JERUSALEM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli army continues to intensify their restrictions at the entrance to Jerusalem city, set up several flying checkpoints on the main road leading to the city and prevented worshipers under the age of 50 from conducting prayers at Al-Aqsa mosque compound. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the ‘demarcation area’ along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits. (iii) The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill between Biddu and Beit Ikksa villages. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the entrance to Jaba’ village. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to Beit Ikksa village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandiya checkpoint. • <u>Checkpoints:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli authorities continue to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a “border crossing point” and designate a special crossing lane for holders of Jerusalem IDs and another for those possessing permits to access Jerusalem city and at 06:00, Israeli forces closed the checkpoint impeding the free flow of traffic. (ii) On September 19th 2012, Israeli forces closed Ras Khamis checkpoint near Shu’fat camp and impeded the free flow of traffic in order to construct the wall. • <u>Flying Checkpoints:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> At 24:00, Israeli Forces set up a flying checkpoint on the junction of Al Ram, searched civilians and vehicles. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 02:00 on the 9th of October, 2013, Israeli forces raided and patrolled the village of Hizma. (ii) On the early morning of the 9th of October, 2013, Israeli forces raided town of Abu Dis, stormed, searched several houses, and detained 2 residents. (iii) At 16:00, Israeli forces raided Anata, confrontations took place

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Detention:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i). On October 9th, 2013, Israeli Forces detained Ata Rayan from Bet Doqo. (ii) On the 9th of October, Israeli Forces detained 2 citizens (including a woman) in the old city of Jerusalem Ayda Sedawi, and Naser Quse. (iii) At 08:00, Israeli Forces detained Ashraf Abasi from silwan. (iv) At 04:00, Israeli Forces detained Munzer Rwid 13 years, and Ahmad Abu Nab 14 years from Silwan. • <u>Settlements Activity:</u> On October 9th, Israeli Authorities approved the building of new 58 units in the settlement of “Besgat Zeave” in occupied Jerusalem. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the Wall gate in Abu Dis town. (ii) The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate on Al-Shayyah road in the area between Al-Sawahira Al-Sharqiya and Al-Slewahira Al-Gharbiya villages, only allowing civilians holding Jerusalem IDs to cross, after subjecting them to thorough searches using electronic devices. • <u>Wall Construction:</u> Wall construction continued in the areas north and south of Qalandiya village; south of Al-Za’ayyem village; and in Wadi Al-Eizariya west of the illegal settlement Ma ’ale Adumim.
RAMALLAH & AL BIREH	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Sinjil village well as the junction to Kafr Malik and ‘Ein Samiya villages. (ii) Since September 3rd 2013, Israeli forces closed the north east entrance of Al-Mughier village with dirt mounds. • <u>Raid:</u> At 09:25, Israeli forces raided the town of Beit Leqya until 11:25, confrontation took place. • <u>Settler Violence:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 09:40, Israeli settlers raided the agricultural lands of Turmus Aya, set fire on 30 olive trees belonged to Suleman Abu Awad. (ii) At 01:45, Israeli settlers raided the village of Burqa, set fire on 3 civilian cars, and spray slogans on walls of the village mosque. • <u>Wall Construction:</u> Wall construction resumed in the area west of ‘Abud town in the area surrounding the illegal settlement ‘Ofarim and north of Al-Lubban Al-Gharbi and Rantis villages.
JENIN	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Road:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the road leading to the town of ‘Arraba east of the illegal settlement Dotan. (ii) Since the evening of November 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the western entrance of Ya’bad. • <u>Checkpoints:</u> At 08:00, Israeli Forces closed the checkpoints of “movo Dottan” on the main road of Jenin- Tulkarem until 09:00. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> Passage through the Wall gates is restricted to civilians granted special Israeli permits, which undercuts the access to education and health services for civilians living behind the Wall.
TULKAREM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the road connecting Kafr Al-Labad town to Shufa village. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the detour road leading to Ramin village along the Tulkarem-Nablus main road. • <u>Checkpoint:</u> At 08:50, Israeli forces continue to intensify their restrictions at “Eniv: checkpoint and impeded the free flow of traffic. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> Passage through the Wall gates is restricted to civilians granted special Israeli permits, which undercuts the access to education and health services

	for civilians living behind the Wall.
QALQILIYA	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure of Roads: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli forces continue to close with cement blocks agricultural roads east of Azzun town. (ii) In addition to closing the gate installed since the outbreak the second Intifada, the Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the eastern entrance to Kafr Qaddum village. • Flying Checkpoints: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 08:30, Israeli forces set up a flying checkpoint near the eastern entrance of Qalqeleh. (ii) At 18:00, Israeli Forces set up a flying checkpoint at the entrance of the town Azzoun, detained 2 civilians. • Raid: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 12:15, Israeli forces raided the village of Azzoun Itma, stormed house under construction owned by Ismail Awni Ismail, and forced workers to evacuate. (ii) At 21:30 Israeli Forces raided, and patrolled the city of Qalqiliya. • Attack: At 21:15, Israeli forces positioned at the western side of the city opened fire towards 2 residents. Whom escaped from the location. • Detention: Israeli forces detained Tamer Said Ismaeil and Qusi Shbita at the entrance of Azzoun. • Wall Gates: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to restrict access at ‘Azzun ‘Atma Wall gate closed the steel gate and to search civilians, including students, using a metal detector. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the entrance to the village of Wadi Al- Rasha and to deny civilian access. The Israeli army allows residents to access the village through Gate #109. Having removed the gate at the entrance to the village of Ras Atiya; the Israeli army only allows students to cross to their schools outside the village through the Habla gate. • Wall Construction: Wall construction continued in Kafr Laqif village north of Karnei Shomron settlement; in Immatin village northeast of Immanuel settlement; and east of Kafr Thulth town near Ma ’ale Shomron settlement.
NABLUS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure of Main Roads: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the roads of Til-Burin and Beit Furik-Salem; the settler bypass road connecting the village of Deir al Hatab to the settlement of Alon Moreh; the road connecting the town of ‘Aqraba to the village of Osrin; and the detour road between the town of Qabalan and the village of Osrin. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the northern entrance to Qabalan town; the southern entrances to the town of Jamma’in and the villages of Duma and Qaryut with dirt mounds. • Flying Checkpoint: At 21:15, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the junction of the towns Beita, Aqraba, and the village of Osareen, searched civilians, and vehicles until 22:30. • Raid: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 11:50, Israeli forces raided the, and stormed the school of the village Bureen. (ii) At 23:50, Israeli forces raided the city of Nablus, stormed 3 houses, detained 3 residents, and physically assaulted 2 others (Ahmmad refa’i, and Adham Shalabi). • Detention: Israeli forces detained Mahmmoud Nana, Hafez Duikat, and Muhammed Tawafsha in the city of Nablus.

	<p><u>Settlers Violence:</u></p> <p>(i) On the morning of October 9th, A group of Israeli Settlers raided the lands of Jabal El Mzra'a located near the villages of Jalod, and Qaryot, and set on fire approximately 400 olive trees</p> <p>(ii) On the 9th of October, 2013, a group of Israeli settlers raided the village of Jalod, throw stones on the village school, and destroyed the front glass of 5 vehicles.</p>
SALFIT	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <p>(i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the entrance to two detour roads connecting Marda village to its farmland.</p> <p>(ii) On 15.04.2012, the Israeli army has opened the northern entrance to Salfit city to civilian which was closed since the year 2000 and prevented access from 08:00 until 09:20.</p> <p>(iii) Since 11:00 on July 30th 2012, Israeli forces have closed two roads leading to Abu Nasar and Qatan Al-Jama' located in western area of Deir Istiya with cement blocks.</p> • <u>Checkpoints:</u> Israeli forces continue to intensify their restrictions at Za'tara Al-checkpoint and impeded the free flow of traffic. • <u>Flying Checkpoints:</u> At 11:15, and 15:00, Israeli forces set up a flying checkpoint on the northern entrance of the city Salfit, and closed the main Iron Gate. • <u>Wall Construction:</u> Wall construction continued in the area north of Deir Istiya town southeast of the illegal settlement.
JERICHO	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Checkpoints:</u> Israeli forces continue to intensify its restrictions at Al-Hamra checkpoint set up along the road connecting Jericho and Nablus District. • <u>Flying Checkpoints:</u> <p>(i) At 08:10, Israeli forces set up a flying checkpoint at the southern entrance of the city Jericho, searched civilians and vehicles until 08:50</p> • <u>Demonstrations:</u> At 10:30, a demonstration took place in front the Red Cross offices in the city of Jericho in solidarity with prisoners detained in Israeli prisons.
BETHLEHEM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <p>(i) The Israeli army continues to close roads to An Nu'man village, with the exception of the road leading to the Wall gate in the south-eastern area of the village.</p> <p>(ii) Since 15 September 2007, the Israel army has prevented civilians from accessing or staying on 22 dunumes of confiscated land in Al Mazmuriya area in Beit Sahur and Bethlehem cities.</p> • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <p>(i) The Israeli army continues to close the Beit Jala-Wadi Ahmed road; a road between Um Tuba and Al-Jass ; a road between Um Tuba and Khilat Nu'man: a road between Um Tuba and the wall; a road between Al-Khas village and the wall; the 2 by pass roads located south of Al-Walaja; a road between Talita Qumi and Nazlat Al-Sider in Beit Jala; the eastern road of Al-Khader; the road between Al-Khader and Beit Jala ; the road between Al-Khader and road #60 which lead to the eastern neighbourhoods of Bethlehem; a road leading to Wadi Rahal, and a road east of Beit Fajjar town with dirt mounds.</p> <p>(ii) The Israeli army continues to close the road leading to "Newe Daniyyel" settlement and agricultural land in Al-Khader; a road between Um Tuba and Wadi Al-Hums: Wadi Fukin, Al-Jaba, the Green Line; a road between Za'tara and a detour road, and a road between Taqou and Khirbet Al-Deir with cement blocks.</p> <p>(iii) Since August 2nd 2012, Israeli forces closed a road leading to Beit Jalla.</p> <p>(iv) Since May 8th 2013, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Carmisan area in Beit Jalla and Al-Walaja with a steel gate and barbed wires.</p>

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> (v) Since June 3rd 2013, the Israeli army closed the road connecting Nihalin and road 60 with dirt mounds. (vi) Since 13:20 on September 29th 2013, the Israeli army closed a road leading to 50 acres of agricultural land in Wadi Salem area in Al-Khadr with dirt mounds. • <u>Flying Checkpoints:</u> At 21:55, Israeli Forces set up a flying checkpoint at the entrance of the town Beit Fajar, searched civilians and vehicles. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 09:00, and 00:55, Israeli forces raided the city of Bethlehem, set up a flying checkpoint, and occupied the roofs of 3 buildings near checkpoint 300 at the northern entrance of the city. (ii) At 09:40, Israeli Forces raided the village of El Ma'sara, and served notes to Hassan Brejea to report to the Israeli intelligence. (iii) At 11:10, Israeli Forces raided the town of El Khader, occupied the roof of a house, confrontation took place, a woman was injured, and several were suffered from the inhalation of tear gas. (iv) At 23: 45, Israeli Forces raided Al Obidia town, stormed a house, and detained the resident Muhammed Rabia'a. • <u>Wall Construction:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Wall construction has continued in North West of Beit Jala town. (ii) On May 1st 2103, an Israeli court ordered the halt of wall construction near Betar village. (iii) On July 21st 2013, Israeli courts ordered the halt of construction of the wall in Al-Carmisan area in the west area of Beit Jalla.
HEBRON	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close Al-Shuhada' Street, Al-Sahleh and Khuzq Al-Far areas, as well as the old gold market in Hebron's Old City. In addition to closing the entrance to Al-Qeisi neighbourhood, the Israeli army continues to close the entrances to the area of Al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) with an electronic gate; Al-Laban Market also remains closed. (ii) Since 05 January 2009, the Israeli army has closed the area located along the Green Line south of the town of Yatta. Having seized land for Wall construction, the Israeli army evicted the Palestinian residents and denied them access to the area. . • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Al-Thahiriya and Al-Samoa' towns, Al-'Arrub refugee camp, and Al-Tuwani and Al-Karmil villages. (ii) The Israeli army continues to prohibit Palestinian vehicles from travelling along the old Al-Shalala Street leading to Hebron's Old City. (iii) The Israeli army continues to close all roads leading to Road # 60 as well as detour roads along the settler bypass road leading to Yatta town. (iv) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds a detour road leading to e to Al-Simiya village, the southern entrance of Al-Samou' and the entrance of Beit Annun with cement blocks. (v) Since July 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Safa and Al-Dirat and also closed the entrance of south Yatta with cement blocks. (vi) Since December 27th 2012, Israeli forces closed the west entrance of Swiesiya village which connects Yatta and Al-Samou' village with cement blocks. (vii) Since 09:45 on September 23rd 2013, Israeli forces closed the main road leading to "Haji" settlement and impeded the free flow of traffic

(ii) At 18:00, Israeli Forces set up a flying checkpoint at the entrance of the town Saer, search citizens, and Vehicles. (iii) At 18:35, Israeli Forces set up a flying checkpoint on Halhoul Bridge, searched civilians, and vehicles. • <u>Detention:</u> On the down of October 9th, 2013, Israeli Forces detained Ilan Awad after Storming and searching his house during the raid to the town of Beit Ummar. • <u>Temporary Detention:</u> At 19:00, Israeli Forces temporally detained 2 children (Muhammad Abu Maria 13, and his brother Bader17), at the entrance of the town Beit Ummar. • <u>Wall Construction:</u> Wall construction continued in the area surrounding the illegal settlement Eshkolot, west of Al-Thahriya town.

At a later time on the same day, armed Palestinian groups announced an agreement to cease fire. • On November 14th 2011 Israeli forces placed floating marks 3 miles from Gaza's seashore and warned fishermen against passing beyond the mark and on November 24th 2012, Israeli forces imposed floating marks of 6 miles and on March 21st 2013 re imposed fishing restrictions of 3 miles.

NORTHERN GAZA	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Crossing Point:</u> Beit Hanun (Erez) is open for the passage of critical patients, journalists, NGO staff, businessmen and passengers travelling abroad through Al-Karama crossing with previous coordination.
GAZA	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Crossing Points:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Al-Muntar (Karni) Crossing is closed. Beginning on 02 March 2011, the Crossing has been effectively closed following a unilateral Israeli decision. (ii) Al-Shija'iya (Nahal 'Oz) Crossing is closed. Beginning on 04 January 2010, the Crossing has been closed following a unilateral Israeli decision.
RAFAH	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Crossing Points :</u> • Yasser 'Arafat International Airport remains closed. • Rafah (Al 'Awdah) is open. (For students, medical cases, and those with permits). • Sufa Crossing is closed. • Karm Abu Salem (Karem Shalom) Crossing is open for the passage of critical patients, journalists, NGO staff, businessmen and passengers travelling abroad through Al-Karama crossing with previous coordination, diesel fuel , construction material for Internationally funded projects and allowed 40 truckloads of humanitarian goods, 20 Truckloads of construction material and 10 truckloads of construction steel.

Detainees

Israeli district court in Jerusalem ruled Inam Qalambo from Jerusalem for 7, and a half months imprisonment
