WEST BANK

• Closure:

- (i) On October 9th 2015, the Israeli army, intensified their restrictions at the entrance to Jerusalem city, set up several flying checkpoints on the main road leading to the city and prevented worshipers under the age of 50 from conducting prayers at Al-Aqsa mosque compound, which forced residents to conduct prayers near checkpoints located outside Al-Aqsa mosque compound.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the 'demarcation area' along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits.
- (iii) The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill between Biddu and Beit Iksa villages.

• Closure of Main Roads:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the entrance to Jaba' village.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to Beit Iksa village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandiya checkpoint.

• Checkpoints:

- (i) Israeli authorities continue to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a "border crossing point" and designate a special crossing lane for holders of Jerusalem IDs and another for those possessing permits to access Jerusalem city.
- (ii) On September 19th 2012, Israeli forces closed Ras Khamis checkpoint near Shu'fat camp and impeded the free flow of traffic in order to construct the wall.
- <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 14:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint between Beit Liqya and Beit Annan.
- **Raid:** At 23:30, Israeli forces raided Shu'fat camp, clashed with several residents, and as a result killed a resident and injured 25 others including one critically injured.
- <u>Killing:</u> Israeli forces killed Ahmad Salah during confrontations in Shu'fat camp.

• Detention:

- (i) At 14:40, Israeli forces detained the child Yunis Tayarat (17 years old) {A resident of Bani Na'im in Hebron} for allegedly stabbing an Israeli settler.
- (ii) At 21:10, Israeli forces detained Mustafa Ashir in Al-Tut neighbourhood.
- (iii) At 23:45, Israeli forces detained Khadija Obied (A journalist) in Al-Eisawiya village.
- (iv) At 23:45, Israeli forces detained two residents: Rakan Siyam and Nassar Siyam in Wadi Al-Juz neighbourhood.

• Attack:

(i) At 14:00, Israeli forces positioned near Qalandiya checkpoint fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and as a result injured two residents: Anas Samarah and Bassam Abu Nasser.

JERUSALEM

- (ii) At 14:00, Israeli forces positioned in Dahiyat Al-Barid area in Al-Ram fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.
- (iii) At 14:00, Israeli forces positioned near Shu'fat checkpoint fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and injured five residents.
- (iv) At 14:00, Israeli forces positioned near Beit Iksa checkpoint fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.
- (v) At 15:00, Israeli forces positioned in Abu Dis and Al-Eizariya fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and as a result injured 17 residents and left several others suffocated from tear gas inhalation.
- (vi) At 15:30, Israeli forces positioned near the entrance of Anata fired, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and as a result injured four residents: Ali Aliyan and Ahmad Haykal.
- (vii)At 16:00 and again at 23:30, Israeli forces positioned at the North entrance of Al-Eisawiya village Eizariya fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and as a result injured 17 residents and left several others suffocated from tear gas inhalation.
- (viii) At 16:00, Israeli forces positioned in Ras Al-Kabsa area junction in Abu Dis Eizariya fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.
- (ix) At 16:00, Israeli forces positioned near Al-Za'im checkpoint fired Eizariya fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.
- (x) At 16:00, Israeli forces positioned in Al-Sheikh Sa'ed village Eizariya fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.
- (xi) At 19:30, Israeli forces positioned in the old city of Jerusalem fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.
- (xii) At 19:30, Israeli forces positioned in Al-Sunah neighbourhood fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.
- (xiii) At 19:50, Israeli forces positioned in Al-Tur neighbourhood fired live ammunition; rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and as a result injured a resident.
- (xiv) At 21:35, Israeli force positioned in Shu'fat neighbourhood fired live ammunition; rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and as a result injured the child Layth Abu Nijmah (17 years old).
- (xv)At 23:30, Israeli forces positioned in Wadi Al-Joz neighbourhood fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.
- (xvi) At 23:30, Israeli forces positioned in Biddo fired live ammunition; rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and as a result injured Billal Nakhlah.
- (xvii) At 23:30, Israeli forces positioned near the entrance of Bir Nabalah fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.
- (xviii) At 24:00, Israeli forces positioned in Sur Bahar village fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.

• Settler Violence:

- (i) At 11:50, Israeli settlers stormed the old city of Jerusalem and stoned several residents and merchants.
- (ii) On October 9th 2015, a group of Israeli settlers positioned near Jaba' checkpoint located along the main road connecting Jerusalem, Ramallah and Jericho and stoned several residents and vehicles and as a result damaged the windshield of a vehicle owned by Abdel-Rahaman Ghayth and as a result injured his wife who was hospitalised with a fractured arm.

• Wall Gates:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the Wall gate in Abu Dis town.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate on Al-Shayyah road in the area between Al-Sawahira Al-Sharqiya and Al-Slewahira Al-Gharbiya villages, only allowing civilians holding Jerusalem IDs to cross, after subjecting them to thorough searches using electronic devices.

• Closure of Main Roads:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Sinjil village well as the junction to Kafr Malik and 'Ein Samiya villages
- (ii) . On October 3rd 2015, Israeli forces closed the main road located near "Bet El" settlement and leading to Al-Jalazoun camp with cement blocks.
- (iii) Since 12:45 on October 5th 2015, Israeli forces closed the entrance of Deir Nathim village with cement blocks.
- <u>Checkpoint:</u> At 23:35 on October 4th 2015, Israeli forces closed Al-Mahakma checkpoint located near "Bet El" settlement in North Al-Bireh city and impeded the free flow of Traffic.

• Flying Checkpoint:

- (i) At 22:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Beit Ur Al-Tahta village.
- (ii) At 00:30, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint in the area between Deir Ibzi' and Ain Arik village until 03:00.
- <u>Temporary Detention:</u> At 19:45, Israeli forces positioned near Kafr Ni'meh village temporarily detained three children: Mohammad Mufid Ishtayeh (15 years old), Mohammad Omar Ishtayeh (15 years old) and Musa Ahmad Musa (15 years old) then released them at a later time.

• Attack:

- (i) At 13:40, Israeli forces positioned near the entrance of Obwein village fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and as a result injured Ahmad Al-Barghouthi (A resident of Beit Rima).
- (ii) At 14:30, Israeli forces positioned in the vicinity Al-Mahakma checkpoint located near "Bet El" settlement in North Al-Bireh city fired live ammunition, rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents (who were protesting aginst the continued Israeli Military and Settler assault on Al-Agsa mosque compound) for alleged stoning and as a result injured 29 residents including a child and 4 critical injuries: Murad Subieh (Cruiticaly wonded in the eye), Mahmoud Al-Dik, , Salem Abu Salem, Moath Saleh, Mahmoud Sha'ath, Mahmoud Shahin, Omar Armos, Tareq Abu Shakra, Fahmi Faheem Najm, Salem Turki Zrauah, Abdullah Odeh, Anas Khalil Shuraitah, Saad Khadr Taysir, Haitham Nazih Muammar, Hassan Ali Mazin, Nasser Issa Sarhan, Iyad Ali Abu Gharbiya, Mohammed Nabil Dubis, Ghassan Fayez Abu Nasser, Saeed Ahmed Mohammed Rizi, Mohammed Saleh Nakhlah, Bilal Abdel Nasser Nakhlah, Khalid Nael Hamad, Mohammed Mamdouh Amira, Hisham Mahmoud Hani, Mohammed Hamed Ali, Omar Mattar, and Said Khadr Bseiso, and left several others suffocating due to inhaling tear gas.

- (iii) At 16:50, Israeli forces positioned near the entrance of Silwad fired live ammunition rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and as a result injured 3 residents: Tarik Hamad and left several others suffocating due to inhaling tear gas.
- (iv) At 16:50, Israeli forces positioned at the entrance of Al-Mughier village fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and as a result injured 8 residents including Hamadallah Jallal and left several others suffocating due to inhaling tear gas.
- (v) At 17:00, Israeli forces positioned near the entrance of Sinjil village fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.
- (vi) At 17:00, Israeli forces positioned near the entrance of Abboud fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and as a result injured 2 residents: Waleed Abdel-Majeed and Mohammad Attah and left several others suffocating due to inhaling tear gas.
- (vii)At 17:00, Israeli forces positioned near Budrous village fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.
- (viii) At 18:00, Israeli forces positioned near Al-Mazra'a Al-Gharbiya village fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.
- (ix) At 21:10, Israeli forces positioned near the entrance of Shuqba village fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.
- (x) At 21:15, Israeli forces positioned near the entrance of Ras Kar Kar village fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.

Demonstrations:

- (i) At 13:25, a demonstration took place in Bil'in protesting against the construction of the wall during which they clashed with Israeli forces and as a result injured Issah Sarour and left several residents suffocated from tear gas inhalation
- (ii) At 13:30, a demonstration took place in Ni'lin protesting against the construction of the wall during which they clashed with Israeli forces and as a result left several residents suffocated from tear gas inhalation.
- (iii) At 13:30, a demonstration took place in Al-Nabi Saleh village protesting against the confiscation of land for the purpose of settlement construction during which they clashed with Israeli forces who fired live ammunition, stun and tear gas grenades towards demonstrators and as a result left several others suffocated from tear gas inhalation.

• Closure of Main Road:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the road leading to the town of 'Arraba east of the illegal settlement Dotan.
- (ii) Since the evening of November 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the western entrance of Ya'bad.
- Raid: At 21:40, Israeli forces raided Zubaba village, clashed with several residents then withdrew at 22:00.
- Attack: At 14:40, Israeli forces positioned near the entrance of Al-Jamalah checkpoint located in North Jenin fired live ammunition, rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and as a result injured 6 residents including 3 children, a Journalist and a Paramedic: Islam Hamadah (15 years old), Mohammad Khaled Jarradat (16 years old), Mohammad Rajeh Jaraddat, Sakher Zuhedeh, Wissam Abu Obied and Arsan Abu Zaho.

- (i) At 14:45, Israeli forces positioned at the entrance of Azzun, fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and as a result injured 17 residents including 2 paramedics and left several others suffocated from tear gas inhalation.
- (ii) At 15:00, Israeli forces positioned near the south entrance of Qalqiliya fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and as a result left several others suffocated from tear gas inhalation.
- (iii) At 17:30, Israeli forces positioned near Al-Jaljoliya gate located in south west Qalqiliya fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and as a result injured 2 residents including a child: Ammar Sharim (16 years old) and Billal Abu Odwan
- **Demonstration:** At 13:00, a demonstration took place in Kafr Qaddum against the closure of the east entrance during which they clashed with Israeli forces who raided the village, occupied the rooftops of several homes and converted them into military posts and tried to disrupt the demonstration by firing live ammunition, rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards demonstrators who attempted to reach they demonstration site and as a result injured Mo'yad Ishtewi (60 years old) with critical injuries as well as leaving several others suffocated from tear gas inhalation.

Wall Gates:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to restrict access at 'Azzun 'Atma Wall gate and impeded the free flow of traffic. The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the entrance to the village of Wadi Al- Rasha and to deny civilian access.
- (ii) The Israeli army allows residents to access the village through Gate #109. Having removed the gate at the entrance to the village of Ras Atiya; the Israeli army only allows students to cross to their schools outside the village through the Habla gate.
- <u>Closure:</u> Since December 17th 2013, Israeli forces ordered the closure 500 dunumes of land in Qusra village as a closed military area.

• Closure of Main Roads:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close the roads of Til-Burin and Beit Furik-Salem; the settler bypass road connecting the village of Deir al Hatab to the settlement of Alon Moreh; the road connecting the town of 'Aqraba to the village of Osrin; and the detour road between the town of Qabalan and the village of Osrin.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the northern entrance to Qabalan town; the southern entrances to the town of Jamma'in and the villages of Duma and Qaryut.
- Raid: At 02:55, Israeli forces raided Nablus, stormed and searched a home then withdrew at 05:25.
- <u>Physical Assault:</u> At 22:20, Israeli forces positioned at Huwara checkpoint assaulted the child Abdel-Rahman Al-Damiri (17 years old) and as a result, left him hospitalised with contusions.
- Attack: At 13:50, Israeli forces positioned at the west entrance of Beit Furiq and at Huwara checkpoint fired live ammunition, rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and as a result injured 23 residents including a child, a resident critically injured and an international Peace activist{A French Citizen}: Izz al-Din Basil Sheikh Khalil, 15 years old, Majd Sajid Mulaitat seriously injured, Basil Younis Hanani, Mohammed Abu Kishik, Ala Iyad Haj Mohamed, Majid Hashash, Samir Elawi, Ahmed Al-Khatib, Sabri

SALFIT	 Closure of Main Roads: The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the entrance to two detour roads connecting Marda village to its farmland. On 15.04.2012, the Israeli army has opened the northern entrance to Salfit city to civilian, which was closed since the year 2000 and prevented access from 08:00 until 09:20. Since 11:00 on July 30th 2012, Israeli forces have closed two roads leading to Abu Nasar and Qatan Al-Jama' located in western area of Deir Istiya with cement blocks. Checkpoint: Israeli forces intensified their restrictions at Za'tara checkpoint and impeded the free flow of traffic. Flving Checkpoint: At 17:35, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Al-Zawiya. Attack:
	Dik and set fire to a home owned by Rabi' Al-Dik.
JERICHO	 Checkpoints:, Israeli forces continue to intensify its restrictions at Al-Hamra checkpoint set up along the road connecting Jericho and Nablus District. Flying Checkpoint: At 21:45, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at road (90) junction near Al-Nu'wmeh village located at the north entrance of Jericho until 01:30. Raid: At 05:05, Israeli forces raided Jericho and Ain Al-Sultan camp, stormed and searched a home after destroying the main gate entrance using explosives, detained a resident in the camp then withdrew at 05:30. Attack: At 13:40, Israeli forces positioned near the south entrance of Jericho fired, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and detained 3 residents including a child. Detention: (i) Israeli forces detained Majdi Owidat in Al-Ain camp in Jericho. (ii) Israeli forces detained three residents: Hamam Magharbi (15 years old), Raed Kafti and Ubrahim Barahma at the south entrance of Jericho.

• Closure:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close roads to An Nu'man village, with the exception of the road leading to the Wall gate in the south-eastern area of the village.
- (ii) Since 15 September 2007, the Israel army has prevented civilians from accessing or staying on 22 dunumes of confiscated land in Al Mazmuriya area in Beit Sahur and Bethlehem cities.

• Closure of Main Roads:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close the Beit Jala-Wadi Ahmed road; a road between Um Tuba and Al-Jass; a road between Um Tuba and Khilat Nu'man: a road between Um Tuba and the wall; a road between Al-Khas village and the wall; the 2 by pass roads located south of Al-Walaja; a road between Talita Qumi and Nazlat Al-Sider in Beit Jala; the eastern road of Al-Khader; the road between Al-Khader and Beit Jala; Wadi Rahal road near "Ifrat" settlement, the road between Al-Khader and road #60 which lead to the eastern neighbourhoods of Bethlehem; a road leading to Wadi Rahal, and a road east of Beit Fajjar town with dirt mounds.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the road leading to "Newe Daniyyel" settlement and agricultural land in Al-Khader; a road between Um Tuba and Wadi Al-Hums: Wadi Fukin, Al-Jaba, the Green Line; a road between Za'tara and a detour road, and a road between Taqou and Khirbet Al-Deir with cement blocks.
- (iii) Since August 2nd 2012, Israeli forces closed a road leading to Beit Jalla.
- (iv) Since May 8th 2013, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Carmisan area in Beit Jalla and Al-Walaja with a steel gate and barbed wires.
- (v) Since June 3rd 2013, the Israeli army closed the road connecting Nihalin and road 60 with dirt mounds.
- (vi) Since 13:20 on September 29th 2013, the Israeli army closed a road leading to 50 acres of agricultural land in Wadi Salem area in Al-Khadr with dirt mounds.
- (vii) Israeli forces closed the main road connecting Surif and Al-Jub'a village with dirt mounds
- (viii) On January 28th 2014, Israeli forces closed the steel gate at the entrance of Nihalin { replacing the dirt mounds placed at the entrance since the year 2002} and placed time schedule for opening the gate from 06:00 until 14:00 on a daily bases.
- (ix) Since 10:45 on September 8th 2015, Israeli forces closed the agricultural road located in Arab Al-Rashaydeh village located near "Malee Amous" settlement with dirt mounds.

• Raid:

- (i) On the evening of October 9th 2015, Israeli forces raided Husan village, detained 2 residents including a woman and a child.
- (ii) On the evening of October 9th 2015, Israeli forces raided Harmalah, detained a child after storming and searching a home.

• Attack:

- (i) At 13:55, Israeli forces positioned near the west entrance of Taqou' fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and as a result injured 3 residents and left several others suffocated from tear gas inhalation.
- (ii) At 13:55, Israeli forces positioned near Billal Bin Rabah mosque located in North Bethlehem fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and as a result injured four residents: Yusef Sadouq, Jaffar Radayda, Abdallah Da'rout and Sayf-Al-Din Ahmad as well as leaving several others suffocated from tear gas inhalation.

BETHLEHEM

- (iii) At 14:05, Israeli forces positioned at the west entrance of Beit Fajjar fired Rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and as a result injured 5 residents: Rabi' Taqatqa, Mohamamd Taqatqa, Ala Taqatqa, Abdallah Thawabteh and Abed Al-Wahish as well as leaving several others suffocated from tear gas inhalation and detained a resident.
- (iv) At 15:40, Israeli forces positioned in Um AL-Rakaba area located in Al-Khader fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.

Detention:

- (i) At 15:35, Israeli forces detained Ahmad Al-Amour (a resident iof Tagolu') as he was reporting to Israeli Intelligence for questioning based on a prior summon.
- (ii) Israeli forces detained Shadi Za'oul and the child: Ahmad Za'oul (17 years old) in Husan village.
- (iii) Israeli forces detained the child :Qusay Al-Zir (17 years old).
- (iv) Israeli forces detained Jawad Taqatqa near the west entrance of Beit Fajjar.

Closure:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close Khuzq Al-Far areas, as well as the old gold market in Hebron's Old City. In addition to closing the entrance to Al-Qeisi neighbourhood, the Israeli army continues to close the entrances to the area of Al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) with an electronic gate; Al-Laban Market also remains closed.
- (ii) Since 05 January 2009, the Israeli army has closed the area located along the Green Line south of the town of Yatta. Having seized land for Wall construction, the Israeli army evicted the Palestinian residents and denied them access to the area.

Closure of Main Roads:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Al-Karmil villages.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to prohibit Palestinian vehicles from travelling along the old Al-Shalala Street leading to Hebron's Old City.
- (iii) The Israeli army continues to close all roads leading to Road # 60 as well as detour roads along the settler bypass road leading to Yatta town.
- (iv) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds a detour road leading to e to Al-Simiya village, the southern entrance of Al-Samou' and the entrance of Beit Annun with cement blocks.
- (v) Since July 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Safa and Al-Dirat and also closed the entrance of south Yatta with cement blocks.
- (vi) At 11:00 on August 6th 2015, Israeli forces closed the entrance of Al-Hajara village located in south Dura with cement blocks.

Injury: At 11:00, 2 residents: Sa'di Rasras and Ahmad Al-Aza{Both residents of Al-Fuwar camp} were injured after being assaulted and stabbed by a group of Israeli settlers in Domona city inside Israel leaving them hospitalised in Israeli hospitals.

Attack:

- (i) At 12:40, Israeli forces positioned near "Kiryat Arba" settlement in the old city of Hebron opened fire towards and killed a resident for allegedly attempting to stab an Israeli soldier.
- (ii) At 13:15, Israeli forces positioned near the entrance of Beit Ummar, Al-Oroub camp, near Halhoul bridge, Bab Al-Zawiya area and Taroq bin Zied junction in the old city of Hebron and near Zif village camp fired live ammunition, rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and as a result injured 13 residents including: Omar Aqel {A medic} {who was seriously injured in the eye

- and as result lost is eyes site} as he was attempting to assist a wounded resident.
- (iii) At 17:15, Israeli forces positioned at the entrance of Bani Na'im and at Beit Awwa and Khursa village junctions fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.
- **<u>Killing:</u>** Israeli forces opened fire towards and killed Mohammad Al-Ja'bari ear "Kiryat Arba" settlement in the old city of Hebron for allegedly attempting to stab an Israeli soldier.

• Detention:

- (i) At 14:00, Israeli forces detained 2 residents including a child: Omaar Al-Bidawi (16 years old) and Ahmad Al-Bidawi {Both residents of Al-Oroub camp}.
- (ii) At 01:40, Israeli forces detained Jallal Rayan (A resident of Deir Sammit) for allegedly attempting to climb into "Nojohot" settlement.

• Settler Violence:

- (i) On the morning of October 9th 2015, Israeli settlers stormed Birin village located in north east Yatta and attacked Na'im Al-Azazma' a home and damaged solar panels for water heating.
- (ii) At 13:10, a group of Israeli settlers from "Kiryat Arba' stoned severalkk homes in Al-Ja'bari neighbourhood in the old city of Hebron.
- (iii) At 18:20, a group of Israeli settlers stormed Jabal Juhar and attacked a home-owned bu Manal Da'na.
- (iv) At 18:21, a group of Israeli settlers stormed Wadi Al-Nasri area located near "Kiryat Arba" settlement in the old city of Hebron and set fire to several storage rooms and set fire to a vehicle owned by Nihad Da'na.
- (v) At 22:55, a group of Israeli settlers stormed Al-Kasra area located near "Kiryat Arba" settlement in the old city of Hebron.

ALL DISTRICTS

- At 19:00 on August 26th 2014, Palestinian Gunmen and the Israeli military agreed to a cease fire agreement (brokered by the Arab Republic of Egypt) which includes the opening of border crossings to allow the entry of emergency supplies and humanitarian goods as well as construction material and agreed to increase the fishing limit to 6 nautical miles with possibility of increase to 12 nautical miles by the end of the year and to decrease the Military area to 100 meters, allow freedom of movement and a halt to targeted killings and assassinations and negotiations will be held for discussion on rebuilding the sea port and airports in the coming month.
- Israeli forces broke the ceasefire agreement by opening fire towards North Gaza, Gaza, Central Gaza, Khan Yunis and Rafah.
- Israeli Naval vessels broke the ceasefire agreement by opening fire towards Palestinian fishing boats off the shores of North Gaza and as a result killed 7 residents including a child and injured 144 others including 16 children, 5 critically injured and a Turkish Journalist.
- Palestinian gunmen broke the ceasefire agreement by opening fire and launching projectiles towards the Green Line as alleged by the Israeli military.

NORTHERN GAZA

- <u>Closure of Crossing Point:</u> Beit Hanun (Erez) is open for the passage of critical patients, journalists, NGO staff, businesspersons and passengers travelling abroad through Al-Karama crossing with previous coordination.
- Attack:

	 (i) At 07:30 on October 9th 2015, Israeli Naval vessels opened fire towards Palestinian fishing boats off the shores of Al-Sudaniya area in west Beit Lahiya and as a result damaged a fishing boat. (iv) At 16:00, Israeli forces positioned behind the Green Line fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents in east Al-Shuhada cemetery located in east Jabaliya as they were protesting the Israeli Military and settler assault on Al-Aqsa mosque compound and as a result injured 3 residents.

GAZA	 Closure of Crossing Points: (i) Al-Muntar (Karni) Crossing is closed. Beginning on 02 March 2011, the Crossing has been effectively closed following a unilateral Israeli decision. (ii) Al-Shija'iya (Nahal 'Oz) Crossing is closed. Beginning on 04 January 2010, the Crossing has closed following a unilateral Israeli decision. Attack: At 13:15, Israeli forces positioned behind the Green Line fired live ammunition stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents located in the vicinity of Al-Shija'iya (Nahal 'Oz) Crossing in east Gaza fired tear gas grenades towards several residents in North Beit Lahiya Jabaliya as they were protesting the Israeli Military and settler assault on Al-Aqsa mosque compound and as a result killed 4 residents and injured 114 residents including 11 children, a Turkish journalist and 5 critically injured.
