<p>JERUSALEM</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army, intensified their restrictions at the entrance to Jerusalem city, set up several flying checkpoints on the main road leading to the city and prevented worshipers under the age of 50 from conducting prayers at Al-Aqsa mosque compound. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the ‘demarcation area’ along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits. (iii) The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill between Biddu and Beit Iksa villages. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the entrance to Jaba’ village. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to Beit Iksa village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandiya checkpoint. • <u>Checkpoints:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli authorities continue to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a “border crossing point” and designate a special crossing lane for holders of Jerusalem IDs and another for those possessing permits to access Jerusalem city and closed the checkpoint at 01:20 and impeded the free flow of traffic until 04:05. (ii) On September 19th 2012, Israeli forces closed Ras Khamis checkpoint near Shu’fat camp and impeded the free flow of traffic in order to construct the wall. • <u>Settler Violence:</u> On October 5th 2014, Israeli settlers under the protection of Israeli Military forces occupied two apartments inside of “Anan Baydoun” building in Silwan Neighbourhood of Jerusalem. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the Wall gate in Abu Dis town. (ii) The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate on Al-Shayyah road in the area between Al-Sawahira Al-Sharqiya and Al-Slewahira Al-Gharbiya villages, only allowing civilians holding Jerusalem IDs to cross, after subjecting them to thorough searches using electronic devices.
<p>RAMALLAH & AL BIREH</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Sinjil village well as the junction to Kafr Malik and ‘Ein Samiya villages. (ii) Since September 3rd 2013, Israeli forces closed the north east entrance of Al-Mughier village with dirt mounds. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 19:50, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Deir Abu Mash’al village until 23:00 (ii) At 22:25, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Shuqba village; temporarily detained bus filled with residents then released them

	<p>at 23:25.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 03:00, Israeli forces raided Awarta until 04:30. (ii) At 04:00, Israeli forces raided Al-Jalazoun camp, detained a resident then withdrew at 04:30. • <u>Detention:</u> Israeli forces detained Mustafa Dalashiya in Al-Jalazoun camp. • <u>Settler Violence:</u> At 12:00, Israeli settlers under the protection of Israeli forces stormed agricultural land in North Al-Bireh city and Harassed and prevented several residents from harvesting Olives then withdrew under the protection of Israeli forces. • <u>Provocation of Palestinian Security Forces:</u> At 12:30, Israeli forces positioned at Al-Mahakma checkpoint in North Ramallah temporarily seized three buses carrying Palestinian Police officers, searched the buses and its passengers then prevented it from crossing the checkpoint.
JENIN	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Road:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the road leading to the town of ‘Arraba east of the illegal settlement Dotan. (ii) Since the evening of November 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the western entrance of Ya’bad. • <u>Raid:</u> At 13:10, Israeli forces raided Jenin.
TUBAS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 16:55, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Al-Taghrah village located in east Tubas until 18:45. • <u>Raid:</u> At 17:05, Israeli forces raided Tayassir village • <u>Home Demolition:</u> At 11:00, Israeli forces stormed Um Jamal area in the North Jordan valley and served a demolition order for a Barracks and several tents.
TULKAREM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the road connecting Kafr Al-Labad town to Shufa village. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the detour road leading to Ramin village along the Tulkarem-Nablus main road. (iii) On August 5th 2014, Israeli forces closed the main steel gate and placed cement block along the road connecting Shufa and Izbit Shufa villages near “Aveni Hivits”. • <u>Checkpoint:</u> At 19:05, Israeli forces intensified their restrictions at “Eniv” checkpoint located along the main road connecting Tulkarem and Nablus and impeded the free flow of traffic until 20:30.
QALQILIYA	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli forces continue to close with cement blocks agricultural roads east of Azzun town. (ii) In addition to closing the gate installed since the outbreak the second Intifada, the Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the eastern entrance to Kafr Qaddum village. (iii) At 12:10 on September 2nd 2014, Israeli forces closed the main road connecting Qalqiliya and Nablus near Al-Nabi Eliyas village with cement blocks. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 09:45, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint in the area between Ras Atiyah and Izbit Jal’oud until 14:25 (ii) At 14:20, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint in the area between Qalqiliya and Habalah and clashed with several residents then withdrew later. • <u>Raid:</u> At 01:30, Israeli forces raided Qalqiliya, clashed with several residents, suffocated 3 residents from tear gas inhalation, detained a resident then withdrew at 02:30.

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Detention:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 01:00, Israeli forces positioned near the wall gate in detained two residents including a child: Amir Sharim (16 years old) and Salim Sharim. (ii) Israeli forces detained Eyad Silmi in Qalqiliya. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to restrict access at ‘Azzun ‘Atma Wall gate and impeded the free flow of traffic. The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the entrance to the village of Wadi Al- Rasha and to deny civilian access. (ii) The Israeli army allows residents to access the village through Gate #109. Having removed the gate at the entrance to the village of Ras Atiya; the Israeli army only allows students to cross to their schools outside the village through the Habla gate.
<p>NABLUS</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> Since December 17th 2013, Israeli forces ordered the closure 500 dunumes of land in Qusra village as a closed military area. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the roads of Til-Burin and Beit Furik-Salem; the settler bypass road connecting the village of Deir al Hatab to the settlement of Alon Moreh; the road connecting the town of ‘Aqraba to the village of Osrin; and the detour road between the town of Qabalan and the village of Osrin. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the northern entrance to Qabalan town; the southern entrances to the town of Jamma’in and the villages of Duma and Qaryut. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 10:45 and again at 15:40, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Beit Dajjan village junction and detained a University Student. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 15:55, Israeli forces raided Orif village. (ii) At dawn on October 6th 2014, Israeli forces raided Nablus and detained a resident • <u>Detention:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli forces detained Suhayeb Abu Thabet in Beit Dajjan village. (ii) Israeli forces detained Jasser Dweikat in Nablus. • <u>Settler Violence:</u> At dawn on October 6th 2014, Israeli settlers under the protection of Israeli forces stormed agricultural land in Burin village and chopped off the limbs of 15 Olive trees owned by Ahmad Abu Khalifeh.
<p>SALFIT</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the entrance to two detour roads connecting Marda village to its farmland. (ii) On 15.04.2012, the Israeli army has opened the northern entrance to Salfit city to civilian, which was closed since the year 2000 and prevented access from 08:00 until 09:20. (iii) Since 11:00 on July 30th 2012, Israeli forces have closed two roads leading to Abu Nasar and Qatan Al-Jama’ located in western area of Deir Istiya with cement blocks. • <u>Checkpoints:</u> Israeli forces intensified their restrictions at Za’tara checkpoint and impeded the free flow of traffic. • <u>Assault on Property:</u> At 08:35, Israeli forces forcibly removed Mohammad Salameh (A resident of Harris village) from his agriculture land in south Harris village as he was harvesting Olives.

<p>JERICHO</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Checkpoints:</u> Israeli forces intensified its restrictions at Al-Hamra checkpoint set up along the road connecting Jericho and Nablus District. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 10:55, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Dead Sea junction until 12:10 (ii) At 17:30, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint along road (90) near Al-New'meh village located at the North entrance of Jericho. (iii) At 18:55, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Fasayil village. (iv) At 13:45, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the south entrance of Jericho and detained a resident. • <u>Detention:</u> Israeli forces positioned at a checkpoint at the south entrance of Jericho detained Farouq Ashour (A resident of Hebron).
<p>BETHLEHEM</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close roads to An Nu'man village, with the exception of the road leading to the Wall gate in the south-eastern area of the village. (ii) Since 15 September 2007, the Israel army has prevented civilians from accessing or staying on 22 dunumes of confiscated land in Al Mazmuriya area in Beit Sahur and Bethlehem cities. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the Beit Jala-Wadi Ahmed road; a road between Um Tuba and Al-Jass ; a road between Um Tuba and Khilat Nu'man: a road between Um Tuba and the wall; a road between Al-Khas village and the wall; the 2 by pass roads located south of Al-Walaja; a road between Talita Qumi and Nazlat Al-Sider in Beit Jala; the eastern road of Al-Khader; the road between Al-Khader and Beit Jala ; Wadi Rahal road near "Ifrat" settlement ,the road between Al-Khader and road #60 which lead to the eastern neighbourhoods of Bethlehem; a road leading to Wadi Rahal, and a road east of Beit Fajjar town with dirt mounds. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the road leading to "Newe Daniyyel" settlement and agricultural land in Al-Khader; a road between Um Tuba and Wadi Al-Hums: Wadi Fukin, Al-Jaba, the Green Line; a road between Za'tara and a detour road, and a road between Taqou and Khirbet Al-Deir with cement blocks. (iii) Since August 2nd 2012, Israeli forces closed a road leading to Beit Jalla. (iv) Since May 8th 2013, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Carmisan area in Beit Jalla and Al-Walaja with a steel gate and barbed wires. (v) Since June 3rd 2013, the Israeli army closed the road connecting Nihalin and road 60 with dirt mounds. (vi) Since 13:20 on September 29th 2013, the Israeli army closed a road leading to 50 acres of agricultural land in Wadi Salem area in Al-Khadr with dirt mounds. (vii) Israeli forces closed the main road connecting Surif and Al-Jub'a village with dirt mounds. (viii) On January 28th 2014, Israeli forces closed the steel gate at the entrance of Nihalin { replacing the dirt mounds placed at the entrance since the year 2002} and placed time schedule for opening the gate from 06:00 until 14:00 on a daily bases. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 08:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Al-Asakra village until 08:15. (ii) At 10:30, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint along the main road near Marah Rabah village until 12:00. (iii) At 11:40, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at "Kafir Etsioyon" settlement.

	<p>(iv) At 17:10, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the West entrance of Taqou' until 17:30.</p> <p>(v) At 18:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the North entrance of Taqou' and prevented residents from entering or leaving the village until 18:25.</p> <p>(vi) At 18:50, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Beit Fajjar, temporarily detained 3 children, assaulted them then released them at 21:00</p> <p>(vii) At 19:25, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint in Ush Al-Ghurab area located in east Beit Sahur until 20:45.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Attack: On the evening of October 5th 2014, Israeli forces positioned at Al-Ayda camp fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.
<p style="text-align: center;">HEBRON</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close Al-Shuhada' Street, Al-Sahleh and Khuzq Al-Far areas, as well as the old gold market in Hebron's Old City. In addition to closing the entrance to Al-Qeisi neighbourhood, the Israeli army continues to close the entrances to the area of Al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) with an electronic gate; Al-Laban Market also remains closed. (ii) Since 05 January 2009, the Israeli army has closed the area located along the Green Line south of the town of Yatta. Having seized land for Wall construction, the Israeli army evicted the Palestinian residents and denied them access to the area. • Closure of Main Roads: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Al-Thahiriya and Al-Samoa' towns, Al-'Arrub refugee camp, and Al-Tuwani and Al-Karmil villages. (ii) The Israeli army continues to prohibit Palestinian vehicles from travelling along the old Al-Shalala Street leading to Hebron's Old City. (iii) The Israeli army continues to close all roads leading to Road # 60 as well as detour roads along the settler bypass road leading to Yatta town. (iv) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds a detour road leading to e to Al-Simiya village, the southern entrance of Al-Samou' and the entrance of Beit Annun with cement blocks. (v) Since July 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Safa and Al-Dirat and closed the entrance of south Yatta with cement blocks. (vi) On September 4th 2014, Israeli forces closed a road in Eiw Al-Bas and Al-Bayda and Al-Ras area in Ithna located near the wall gate. (vii) At 13:40 on September 16th 2014, Israeli forces closed the main road leading to Al-Ibrahim mosque in the old city of Hebron. • Flying Checkpoint: At 20:20, Israeli forces set up three checkpoints at the North entrance of Hebron, the entrance of Farsh Al-Hawa area in North Hebron and at the entrance of Beit Anoun village. • Raid: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 11:05, Israeli forces raided Bani Na'im and detained a resident. (ii) At 15:00, Israeli forces raided Yaqin area located at the entrance of Bani Na'im and summoned Tawfiq Manasrah to report to Israeli Intelligence for questioning. (iii) At 16:30, Israeli forces raided Dura until 17:00. • Detention: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) On October 5th 2014, Israeli forces detained Mustafa Da'na in the old city of Hebron.

ALL DISTRICTS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • At 19:00 on August 26th 2014, Palestinian Gunmen and the Israeli military agreed to a cease fire agreement (brokered by the Arab Republic of Egypt) which includes the opening of border crossings to allow the entry of emergency supplies and humanitarian goods as well as construction material and agreed to increase the fishing limit to 6 nautical miles with possibility of increase to 12 nautical miles by the end of the year and to decrease the Military area to 100 meters, allow freedom of movement and a halt to targeted killings and assassinations and negotiations will be held for discussion on rebuilding the sea port and airports in the coming month.

GAZA	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure of Crossing Points: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Al-Muntar (Karni) Crossing is closed. Beginning on 02 March 2011, the Crossing has been effectively closed following a unilateral Israeli decision. (ii) Al-Shija'iya (Nahal 'Oz) Crossing is closed. Beginning on 04 January 2010, the Crossing has closed following a unilateral Israeli decision.
RAFAH	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure of Crossing Points : <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Yasser 'Arafat International Airport remains closed. (ii) Rafah (<i>Al 'Awdah</i>) Crossing is closed (iii) Sufa Crossing is closed. (iv) Karm Abu Salem (Karem Shalom) Crossing is closed.
