## SUMMARY OF EVENTS

<b>JERUSALEM</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b><u>Closure:</u></b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) On October 10<sup>th</sup> 2015, the Israeli army, continues to intensify their restrictions at the entrance to Jerusalem city, set up several flying checkpoints on the main road leading to the city and prevented worshipers from conducting prayers at Al-Aqsa mosque compound and installed metal Detectors at the entrances of Al-Wad neighbourhood road in order to force residents to enter through them.</li> <li>(ii) The Israeli army continues to close the 'demarcation area' along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits.</li> <li>(iii) The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill between Biddu and Beit Ikxa villages.</li> </ul> </li> <li>• <b><u>Closure of Main Roads:</u></b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the entrance to Jaba' village.</li> <li>(ii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to Beit Ikxa village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandiya checkpoint.</li> </ul> </li> <li>• <b><u>Checkpoints:</u></b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) Israeli authorities continue to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a "border crossing point" and designate a special crossing lane for holders of Jerusalem IDs and another for those possessing permits to access Jerusalem city.</li> <li>(ii) On September 19<sup>th</sup> 2012, Israeli forces closed Ras Khamis checkpoint near Shu'fat camp and impeded the free flow of traffic in order to construct the wall.</li> </ul> </li> <li>• <b><u>Raid:</u></b> At 13:15, Israeli forces raided Samir Ammis area and Kafr Aqab village, stormed and searched the home of the child: Ishaq Badran (15 years old) {who was killed by Israeli forces after he allegedly stabbed two Israeli settlers in Jerusalem} then withdrew at 15:25.</li> <li>• <b><u>Killing:</u></b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) At 10:30, the child Ishaq Badran (15 years old) {a resident of Kafr Aqab village in North Jerusalem} was killed after Israeli forces opened fire</li> </ul> </li> </ul>

	<p>towards him near Al-Masara neighbourhood in Jerusalem after he allegedly stabbed two Israeli settlers.</p> <p>(ii) At 15:15, Mohammad Sa'ed Ali {A resident of Shu'fat camp} was killed after Israeli forces opened fire towards him near Bab Al-Amoud area for allegedly stabbing three Israeli soldiers.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b><u>Assault on Medical Sector:</u></b> At 16:45, Israeli forces stormed Al-Makased and Al-Mutala' {Augusta –Victoria} hospitals in Jerusalem as they were searching for residents who were injured during confrontations and detained an injured resident.</li> <li>• <b><u>Detention:</u></b> Israeli forces detained Khalil Ahmad Khalil {A resident of Al-Isawiya} as they stormed Al-Makased and Al-Mutala' {Augusta –Victoria} hospitals in Jerusalem.</li> <li>• <b><u>Attack:</u></b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) At 10:15, Israeli forces positioned at Al-Madaris road in Ras Al-Amoud neighbourhood fired, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.</li> <li>(ii) At 11:00 and again at 21:35, Israeli forces positioned near the entrance of Anata fired live ammunition; rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and as a result injured Issa Massalmah.</li> <li>(iii) At 15:00 and again at 22:35, Israeli forces positioned in the vicinity of Shu'fat checkpoint fired live ammunition, rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and as a result injured 2 residents including a journalist: Muna Al-Qawasmi (A journalist) and Yazid Al-Joulani and also injured Mohammad Salaymeh after her car rammed into an electrical pole after Israeli forces sprayed pepper spray onto her face.</li> <li>(iv) At 15:15, Israeli forces positioned in Bab Al-Amoud area fired, rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and as a result injured a resident.</li> <li>(v) At 16:45, Israeli forces positioned in Al-Salam and Ras Khamis neighbourhoods fired, rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.</li> <li>(vi) At 17:15, Israeli forces positioned near the North entrance of Al-Ram fired; rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.</li> <li>(vii) At 18:30, Israeli forces positioned near Qalandiya checkpoint fired, rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.</li> <li>(viii) At 19:40, Israeli forces positioned near the wall gate in Qutna village fired, rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.</li> <li>(ix) At 20:50, Israeli forces positioned in Al-Tur neighbourhood fired, rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.</li> <li>(x) At 21:55, Israeli forces positioned in Silwan neighbourhood fired live ammunition; rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.</li> </ul> </li> <li>• <b><u>Wall Gates:</u></b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the Wall gate in Abu Dis town.</li> <li>(ii) The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate on Al-Shayyah road in the area between Al-Sawahira Al-Sharqiya and Al-Slewahira Al-Gharbiya villages, only allowing civilians holding Jerusalem IDs to cross, after subjecting them to thorough searches using electronic devices.</li> </ul> </li> </ul>

<p><b>AL BIREH</b></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Sinjil village well as the junction to Kafr Malik and ‘Ein Samiya villages.</li> <li>(ii) On October 3<sup>rd</sup> 2015, Israeli forces closed the main road located near “Bet El” settlement and leading to Al-Jalazoun camp with cement blocks.</li> <li>(iii) Since 12:45 on October 5<sup>th</sup> 2015, Israeli forces closed the entrance of Deir Nathim village with cement blocks.</li> <li>• <b><u>Checkpoints:</u></b> Since 23:35 on October 4<sup>th</sup> 2015, Israeli forces closed Al-Mahakma checkpoint located near “Bet El” settlement in North Al-Bireh city.</li> <li>• <b><u>Raid:</u></b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) At 20:55, Israeli forces raided Ni’lin village until 21:40.</li> <li>(ii) At 22:30, Israeli forces raided Budrous village fired flash grenades into the sky as they searched the area near the wall gate.</li> <li>(iii) At 02:10, Israeli forces raided Al-Bireh city, stormed a building then withdrew at 06:00.</li> <li>(iv) At 04:20, Israeli forces raided Qubar village and summoned Yusef Al-Barghouthi to report to Israeli Intelligence for questioning then withdrew at 05:00.</li> <li>(v) At 02:20, Israeli forces raided Attarah until 05:00.</li> </ul> </li> <li>• <b><u>Attack:</u></b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) At 13:15, Israeli forces positioned at Al-Makhakma checkpoint located near “Beit El” settlement in North Al-Bireh city fired live ammunition, rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning as they were protesting against the continued Israeli military and settler assault on Al-Aqsa mosque compound in the old city of Jerusalem and as a result injured 17 residents including 3 children: Yazid Haytham Kandil (15 years old), Laith Bader Yacoub (16 years old), Khalil Mohammed Shahin (17 years old), Ahmed Musleh Ismail, Murad Naseem Bawatneh, Musab Abdul Jalil Zaki Tartir, Osama Adam Rifai, Amin Saeed Dawood, Mahmoud Madi Dar Al Badr, Ali Tayseer Sarsour, Ali Abdul Rahim Abdul Rahman, Bilal Mohammed Badawi, Ibrahim Nizar Abdel-Mohsen, Khaled Jamil Tarifi, Ibrahim Jad, Mohammad Sami Abdel-Hafiz, and Saber Mustafa Ismail, and left several others – suffocated from tear gas inhalation, and detained a university student – Daniya Musa Ghalith ( residents of Jalazoun refugee camp), and released her at a later time.</li> <li>(ii) At 17:15, Israeli forces positioned near Pesagout settlement located in east Al-Bireh city fired, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.</li> <li>(iii) At 20:00, Israeli forces positioned at the entrance of Shuqba village fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.</li> <li>(iv) At 22:20, Israeli forces positioned at the entrance of Al-Nabi Saleh village fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.</li> <li>(v) At 23:15, Israeli forces positioned near the entrance of Al-Mughier village fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.</li> </ul> </li> <li>• <b><u>Settler Violence:</u></b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) At 12:55, a group of Israeli settlers positioned near Dier Ammar and Ras Karkar villages stoned residents and vehicles.</li> <li>(ii) At 13:55, a group of Israeli settlers assaulted several farmers on agricultural land in Beit Illou village.</li> </ul> </li> </ul>

	<p>(ii) Since the evening of November 25<sup>th</sup> 2012, Israeli forces closed the western entrance of Ya'bad.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b>Raid:</b> At 02:00 on October 10<sup>th</sup> 2015, Israeli forces raided Barta'a Al-Sharqiya village, clashed with several residents and as a result, injured Zakariya Qubha leaving him hospitalised and detained four residents.</li> <li>• <b>Detention:</b> Israeli forces detained four residents: Nabil Qubha, Mohammad Qubha, Shadi Qubha and Saed Aqhash in Barta'a village.</li> <li>• <b>Wall Gates:</b> Israeli forces continue to close the wall gate and only allow those holding special permits to enter through it.</li> </ul>
<p><b>TUBAS</b></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b>Assault on Property:</b> At 10:20, Israeli forces stormed Khirbeit Al-Ras village located in the North Jordan valley and served a military order for the removal of 10 families from their homes on October 12<sup>th</sup> &amp; 13<sup>th</sup> 2015 for alleged military training.</li> </ul>
<p><b>TULKAREM</b></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b>Checkpoint:</b> At 20:40, Israeli forces continue to intensify their restrictions at "Eniv" checkpoint located along the main road connecting Tulkarem and Nablus and impeded the free flow of traffic until 21:45.</li> <li>• <b>Raid:</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) At 10:55, Israeli forces raided Zieta and detained a resident.</li> <li>(ii) At 20:30, Israeli forces raided Shufa village until 23:00.</li> </ul> </li> <li>• <b>Attack:</b> At 15:30, Israeli forces positioned near Ghishouri industrial plants located in west Tulkarem fired live ammunition, rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and as a result injured Ahmad Abdel-Hafith (A resident of Kafr Aboush village) and left several others suffocated from tear gas inhalation.</li> <li>• <b>Detention:</b> Israeli forces detained Abdel-Khaleq Awwadallah in Zieta.</li> <li>• <b>Wall Gate:</b> At 17:25, Israeli forces closed the wall gates in Deir Al-Ghusoun and Far'oun villages and prevented several residents, labourers and farmers from returning to their homes until reopening the gates at 18:10.</li> </ul>
<p><b>QALQILIYA</b></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b>Closure of Roads:</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) Israeli forces continue to close with cement blocks agricultural roads east of Azzun town.</li> <li>(ii) In addition to closing the gate installed since the outbreak the second Intifada, the Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the eastern entrance to Kafr Qaddum village.</li> <li>(iii) Since 10:40 on September 1<sup>st</sup> 2015, Israeli forces closed an agricultural road leading to Far'ata village, which is located near "Gillad" settlement with a steel Gate.</li> </ul> </li> <li>• <b>Flying Checkpoint:</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) At 09:30, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Azzun.</li> <li>(ii) At 15:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Al-Nabi Eliyas village.</li> <li>(iii) At 18:30, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Jit village junction, temporarily detained Ahmad Suwan (A Presidential Guard) then released him after detonating his back pack for allegedly containing a suspicious object.</li> </ul> </li> <li>• <b>Attack:</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) At 18:00, Israeli forces positioned at Al-Jaljoulia gate located in south west Qalqiliya fired live ammunition, rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and as a result injured the child: Abdel-Rahim Shuwahna (16 years old) after he was struck by a tear gas grenade in the back leaving him hospitalised and also left several others suffocated from tear gas inhalation.</li> <li>(ii) At 18:40, Israeli forces positioned at the entrance of Azzun fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and as a result left several residents suffocated from tear gas inhalation.</li> </ul> </li> </ul>

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b><u>Demonstration:</u></b> At 17:35, a demonstration took place in Kafr Qaddum against the closure of the east entrance during which Israeli forces tried to disrupt the demonstration by firing rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards demonstrators who attempted to reach they demonstration site.</li> <li>• <b><u>Wall Gates:</u></b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) The Israeli army continues to restrict access at ‘Azzun ‘Atma Wall gate and impeded the free flow of traffic. The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the entrance to the village of Wadi Al- Rasha and to deny civilian access.</li> <li>(ii) The Israeli army allows residents to access the village through Gate #109. Having removed the gate at the entrance to the village of Ras Atiya; the Israeli army only allows students to cross to their schools outside the village through the Habla gate.</li> </ul> </li> </ul>
<p><b>NABLUS</b></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b><u>Closure:</u></b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) Since December 17<sup>th</sup> 2013, Israeli forces ordered the closure 500 dunumes of land in Qusra village as a closed military area.</li> <li>(ii) Since the evening of October 1<sup>st</sup> 2015, Israeli forces closed the entrances surrounding Nablus and declared it a closed military zone as well as setting up several checkpoint at the entrances of surrounding villages for the alleged shooting of an Israeli settler vehicle located in the area between “Yitmar” and “Alon Moriya” settlement, which killed two Israeli settlers.</li> </ul> </li> <li>• <b><u>Closure of Main Roads:</u></b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) The Israeli army continues to close the roads of Til-Burin and Beit Furik-Salem; the settler bypass road connecting the village of Deir al Hatab to the settlement of Alon Moreh; the road connecting the town of ‘Aqraba to the village of Osrin; and the detour road between the town of Qabalan and the village of Osrin.</li> <li>(ii) The Israeli army continues to close the northern entrance to Qabalan town; the southern entrances to the town of Jamma’in and the villages of Duma and Qaryut.</li> <li>(iii) At 22:00, Israeli forces closed the North entrance of Awarta with dirt mounds.</li> </ul> </li> <li>• <b><u>Checkpoint:</u></b> At 21:40, Israeli forces intensified their restrictions at Huwara checkpoint and impeded the free flow of traffic until 21:45.</li> <li>• <b><u>Flying Checkpoint:</u></b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) At 12:10, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint near Yitsahar settlement junction located in North Huwara until 13:00.</li> <li>(ii) At 15:50, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at “Shave Shomron” settlement junction until 16:30.</li> </ul> </li> <li>• <b><u>Raid:</u></b> At 16:10, Israeli forces raided Al-Labban Al-Sharqiya village and confiscated several water meters in the village from the local village council.</li> <li>• <b><u>Settler Violence:</u></b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) At 22:20, a group of Israeli settlers stormed the area between Qusra and Jalloud villages then were chased away by local residents.</li> <li>(ii) At 23:20, a group of Israeli settlers attempted to storm Orif village then were chased away by local residents.</li> </ul> </li> </ul>
<p><b>SALFIT</b></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b><u>Closure of Main Roads:</u></b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the entrance to two detour roads connecting Marda village to its farmland.</li> <li>(ii) On 15.04.2012, the Israeli army has opened the northern entrance to Salfit city to civilian which was closed since the year 2000 and prevented access from 08:00 until 09:20.</li> <li>(iii) Since 11:00 on July 30<sup>th</sup> 2012, Israeli forces have closed two roads leading to Abu Nasar and Qatan Al-Jama’ located in western area of Deir Istiya with cement blocks.</li> </ul> </li> </ul>

<p style="text-align: center;"><b>JERICHO</b></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b>Checkpoints:</b> At 21:10, Israeli forces intensified its restrictions at Al-Hamra checkpoint set up along the road connecting Jericho and Nablus District.</li> <li>• <b>Raid:</b> At 21:10, Israeli forces raided Marj Al-Na'ja and Marj Al-Ghazal villages and warned local residents from using road (90) in order to avoid clashes with Israeli settlers.</li> <li>• <b>Attack:</b> At 16:40, Israeli forces positioned at the south entrance of Jericho fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.</li> </ul>
