JERUSALEM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli army continues to intensify their restrictions at the entrance to Jerusalem city, set up several flying checkpoints on the main road leading to the city and prevented worshipers under the age of 50 from conducting prayers at Al-Aqsa mosque compound. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the ‘demarcation area’ along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits. (iii) The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill between Biddu and Beit Ikksa villages. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the entrance to Jaba’ village. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to Beit Ikksa village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandiya checkpoint. • <u>Checkpoints:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli authorities continue to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a “border crossing point” and designate a special crossing lane for holders of Jerusalem IDs and another for those possessing permits to access Jerusalem city and at 06:00, Israeli forces closed the checkpoint impeding the free flow of traffic. (ii) On September 19th 2012, Israeli forces closed Ras Khamis checkpoint near Shu’fat camp and impeded the free flow of traffic in order to construct the wall. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 06:00, 11:25 on the 10th of October, 2013, Israeli forces raided the town of Abu Dis, confrontations took place. (ii) At 09:00, Israeli Forces raided the Town of Anata, stormed a farm, and physically assaulted its owner. (iii) At 09:00, Israeli raided the town of El Ezaria, and stormed 2 houses. (iv) At 11:30, Israeli Forces raided El Esawiyeh town. • <u>Detention:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) On October 10th, Israeli Forces detained Jihad Zitoun 16 and Ahmmad Rajabi 14 from Silwan. (ii) On the evening of October 10th, Israeli Forces detained Jameel Abasi from Silwan after getting out from his prayers in El- Aqsa mosque.

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Physical Assault:</u> On October 10th, Israeli Forces assaulted, and injured Walid Ferawi near the main gate leading to the Aqsa mosque, he was hospitalized later. • <u>Attack:</u> At 23:30, on the 9th of October, Israeli Forces fired sound, and tear gas grenades toward residents in the old city of Jerusalem. • <u>Obstruction of places of worship:</u> At 08:00 a group of Israeli settlers, accompanied with Israeli police raided the Aqsa mosque and provocatively walked in its yards. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the Wall gate in Abu Dis town. (ii) The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate on Al-Shayyah road in the area between Al-Sawahira Al-Sharqiya and Al-Slewahira Al-Gharbiya villages, only allowing civilians holding Jerusalem IDs to cross, after subjecting them to thorough searches using electronic devices. • <u>Wall Construction:</u> Wall construction continued in the areas north and south of Qalandiya village; south of Al-Za'ayem village; and in Wadi Al-Eizariya west of the illegal settlement Ma 'ale Adumim.
RAMALLAH & AL BIREH	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Sinjil village as well as the junction to Kafr Malik and 'Ein Samiya villages. (ii) Since September 3rd 2013, Israeli forces closed the north east entrance of Al-Mughier village with dirt mounds. • <u>Raid:</u> At 14:15, 20:25, Israeli forces raided the city of El Bireh and detained Muhamed Abu Muslem. • <u>Wall Construction:</u> Wall construction resumed in the area west of 'Abud town in the area surrounding the illegal settlement 'Ofarim and north of Al-Lubban Al-Gharbi and Rantis villages.

(ii) Since the evening of November 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the western entrance of Ya'bad. • <u>Flying Checkpoints:</u> At 22:20, Israeli Forces set up a flying check point on the entrance of Araba, searched civilians, and vehicles. • <u>Raids:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 13:35, Israeli Forces raided the village of Jalqamoun. (ii) At 01:45, 03:25, Israeli Forces raided the Town of Yabad • <u>Wall Gates:</u> Passage through the Wall gates is restricted to civilians granted special Israeli permits, which undercuts the access to education and health services for civilians living behind the Wall.
Tubas	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> October 11th, Israeli Forces set closure on the northern area of the Jordan valley, closed Tyasser checkpoint, and prevent residents from entering the area, setting up several checkpoint on the roads.
TULKAREM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the road connecting Kafr Al-Labad town to Shufa village. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the detour road leading to Ramin village along the Tulkarem-Nablus main road. • <u>Checkpoint:</u> At 09:00, Israeli forces continue to intensify their restrictions at "Eniv: checkpoint and impeded the free flow of traffic.

(ii) In addition to closing the gate installed since the outbreak the second Intifada, the Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the eastern entrance to Kafr Qaddum village. • <u>Flying Checkpoints:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 19:00, Israeli forces set up a flying checkpoint at the entrance of Azzoun. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 19:50, Israeli forces raided the village of Azzoun, patrolled the village until 22:20. (ii) At 21:30 Israeli Forces raided, and patrolled the city of Qalqiliya. • <u>Attack:</u> At 00:03, Israeli raided the city of Qalqileh, stormed several homes, and arrested 3 residents, handed the resident Walid Swalem a note to report to Israeli intelligence, confiscated the ID of the resident Ahmmad Abu Khader before withdrawing at 04:00 • <u>Detention:</u> Israeli forces detained the Journalist Mahmoud Shanti, Musab Zahran, and Assam Zaid in the city of Qalqileh. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to restrict access at 'Azzun 'Atma Wall gate closed the steel gate and to search civilians, including students, using a metal detector. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the entrance to the village of Wadi Al- Rasha and to deny civilian access. The Israeli army allows residents to access the village through Gate #109. Having removed the gate at the entrance to the village of Ras Atiya; the Israeli army only allows students to cross to their schools outside the village through the Habla gate. • <u>Wall Construction:</u> Wall construction continued in Kafr Laqif village north of Karnei Shomron settlement; in Immatin village northeast of Immanuel settlement; and east of Kafr Thulth town near Ma 'ale Shomron settlement.
NABLUS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the roads of Til-Burin and Beit Furik-Salem; the settler bypass road connecting the village of Deir al Hatab to the settlement of Alon Moreh; the road connecting the town of 'Aqraba to the village of Osrin; and the detour road between the town of Qabalan and the village of Osrin. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the northern entrance to Qabalan town; the southern entrances to the town of Jamma'in and the villages of Duma and Qaryut with dirt mounds. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 18:20, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the junction of the village Sorra, searched civilians, and vehicles. • At 02:15, Israeli Forces set up a checkpoint on the main road of Elbedan, searched citizens, and Vehicles until 04; 00. • <u>Raid:</u> • At 14:45, Israeli forces raided, and patrolled the village of Salem until 22; 35. • <u>Detention:</u> At 14; 15 Israeli forces detained Yourself Shtewi from the village of

	<p>Kufer Qadoum at Hwara checkpoint.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Settlers Violence:</u> At 16:30, ,A group of Israeli Settlers set fire on the agricultural lands of Der El Htab Leaving several olive trees destroyed before enabling citizens setting the fire off.
SALFIT	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the entrance to two detour roads connecting Marda village to its farmland. (ii) On 15.04.2012, the Israeli army has opened the northern entrance to Salfit city to civilian which was closed since the year 2000 and prevented access from 08:00 until 09:20. (iii) Since 11:00 on July 30th 2012, Israeli forces have closed two roads leading to Abu Nasar and Qatan Al-Jama' located in western area of Deir Istiya with cement blocks. • <u>Checkpoints:</u> Israeli forces continue to intensify their restrictions at Za'tara Al-checkpoint and impeded the free flow of traffic. • <u>Flying Checkpoints:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 14:50, Israeli forces set up a flying checkpoint under the bridge of Iskaka, searched civilians and vehicles. (ii) At 18:05, Israeli Forces set up checkpoint at the entrance of Der Balot, searched citizens, and vehicles. • <u>Raids:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i)At 09:20, Israeli Forces raided the town of Deatr Istia. (ii) At 10:10, Israeli Forces raided the village of Hars, temporary detained several of residents. <p>At 14:50, Israeli Forces raided the village of Yasuf, temporary detained number of residents.</p> • <u>Wall Construction:</u> Wall construction continued in the area north of Deir Istiya town southeast of the illegal settlement.
JERICHO	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> • October 11th, Israeli Forces set closure on the northern area of the Jordan valley, closed Tyasser checkpoint, and prevent residents from entering the area, setting up several checkpoint on the roads. • <u>Checkpoints:</u> Israeli forces continue to intensify its restrictions at Al-Hamra checkpoint set up along the road connecting Jericho and Nablus District. • <u>Flying Checkpoints:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> At 19:25, Israeli forces set up a flying checkpoint near the village of Ein Deuk, searched residents, and vehicles.until 02:10. • <u>Raids:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 08:15, Israeli Forces raided the village of El Ouja, take photos to a merchant shop, after patrolling the area. (ii) At 05:50, Israeli Forces raided the villages of Marj Na'ja, and Mar El Gaza, imposed curfew on them, setting several checkpoint, and arrested 3 residents (Nasser Bani Oda, and his brothers Nemer, and Yusuf)..
BETHLEHEM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close roads to An Nu'man village, with the exception of the road leading to the Wall gate in the south-eastern area of the village. (ii) Since 15 September 2007, the Israel army has prevented civilians from accessing or staying on 22 dunumes of confiscated land in Al Mazmuriya area in Beit Sahur and Bethlehem cities. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the Beit Jala-Wadi Ahmed road; a road between Um Tuba and Al-Jass ; a road between Um Tuba and Khilat Nu'man:

(ii) At 02:25, Israeli Forces raided the village of Beit Fajar, stormed a house, and handed the resident Jawad Thwapta a notes to report to Israeli intelligence. (iii) At 02:35, Israeli Forces raided the city of Bethlehem, handed the civilian Amar Khatib a note to report to Israeli intelligence. • <u>Detention:</u> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. At 12:00, Israeli Forces arrested Wa’el Abu Swi from his land at Nashash area. 2. Israeli Forces arrested Ahmmad Hussein in the town of El Khader. • <u>Settler Violence:</u> <p>At 07:40, a group of Israeli Settlers under the protection of the Israeli Forces raided Suleman pools area in the village of Artass, had religious prayer in the site, Israeli Forces arrested the Journalist Samer Hamd after preventing him from taking photos in the place..</p> • <u>Wall Construction:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Wall construction has continued in North West of Beit Jala town. (ii) On May 1st 2103, an Israeli court ordered the halt of wall construction near Betar village. (iii) On July 21st 2013, Israeli courts ordered the halt of construction of the wall in Al-Carmisan area in the west area of Beit Jalla.
<p>HEBRON</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close Al-Shuhada’ Street, Al-Sahleh and Khuzq Al-Far areas, as well as the old gold market in Hebron’s Old City. In addition to closing the entrance to Al-Qeisi neighbourhood, the Israeli army continues to close the entrances to the area of Al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) with an electronic gate; Al-Laban Market also remains closed. (ii) Since 05 January 2009, the Israeli army has closed the area located along the Green Line south of the town of Yatta. Having seized land for Wall construction, the Israeli army evicted the Palestinian residents and denied them access to the area. . • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Al-Thahiriya and Al-Samoa’

- towns, Al-‘Arrub refugee camp, and Al-Tuwani and Al-Karmil villages.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to prohibit Palestinian vehicles from travelling along the old Al-Shalala Street leading to Hebron’s Old City.
 - (iii) The Israeli army continues to close all roads leading to Road # 60 as well as detour roads along the settler bypass road leading to Yatta town.
 - (iv) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds a detour road leading to e to Al-Simiya village, the southern entrance of Al-Samou’ and the entrance of Beit Annun with cement blocks.
 - (v) Since July 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Safa and Al-Dirat and also closed the entrance of south Yatta with cement blocks.
 - (vi) Since December 27th 2012, Israeli forces closed the west entrance of Swiesiya village which connects Yatta and Al-Samou’ village with cement blocks.
 - (vii) Since 09:45 on September 23rd 2013, Israeli forces closed the main road leading to “Haji” settlement and impeded the free flow of traffic
- **Flying Checkpoint:**
 - (i) At 13:20, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of El Fahes area south the city of Hebron, temporary detained the police officer Abe Allah Tall.
 - (ii) At 16:40, Israeli Forces set up a flying checkpoint at the northern entrance of the city of Hebron, searched citizens, and vehicles.
 - (iii) At 17:00, Israeli Forces set up a flying checkpoint at the entrance of the village of Bani Noa’m, searched civilians, and vehicles.
 - (iv) At 17:15, Israeli Forces set up a flying checkpoint at the entrance of Fawar camp, searched civilian, and vehicles.
 - (v) At 18: 50, Israeli Forces set up a checkpoint in the area of wadi Resha near the town of Idna, searched civilians, ad vehicles.
 - (vi) At 07:00, Israeli Forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of El Aroub Camp.
 - (vii) At 07:10, Israeli Forces set up a checkpoint between the cities of Tarqumeh, and Idna, searched citizens, and vehicles.
 - **Raids:**
 - (i) At 08:40, Israeli Forces raided and patrolled the towns of Yatta, and Bani Nua’m.
 - (ii) At 08:50, Israeli Forces raided the city of Hebron, stormed several houses, and patrolled the area until 00:10.
 - (iii) At 09:20, Israeli Forces raided, and patrolled the village of Rehanian.
 - **Attack:** At 09:55, Israeli Forces shot rubber coated bullets at the entrance of El Hawouze area under the pretext of stone throwing.
 - **Wall Construction:** Wall construction continued in the area surrounding the illegal settlement Eshkolot, west of Al-Thahriya town.

At a later time on the same day, armed Palestinian groups announced an agreement to cease fire. • On November 14th 2011 Israeli forces placed floating marks 3 miles from Gaza's seashore and warned fishermen against passing beyond the mark and on November 24th 2012, Israeli forces imposed floating marks of 6 miles and on March 21st 2013 re imposed fishing restrictions of 6 miles. • Israeli Forces broke the cease fire by opening fire from naval bouts across the sea in the district of Northern Gaza.
<p style="text-align: center;">NORTHERN GAZA</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Crossing Point:</u> Beit Hanun (Erez) is open for the passage of critical Patients, journalists, NGO staff, businessmen and passengers travelling abroad through Al-Karama crossing with previous coordination. <p><u>Attack:</u> On the down of October 11th, 2013, Israeli Naval Forces opened fire at the Palestinian fishermen in front of Sodania area west of the town of Beith Lahia.</p>
<p style="text-align: center;">GAZA</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Crossing Points:</u> (i) Al-Muntar (Karni) Crossing is closed. Beginning on 02 March 2011, the Crossing has been effectively closed following a unilateral Israeli decision. (ii) Al-Shija'iya (Nahal 'Oz) Crossing is closed. Beginning on 04 January 2010, the Crossing has been closed following a unilateral Israeli decision.
<p style="text-align: center;">RAFAH</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Crossing Points :</u> • Yasser 'Arafat International Airport remains closed. • Rafah (<i>Al 'Awdah</i>) is open. (For students, medical cases, and those with permits). • Sufa Crossing is closed. • Karm Abu Salem (Karem Shalom) Crossing is open for the passage of critical patients, journalists, NGO staff, businessmen and passengers travelling abroad through Al-Karama crossing with previous coordination, diesel fuel , construction material for Internationally funded projects and allowed 40 truckloads of humanitarian goods, 20 Truckloads of construction material and 10 truckloads of construction steel.
