<p>JERUSALEM</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Since dawn on October 4th 2015, the Israeli army, intensified their restrictions at the entrance to Jerusalem city, set up several flying checkpoints on the main road leading to the city and prevented worshipers under the age of 50 from conducting prayers at Al-Aqsa mosque compound. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the ‘demarcation area’ along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits. (iii) The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill between Biddu and Beit Ikksa villages. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the entrance to Jaba’ village. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to Beit Ikksa village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandiya checkpoint. • <u>Checkpoints:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli authorities continue to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a “border crossing point” and designate a special crossing lane for holders of Jerusalem IDs and another for those possessing permits to access Jerusalem city. (ii) On September 19th 2012, Israeli forces closed Ras Khamis checkpoint near Shu’fat camp and impeded the free flow of traffic in order to construct the wall. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 14:30, Israeli forces raided Beit Hanina and stormed the condolence home of Fadi Aloun and fired live ammunition, stun and tear gas grenades towards residents for alleged stoning. (ii) At 02:00, Israeli forces raided Al-Eisawiya village. • <u>Attack:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 12:50, Israeli forces positioned in the vicinity of Qalandiya camp fired live ammunition, rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning who were participating in a demonstration protesting against the Israeli Military and Israeli settler assault on Al-Aqsa mosque compound and as a result injured 8 residents: including 2 children and 2 journalists: Salah Al-din Al-Sa’idi (12 years old), Akram Hamdan (16 years old), Salah Al-Din Thiyab (A journalist), Alaa Daraghmeh (A journalist), Hamza Al-Sar’awi, Omar Daraghmeh, Fadi Taha and Billal Nassar and also left several others suffocated from tear gas inhalation. (ii) At 13:50, Israeli forces positioned near the north junction Of Al-Ram fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning. (iii) At 16:20, Israeli forces positioned in Silwan neighbourhood fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning. (iv) At 16:30, Israeli forces positioned at the entrance of Anata fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and as a result injured Yasser Amran.

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> (v) At 18:00, Israeli forces positioned in Silwan fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and as a result injured Su'ad Abu Ramoz after she was struck by a tear gas grenade canister to the head leaving her hospitalised with severe contusions and burns. (vi) At 18:30, Israeli forces positioned near the wall gate in Qutna village fired live ammunition; rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and as a result injured Hussein Al-Fuqiya and Mohammad Hushiya. (vii) At 19:20, Israeli forces positioned in Beit Hanina fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning. (viii) At 20:00, Israeli forces positioned in Abu Dis fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning. (ix) At 20:00, Israeli forces positioned near Shu'fat checkpoint fired live ammunition; rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and as a result injured Mohammad Muhisein. (x) At 21:40, Israeli forces positioned in Raps Al-Amour neighbourhood fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning (xi) At 22:30, Israeli forces positioned near the wall gate in Beit Jira fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning. (xii) At 23:30, Israeli forces positioned in Wade Al-Job neighbourhood stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning. (xiii) At 23:40, Israeli forces positioned in the old city of Jerusalem fired live ammunition; rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and as a result injured two residents: Ala Savour and Murad Al-Alone. • <u>Assault on Places of Worship:</u> At 09:00, a group of Israeli settlers under the protection of Israeli military and Police forces stormed Al-Aqsa mosque compound in the old city of Jerusalem and provoked worshipers. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the Wall gate in Abu Dis town. (ii) The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate on Al-Shayyah road in the area between Al-Sawahira Al-Sharqiya and Al-Slewahira Al-Gharbiya villages, only allowing civilians holding Jerusalem IDs to cross, after subjecting them to thorough searches using electronic devices.
<p>RAMALLAH & AL BIREH</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Sinjil village well as the junction to Kafr Malik and 'Ein Samiya villages. (ii) On October 3rd 2015, Israeli forces closed the main road located near "Bet El" settlement and leading to Al-Jalazoun camp with cement blocks. (iii) Since 12:45 on October 5th 2015, Israeli forces closed the entrance of Deir Nathim village with cement blocks. • <u>Checkpoints:</u> At 23:35 on October 4th 2015, Israeli forces closed Al-Mahakma checkpoint located near "Bet El" settlement in North Al-Bireh city. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 13:00, Israeli forces raided Al-Tireh neighbourhood in Ramallah and stormed a school. (ii) At 23:45, Israeli forces raided Al-Bireh city, stormed a gas station and confiscated surveillance camera footage and summoned Mahmoud Aliyan to report to Israeli Intelligence for questioning then withdrew at 00:30. (iii) At 05:10, Israeli forces raided Silwad and stormed two homes.

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Attack:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 08:50, Israeli forces positioned at Atarah bridge located in North Bir Ziet fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning. (ii) At 08:50, Israeli forces positioned near the entrance of Deir Nathim village fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning. (iii) At 12:50, Israeli forces positioned near the entrance of Al-Jalazoun camp fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and as a result injured the child Mohammad Nakhla (17 years old) with critical injuries. (iv) At 13:00, Israeli forces positioned near the entrance of Al-Nabi Saleh village fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning. (v) At 13:10, Israeli forces positioned near “Al-Mahakma” checkpoint located near “Bet El” settlement in North Al-Bireh city fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and as a result injured four residents: Yazan Al-Khatib, Ali Hussien Ali, Ahmad Al-Barghouthi, and Diana Nassar leaving them hospitalised with contusions. (vi) At 18:00, Israeli forces positioned near “Pesagout” settlement located in east Al-Bireh city fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning. (vii) At 21:10, Israeli forces positioned at the entrance of Turmus’aya fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and as a result injured Suliman Awwad. • <u>Settler Violence:</u> At 09:50, group of Israeli settlers positioned near “Shilo” settlement located in Turmus’aya stoned residents and vehicles travelling along the main road connecting Ramallah and Nablus.
<p>JENIN</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Road:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the road leading to the town of ‘Arraba east of the illegal settlement Dotan. (ii) Since the evening of November 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the western entrance of Ya’bad. • <u>Attack:</u> At 16:40, Israeli forces positioned in the vicinity of Al-Jamalah checkpoint located in North Jenin fired live ammunition, rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and as a result injured 2 children: Mohammad Sabah (15 years old) and Ahmad Khalifa (15 years old) and detained 6 residents as well as temporarily detaining the child Layth Abu Farha (10 years old) then released him at a later time. • <u>Detention:</u> Israeli forces detained six residents: Raed Sha’ban, Mohamad Sha’ban, Assad Qarqash, Thaer Abu Farha, Omar Kamil and Amir Abu Zaho near Al-Jamalah checkpoint located in North Jenin. • <u>Temporary Detention:</u> At 20:30, Israeli forces positioned in the vicinity of Al-Jamalah checkpoint located in North Jenin temporarily detained 5 residents: Thaer Shan’at, Samer Qani’, Foad Mahajna, Mohammad Azzouqa and Mohammad Amran. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> Israeli forces continue to close the wall gate and only allow those holding special permits to enter through it.
<p>TULKAREM</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Checkpoint:</u> Israeli forces continue to intensify their restrictions at “Eniv” checkpoint located along the main road connecting Tulkarem and Nablus and impeded the free flow of traffic.

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Raid:</u> At 10:30, Israeli forces raided Far’oun village stormed a home near the wall gate near the village. • <u>Detention:</u> At 18:35, Israeli forces positioned near the wall gate in Quffin village detained Nadeem Ammar (A residents of Quffin). • <u>Settler Violence:</u> At 22:00, a group of Israeli settlers positioned in the area between Shufa and Izbit Shiufa village stoned residents and vehicles.
<p style="text-align: center;">QALQILIYA</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli forces continue to close with cement blocks agricultural roads east of Azzun town. (ii) In addition to closing the gate installed since the outbreak the second Intifada, the Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the eastern entrance to Kafr Qaddum village. (iii) Since 10:40 on September 1st 2015, Israeli forces closed an agricultural road leading to Far’ata village, which is located near “Gillad” settlement with a steel Gate. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 10:25, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Jit village junction. (ii) At 20:10, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint near “Karni Shomron” settlement junction. • <u>Attack:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 20:20, Israeli forces positioned near “Jaljoliya” checkpoint located in south east Qalqiliya fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning. (ii) At 20:40, Israeli forces positioned at the entrance of Azzun fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning. • <u>Settler Violence:</u> At 22:00, a group of Israeli settlers positioned along the main road in Jit village attempted to attack the home of Azzan Thiyab during which local residents were able to prevent the attack and chase them away from the area. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to restrict access at ‘Azzun ‘Atma Wall gate and impeded the free flow of traffic. The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the entrance to the village of Wadi Al- Rasha and to deny civilian access. (ii) The Israeli army allows residents to access the village through Gate #109. Having removed the gate at the entrance to the village of Ras Atiya, the Israeli army only allows students to cross to their schools outside the village through the Habla gate.
<p style="text-align: center;">NABLUS</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Since December 17th 2013, Israeli forces ordered the closure 500 dunumes of land in Qusra village as a closed military area. (ii) Since the evening of October 1st 2015, Israeli forces closed the entrances surrounding Nablus and declared it a closed military zone as well as setting up several checkpoint at the entrances of surrounding villages for the alleged shooting of an Israeli settler vehicle located in the area between “Yitmar” and “Alon Moriya” settlement, which killed two Israeli settlers. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the roads of Til-Burin and Beit Furik-Salem; the settler bypass road connecting the village of Deir al Hatab to the settlement of Alon Moreh; the road connecting the town of ‘Aqraba to the village of Osrin; and the detour road between the town of Qabalan and the village of Osrin. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the northern entrance to Qabalan town; the southern entrances to the town of Jamma’in and the villages of Duma and Qaryut. (iii) At 22:00, Israeli forces closed the North entrance of Awarta with dirt mounds.

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Checkpoint:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 09:40, Israeli forces intensified their restrictions at Huwara checkpoint and impeded the free flow of traffic. (ii) At 13:13, Israeli forces intensified their restrictions at Beit Furiq checkpoint, impede the free flow of traffic, and placed cement blocks in front of the checkpoint. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 10:25, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint near “Yitsahar” settlement junction located in North Huwara. (ii) At 15:35, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint between Nablus and Assira Al-Shimaliya. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 00:20 on October 6th 2015, Israeli forces raided Huwara, stormed two homes and detained a resident. (ii) At 03:00, Israeli forces raided Rujieb village and stormed a home. (iii) At 03:10, Israeli forces raided Nablus, stormed Karam Al-Masri’s home and took measurement of the home area, then stormed several other homes and detained two resident. (iv) At 04:00, Israeli forces raided Tel village. • <u>Detention:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 23:55, Israeli forces positioned near the entrance of Al-Laban Al-Sharqiya village detained three residents: Obieda Owies, Mustafa Oweis and Mahmoud Oweis. (ii) Israeli forces detained Maher Damiri in Huwara. (iii) Israeli forces detained two residents: Ibrahim Al-Shunar and Wajih Awafnah in Nablus.
<p>SALFIT</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the entrance to two detour roads connecting Marda village to its farmland. (ii) On 15.04.2012, the Israeli army has opened the northern entrance to Salfit city to civilian which was closed since the year 2000 and prevented access from 08:00 until 09:20. (iii) Since 11:00 on July 30th 2012, Israeli forces have closed two roads leading to Abu Nasar and Qatan Al-Jama’ located in western area of Deir Istiya with cement blocks. • <u>Checkpoint:</u> Israeli forces continue to intensify their restrictions at Za’tara checkpoint and impeded the free flow of traffic. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 18:00, Israeli forces raided Salfit until 20:15. (ii) At 19:50, Israeli forces raided Deir Istiya village. • <u>Detention:</u> At 22:15, Israeli forces positioned at Za’tara checkpoint junction detained the child: Hassan Ma’rouf (12 years old) { A resident of Zawata village in Nablus } for allegedly attempting to stab an Israeli soldier.
<p>JERICHO</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Checkpoints:</u> Israeli forces intensified its restrictions at Al-Hamra checkpoint set up along the road connecting Jericho and Nablus District. • <u>Attack:</u> At 15:45 and again at 21:00, Israeli forces positioned near the North entrance of Jericho fired, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning, temporarily detained three residents: Hatem Safi, Mohammad Safi and Yusef Ibrahim then released them later.

BETHLEHEM

- **Closure:**
 - (i) The Israeli army continues to close roads to An Nu'man village, with the exception of the road leading to the Wall gate in the south-eastern area of the village.
 - (ii) Since 15 September 2007, the Israel army has prevented civilians from accessing or staying on 22 dunumes of confiscated land in Al Mazmuriya area in Beit Sahur and Bethlehem cities.
- **Closure of Main Roads:**
 - (i) The Israeli army continues to close the Beit Jala-Wadi Ahmed road; a road between Um Tuba and Al-Jass ; a road between Um Tuba and Khilat Nu'man: a road between Um Tuba and the wall; a road between Al-Khas village and the wall; the 2 by pass roads located south of Al-Walaja; a road between Talita Qumi and Nazlat Al-Sider in Beit Jala; the eastern road of Al-Khader; the road between Al-Khader and Beit Jala ; Wadi Rahal road near "Ifrat" settlement ,the road between Al-Khader and road #60 which lead to the eastern neighbourhoods of Bethlehem; a road leading to Wadi Rahal, and a road east of Beit Fajjar town with dirt mounds.
 - (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the road leading to "Newe Daniyyel" settlement and agricultural land in Al-Khader; a road between Um Tuba and Wadi Al-Hums: Wadi Fukin, Al-Jaba, the Green Line; a road between Za'tara and a detour road, and a road between Taqou and Khirbet Al-Deir with cement blocks.
 - (iii) Since August 2nd 2012, Israeli forces closed a road leading to Beit Jalla.
 - (iv) Since May 8th 2013, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Carmisan area in Beit Jalla and Al-Walaja with a steel gate and barbed wires.
 - (v) Since June 3rd 2013, the Israeli army closed the road connecting Nihalin and road 60 with dirt mounds.
 - (vi) Since 13:20 on September 29th 2013, the Israeli army closed a road leading to 50 acres of agricultural land in Wadi Salem area in Al-Khadr with dirt mounds.
 - (vii) Israeli forces closed the main road connecting Surif and Al-Jub'a village with dirt mounds.
 - (viii) On January 28th 2014, Israeli forces closed the steel gate at the entrance of Nihalin { replacing the dirt mounds placed at the entrance since the year 2002 } and placed time schedule for opening the gate from 06:00 until 14:00 on a daily bases.
 - (ix) At 10:45 on September 8th 2015, Israeli forces closed the agricultural road located in Arab Al-Rashaydeh village located near "Malee Amoush" settlement with dirt mounds.
- **Flying Checkpoint:** At 14:00, Israeli force set up a checkpoint near Dar Salah Village Bridge located at the east entrance of Beit Sahour until 15:15.
- **Raid:** At 18:20, Israeli forces raided Taqou', occupied Thiab Al-Amour's home and convert edits rooftop into a military post during which they clashed with several residents as they stormed 4 homes and injured a resident then withdrew at 22:00.
- **Attack:**
 - (i) At 13:15, Israeli forces positioned near the west entrance of Taqou' fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and occupied Yusef Al-Sha'ers home and converted its rooftop into a military post.
 - (ii) At 13:40, Israeli forces positioned in the vicinity of Billal Bin Rabah mosque located in North Bethlehem fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and as a result injured 8 residents including a paramedic: Muhsien Hamarat (A paramedic), Khader Hadaya, Basil Harimi, Eyad Sha'lan, Abdel-Hafith Al-Gharouz, Hamza Sarasra, Mahmoud Sha'fout and Abdallah Raqab.

	<p>(iii) At 22:00, Israeli forces positioned near the entrance of Husan village fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Land Levelling:</u> On October 2nd 2015, Israeli forces stormed Al-Mina village located near Taqou' and levelled 100 dunumes (Acres) of land for installing electrical transformers and construction of a concrete fence.
<p style="text-align: center;">HEBRON</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close Khuzq Al-Far areas, as well as the old gold market in Hebron's Old City. In addition to closing the entrance to Al-Qeisi neighbourhood, the Israeli army continues to close the entrances to the area of Al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) with an electronic gate; Al-Laban Market also remains closed. (ii) Since 05 January 2009, the Israeli army has closed the area located along the Green Line south of the town of Yatta. Having seized land for Wall construction, the Israeli army evicted the Palestinian residents and denied them access to the area. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Al-Karmil villages. (ii) The Israeli army continues to prohibit Palestinian vehicles from travelling along the old Al-Shalala Street leading to Hebron's Old City. (iii) The Israeli army continues to close all roads leading to Road # 60 as well as detour roads along the settler bypass road leading to Yatta town.
