Attack: Oh the evening of October 5th 2012, Israeli forces positioned near Ras Al-Amoud neighbourhood in the old city of Jerusalem fired stun and tear gas grenades towards residents for alleged stoning leaving 4 residents suffocated from tear gas inhalation and also detained a resident. At a later time on the same day, armed Palestinian groups announced an agreement to cease fire. The ceasefire has been further renewed on 23 June 2012 at 24:00. On 14.12.2011, Israeli forces placed floating marks 3 miles from Gaza's seashore and warned fishermen against passing beyond the mark. Israeli forces broke the ceasefire agreement by opening fire towards Khan Yunis.
