<b>JERUSALEM</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b><u>Closure:</u></b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) Since dawn on October 4<sup>th</sup> 2015, the Israeli army, intensified their restrictions at the entrance to Jerusalem city, set up several flying checkpoints on the main road leading to the city and prevented worshipers under the age of 50 from conducting prayers at Al-Aqsa mosque compound.</li> <li>(ii) The Israeli army continues to close the 'demarcation area' along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits.</li> <li>(iii) The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill between Biddu and Beit Iksa villages.</li> </ul> </li> <li>• <b><u>Closure of Main Roads:</u></b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the entrance to Jaba' village.</li> <li>(ii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to Beit Iksa village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandiya checkpoint.</li> <li>(iii) At -2:00 on October 5<sup>th</sup> 2015, Israeli forces closed the north junction of Al-Ram with cement blocks.</li> </ul> </li> <li>• <b><u>Checkpoints:</u></b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) Israeli authorities continue to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a "border crossing point" and designate a special crossing lane for holders of Jerusalem IDs and another for those possessing permits to access Jerusalem city.</li> <li>(ii) On September 19<sup>th</sup> 2012, Israeli forces closed Ras Khamis checkpoint near Shu'fat camp and impeded the free flow of traffic in order to construct the wall.</li> </ul> </li> <li>• <b><u>Flying Checkpoint:</u></b> At 17:30, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the east entrance of Hizma village.</li> <li>• <b><u>Raid:</u></b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) At 19:00, Israeli forces raided Qutna village, clashed with several residents and detained a resident.</li> <li>(ii) At 21:00, Israeli forces raided Beit Ijza village, stormed several homes and detained 2 residents.</li> <li>(iii) At 06:00, Israeli forces raided Abu Dis and detained 3 residents.</li> </ul> </li> <li>• <b><u>Attack:</u></b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) At 09:30, Israeli forces positioned in Ras Al-Amoud neighbourhood fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.</li> <li>(ii) At 10:15 and again at 23:00, Israeli forces positioned near the north junction of Al-Ram fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.</li> </ul> </li> </ul>

- (iii) At 15:00, Israeli forces positioned near Shu'fat checkpoint fired rubber coated steel bullets; stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and detained a resident.
- (iv) At 15:30, Israeli forces positioned near Qalandiya checkpoint fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and as a result injured six residents.
- (v) At 15:40, Israeli forces positioned in Al-Jabal area junction and in Ras Kabsa area in Abu Dis, fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.
- (vi) At 15:40, Israeli forces positioned at the entrance of Anata fired, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.
- (vii) At 17:40, Israeli forces positioned at the entrance of Biddu fired, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.
- (viii) At 18:30, Israeli forces positioned in Beit Hanina fired live ammunition; rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and as a result injured Nizar Qutri and damaged a vehicle owned by Adnan Ghayth.
- (ix) At 21:00, Israeli forces positioned at the entrance of Al-Eisawiya village fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and as a result injured Bara' Mahmoud.
- (x) At 21:30, Israeli forces positioned at the entrance of Al-Eizariya fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.
- (xi) At 22:20, Israeli forces positioned at the entrance of Hizma village fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.
- (xii) At 22:40, Israeli forces positioned in Al-Thuri neighbourhood fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.

- **Detention:**

- (i) On the morning of October 5<sup>th</sup> 2015, Israeli forces positioned inside Al-Aqsa mosque compound in the old city of Jerusalem detained Yasser Qawasmi.
- (ii) On the morning of October 5<sup>th</sup> 2015, Israeli forces positioned near Bab Al-Absat gate {A main gate entrance leading to Al-Aqsa mosque compound in the old city of Jerusalem} detained the child Mohammad Al-Karaki.
- (iii) At 20:00, Israeli forces detained 3 residents: Karim Abu Khdeir, Mohammad Da'is and Mohammad Jaber in Shu'fat neighbourhood.
- (iv) At 21:00, Israeli forces detained 2 residents including a child: Mu'tasim Masauda (17 years old) and Ibrahim Al-Natsha in Silwan neighbourhood.
- (v) Israeli forces detained Abdel-Majid Abu Zaydeh in Qutna village.
- (vi) Israeli forces detained 2 residents: Qassim Nidal Rayan and Qassim Nizar Rayan in Beit Ijza village.
- (vii) Israeli forces detained 3 residents: Mohammad Ayash, Mohammad Rabi' and Haytham Ayyad in Abu Dis.
- (viii) Israeli forces detained Ahmad Nassar (17 years old) in Ras Al-Amoud neighbourhood.
- (ix) Israeli forces detained Raed Abu Jibnah near Shu'fat checkpoint.

- **Home Demolition:**

- (i) At dawn on October 6<sup>th</sup> 2015, Israeli forces stormed Jabal Al-Mukabir neighbourhood and demolished (Using explosive detonation) 2 homes owned by : Mohammad Nayef Ja'abis ( who was killed by Israeli forces on April 8<sup>th</sup> 2014 for allegedly attempting to run over Israeli settlers with a bulldozer) and Ghassan Abu Jamal {who was killed by Israeli forces on November 18<sup>th</sup> 2014 after he allegedly killed several Israeli settlers inside a Synagouge near "Har Nouf" settlement} during which Israeli forces declared the area a closed military zone and forced 23 families living in the

	<p>area to evacuate their homes during which they clashed with several residents as they implemented the home demolition.</p> <p>(ii) At dawn on October 6<sup>th</sup> 2015, Israeli forces stormed Al-Thuri neighbourhood in Jerusalem and sealed off (using cement blocks and concrete) a room in a home owned by the family of Mu'taz Hijazi {Who was killed by Israeli forces on October 30<sup>th</sup> 2014 for allegedly attempting to kill the extremist Israeli settler Yahuda Glick}.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b><u>Assault on Places of Worship:</u></b> At 09:00, a group of Israeli settlers under the protection of Israeli military and Police forces stormed Al-Aqsa mosque compound in the old city of Jerusalem and provoked worshippers.</li> <li>• <b><u>Settler Violence:</u></b> At 23:40, a group of Israeli settlers positioned in Jerusalem assaulted and stabbed Murad Abu Ghush (A resident of Al-Eisawiya) and as a result left him hospitalised.</li> <li>• <b><u>Wall Gates:</u></b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the Wall gate in Abu Dis town.</li> <li>(ii) The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate on Al-Shayyah road in the area between Al-Sawahira Al-Sharqiya and Al-Slewahira Al-Gharbiya villages, only allowing civilians holding Jerusalem IDs to cross, after subjecting them to thorough searches using electronic devices.</li> </ul> </li> </ul>
<p><b>RAMALLAH &amp; AL BIREH</b></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b><u>Closure of Main Roads:</u></b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Sinjil village well as the junction to Kafr Malik and 'Ein Samiya villages.</li> <li>(ii) On October 3<sup>rd</sup> 2015, Israeli forces closed the main road located near "Bet El" settlement and leading to Al-Jalazoun camp with cement blocks.</li> <li>(iii) At 12:45 on October 5<sup>th</sup> 2015, Israeli forces closed the entrance of Deir Nathim village with cement blocks.</li> </ul> </li> <li>• <b><u>Checkpoints:</u></b> At 23:35 on October 4<sup>th</sup> 2015, Israeli forces closed Al-Mahakma checkpoint located near "Bet El" settlement in North Al-Bireh city.</li> <li>• <b><u>Flying Checkpoint:</u></b> At 11:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Al-Nabi Saleh village until 15:15.</li> <li>• <b><u>Temporary Detention:</u></b> At 24:00, Israeli forces positioned at "Ofar" Military base/ Prison temporarily detained 5 residents: Naseem Dahabra, Ashraf Khali, Zahar Hatim Zahar, Hussien Musabah and Mohammad Jabra then released them at a later time.</li> <li>• <b><u>Attack:</u></b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) At 08:50, Israeli forces positioned near Atarah bridge located in North Bir Zeit fired live ammunition, rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents near the settlement entrance for alleged stoning and as a result injured 3 residents including 2 children: Ammar Hamad (15 years old), Ahmad Obied (17 years old) and Mohammad Qassim {All residents of Al-Jalazoun camp}.</li> <li>(ii) At 11:20, Israeli forces positioned in the vicinity of "Bet El" settlement located in North Al-Bireh city fired live ammunition, rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents near the settlement entrance for alleged stoning and as a result injured 8 residents including 4 children: Qusay Daghar (16 years old), Tariq Hillal (11 years old), Ahmad Izat (17 years old), Qusay Saleem (16 years old), Tariq Al-Matour, Ishaq Dayef, Mohammad Qawasmi and Mohammad Alawneh.</li> <li>(iii) At 13:20, Israeli forces positioned near the entrance of "Pesagout" settlement located in the east area of Al-Bireh city fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.</li> </ul> </li> </ul>

	<p>(iv) At 13:55, Israeli forces positioned at the entrance of “Ofar “ Military base/ prison fired rubber coated steel bullets , stun and tear gas grenades towards several school children for alleged stoning and as a result injured a child and temporarily detained 4 children then released them at a later time.</p> <p>(v) At 18:25, Israeli forces positioned near Budruos village fired, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.</p> <p>(vi) At 18:50, Israeli forces positioned at the entrance of Kafr Malik village fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.</p> <p>(vii) At 19:00, Israeli forces positioned near Safa village , fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and as a result injured 6 residents and assaulted Layth Alqam</p> <p>(viii) At 20:10, Israeli forces positioned at the entrance of Al-Jalazoun camp fired. 	<p>(iii) Since 10:40 on September 1<sup>st</sup> 2015, Israeli forces closed an agricultural road leading to Far'ata village which is located near "Gillad" settlement with a steel Gate.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b><u>Flying Checkpoint:</u></b> At 00:15, Israeli force set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Immatin village.</li> <li>• <b><u>Settler Violence:</u></b> At 23:40, Israeli settlers under the protection of Israeli forces stormed Al-Fundq village during which Israeli forces fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents as they attempted to prevent the settler attack and as a result suffocated 10 residents including a 5 year old child and 2 paramedics from tear gas inhalation.</li> <li>• <b><u>Wall Gates:</u></b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) The Israeli army continues to restrict access at 'Azzun 'Atma Wall gate and impeded the free flow of traffic. The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the entrance to the village of Wadi Al- Rasha and to deny civilian access.</li> <li>(ii) The Israeli army allows residents to access the village through Gate #109. Having removed the gate at the entrance to the village of Ras Atiya; the Israeli army only allows students to cross to their schools outside the village through the Habla gate.</li> </ul> </li> </ul>

## HEBRON

- **Closure:**
  - (i) The Israeli army continues to close Khuzq Al-Far areas, as well as the old gold market in Hebron's Old City. In addition to closing the entrance to Al-Qeisi neighbourhood, the Israeli army continues to close the entrances to the area of Al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) with an electronic gate; Al-Laban Market also remains closed.
  - (ii) Since 05 January 2009, the Israeli army has closed the area located along the Green Line south of the town of Yatta. Having seized land for Wall construction, the Israeli army evicted the Palestinian residents and denied them access to the area.
- **Closure of Main Roads:**
  - (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Al-Tuwani and Al-Karmil villages.
  - (ii) The Israeli army continues to prohibit Palestinian vehicles from travelling along the old Al-Shalala Street leading to Hebron's Old City.
  - (iii) The Israeli army continues to close all roads leading to Road # 60 as well as detour roads along the settler bypass road leading to Yatta town.
  - (iv) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds a detour road leading to e to Al-Simiya village, the southern entrance of Al-Samou' and the entrance of Beit Annun with cement blocks.
  - (v) Since July 25<sup>th</sup> 2012, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Safa and Al-Dirat and also closed the entrance of south Yatta with cement blocks.
  - (vi) At 11:00 on August 6<sup>th</sup> 2015, Israeli forces closed the entrance of Al-Hajara village located in south Dura with cement blocks.
- **Flying Checkpoint:** At 19:40, Israeli forces set up 3 checkpoints at the entrances of Al-Oroub camps, Beit Ummar and Al-Nabi Yunis area located along the main road connecting Hebron and Bethlehem.
