<b>JERUSALEM</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b><u>Closure:</u></b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) At dawn on October 4<sup>th</sup> 2015, the Israeli army, intensified their restrictions at the entrance to Jerusalem city, set up several flying checkpoints on the main road leading to the city and prevented worshipers under the age of 50 from conducting prayers at Al-Aqsa mosque compound.</li> <li>(ii) The Israeli army continues to close the ‘demarcation area’ along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits.</li> <li>(iii) The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill between Biddu and Beit Iksa villages.</li> </ul> </li> <li>• <b><u>Closure of Main Roads:</u></b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the entrance to Jaba’ village.</li> <li>(ii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to Beit Iksa village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandiya checkpoint.</li> </ul> </li> <li>• <b><u>Checkpoints:</u></b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) Israeli authorities continue to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a “border crossing point” and designate a special crossing lane for holders of Jerusalem IDs and another for those possessing permits to access Jerusalem city.</li> <li>(ii) On September 19<sup>th</sup> 2012, Israeli forces closed Ras Khamis checkpoint near Shu’fat camp and impeded the free flow of traffic in order to construct the wall.</li> <li>(iii) At 21:15, Israeli forces closed Jaba’ checkpoint, which is located along the main road connecting Jerusalem, Ramallah and Jericho and thus impeded the free flow of traffic then reopened it later.</li> </ul> </li> <li>• <b><u>Flying Checkpoint:</u></b> At 10:50, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint beneath Bir Nabala bridge until 13:00.</li> <li>• <b><u>Raid:</u></b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) At 06:25 on October 3<sup>rd</sup> 2015, Israeli forces raided Abu Dis until 13:35.</li> <li>(ii) At 23:00, Israeli forces raided Al-Eisawiya village, detained 2 residents, clashed with several residents as they stormed and searched Fadi Alouns home {The resident who was killed by Israeli forces for allegedly attempting to stab Israeli settlers}.</li> <li>(iii) At 02:40, Israeli forces raided Al-Ram, clashed with several residents and as a result set fire to a vehicle after a tear gas grenades canister exploded inside it.</li> <li>(iv) At 02:55, Israeli forces raided Qutna village until 06:00.</li> </ul> </li> </ul>

- **Attack:**
  - (i) At 17:00, Israeli forces positioned at Bab Hata gate {A Main gate entrance leading to Al-Aqsa mosque compound} and near Wadi Al-Joz neighbourhood fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.
  - (ii) At 18:00, Israeli forces positioned near the North entrance of Al-Ram fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.
  - (iii) At 18:50, Israeli forces positioned near Bab Al-Absat gate {A main gate entrance leading to Al-Aqsa mosque compound in the old city of Jerusalem} opened fire towards and killed a University student {after he stabbed and shot several Israeli settlers and as a result killed two settlers and injured three other settlers}.
  - (iv) At 19:30, Israeli forces positioned at the entrance of Al-Eisawiya village, in Wadi Al-Juz, Ras Al-Amoud & Jabal Mikabir neighbourhoods, and in Al-Abbasat and Al-Zahra gate {Main gate entrance leading to Al-Aqsa mosque compound in the old city of Jerusalem} fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.
  - (v) At 22:45, Israeli forces positioned in Al-Jabal area junction and in Ras Al-Kabsa area in Abu Dis fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.
  - (vi) At 22:45, Israeli forces positioned near Qalandiya checkpoint and near Qalandiya airport road, fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and as a result injured Abdel-Ra'uf Ramaya.
  - (vii) At 23:15, Israeli forces positioned near the North junction of Al-Ram fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.
  - (viii) At 23:30, Israeli forces positioned in Al-Massarar neighbourhood fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.
  - (ix) At 23:50, Israeli forces positioned near Shu'fat checkpoint fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.
  - (x) At 03:00, Israeli forces positioned in Al-Massarar neighbourhood opened fire towards a resident after he was being chased by a mob of Israeli settlers and as a result killed him for allegedly attempting to stab a settler.
- **Killings:**
  - (i) Israeli forces opened fire towards and killed Muhanad Al-Halabi (A resident of Surda village in Ramallah) near Bab Al-Absat gate {A main gate entrance leading to Al-Aqsa mosque compound in the old city of Jerusalem}.
  - (ii) Israeli forces opened fire towards and killed Fadi Aloun (A resident of Al-Eisawiya village) in Al-Massarar neighbourhood.
- **Physical Assault:** At 20:00, Israeli forces positioned near Jabal Al-Mukabir neighbourhood and in Al-Eisawiya village assaulted 2 residents including a Paramedic as he was treating a patient: Fadi Obiedi (A Paramedic) and Sabri Sandouqa.
- **Assault on Places of Worship:** On the morning of October 3<sup>rd</sup> 2015, Israeli military and Police forces stormed Al-Aqsa mosque compound in the old city of Jerusalem and temporarily detained several worshiper inside the mosque and forcibly removed them from inside the mosque.
- **Settler Violence:**
  - (i) At 21:15, a group of Israeli settlers positioned near Silwan neighbourhood stoned several homes during which Israeli forces fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents who attempted

	<p>to prevent the settler attack and Israeli forces detained three residents including two children.</p> <p>(ii) At 23:40, a group of Israeli settlers attempted to storm Mukhmas village during which local residents prevented them and chased them away from the area.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b><u>Detention:</u></b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) At 07:30 on October 3<sup>rd</sup> 2015, Israeli forces detained the child: Mohammad Abu Shamsiya (14 years old) as he was heading to school near Silwan neighbourhood.</li> <li>(ii) At 21:40, Israeli forces detained Khader Nuwarat (A resident of Bethlehem) in Jerusalem.</li> <li>(iii) Israeli forces detained Ismat Obied and Munthir Obied in Al-Eisawiya village.</li> <li>(iv) Israeli forces detained three residents: Mahmoud Al-Awar (15 years old), Anas Abu Wahdan (16 years old) and Omar Da'na in Silwan neighbourhood.</li> </ul> </li> <li>• <b><u>Wall Gates:</u></b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the Wall gate in Abu Dis town.</li> <li>(ii) The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate on Al-Shayyah road in the area between Al-Sawahira Al-Sharqiya and Al-Slewahira Al-Gharbiya villages, only allowing civilians holding Jerusalem IDs to cross, after subjecting them to thorough searches using electronic devices.</li> </ul> </li> </ul>
