem. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the Wall gate in Abu Dis town. (ii) The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate

(ii) Since September 3rd 2013, Israeli forces closed the north east entrance of Al-Mughier village with dirt mounds. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 11:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint beneath Yabrud Village Bridge. (ii) At 23:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Atara bridge located in North Bir Zeit until 23:30. • <u>Raid:</u> At 01:45, Israeli forces raided Awarat until 03:45. • <u>Settler Violence:</u> At 17:25, Israeli settlers positioned near “Bet El” settlement stoned several residents and vehicles passing along the main road near Al-Jalazoun camp.

At 03:20, Israeli forces raided Qabatiya and detained 2 residents.</p> • <u>Detention:</u> Israeli forces detained Luai Saba’neh and Yusef Kameel in Qabatiya. • <u>Temporary Detention::</u> At 21:30, Israeli forces positioned at “Dotan” checkpoint located along the main road connecting Jenin and Tulkarem temporarily detained Amar Amarnah (A resident of Ya’bad) then released him at 22:20

TULKAREM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the road connecting Kafr Al-Labad town to Shufa village. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the detour road leading to Ramin village along the Tulkarem-Nablus main road. (iii) On August 5th 2014, Israeli forces closed the main steel gate and placed cement block along the road connecting Shufa and Izbit Shufa villages near “Aveni Hivits”. • <u>Checkpoint:</u> Israeli forces intensified their restrictions at “Eniv” checkpoint

(iii) At 12:10 on September 2nd 2014, Israeli forces closed the main road connecting Qalqiliya and Nablus near Al-Nabi Eliyas village with cement blocks. • Flying Checkpoint: At 21:30, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Jit village junction until 22:30. • Wall Gates: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to restrict access at ‘Azzun ‘Atma Wall gate and impeded the free flow of traffic. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the northern entrance to Qabalan town; the southern entrances to the town of Jamma’in and the villages of Duma and Qaryut. • Flying Checkpoint: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 08:30 and again at 19:15, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Beit Furiq until 23:10 (ii) At 12:30, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint along the main road connecting Al-Bithan and Al-Far’a until 12:45. • Raid: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 02:05, Israeli forces raided Deir Sharaf village, stormed two homes, detained a resident then withdrew at 03:15. (ii) At 02:55, Israeli forces raided Osirin village, stormed several homes and summoned four residents: Ahmad Adeli, Thaer Adli, Omran Miflih and Rafe’ Adeli to report to Israeli Intelligence for questioning then withdrew at 04:10. (iii) At 03:05, Israeli forces raided Burqa village, detained a resident then withdrew at 03:45. • Detention: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli forces detained Osama Suliman in Deir Sharaf. (ii) Israeli forces detained Suliman Sayf in Burqa village. • Temporary Detention: At 13:45, Israeli forces positioned in Jabal Atil area in north Nablus temporarily detained Bajjas Judeh and Mahmoud Judeh (Both residents of Araq Al-Taya village) then released them at 15:25.

(ii) On 15.04.2012, the Israeli army has opened the northern entrance to Salfit city to civilian, which was closed since the year 2000 and prevented access from 08:00 until 09:20. (iii) Since 11:00 on July 30th 2012, Israeli forces have closed two roads leading to Abu Nasar and Qatan Al-Jama' located in western area of Deir Istiya with cement blocks. • <u>Checkpoints:</u> Israeli forces intensified their restrictions at Za'tara checkpoint and impeded the free flow of traffic. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 08:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the West entrance of Kafr Al-Dik until 09:20. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 02:30, Israeli forces raided Qarwat Bani Hassan, detained six residents after storming their homes then withdrew at 03:30. (ii) At 17:10, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the Dead Sea junction. (iii) At 17:30, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint along road (90) near Al-New'meh village located at the North entrance of Jericho until 21:00.

	<p>accessing or staying on 22 dunumes of confiscated land in Al Mazmuriya area in Beit Sahur and Bethlehem cities.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the Beit Jala-Wadi Ahmed road; a road between Um Tuba and Al-Jass ; a road between Um Tuba and Khilat Nu'man: a road between Um Tuba and the wall; a road between Al-Khas village and the wall; the 2 by pass roads located south of Al-Walaja; a road between Talita Qumi and Nazlat Al-Sider in Beit Jala; the eastern road of Al-Khader; the road between Al-Khader and Beit Jala ; Wadi Rahal road near "Ifrat" settlement ,the road between Al-Khader and road #60 which lead to the eastern neighbourhoods of Bethlehem; a road leading to Wadi Rahal, and a road east of Beit Fajjar town with dirt mounds. (iii)Israeli forces detained Ammar Jahajrah in area between Al-Khadr and Irtas village. • <u>Injury:</u> At 17:55, 2 children: Malik Abu Daya (12 years old) and Ali Abu Daya {residents of Taqou'} were injured after an Israeli Military UXO exploded as they were herding their goats in an area located in West Taqou'.
<p>HEBRON</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close Al-Shuhada' Street, Al-Sahleh and Khuzq Al-Far areas, as well as the old gold market in Hebron's Old City. In addition to closing the entrance to Al-Qeisi neighbourhood, the Israeli army continues to close the entrances to the area of Al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) with an electronic gate; Al-Laban Market also remains closed. (ii) Since 05 January 2009, the Israeli army has closed the area located along the Green Line south of the town of Yatta. Having seized land for Wall construction, the Israeli army evicted the Palestinian residents and denied them access to the area. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u>

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Al-Thahiriya and Al-Samoa' towns, Al-‘Arrub refugee camp, and Al-Tuwani and Al-Karmil villages. (ii) The Israeli army continues to prohibit Palestinian vehicles from travelling along the old Al-Shalala Street leading to Hebron’s Old City. (iii) The Israeli army continues to close all roads leading to Road # 60 as well as detour roads along the settler bypass road leading to Yatta town. (iv) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds a detour road leading to e to Al-Simiya village, the southern entrance of Al-Samou’ and the entrance of Beit Annun with cement blocks. (v) Since July 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Safa and Al-Dirat and also closed the entrance of south Yatta with cement blocks. (vi) On September 4th 2014, Israeli forces closed a road in Eiwn Al-Bas and Al-Bayda and Al-Ras area in Ithna locat6ed near the wall gate. <p style="text-align: center;">ALL DISTRICTS</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • At 19:00 on August 26th 2014, Palestinian Gunmen and the Israeli military agreed to a cease fire agreement (brokered by the Arab Republic of Egypt) which includes the opening of border crossings to allow the entry of emergency supplies and humanitarian goods as well as construction material and agreed to increase the fishing limit to 6 nautical miles with possibility of increase to 12 nautical miles by the end of the year and to decrease the Military area to 100 meters, allow freedom of movement and a halt to targeted killings and assassinations and negotiations will be held for discussion on rebuilding the sea port and airports in the coming month. • Israeli forces broke the cease-fire agreement by raiding and opening fire toward Khan Yunis.

NORTHERN GAZA	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Crossing Point:</u> Beit Hanun (Erez) is open for the passage of critical patients, journalists, NGO staff, businessmen and passengers travelling abroad through Al-Karama crossing with previous coordination.
GAZA	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Crossing Points:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Al-Muntar (Karni) Crossing is closed. Beginning on 02 March 2011, the Crossing has been effectively closed following a unilateral Israeli decision. (ii) Al-Shija'iyah (Nahal 'Oz) Crossing is closed. Beginning on 04 January 2010, the Crossing has closed following a unilateral Israeli decision.
KHAN YUNIS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Raid:</u> On the morning of October 1st 2014, Israeli forces, Military tanks and fighter jets escorting several military bulldozer and stormed 150 m into the vicinity of the east area of Al-Fakhari and opened fire as they levelled a plot of agricultural land.
RAFAH	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Crossing Points :</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Yasser 'Arafat International Airport remains closed. (ii) Rafah (<i>Al 'Awdah</i>) Crossing is open for the entry and exit of residents , students , tourists and businessmen (iii) Sufa Crossing is closed. (iv) Karm Abu Salem (Karem Shalom) Crossing is open for the entry of tourist and foreign diplomats and the entry of Humanitarian assistance and construction material funded by UNRWA.
