<p><b>All Districts</b></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>At 24:00 on October 2<sup>nd</sup> 2014, the Israeli Military closed all crossings in the West Bank for Passover Holiday and prevented residents from entering Israel except those with permits, Diplomatic missions and Humanitarian cases and the closure of crossings will continue until 24:00 on October 4<sup>th</sup> 2014.</li> </ul>
<p><b>JERUSALEM</b></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li><b>Closure:</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) On October 2<sup>nd</sup> 2014 The Israeli army, intensified their restrictions at the entrance to Jerusalem city for Passover holiday, set up several flying checkpoints on the main road leading to the city and prevented worshippers under the age of 50 from conducting prayers at Al-Aqsa mosque compound.</li> <li>(ii) The Israeli army continues to close the ‘demarcation area’ along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits.</li> <li>(iii) The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill between Biddu and Beit Iksa villages.</li> </ul> </li> <li><b>Closure of Main Roads:</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the entrance to Jaba’ village.</li> <li>(ii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to Beit Iksa village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandiya checkpoint.</li> </ul> </li> <li><b>Checkpoints:</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) Israeli authorities continue to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a “border crossing point” and designate a special crossing lane for holders of Jerusalem IDs and another for those possessing permits to access Jerusalem city and closed the checkpoint at 01:20 and impeded the free flow of traffic until 04:05.</li> <li>(ii) On September 19<sup>th</sup> 2012, Israeli forces closed Ras Khamis checkpoint near Shu’fat camp and impeded the free flow of traffic in order to construct the wall.</li> </ul> </li> <li><b>Attack:</b> At 00:30, Israeli forces positioned in the old city of Jerusalem fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and damage of several surveillance cameras on the roads and detained two residents including a child.</li> <li><b>Detention:</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) At 24:00, Israeli forces positioned near the Wall gate in Biddu detained four children: Basel Shamasneh (14 years old), Ahmad Mansour (13 years old), Ali Houshiyeh (14 years old) and Yahya Qais (14 years old).</li> <li>(ii) Israeli forces detained two residents: Munir Nimnr (17 years old) and Ayman Salim in the old city of Jerusalem.</li> </ul> </li> <li><b>Assault on Property:</b> At 09:00, Israeli forces stormed “Dar Assaf” Center for Music and Literature located in Al-Shiekh Jarrah neighbourhood in Jerusalem and served a notice preventing an event hosted by the Negotiation Affairs Department of Palestinian Liberation Organization.</li> <li><b>Assault on Places of Worship:</b> On the morning of October 2<sup>nd</sup> 2014, Israeli settlers under the protection of Israeli forces stormed Al-Aqsa mosque compound in the old city of Jerusalem and provoked worshippers.</li> <li><b>Wall Gates:</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the Wall gate in</li> </ul> </li> </ul>
