| <p style="text-align: center;">ALL DISTRICTS</p> | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The Israeli army continues to intensify its restrictions at checkpoints set up on the main roads connecting the West Bank districts, thereby isolating the northern districts from the southern districts as well as the Jericho district and the Jordan Valley from the remainder of the West Bank. • Beginning on the evening of 06 October 2006, the Israeli army has imposed a complete closure on the West Bank districts and prevented civilians from entering the city of Jerusalem or crossing the Green Line, only allowing access to workers holding permits, due to the Jewish Festival of Sukkot. The closure will last until the evening of 15 October 2006. |

| <p style="text-align: center;">JERUSALEM</p> | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure: The Israeli army continues to intensify its restrictions at checkpoints located at the entrances to the city of Jerusalem, in the old city of Jerusalem, and around Al Aqsa Mosque compound. • Closure of Main Roads: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrance opposite the junction to Dahiyat al Bareed in the city of Jerusalem with a barbed wire gate and to deny civilian access. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the road connecting Dahiyat al Bareed to the town of Ar Ram in order to complete Wall construction in the area. (iii) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the entrance to the village of Jaba', which connects the village to the cities of Jerusalem, Ramallah, and Jericho. • Checkpoint: The Israeli army continues to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a "border crossing point" and has designated a special crossing for holders of Jerusalem IDs and those possessing permits to access the city of Jerusalem. • Wall Gates: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the Wall gate in the town of Abu Dis with cement blocks. (ii) The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate on Ash Shayyah road in the area between the villages of As Sawahira ash Sharqiya and As Sawahira al Gharbiya, only allowing civilians holding Jerusalem IDs to cross, after subjecting them to thorough searches using electronic devices. • Wall Construction: Wall construction continues in Dahiyat al Bareed, Dahiyat al Aqbat, from the village of Hizma to 'Anata, along the Hizma-Jaba' road, the area of Al 'Eizariya to Ash Shayyah, near Al Quds University, in the town of As Sawahira ash Sharqiya, from the village of Beit Surik to Biddu, in the areas of Al Judeira, Bir Nabala, and Beit Hanina, west of the village of Al Jib, and in the vicinity of the village of Qatanna. • Flying Checkpoints: At 16:00, the Israeli army set up 2 flying checkpoints on the junctions to the settlement of Ma'ale Adumim and the area of Al |

The Israeli army also set up a checkpoint at the entrance to the village of Hizma and searched civilians and vehicles. (ii) The Israeli army raided the village of Al 'Isawiya and arrested 2 civilians. • <u>Arrests:</u> The Israeli army arrested 2 civilians in the village of Al 'Isawiya: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Firas Salah Mahmoud; (ii) Saleh Mohammed Saleh Dari. |
| RAMALLAH & EL BIREH | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt barricades the eastern entrance to the village of Sinjil. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the western entrance to the village of Saffa. • <u>Checkpoint:</u> The Israeli army continues to intensify its restrictions at the checkpoint set up on the overpass to the town of 'Atara and to impede access to the city of Ramallah for civilians holding IDs issued in the northern districts of the West Bank. • <u>Wall Construction:</u> Wall construction continues in the areas of Al Midya to Budrus, Al Midya to Ni'lin, Bil'in to Saffa, in the village of Beit Liqya, in the town of Beituniya, and west of the town of 'Abud and the village of Beit Sira. • <u>Flying Checkpoints/Detention:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 10:00, the Israeli army set up 5 flying checkpoints at the entrances to the villages of Saffa, Kharbatha al Misbah, Beit Liqya, Beit Sira, and Beit 'Ur at Tahta. For several hours, Israeli troops positioned at these flying checkpoints prevented civilians from leaving their villages towards the city of Ramallah. (ii) The Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint on 'Uyun al Haramiya junction on the Ramallah-Nablus road and detained a number of civilians. • <u>Raids/Injuries/Detentions:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 18:15, the Israeli army, including 27 jeeps and 2 bulldozers, raided the city of Ramallah. Confrontations took place between the Israeli army and civilians, during which the Israeli army injured 2 civilians, including 1 child. The Israeli army also arrested 1 civilian, detained 10 others, and withdrew at 21:30. (ii) At 03:15, the Israeli army, including 9 jeeps, raided and patrolled the city of El Bireh. • <u>Arrest:</u> The Israeli army arrested 'Issam al Baghdadi in the city of Ramallah. |

The Israeli army also continues to operate a surveillance camera in order to observe the area surrounding the checkpoint. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> Passage through the Wall gates is restricted to civilians granted special Israeli permits. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 19:00, the Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint near the village of Barta'a, searched civilian vehicles, and arrested 2 civilians, including 1 child, allegedly for locating explosives in their possession. • <u>Raids:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 20:00, the Israeli army raided and patrolled the town of As Silat al Harithiya. (ii) At 22:00, the Israeli army raided and patrolled the town of Al Yamun. (iii) At 01:00, the Israeli army, including 30 jeeps, raided the town of Qabatiya, searched a number of houses, and arrested 2 civilians (brothers). At 05:00, the Israeli army withdrew from the area. • <u>Arrests:</u> Israeli troops positioned at the flying checkpoint set up near the village of Barta'a arrested 2 civilians: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Salah ad Din Salah Kmeil, 17 years old; and (ii) Mohammed Nouri Abu ar Rub. <p>The Israeli army arrested 2 civilians in the town of Qabatiya:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (iii) Mohammed Naji Kmeil; and (iv) 'Awadh Naji Kmeil. |
| TULKAREM | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> The Israeli army continues to declare the district of Tulkarem a closed military zone and to impede civilian access to and from the district. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> The Israeli army continues to close with dirt barricades the Dahiyat Iktaba-Bal'a road, the entrance to the village of Saffarin, the road connecting the town of Deir al Ghusun to 'Attil plain, and the southern entrance to the village of Ramin. • <u>Checkpoints:</u> The Israeli army continues to intensify its restrictions at 'Einav checkpoint on the Tulkarem-Nablus road as well as at Jubara checkpoint (the southern entrance to the city of Tulkarem). At 'Einav checkpoint, the Israeli army has confined crossing times to the period between 07:00 and 17:00 every day. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> Passage through the Wall gates is restricted to civilians granted special Israeli permits. |

At 02:30, the Israeli army withdrew from the area. • Arrests: The Israeli army arrested 2 civilians in the town of 'Azzun: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Qussay Hussam Hannoun, 17 years old; and (ii) Mustafa Bilal 'Imran. |
| NABLUS | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure of Main Roads: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the Jenin-Nablus road between the junction to the village of Deir Sharaf and the settlement of Shavei Shomron. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt barricades Al Badhan road, which is the north-eastern entrance to the city of Nablus, as well as the southern entrance to the village of Qaryut. • Checkpoints: The Israeli army continues to regulate times for crossing checkpoints set up around the city of Nablus: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Huwwara and Beit Iba checkpoints (set up at the southern and western entrances to the city of Nablus respectively) are closed at 23:00. (ii) Al Badhan checkpoint (set up at the eastern entrance to the city of Nablus) remains closed with dirt barricades. (iii) Nablus-'Asira ash Shamaliya checkpoint (set up at the northern entrance to city) is open from 06:30 to 20:00. (iv) At Tur neighbourhood checkpoint (set up on Jirzim Mount) is closed on Fridays and Saturdays as well as during Jewish holidays. On all other days, it is open for civilian residents of the neighbourhood only. (v) Beit Furik checkpoint is open to civilian residents of the town of Beit Furik and the village of Beit Dajan until 17:30. • Raids/Attack/Injury: At 02:00, the Israeli army, accompanied by 1 bulldozer, raided the city of Nablus as well as the refugee camps of Balata, 'Askar, and 'Ein Beit el Ma' and searched 7 houses. In 'Ein Beit el Ma' refugee camp, the Israeli army opened fire, killing 1 civilian and injuring another. The Israeli army also arrested 5 civilians, including 2 brothers, and withdrew at 05:30. • Killing: The Israeli army killed Abdullah Mohammed Mansour in 'Ein Beit el Ma' refugee camp. • Arrests: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 10:30, Israeli troops positioned at the checkpoint set up in the area between the city of Nablus and the town of 'Asira ash Shamaliya arrested Fadi Ribhi Yaseen. (ii) At 15:30, Israeli troops positioned at Beit Iba checkpoint arrested Basem Ibrahim Fayyadh, a Palestinian National Security officer. <p>The Israeli army arrested 5 civilians in the city of Nablus and its refugee camps:</p> |

The Israeli troops released Abu Hweidi after liaison with the Israeli authorities (through the DCO). • <u>Settler Violence/Destruction of Property:</u> Israeli settlers set fire to civilian land cultivated with olive trees in the village of Al Lubban ash Sharqi. |
| SALFIT | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army has continued to close the main north-western entrance to the city of Salfit with dirt barricades since the beginning of the current <i>Intifada</i> (Uprising). (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt barricades the western entrances to the town of Bruqin and the village of Marda. The Israeli army also continues to close with cement blocks the western entrance to the town of Kafr ad Dik. • <u>Checkpoints:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to intensify its restrictions at Deir Ballut checkpoint and to deny civilian access to the town of Kafr ad Dik. (ii) The Israeli army continues to intensify its restrictions at the Za’tara junction checkpoint and to deny access to civilians under 35 years of age. • <u>Wall Construction:</u> Wall construction continues near the Green Line in the town of Deir Ballut and the villages of Az Zawiya and Rafat, northwest of the city of Salfit, and in the village of Marda and the town of Kifl Haris north of the settlement of Ari’el. • <u>Raid:</u> At 18:30, the Israeli army, including 2 jeeps, raided the village of Marda and patrolled the area until 19:30. |
| JERICHO | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> The Israeli army continues to close Road # 90 between the city of Jericho and the village of Al ‘Auja with cement blocks and to prevent farmers not holding Jericho Governorate IDs from reaching their land, forcing them to apply for access permits. The Israeli army also continues to deny access to the city to holders of Israeli IDs. • <u>Checkpoint:</u> The Israeli army continues to close Al Hamra checkpoint set up on the Jericho-Nablus road, denying civilian access, except for farmers holding Jericho IDs. • <u>Arrests:</u> At 08:00, Israeli troops positioned at Al Karama (Allenby) Bridge arrested 2 civilians: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Husam Waleed al ‘Asali; and (ii) Mohammed Subhi Barahmeh. |

(ii) At 01:05, the Israeli army raided the town of Al Khadr, arrested 2 civilians, and detained the ID cards of 3 others (a civilian and his 2 sons). (iii) At 01:10, the Israeli army raided the town of Beit Fajjar, searched 1 house, and served a summons to 1 civilian to report to the Israeli Intelligence. • <u>Arrests:</u> The Israeli army arrested 2 civilians in the town of Al Khadr: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Mohammed Khalil Ghneim; and (ii) Maher Nassri Shihadeh. |
| HEBRON | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the following locales in the old city of Hebron: Ash Shuhada’ Street and the area of As Sahleh with cement blocks and barbed wire; the old gold market with an iron gate; the area of Khuzq al Far near the settlement of Abraham Avino with a dirt barricade and an iron gate; and the entrance to the area of Al Khan with an electronic gate, isolating the area from Al Laban Market and the area of As Sahleh. (ii) Although it expired on 07 May 2006, the Israeli army continues to implement a military order stipulating the prohibition of civilian vehicles from travelling along the road connecting the settlement of Kiryat Arba’ to the Ibrahimi Mosque in the old city of Hebron unless they possess access permits. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt barricades the following locales: the area of Al Hawawir leading to the town of Halhul; the area of Al Fahs south of the city of Hebron; the junction to the area of Farsh al Hawa leading to Road # 35 northwest of the city of Hebron; and the entrance to the village of Beit ‘Einun. The Israeli army also continues to close with cement blocks the entrance to Al Qeisi neighbourhood in the old city of Hebron. (ii) In accordance with Military Order # 378, the Israeli army continues to prohibit Palestinian vehicles from travelling along Shalala Old Street |

At 21:30, Farhat was admitted to Hebron Public Hospital for medical treatment. • Palestinian Security Measure: At 15:00, Palestinian security forces seized and handed over to the Israeli authorities (through the DCO) 4 tear gas grenades, 1 hand grenade, 1 explosive device, 1 explosive belt, and an unfinished explosive device. |

Beginning on 28 June 2006, the Israeli army has also reinforced the concentration of its armed forces along the eastern border of the district of Rafah. |
| <p style="text-align: center;">NORTHERN GAZA</p> | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure of Crossing Point: Beit Hanun (Erez) Crossing is partially open only to foreign nationals, VIPs, and humanitarian cases. • Air Attack: At 02:00, Israeli F16 combat aircraft fired 1 missile towards and destroyed 1 house in Gaza city, after the Israeli army had notified residents to evacuate. • House Demolition: The house that was destroyed during the Israeli air attack on Gaza city belongs to a civilian from the family of Farhat. |

| | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Attack/Injuries:</u> At 14:50, the Israeli army opened fire from one of its locations on the Green Line towards a number of civilians northwest of the town of Beit Lahiya, injuring 2 civilians, including 1 child. • <u>Raids/Attacks/Injury:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Beginning at 16:15 on 09 October 2006, the Israeli army has remained positioned on Palestinian territory east of the town of Beit Hanun. The Israeli army also opened fire towards civilian houses, injuring 1 child. (ii) At 12:05, the Israeli army, including a number of armoured vehicles and 1 bulldozer, raided Palestinian territory near Point 63 on the Green Line east of the town of Jabalya. The air attack resulted in the injury of 1 armed Palestinian individual. (ii) At 02:00, Israeli F16 combat aircraft fired 1 missile towards and caused damage to 1 Palestinian National Security location east of Al Bureij refugee camp. |

| RAFAH | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Crossing Points:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Yasser 'Arafat International Airport remains closed. (ii) Rafah Crossing is partially open. Until 13:30, the Israeli army opened the Crossing only to arrivals as well as civilians travelling to Saudi Arabia to perform <i>Umrah</i> (a visit or "minor pilgrimage" to the Holy Shrines in the city of Mecca). (iii) Karm Abu Salim (Karem Shalom) Crossing is closed. • <u>Incursion:</u> Beginning at 18:20 on 07 August 2006, the Israeli army has remained positioned around Yasser 'Arafat International Airport east of the city of Rafah. • <u>Attack:</u> At 01:30 on 10 October 2006, the Israeli army opened fire from its position in the area surrounding Yasser 'Arafat International Airport towards Palestinian territory around the Airport east of the city of Rafah, killing 1 civilian. The Israeli army also arrested the killed civilian's brother. • <u>Killing:</u> The Israeli army killed Amin Jmei'an as Soufi in the area surrounding Yasser 'Arafat International Airport east of the city of Rafah. • <u>Arrest:</u> The Israeli army arrested a brother of Amin as Soufi, who was killed in the area surrounding Yasser 'Arafat International Airport. • <u>Palestinian Attack:</u> At 12:20, armed Palestinian individuals fired 1 anti-tank mortar towards the Green Line east of the city of Rafah. |
