| <b>JERUALEM</b> | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b><u>Closure:</u></b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) On October 8<sup>th</sup> 2015, the Israeli army, intensified their restrictions at the entrance to Jerusalem city, set up several flying checkpoints on the main road leading to the city and prevented worshippers under the age of 50 from conducting prayers at Al-Aqsa mosque compound.</li> <li>(ii) The Israeli army continues to close the ‘demarcation area’ along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits.</li> <li>(iii) The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill between Biddu and Beit Iksa villages.</li> </ul> </li> <li>• <b><u>Closure of Main Roads:</u></b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the entrance to Jaba’ village.</li> <li>(ii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to Beit Iksa village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandiya checkpoint.</li> </ul> </li> <li>• <b><u>Checkpoints:</u></b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) Israeli authorities continue to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a “border crossing point” and designate a special crossing lane for holders of Jerusalem IDs and another for those possessing permits to access Jerusalem city.</li> <li>(ii) On September 19<sup>th</sup> 2012, Israeli forces closed Ras Khamis checkpoint near Shu’fat camp and impeded the free flow of traffic in order to construct the wall.</li> </ul> </li> <li>• <b><u>Flying Checkpoint:</u></b> At 18:30, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Biddu until 23:40.</li> <li>• <b><u>Raid:</u></b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) At 15:15, Israeli forces raided Shu’fat camp, clashed with several residents as they stormed the home of Subhi Abu Khalifeh (the residents who was detained by Israeli forces as he allegedly stabbed a settler and then was killed after Israeli forces opened fire towards him in Jerusalem) and as a result killed a resident, and injured 21 residents including 3 critically injured: Anas Khalifeh, Ehab Shawamra and Mohammad Al-Ja’bari and also left several others suffocated from tear gas inhalation.</li> </ul> </li> </ul> |

(ii) At 18:40, Israeli forces raided Samir Amis area located in North Jerusalem, clashed with several residents as they marched towards the home of Thaer Abu Ghazaleh (who was killed by Israeli forces after he stabbed an Israeli in Tel Aviv) and informed his family to demolish their home then withdrew at 19:30.

(iii) At 19:30, Israeli forces raided Abu Dis, clashed with several residents, detained a resident then withdrew at 22:50.

- **Killing:**

- (i) At 15:15, Thaer Abu Ghazaleh (A resident of Kafr Aqab village) was killed after Israeli forces opened towards him after he allegedly stabbed four Israeli settlers including a Military officer in Tel Aviv inside Israel.

- (ii) Israeli forces opened fire towards and killed Wissam Faraj during confrontations with several residents as they stormed Shu'fat camp.

- **Detention:**

- (i) At 11:30, Israeli forces detained Subhi Abu Khalifeh (A resident of Shu'fat camp) in Al-Sheikh Jarrah neighbourhood .

- (ii) At 15:00, Israeli forces detained three residents: Ata Dubrus, Mohammad Obied and Zakariya Darwish (All residents of Al-Eisawiya village).

- (iii) At 19:20, Israeli forces detained Loai Al-Shamali (A resident of Doha in Bethlehem) in Jerusalem.

- (iv) The detained in Abu Dis was Muhammed Sufian.

- **Attack:**

- (i) At 12:40, Israeli forces positioned near the wall gate in Abu Dis fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.

- (ii) At 15:30, Israeli forces positioned near Qalandiya checkpoint, fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.

- (iii) At 17:00, Israeli forces positioned near the entrance of Anata village fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.

- (iv) At 17:00, Israeli forces positioned in the North entrance of Al-Ram fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.

- (v) At 17:00, Israeli forces positioned in Al-Eizariya fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.

- (vi) At 19:00, Israeli forces positioned in Dahiyat Al-Barid area in Al-Ram fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.

- (vii) At 19:30, Israeli forces positioned near the wall gate in Beit Ijza village fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.

- (viii) At 21:30, Israeli forces positioned in Bab Hata gate area ( A main gate entrance leading to Al-Aqsa mosque compound ) in the old city of Jerusalem fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning as they stormed a home.

- (ix) At 21:30, Israeli forces positioned in Al-Tur and Ras Al-Amoud neighbourhoods fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.

- (x) At 22:00, Israeli forces positioned at the entrance of Al-Eisawiya village fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.

- (xi) At 22:00, Israeli forces positioned near the entrance of Hizma village fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.

- (xii) At 22:10, Israeli forces positioned near the entrance of Biddo fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.

| <p><b>RAMALLAH<br/>&amp;<br/>AL BIREH</b></p> | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b><u>Closure of Main Roads:</u></b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Sinjil village well as the junction to Kafr Malik and ‘Ein Samiya villages.</li> <li>(ii) Since October 3<sup>rd</sup> 2015, Israeli forces closed the main road near “Bet El” settlement leading to Al-Jalazoun camp with cement blocks.</li> <li>(iii) Since 12:45 on October 5<sup>th</sup> 2015, Israeli forces closed the road leading to Deir Nathim village with cement blocks.</li> </ul> </li> <li>• <b><u>Checkpoint:</u></b> At 23:35 on October 4<sup>th</sup> 2015, Israeli forces closed Al-Mahakma checkpoint located near “Bet El” settlement located north Al-Bireh city and impeded the free flow of traffic.</li> <li>• <b><u>Flying Checkpoint:</u></b> At 23:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Beit Illo village 23:55.</li> <li>• <b><u>Raid:</u></b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) At 22:45, Israeli forces raided Bil’in village.</li> <li>(ii) At 04:30, Israeli forces raided Jifna village, detained a resident then withdrew at 05:00.</li> <li>(iii) At 04:00, Israeli forces raided Silwad, stormed and searched a home and summoned two residents: Hazim Al-Salhi and Issam Al-Da’as to report to Israeli Intelligence for questioning then withdrew at 05:00.</li> </ul> </li> <li>• <b><u>Attack:</u></b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) At 08:45, Israeli forces positioned near Budros village, fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents during which the local boy’s school in the village was forced to cancel classes after Israeli forces fired tear gas grenades into the school.</li> <li>(ii) At 11:00, Israeli forces positioned in the vicinity of “Al-Mahakma checkpoint” located near “Bet El” settlement in North Al-Bireh fired live ammunition, rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several University students{for the second consecutive day} for alleged stoning as they were protesting against the Israeli Military and settler acts of aggression and their assault on Al-Aqsa mosque compound and as a result injured 33 residents{ including a child,3 Paramedics and 2 journalist}: Omar Abdel-Khalil Al-Abed (16 years old), Ahmad Abu Zowid (A journalist), Atef Al-Safadi (A journalist), Yasser Hazam, Abdel Aziz Hamad, Mais Al-Barghouthi, Mohammad Bawab, Qutaybah Balout, Moath Mustafa, Diya’ Al-Maz, Ehab Abu Al-Rob, Bayan Al-Jabar, Akram Qadoura and Ra’fat Snubeir and also left several others suffocated from tear gas inhalation.</li> <li>(iii) At 13:45, Israeli forces positioned near “Pesagout” settlement located in east Al-Bireh city fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.</li> <li>(iv) At 15:25, Israeli forces positioned near the entrance of Al-Nabi Saleh village fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.</li> <li>(v) At 17:20, Israeli forces positioned near the wall gate located in south Al-Bireh city fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.</li> </ul> </li> </ul> |

| <p><b>TULKAREM</b></p> | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b><u>Checkpoint:</u></b> At 22:40, Israeli forces intensified their restrictions at “Eniv” checkpoint located along the main road connecting Tulkarem and Nablus (for the alleged shooting of a Israeli settler vehicle in the area between “Yitmar” and “Alon Moriya” settlement and impeded the free flow of traffic until 06:45.</li> <li>• <b><u>Raid:</u></b> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) At dawn on October 8<sup>th</sup> 2015, Israeli forces raided Safarin village and detained a resident.</li> <li>(ii) On the evening of October 8<sup>th</sup> 2015, Israeli forces raided Far’oun village and clashed with several residents near the wall gate.</li> </ol> </li> <li>• <b><u>Attack:</u></b> At 11:40, Israeli forces positioned in the vicinity of (Ghisouri) factory area located in the west area of Tulkarem fired live ammunition, rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and as a result injured 16 residents including 2 children: Mohammad Matrouk (17 years old), Yazan Othman (15 years old), Karam Haroun, Sa’ed Ali, Mohammad Omier, Bashar Omier, Mohammad Sabah, Waleed Na’sa, , Nihad Abdel-Raziq, Mu’taz Obied, Midhat Mas’aud, Mu’amar Jarradat, , Abdel-Hafith Jabber, Mohammad Jarr, Rami Abdallah and Waleed Abu Safaqa as well as leaving 6 other suffocated from tear gas inhalation and detained a University student.</li> <li>• <b><u>Detention:</u></b> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) On October 7<sup>th</sup> 2015, Israeli forces detained Mahmoud Odeh {A University student}(A resident of Kafr Thulth in Qalqiliya) in Tulkarem city.</li> <li>(ii) Israeli forces detained Usayed Hassan in Safarin village.</li> <li>(iii) Israeli forces positioned near (Ghisouri) factory area located in the west area of Tulkarem detained Mohammad Abu Arra (A resident of Aqaba in Tubas).</li> </ol> </li> <li>• <b><u>Wall Gates:</u></b> At 20:30, Israeli forces closed wall gate (708) located in Far’oun village and prevented several residents and farmers from returning to their homes as well as assaulted 6 residents: Adham Omar, Nasim Atir, Obada Badir, Mohammad Salameh, Omar Otir and Ibrahim Salameh {All residents of Far’oun village} and as a result left them hospitalised with contusions.</li> </ul> |

| <p><b>QALQILIYA</b></p> | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b><u>Closure of Roads:</u></b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) Israeli forces continue to close with cement blocks agricultural roads east of Azzun town.</li> <li>(ii) In addition to closing the gate installed since the outbreak the second Intifada, the Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the eastern entrance to Kafr Qaddum village.</li> <li>(iii) Since 10:40 on September 1<sup>st</sup> 2015, Israeli forces closed an agricultural road leading to Far'ata village, which is located near "Gillad" settlement with a steel gate.</li> </ul> </li> <li>• <b><u>Flying Checkpoint:</u></b> At 07:30, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Azzun.</li> <li>• <b><u>Raid:</u></b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) At 18:50, Israeli forces raided east Qalqiliya area located near Jaljouliya checkpoint, clashed with several residents, temporarily detained 6 residents including 2 children: Mohammad Mahna (16 years old) and Majdi Al-Ju'idi (15 years old), Baha Hilal, Yazan Qashou', Bara' Al-Basha and Omar Saman then released them at a later time then withdrew at 20:00.</li> <li>(ii) At 02:40, Israeli forces raided Qalqiliya until 03:00.</li> </ul> </li> <li>• <b><u>Attack:</u></b> At 20:05, Israeli forces positioned near the entrance of Azzun fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and as a result left several residents suffocated from tear gas inhalation and temporarily detained Khaled Hussien (13 years old).</li> <li>• <b><u>Settler Violence:</u></b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) At 19:05, Israeli settlers positioned near Jit village attempted to storm the village and assault several homes and then stoned several vehicles and as a result damaged 2 vehicles owned by Obieda Arman (A resident of Qalqiliya) and Abdel-Min'em Al-Bari (A resident of Sinariya village) during which Israeli forces detained a resident after his vehicle was damaged as he attempted to prevent the settler attack then withdrew at 20:00.</li> <li>(ii) At 22:05, Israeli settlers positioned near the entrance of Kafr Laqif village, closed the main road connecting Qalqiliya and Nablus and then stoned vehicles passing through the road and then withdrew at 03:30.</li> </ul> </li> <li>• <b><u>Detention:</u></b> Israeli forces detained Obieda Amran (A resident of Qalqiliya) near Jit village.</li> <li>• <b><u>Wall Gates:</u></b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) The Israeli army continues to restrict access at 'Azzun 'Atma Wall gate and impeded the free flow of traffic.
