JERUSALEM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli army continues to intensify their restrictions at the entrance to Jerusalem city, set up several flying checkpoints on the main road leading to the city and prevented worshippers under the age of 50 from conducting prayers at Al-Aqsa mosque compound. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the ‘demarcation area’ along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits. (iii) The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill between Biddu and Beit Ikksa villages. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the entrance to Jaba’ village. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to Beit Ikksa village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandiya checkpoint. • <u>Checkpoints:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli authorities continue to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a “border crossing point” and designate a special crossing lane for holders of Jerusalem IDs and another for those possessing permits to access Jerusalem city and at 06:00, Israeli forces closed the checkpoint impeded the free flow of traffic. (ii) On September 19th 2012, Israeli forces closed Ras Khamis checkpoint near Shu’fat camp and impeded the free flow of traffic in order to construct the wall. (iii) At 16:00, Israeli forces intensified their restrictions at Jaba’ checkpoint placed along the road connecting Jerusalem, Jericho and Ramallah and impeded the free flow of traffic. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 10:00, Israeli forces raided Abu Dis and stormed a Psychological clinic. (ii) At 11:30, Israeli forces raided Beit Ikksa, detained 2 residents after

	<p>assaulting them.</p> <p>(iii) On October 8th 2013, Israeli raided Anata and served Jamal Hussein a notice preventing him from farming his agricultural land which is located near the border fence.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Detention:</u> Israeli forces detained Mohammad Hamayel and Saleh Al-Wahab (National Security Officer). • <u>Confiscation of Property:</u> At 11:00, Israeli forces stormed Jabal Al-Tur neighbourhood in Jerusalem and confiscated several merchant shop surveillance cameras. • <u>Obstruction on Places of Worship:</u> At 08:30, Israeli settlers under the protection of Israeli forces stormed Al-Aqsa mosque compound in the old city of Jerusalem and provoked worshippers. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the Wall gate in Abu Dis town. (ii) The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate on Al-Shayyah road in the area between Al-Sawahira Al-Sharqiya and Al-Slewahira Al-Gharbiya villages, only allowing civilians holding Jerusalem IDs to cross, after subjecting them to thorough searches using electronic devices. • <u>Wall Construction:</u> Wall construction continued in the areas north and south of Qalandiya village; south of Al-Za'ayem village; and in Wadi Al-Eizariya west of the illegal settlement Ma 'ale Adumim.

(ii) Since September 3rd 2013, Israeli forces closed the north east entrance of Al-Mughier village with dirt mounds. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 11:15, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Kafr Malik village until 12:15. (ii) At 17:45, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint beneath Yabrud Village Bridge. • <u>Raid:</u> At 18:20, Israeli forces raided Ramallah until 19:00. • <u>Settler Violence:</u> At 21:10, Israeli settlers stormed Burqa village, set fire to agricultural land and as a result destroyed 4 Olive trees before Palestinian Civil Defence forces could extinguish the flames. • <u>Wall Construction:</u> Wall construction resumed in the area west of 'Abud town in the area surrounding the illegal settlement 'Ofarim and north of Al-Lubban Al-Gharbi and Rantis villages.

(ii) Since the evening of November 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the western entrance of Ya'bad. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 19:30, Israeli forces raided Jenin, clashed with several residents and as a result injured Mohammad Zakarna after being struck with a tear gas grenade canister then withdrew at 23:55. (ii) At 20:00, Israeli forces raided Jalqamus village. (iii) At 20:10, Israeli forces raided Deir Abu Da'if village. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> Passage through the Wall gates is restricted to civilians granted special Israeli permits, which undercuts the access to education and health services for civilians living behind the Wall.

TULKAREM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure of Main Roads: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the road connecting Kafr Al-Labad town to Shufa village. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the detour road leading to Ramin village along the Tulkarem-Nablus main road. • Checkpoint: At 08:50, Israeli forces continue to intensify their restrictions at “Eniv: checkpoint and impeded the free flow of traffic. • Raid: At 23:55, Israeli forces raided Tulkarem until 04:40. • Demonstration: At 10:20, a demonstration took place in front of the International Red Cross headquarters in Tulkarem in solidarity with Palestinian detainees and demanding their release from Israeli prisons. • Wall Gates: Passage through the Wall gates is restricted to civilians granted special Israeli permits, which undercuts the access to education and health services for civilians living behind the Wall.
QALQILIYA	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure of Roads: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli forces continue to close with cement blocks agricultural roads east of Azzun town. (ii) In addition to closing the gate installed since the outbreak the second Intifada, the Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the eastern entrance to Kafr Qaddum village. • Raid: At 21:00, Israeli forces raided Habalat village until 22:10. • Attack: At 12:30, Israeli forces positioned at the wall gate located between Beit Amin and Azzun Atma, opened fire towards 2 residents as they attempted to climb the wall into Israel and as a result injured Rab’e Zayed leaving him hospitalised with contusions and detained a resident. • Detention: Israeli forces detained Mahmoud Zayed near the wall gate located between Beit Amin and Azzun Atma. • Temporary Detention: At 19:00, Israeli forces temporarily detained Bassim Daoud (15 years old) in Al-Nabi Elisa's village as he was near his farm then released him at 21:30. • Assault on Property: At 10:10, Israeli forces prevented several residents from entering their farm land near Jinsafut village for allegedly not having an entry permit. • Settler Violence: At 14:45, Israeli settlers positioned near “Qadumim” settlement and punctured the tires of vehicles owned by Shadi Abdel Ghani and Rashid Barghout. • Wall Gates: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to restrict access at ‘Azzun ‘Atma Wall gate closed the steel gate and to search civilians, including students, using a metal detector. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the entrance to the village of Wadi Al- Rasha and to deny civilian access. The Israeli army allows residents to access the village through Gate #109. Having removed the gate at the entrance to the village of Ras Atiya; the Israeli army only allows students to cross to their schools outside the village through the Habla gate. • Wall Construction: Wall construction continued in Kafr Laqif village north of Karnei Shomron settlement; in Immatin village northeast of Immanuel settlement; and east of Kafr Thulth town near Ma ’ale Shomron settlement.

(ii) At 21:55, Israeli forces raided Salem village. (iii) At 24:00, Israeli forces raided Tel village, stormed several homes, detained 6 residents and summoned 14 residents: Ibrahim Zidan (National Security officer), Ashraf Ramadan, Eyad Ishtayeh, Nimer Hindi, Ja'far Rihan, Ahmad Asaydeh, Osama Yamen, Muthna Ishtayeh, Mahmoud Assaydeh, Sameh Ramadan, Hilmi Ramadan, Ahmad Ramadan, Mo'ayad Hamad, and Sameh Suliman to report to Israeli Intelligence for questioning then withdrew at 04:10. (iv) At 02:35, Israeli forces raided Nablus, stormed a University student dormitory, confiscated a computer then withdrew at 04:00. • <u>Detention:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli forces detained Ahamd Enibus, a resident of Tubas, in the area between Al-Far'a and Al-Bithan. (ii) Israeli forces detained 6 residents: Bakr Ramadan, Ahmad Ramadan, Issa Ramadan, Suliman Hamad, Mahmoud Hindy and Hamdi Ramadan in Tel village. • <u>Confiscation of Property:</u> At 01:45 on October 8th 2013, Israeli forces confiscated a computer owned by Hadish after storming his home as they raided Balata camp in Nablus (as mentioned in the previous report).

(ii) On 15.04.2012, the Israeli army has opened the northern entrance to Salfit city to civilian which was closed since the year 2000 and prevented access from 08:00 until 09:20. (iii) Since 11:00 on July 30th 2012, Israeli forces have closed two roads leading to Abu Nasar and Qatan Al-Jama' located in western area of Deir Istiya with cement blocks. • <u>Checkpoints:</u> Israeli forces continue to intensify their restrictions at Za'tara Al-checkpoint and impeded the free flow of traffic. • <u>Raid:</u> At 01:00, Israeli forces raided Kafr Al-Dik, detained a resident then withdrew at 03:30. • <u>Detention:</u> Israeli forces detained Zakariya Al-Dik in Kafr Al-Dik village. • <u>Wall Construction:</u> Wall construction continued in the area north of Deir Istiya town southeast of the illegal settlement.

(ii) At 24:00, Israeli forces raided Fasayil village, stormed a home, detained 2 residents then withdrew at 00:50. • <u>Detention:</u> Israeli forces detained Alaa Abiyat and Sultan Sawarkat in Fasayil

	<p>village.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close roads to An Nu'man village, with the exception of the road leading to the Wall gate in the south-eastern area of the village. (ii) Since 15 September 2007, the Israel army has prevented civilians from accessing or staying on 22 dunumes of confiscated land in Al Mazmuriya area in Beit Sahur and Bethlehem cities. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the Beit Jala-Wadi Ahmed road; a road between Um Tuba and Al-Jass ; a road between Um Tuba and Khilat Nu'man: a road between Um Tuba and the wall; a road between Al-Khas village and the wall; the 2 by pass roads located south of Al-Walaja; a road between Talita Qumi and Nazlat Al-Sider in Beit Jala; the eastern road of Al-Khader; the road between Al-Khader and Beit Jala ; the road between Al-Khader and road #60 which lead to the eastern neighbourhoods of Bethlehem; a road leading to Wadi Rahal, and a road east of Beit Fajjar town with dirt mounds. (iv) Since May 8th 2013, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Carmisan area in Beit Jalla and Al-Walaja with a steel gate and barbed wires. (v) Since June 3rd 2013, the Israeli army closed the road connecting Nihalin and road 60 with dirt mounds. (vi) Since 13:20 on September 29th 2013, the Israeli army closed a road leading to 50 acres of agricultural land in Wadi Salem area in Al-Khadr with dirt mounds. • <u>Raid:</u> At 12:45, Israeli forces raided Al-Khadr, clashed with several residents then withdrew at 13:20. • <u>Wall Construction:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Wall construction has continued in North West of Beit Jala town. (ii) On May 1st 2103, an Israeli court ordered the halt of wall construction near Betar village. (iii) On July 21st 2013, Israeli courts ordered the halt of construction of the wall in Al-Carmisan area in the west area of Beit Jalla.

In addition to closing the entrance to Al-Qeisi neighbourhood, the Israeli army continues to close the entrances to the area of Al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) with an electronic gate; Al-Laban Market also remains closed. (ii) Since 05 January 2009, the Israeli army has closed the area located along the Green Line south of the town of Yatta. Having seized land for Wall construction, the Israeli army evicted the Palestinian residents and denied them access to the area. . • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Al-Thahiriya and Al-Samoa' towns, Al-'Arrub refugee camp, and Al-Tuwani and Al-Karmil villages. (ii) The Israeli army continues to prohibit Palestinian vehicles from travelling along the old Al-Shalala Street leading to Hebron's Old City. (iii) The Israeli army continues to close all roads leading to Road # 60 as well as detour

At a later time on the same day, armed Palestinian groups announced an agreement to cease fire. • On November 14th 2011 Israeli forces placed floating marks 3 miles from Gaza's seashore and warned fishermen against passing beyond the mark and on November 24th 2012, Israeli forces imposed floating marks of 6 miles and on March 21st 2013 re imposed fishing restrictions of 3 miles. • Israeli forces broke the cease fire agreement by raiding and opening fire towards North Gaza and Rafah and as a result injured a resident in Rafah. • Israeli Naval vessels broke the cease fire agreement by opening fire towards Palestinian fishing boats off the shores of Gaza.
<p>NORTHERN GAZA</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Crossing Point:</u> Beit Hanun (Erez) is open for the passage of critical patients, journalists, NGO staff, businessmen and passengers travelling abroad through Al-Karama crossing with previous coordination. • <u>Attack:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 22:40 on October 7th 2013, Israeli forces positioned behind the Green Line opened fire towards agricultural land in North Beit Hanun. (ii) At 23:30, Israeli forces positioned behind the Green Line opened fire towards agricultural land in Beit Hanun. (iii) At 06:30, Israeli forces positioned behind the Green Line opened fire towards agricultural land in east Beit Hanun.

Beginning on 02 March 2011, the Crossing has been effectively closed following a unilateral Israeli decision. (ii) Al-Shija'iyah (Nahal 'Oz) Crossing is closed. Beginning on 04 January 2010, the Crossing has been closed following a unilateral Israeli decision. • <u>Attack:</u> At 05:30, Israeli Naval vessels opened fire towards Palestinian fishing boats off the shores of Gaza.
RAFAH	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Crossing Points :</u> • Yasser 'Arafat International Airport remains closed. • Rafah (<i>Al 'Awdah</i>) Crossing is closed. • Sufa Crossing is closed. • Karm Abu Salem (Karem Shalom) Crossing is open for the passage of critical patients, journalists, NGO staff, businessmen and passengers travelling abroad through Al-Karama crossing with previous coordination, diesel fuel , construction material for Internationally funded projects and allowed 40 truckloads of humanitarian goods, 20 Truckloads of construction material and 10 truckloads of construction steel. • <u>Attack:</u> On the evening of October 7th 2013, Israeli forces positioned behind the Green Line opened fire towards several farmers in east Shweikiya and as a result injured Ziyad Al-Shawi.
