<p>JERUSALEM</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Since 18:00 on September 27th 2015, the Israeli army, intensified their restrictions at the entrance to Jerusalem city, set up several flying checkpoints on the main road leading to the city and prevented worshipers under the age of 50 from conducting prayers at Al-Aqsa mosque compound. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the ‘demarcation area’ along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits. (iii) The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill between Biddu and Beit Ikksa villages. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the entrance to Jaba’ village. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to Beit Ikksa village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandiya checkpoint. • <u>Checkpoints:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli authorities continue to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a “border crossing point” and designate a special crossing lane for holders of Jerusalem IDs and another for those possessing permits to access Jerusalem city. (ii) On September 19th 2012, Israeli forces closed Ras Khamis checkpoint near Shu’fat camp and impeded the free flow of traffic in order to construct the wall. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 16:25, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint beneath Bir Nabalah Bridge. • <u>Attack:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 18:30, Israeli forces positioned near Ras Al-Kabsa area located in Al-Eizariya fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning. (ii) At 18:30, Israeli forces positioned in Wadi Al-Jouz neighbourhood fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning. (iii) At 19:00, Israeli forces positioned in the vicinity of Hizma checkpoint located near the east entrance of Jerusalem fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents (as they were protesting against the continued daily Israeli settler and Israeli military assault on Al-Aqsa mosque compound) for alleged stoning. (iv) At 19:35, Israeli forces positioned in Abu Dis fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning. • <u>Expulsion:</u> On September 30th 2015, Israeli Authorities issued a court order for the expulsion of Jihad Qous (A resident of the old city of Jerusalem) preventing him from entering Al-Aqsa mosque compound for a period of 15 days.

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Assault on Places of Worship:</u> At 09:00, a group of Israeli settlers under the protection of Israeli military and Police forces stormed Al-Aqsa mosque compound in the old city of Jerusalem and provoked worshippers. • <u>Detention:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 18:30, Israeli forces detained Majdi Sa'ida in Wadi Al-Joz neighbourhood in Jerusalem. (ii) On the evening of September 30th 2015, Israeli forces detained Aqaba Darwish in the old city of Jerusalem. • <u>Settler Violence:</u> On the evening of September 30th 2015, an Israeli settler sprayed pepper spray onto the face of a woman in Aqbat Khaldiya area in the old city of Jerusalem. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the Wall gate in Abu Dis town. (ii) The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate on Al-Shayyah road in the area between Al-Sawahira Al-Sharqiya and Al-Slewahira Al-Gharbiya villages, only allowing civilians holding Jerusalem IDs to cross, after subjecting them to thorough searches using electronic devices.
<p style="text-align: center;">RAMALLAH & AL BIREH</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Sinjil village well as the junction to Kafr Malik and 'Ein Samiya villages. • <u>Checkpoint:</u> At 14:30, Israeli forces closed Al-Mahakma checkpoint located near Bet El settlement in North Al-Bireh city and impeded the free flow of traffic during which confrontations erupted between Israeli forces and residents then reopened it at a later time. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 18:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Khirbathat Al-Misbah village, detained a resident then withdrew at 20:00. (ii) At 20:20, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Ras Kar Kar village junction until 21:00. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At dawn on September 30th 2015, Israeli forces raided Al-Bireh city and detained a Soccer Player (Al-Bireh Youth Foundation Player). (ii) At dawn on September 30th 2015, Israeli forces raided Shuqba village then stormed and searched a home. • <u>Detention:</u> Israeli forces detained Mustafa Abed Al-Danbani in Al-Bireh city.
<p style="text-align: center;">JENIN</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Road:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the road leading to the town of 'Arraba east of the illegal settlement Dotan. (ii) Since the evening of November 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the western entrance of Ya'bad. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At dawn on September 30th 2015, Israeli forces raided Markah village, detained three residents after storming and searching their homes and confiscated a hunting rifle. (ii) At 07:25 on September 30th 2015, Israeli forces raided Deir Abu Da'if village until 09:10. • <u>Detention:</u> Israeli forces detained three residents: Antar Musa, Baker Musa and Ali Mudsas in Marka village. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> Israeli forces continue to close the wall gate and only allow those holding special permits to enter through it.
<p style="text-align: center;">TULKAREM</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Checkpoint:</u> At 12:00, Israeli forces intensified their restrictions at "Eniv" checkpoint located along the main road connecting Tulkarem and Nablus and impeded the free flow of traffic until 12:30.

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 20:10, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Shufa village until 01:10. • <u>Detention:</u> At 23:50, Israeli forces detained positioned at “Eniv” checkpoint located along the main road connecting Tulkarem and Nablus detained Abdallah Mara’ba (A resident of Fahma village in Jenin) for allegedly finding a knife in his possession. • <u>Physical Assault:</u> At 23:50, Israeli forces positioned at “Eniv” checkpoint located along the main road connecting Tulkarem and Nablus assaulted four residents: Mohammad Maraa’beh, Bashar Mara’beh, Mohammad Abdel Salam Mara’beh and Majdi Mara’beh as they detained them and as a result left them hospitalised with contusions. • <u>Temporary Detention:</u> At 16:55, Israeli forces positioned at wall gate # (623) in Deir Al-Ghousoun temporarily detained Tamer Ghannam (A resident of Deir Al-Ghousoun) then released him later.
<p style="text-align: center;">QALQILIYA</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli forces continue to close with cement blocks agricultural roads east of Azzun town. (ii) In addition to closing the gate installed since the outbreak the second Intifada, the Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the eastern entrance to Kafr Qaddum village. (iii) Since 10:40 on September 1st 2015, Israeli forces closed an agricultural road leading to Far’ata village which is located near “Gillad” settlement with a steel Gate. • <u>Attack:</u> At 17:50, Israeli forces positioned near the wall gate in Azzun Atma village fired stun grenades towards residents who attempted to enter Israel for work and as a result injured Mohammad Ibrahim Ahmad (a resident of Kafr Al-Dik) and assaulted Musa Salam leaving him hospitalised with contusions. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to restrict access at ‘Azzun ‘Atma Wall gate and impeded the free flow of traffic. The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the entrance to the village of Wadi Al- Rasha and to deny civilian access. (ii) The Israeli army allows residents to access the village through Gate #109. Having removed the gate at the entrance to the village of Ras Atiya; the Israeli army only allows students to cross to their schools outside the village through the Habla gate.
<p style="text-align: center;">NABLUS</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> Since December 17th 2013, Israeli forces ordered the closure 500 dunumes of land in Qusra village as a closed military area. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the roads of Til-Burin and Beit Furik-Salem; the settler bypass road connecting the village of Deir al Hatab to the settlement of Alon Moreh; the road connecting the town of ‘Aqraba to the village of Osrin; and the detour road between the town of Qabalan and the village of Osrin. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the northern entrance to Qabalan town; the southern entrances to the town of Jamma’in and the villages of Duma and Qaryut. • <u>Checkpoint:</u> At 11:00, Israeli forces intensified their restrictions at Huwara checkpoint and impeded the free flow of traffic until 11:20. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 09:35, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Sarah village junction until 11:00. (ii) At 10:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Deir Sharaf village junction until 10:30. • <u>Raid:</u>

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 11:50, Israeli forces raided Sabustiya village while escorting a group of Israeli settlers who stormed archaeological sites and during which Israeli forces closed all the entrances to the village then withdrew at 16:40. (ii) At 01:45, Israeli forces raided Orif village, detained two residents then withdrew at 03:10. • <u>Detention:</u> Israeli forces detained Fawaz Malidi and Jihad Allan in Orif village. • <u>Physical Assault:</u> At 13:40, Israeli forces assaulted Mohammad Ziyadeh and as a result, left him hospitalised with contusions during their raid into Madma village as mentioned in the previous report. • <u>Settler Violence:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 13:00, Israeli settlers stormed Al-Masaudiya area near Barqa village then withdrew at 13:10. (ii) At 13:45, Israeli settlers stormed Al-Taliya area located in east Rujieb village, installed tents then withdrew at 19:55. (iii) At 17:00, Israeli settlers stormed the area near Al-Nasriya and Al-Aqrabaniya village s then withdrew later.
<p style="text-align: center;">SALFIT</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the entrance to two detour roads connecting Marda village to its farmland. (ii) On 15.04.2012, the Israeli army has opened the northern entrance to Salfit city to civilian, which was closed since the year 2000 and prevented access from 08:00 until 09:20. (iii) Since 11:00 on July 30th 2012, Israeli forces have closed two roads leading to Abu Nasar and Qatan Al-Jama' located in western area of Deir Istiya with cement blocks. • <u>Checkpoint:</u> At 09:20 and again at 17:40, Israeli forces intensified their restrictions at Za'tara checkpoint and impeded the free flow of traffic until 19:50. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 21:35, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the North entrance of Salfit until 22:00.
<p style="text-align: center;">JERICHO</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Checkpoints:</u> Israeli forces intensified its restrictions at Al-Hamra checkpoint set up along the road connecting Jericho and Nablus District. • <u>Flying Checkpoints:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 08:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the Dead Sea junction until 08:10. (ii) At 23:30, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the south entrance of Jericho until 24:00. • <u>Raid:</u> At 24:00, Israeli forces raided Al-Oja village, stormed and searched several homes, detained 4 residents then withdrew at 02:30. • <u>Detention:</u> Israeli forces detained four residents: Mohammad Swidat, Imad Swedat , Hamad Swidat and Qsay Noujom in Al-Oja village.

<p style="text-align: center;">BETHLEHEM</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close roads to An Nu'man village, with the exception of the road leading to the Wall gate in the south-eastern area of the village. (ii) Since 15 September 2007, the Israel army has prevented civilians from accessing or staying on 22 dunumes of confiscated land in Al Mazmuriya area in Beit Sahur and Bethlehem cities. • Closure of Main Roads: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the Beit Jala-Wadi Ahmed road; a road between Um Tuba and Al-Jass ; a road between Um Tuba and Khilat Nu'man: a road between Um Tuba and the wall; a road between Al-Khas village and the wall; the 2 by pass roads located south of Al-Walaja; a road between Talita Qumi and Nazlat Al-Sider in Beit Jala; the eastern road of Al-Khader; the road between Al-Khader and Beit Jala ; Wadi Rahal road near "Ifrat" settlement ,the road between Al-Khader and road #60 which lead to the eastern neighbourhoods of Bethlehem; a road leading to Wadi Rahal, and a road east of Beit Fajjar town with dirt mounds. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the road leading to "Newe Daniyyel" settlement and agricultural land in Al-Khader; a road between Um Tuba and Wadi Al-Hums: Wadi Fukin, Al-Jaba, the Green Line; a road between Za'tara and a detour road, and a road between Taqou and Khirbet Al-Deir with cement blocks. (iii) Since August 2nd 2012, Israeli forces closed a road leading to Beit Jalla. (iv) Since May 8th 2013, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Carmisan area in Beit Jalla and Al-Walaja with a steel gate and barbed wires. (v) Since June 3rd 2013, the Israeli army closed the road connecting Nihalin and road 60 with dirt mounds. (vi) Since 13:20 on September 29th 2013, the Israeli army closed a road leading to 50 acres of agricultural land in Wadi Salem area in Al-Khadr with dirt mounds. (vii) Israeli forces closed the main road connecting Surif and Al-Jub'a village with dirt mounds. (viii) On January 28th 2014, Israeli forces closed the steel gate at the entrance of Nihalin { replacing the dirt mounds placed at the entrance since the year 2002 } and placed time schedule for opening the gate from 06:00 until 14:00 on a daily bases. (ix) At 10:45 on September 8th 2015, Israeli forces closed the agricultural road located in Arab Al-Rashaydeh village located near "Malee Amoush" settlement with dirt mounds. • Flying Checkpoint: At 18:30, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Marah Rabah village until 20:05 • Detention: At 04:30 on September 30th 2015, Israeli forces detained Yahya Hamoud during their raid into Bethlehem as mentioned in the previous report. • Attack: At 18:30, Israeli forces positioned near the West entrance of Taqou' fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.
	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close Al-Shuhada' Street, Al-Sahleh and Khuzq Al-Far areas, as well as the old gold market in Hebron's Old City. In addition to closing the entrance to Al-Qeisi neighbourhood, the Israeli army continues to close the entrances to the area of Al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) with an electronic gate; Al-Laban Market also remains closed. (ii) Since 05 January 2009, the Israeli army has closed the area located along the Green Line south of the town of Yatta. Having seized land for Wall construction, the Israeli army evicted the Palestinian residents and denied them access to the area. • Closure of Main Roads:

<p>HEBRON</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Al-Thahiriya and Al-Samoa' towns, Al-‘Arrub refugee camp, and Al-Tuwani and Al-Karmil villages. (ii) The Israeli army continues to prohibit Palestinian vehicles from travelling along the old Al-Shalala Street leading to Hebron’s Old City. (iii) The Israeli army continues to close all roads leading to Road # 60 as well as detour roads along the settler bypass road leading to Yatta town. (iv) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds a detour road leading to e to Al-Simiya village, the southern entrance of Al-Samou’ and the entrance of Beit Annun with cement blocks. (v) Since July 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Safa and Al-Dirat and also closed the entrance of south Yatta with cement blocks. (vi) At 11:00 on August 6th 2015, Israeli forces closed the entrance of Al-Hajara village located in south Dura with cement blocks. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 10:45, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint between Beit Awwa and Deir Samit village. (ii) At 13:35, Israeli force set up a checkpoint near Al-Addassiya village located in North Bani Na’im until 14:20. (iii) At 21:20, Israeli forces set up 4 checkpoints at the entrances of Beit Ummar, Sa’ir, Haloul and Ithna. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At dawn on September 30th 2015, Israeli forces raided Surif and detained a resident. (ii) At 12:30, Israeli forces raided Hebron as they escorted a group of Israeli settlers who stormed Anaba’ils Tomb then withdrew at 17:00. (iii) At 21:10, Israeli forces raided Beit Ummar, clashed with several residents then withdrew at 01:15. • <u>Detention:</u> Israeli forces detained Billal Ghanimat in Surif village. • <u>Attack:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 12:20, Israeli forces positioned near Tarik Bin Zied School located in the old city of Hebron fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning. (ii) At 13:40, Israeli forces positioned in Bab Al-Zawiya area in Hebron fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and as a result injured Fawzi Al-Shaweiki. • <u>Temporary Detention:</u> At 17:00, Israeli forces positioned in Bab Al-Zawiya area located in Hebron temporarily detained the child Abed Awwad (11 years old) then released him later. • <u>Assault on Places of Worship:</u> On September 30th 2015, Israeli forces closed Al-Ibrahimi mosque compound in the old city of Hebron and prevented worshipers from conducting prayers inside the mosque in order to allow Israeli settlers to perform Talmudic rituals inside the mosque in celebration of the Jewish Holiday. • <u>Settler Violence:</u> At 15:40, a group of Israeli settlers stormed Tel Al-Rumayda neighbourhood in the old city of Hebron and stoned the home of Imad Abu Shamasnah then withdrew at 16:00.

<p style="text-align: center;">ALL DISTRICTS</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • At 19:00 on August 26th 2014, Palestinian Gunmen and the Israeli military agreed to a cease fire agreement (brokered by the Arab Republic of Egypt) which includes the opening of border crossings to allow the entry of emergency supplies and humanitarian goods as well as construction material and agreed to increase the fishing limit to 6 nautical miles with possibility of increase to 12 nautical miles by the end of the year and to decrease the Military area to 100 meters, allow freedom of movement and a halt to targeted killings and assassinations and negotiations will be held for discussion on rebuilding the sea port and airports in the coming month. • Israeli forces broke the ceasefire agreement by raiding and opening fire towards Khan Yunis.

<p style="text-align: center;">GAZA</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Closure of Crossing Points: (ii) Al-Muntar (Karni) Crossing is closed. Beginning on 02 March 2011, the Crossing has been effectively closed following a unilateral Israeli decision. (iii) Al-Shija'iyah (Nahal 'Oz) Crossing is closed. Beginning on 04 January 2010, the Crossing has closed following a unilateral Israeli decision.

(ii) Rafah (<i>Al 'Awdah</i>) Crossing is partially open to allow pilgrims returning from Saudi Arabia to enter. (iii) Sufa Crossing is closed (iv) Karm Abu Salem (Karem Shalom) Crossing open for the entry of tourist and foreign diplomats and the entry of Humanitarian assistance and construction material funded by UNRWA.
