- (ii) At 09:50, Israeli forces positioned near Bab Al-Majlis gate (A main gate entrance leading to Al-Aqsa mosque compound) fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.
- (iii) At 12:15, Israeli forces positioned in Beit Hanina fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.
- (iv) At 12:50, Israeli forces positioned in Sur Bahar village fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and as they stormed (Shurouq Dawiyats) home {who was critically injured after an Israeli settler opened fire toward her for allegedly attempting to stab him in the old city of Jerusalem.
- (v) At 15:00, Israeli forces positioned in the vicinity of Shu'fat checkpoint fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.
- (vi) At 15:00, Israeli forces positioned near the entrance of Anata fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.
- (vii) At 15:10, Israeli forces positioned in the vicinity of Qalandiya checkpoint fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.
- (viii) At 18:00, Israeli forces positioned near the wall gate in Abu Dis fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.
- (ix) At 18:30, Israeli forces positioned near the entrances of Al-Eizariya, Biddu, Al-Eisawiya, Altur, Wadi Al-Joz and Shu'fat camp fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.
- (x) At 19:00, Israeli forces positioned near the North junction of Al-Ram rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.
- (xi) At 19:15, Israeli forces positioned near the entrance of Anata rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.
- (xii) At 19:15, Israeli forces positioned near the entrance of Anata fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b><u>Assault on Places of Worship:</u></b> At 11:30, a group of Israeli settlers under the protection of Israeli military and Police forces stormed Al-Aqsa mosque compound in the old city of Jerusalem and provoked worshippers.</li> <li>• <b><u>Settler Violence:</u></b> At 10:30, a Israeli settler positioned along Al-Wad road area in the old city of Jerusalem opened fire towards Shorouq Dowiyat(A resident of Sur Bahar village) as she was defending her self as a group of Israeli settlers assaulted her (alleging she attempted the stab a settler) and as result left her hospitalised.</li> <li>• <b><u>Wall Gates:</u></b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the Wall gate in Abu Dis town.</li> <li>(ii) The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate on Al-Shayyah road in the area between Al-Sawahira Al-Sharqiya and Al-Slewahira Al-Gharbiya villages, only allowing civilians holding Jerusalem IDs to cross, after subjecting them to thorough searches using electronic devices.</li> </ul> </li> </ul>

- (iv) Since May 8<sup>th</sup> 2013, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Carmisan area in Beit Jalla and Al-Walaja with a steel gate and barbed wires.
- (v) Since June 3<sup>rd</sup> 2013, the Israeli army closed the road connecting Nihalin and road 60 with dirt mounds.
- (vi) Since 13:20 on September 29<sup>th</sup> 2013, the Israeli army closed a road leading to 50 acres of agricultural land in Wadi Salem area in Al-Khadr with dirt mounds.
- (vii) Israeli forces closed the main road connecting Surif and Al-Jub'a village with dirt mounds.
- (viii) On January 28<sup>th</sup> 2014, Israeli forces closed the steel gate at the entrance of Nihalin { replacing the dirt mounds placed at the entrance since the year 2002 } and placed time schedule for opening the gate from 06:00 until 14:00 on a daily bases.
- (ix) At 10:45 on September 8<sup>th</sup> 2015, Israeli forces closed the agricultural road located in Arab Al-Rashaydeh village located near "Malee Amoush" settlement with dirt mounds.
- **Flying Checkpoint:**
  - (i) At 10:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint near Al-Asaqra village until 00:20.
  - (ii) At 23:30, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the west entrance of Beit Fajjar until 00:20.
- **Raid:**
  - (i) At 23:30, Israeli forces raided Al-Khader and clashed with several residents as they stormed 5 homes then withdrew at 01:10.
  - (ii) At 02:30, Israeli forces raided Husan village, stormed a home, detained a resident then withdrew at 04:00.
- **Detention:** Israeli forces detained Milad Al-Sha'er in Husan village.
- **Attack:**
  - (i) At 08:20, Israeli forces positioned near Dar Salah village bridge (located at the east entrance of Beit Sahur) fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several school children for alleged stoning and as a result injured Mujahid Abu Sarhan during which an Israeli settler opened fire towards several residents and as a result injured 2 residents: Suhayeb Hassaneh and Jamil Abu Sarhan.
  - (ii) At 08:20, Israeli forces positioned in the vicinity of Billal Bin Rabah mosque located in North Bethlehem fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.
  - (iii) At 19:10, Israeli forces positioned near "Murad Tourist Resort" located in North Dar Salah village fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning
  - (iv) At 21:00, Israeli forces positioned at the entrance of Fuqin village stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.
- **Settler Violence:**
  - (i) At 09:35, a group of Israeli settlers positioned near Dar Salah village bridge located at the east entrance of Beit Sahour stoned residents and vehicles and as a result damaged a vehicle owned by Fayeze Raba'ya.
  - (ii) At 17:00, a group of Israeli settlers under the protection of Israeli forces positioned near Dar Salah Village Bridge at the east entrance of Beit Sahur stoned residents and vehicles during which Israeli forces occupied Mahmoud Abu Amro's home and converted its rooftop into a military post.
  - (iii) At 18:30, a group of Israeli settlers positioned near the north entrance of Taqou' stoned several homes then withdrew at 19:40.
  - (iv) At 19:45, a group of Israeli settlers positioned near Za'tara Bridge stoned residents and vehicles then withdrew at 21:10.



**HEBRON**

- **Closure:**
  - (i) The Israeli army continues to close Khuzq Al-Far areas, as well as the old gold market in Hebron's Old City. In addition to closing the entrance to Al-Qeisi neighbourhood, the Israeli army continues to close the entrances to the area of Al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) with an electronic gate; Al-Laban Market also remains closed.
  - (ii) Since 05 January 2009, the Israeli army has closed the area located along the Green Line south of the town of Yatta. Having seized land for Wall construction, the Israeli army evicted the Palestinian residents and denied them access to the area.
- **Closure of Main Roads:**
  - (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Al-Karmil villages.
  - (ii) The Israeli army continues to prohibit Palestinian vehicles from travelling along the old Al-Shalala Street leading to Hebron's Old City.
  - (iii) The Israeli army continues to close all roads leading to Road # 60 as well as detour roads along the settler bypass road leading to Yatta town.
  - (iv) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds a detour road leading to e to Al-Simiya village, the southern entrance of Al-Samou' and the entrance of Beit Annun with cement blocks.
  - (v) Since July 25<sup>th</sup> 2012, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Safa and Al-Dirat and also closed the entrance of south Yatta with cement blocks.
  - (vi) At 11:00 on August 6<sup>th</sup> 2015, Israeli forces closed the entrance of Al-Hajara village located in south Dura with cement blocks.
- **Flying Checkpoint:**
  - (i) At 19:10, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Zif village junction.
  - (ii) At 13:20, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Beit Ummar.
- **Raid:**
  - (i) At 08:15, Israeli forces raided Halhoul and stormed 2 homes.
  - (ii) At 19:00, Israeli forces raided Yatta, clashed with several residents as they stormed and searched the home of Amjad Al-Jundi (17 years old) {who was killed by Israeli forces in Kiryat Jat area inside Israeli for allegedly attempting to stab an Israeli soldier} and as a result injured 3 residents including a child: Mohammad Harini (16 years old), Nizar Al-Vaths and Maher Al-Masri.
  - (iii) At 23:55, Israeli forces raided Halhoul, stormed several homes, detained 3 residents then withdrew at 06:55.
  - (iv) At 02:00, Israeli forces raided Dura, detained a resident then withdrew at 06:00.
  - (v) At 02:00, Israeli forces raided Beit Ummar, stormed several homes and detained 12 residents including a Civil Defence force officer.
- **Killing:** At 14:20, the child Amjad Al-Jundi (17 years old) {a resident of Yatta} was killed by Israeli forces in Kiryat Jat area inside Israeli for allegedly attempting to stab an Israeli soldier and steal his assault rifle.
- **Attack:**
  - (i) At 08:40, Israeli forces positioned near Tariq Bin Zied junction in the old city of Hebron fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.
  - (ii) At 10:10, Israeli forces positioned near Beit Anoun village junction fired rubber coated steel bullets stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.
  - (iii) At 13:30, Israeli forces positioned at the entrance of Beit Ummar fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.
