• Closure:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close Al-Shuhada' Street, Al-Sahleh and Khuzq Al-Far areas, as well as the old gold market in Hebron's Old City. In addition to closing the entrance to Al-Qeisi neighbourhood, the Israeli army continues to close the entrances to the area of Al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) with an electronic gate; Al-Laban Market also remains closed.
- (ii) Since 05 January 2009, the Israeli army has closed the area located along the Green Line south of the town of Yatta. Having seized land for Wall construction, the Israeli army evicted the Palestinian residents and denied them access to the area.

• Closure of Main Roads:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Al-Thahiriya and Al-Samoa' towns, Al-Arroub refugee camp, and Al-Tuweini and Al-Karmel villages.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to prohibit Palestinian vehicles from travelling along the old Al-Shalala Street leading to Hebron's Old City.
- (iii) The Israeli army continues to close all roads leading to Road # 60 as well as detour roads along the settler bypass road leading to Yatta town.
- (iv) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds a detour road leading to the entrance to Al-Simiya village.
- (v) The Israeli army continues to close the bypass road leading to agricultural land near road #35 & 60 north of Hebron with dirt mounds, as well as roads leading to Karmah village, entrance to Al-Seimiah village and the road leading to Khalet Al-Buttom, east of Yatta town.

• Flying Checkpoints:

- (i) At 13:25, Israeli forces set up four checkpoints at the entrance to Khursa village junction, searching people and cars.
- (ii) At 18:30, Israeli forces set up four checkpoints at the entrance to Al-Nabi Younis village (the main road between Bethlehem and Hebron), searching people and cars.

• Raids:

- (i) At 09:40, Israeli forces raided Beit Awa
- (ii) At 02:30, Israeli forces raided Yatta town, searched 2 homes and detained 3 brothers
- (iii) At 04:00, Israeli forces raided Beit Ummar village and detained 2 residents.

• Detentions:

- (i) Ayed, Mahmoud and Adnan Daagneh were detained during the raid on Yatta.
- (ii) Ahmad Abu Maria and Yousef Abu Maryia were detained during the raid on Beit Ummar.
- <u>Detention:</u> At 07:30, Israeli forces barred students and teachers of Qurtuba School from passing through the checkpoint at Al-Shuhadaa Street in the Old City after they refused to go through metal detectors. The soldiers assaulted the teachers and several students, leaving 10 girls with bruises.
- <u>Settler Violence:</u> At 16:45, a group of Israeli armed settlers, protected by Israeli forces, raided an area near Wadi Khanease in Halhoul town, and spray painted anti-Arab slogans.
- <u>Demonstration</u>: At 12:35, a rally was organized in Hebron's city centre, in solidarity with Palestinian detainees who have been on an open-ended hunger strike for 14 days to protest Israeli measures, including solitary confinement. <u>Wall</u>

GAZA STRIP

ALL DISTRICTS	 At 02:00 on 18 January 2009, the unilateral ceasefire declared by Israel came into effect. At a later time on the same day, armed Palestinian groups announced an agreement to cease fire. The ceasefire has been further renewed on 10 August 2011 at 21:00. Israeli forces violated the ceasefire by firing artillery shells from their positions at the Green Line towards north Gaza and Khan Younis
NORTHERN GAZA	 Closure of Crossing Point: Beit Hanun (Erez) is partially opened for humintarian aid, access to internationals, journalists and NGO workers with permits.) Raids: On 10.10.2011, Israeli forces carried out an incursion east of Jabalia town and opened fire towards agricultural land while levelling the area. Israeli warplanes flew overhead during the incursion.
GAZA	 Closure of Crossing Points: Al-Muntar (Karni) Crossing is closed. Beginning on 02 March 2011, the Crossing has been effectively closed following a unilateral Israeli decision. Al-Shija'iya (Nahal 'Oz) Crossing is closed. Beginning on 04 January 2010, the Crossing has been closed following a unilateral Israeli decision.
KhanYunis	Raids: On the evening of 10.10.2011, Israeli forces carried out an incursion into Al-Qarara town and opened fire towards agricultural land while levelling the area. Israeli warplanes flew overhead during the incursion.
	 Closure of Crossing Points: (All Closed) Yasser 'Arafat International Airport remains closed. Rafah (Al 'Awdah) Crossing is closed Sufa Crossing is closed.
RAFAH	 Karm Abu Salem (Karem Shalom) Crossing is partially opened for access for humanitarian aid, cooking gas, 30 imported cars and construction materials for international projects. Al Awda crossing – Rafah is opened for humanitarian cases, students, and permit holders.

Update on Prisoners

On 8.10.2011, Palestinian prisoners continue their open-ended hunger strike, now on its 14th day, to protest against mistreatment and solitary confinement policy.
