JERUSALEM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to intensify their restrictions at the entrance to Jerusalem city, set up several flying checkpoints on the main road leading to the city and prevented worshipers under the age of 50 from conducting prayers at Al-Aqsa mosque compound. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the ‘demarcation area’ along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits. (iii) The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill between Biddu and Beit Iksa villages. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the entrance to Jaba’ village. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to Beit Iksa village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandiya checkpoint. • <u>Checkpoints:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli authorities continue to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a “border crossing point” and designate a special crossing lane for holders of Jerusalem IDs and another for those possessing permits to access Jerusalem city and closed the checkpoint at 01:20 and impeded the free flow of traffic until 04:05. (ii) On September 19th 2012, Israeli forces closed Ras Khamis checkpoint near Shu’fat camp and impeded the free flow of traffic in order to construct the wall. (iii) At 17:00, Israeli forces intensified their restrictions at Jaba’ checkpoint located along the main road connecting Ramallah, Jericho and Jerusalem. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 15:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Jaba’ village junction. • <u>Raid:</u> At 04:15, Israeli forces raided Biddu and clashed with its residents. • <u>Detention:</u> At dawn on October 12th 2014, Israeli forces detained two residents: Munir Al-Basati and Wissam Sadr after storming their homes in the old city of Jerusalem. • <u>Attack:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 14:50, Israeli forces positioned near Al-Ram junction fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning then

(ii) In addition to closing the gate installed since the outbreak the second Intifada, the Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the eastern entrance to Kafr Qaddum village. (iii) At 12:10 on September 2nd 2014, Israeli forces closed the main road connecting Qalqiliya and Nablus near Al-Nabi Eliyas village with cement blocks. • <u>Flying Checkpoints:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 10:40, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Haballah tunnel (located on the south entrance of Qalqiliya) until 11:00. (ii) At 04:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the east entrance of Qalqiliya until 06:00. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to restrict access at ‘Azzun ‘Atma Wall gate and impeded the free flow of traffic. The Israeli army to close with an iron gate the entrance to the village of Wadi Al- Rasha and to deny civilian access. At 14:30, the Israeli army closed the Iron Gate thus impeding the free flow of traffic until reopening it at 14:49. (ii) The Israeli army allows residents to access the village through Gate #109. Having removed the gate at the entrance to the village of Ras Atiya, the Israeli army only allows students to cross to their schools outside the village through the Habla gate.

(ii) The Israeli army continues to close the northern entrance to Qabalan town; the southern entrances to the town of Jamma’in and the villages of Duma and Qaryut. • <u>Checkpoint:</u> At 18:25, Israeli forces intensified their restrictions at Huwara checkpoint and impeded the free flow of traffic until 18:40. • <u>Flying Checkpoints:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 14:10, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint along the main road located north of Huwarah and detained a resident after confiscating his vehicle for allegedly finding a hunting rifle inside the vehicle. (ii) At 23:20, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint near Kafr Kalil village until 02:45.

(ii) At 01:45, Israeli forces raided Tel village, stormed a home then withdrew at 03:40. • <u>Detention:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli forces detained an unidentified resident at a checkpoint along the main road located north of Huwarah. (ii) Israeli forces detained Saleem Abu Saud in Nablus city.

(ii) On 15.04.2012, the Israeli army has opened the northern entrance to Salfit city to civilian, which was closed since the year 2000 and prevented access from 08:00 until 09:20. (iii) Since 11:00 on July 30th 2012, Israeli forces have closed two roads leading to Abu Nasar and Qatan Al-Jama' located in western area of Deir Istiya with cement blocks. • <u>Checkpoints:</u> At 10:50, Israeli forces intensified their restrictions at Za'tara checkpoint and impeded the free flow of traffic until 11:40. • <u>Temporary Detention:</u> At 14:35, Israeli forces positioned at Za'tara checkpoint temporarily detained Jihad Hashash (A National Security Force officer) then released him at 15:00. • <u>Settler Violence:</u> At 10:50, Israeli settlers stormed agricultural land in Yasuf village, attacked several residents as they were harvesting Olives and assaulted Alaa Hamoud leaving her severely injured and then they set fire to a vehicle owned by Mohammad Hamoud.

(ii) At 09:45, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint along road (90) near Al-Nuwe'meh village located at the North entrance of Jericho until 10:05. (iii) At 18:55, Israeli forces set up a flying checkpoint at the junction of El Nabi Musa area. (iv) At 00:50, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint near Al-Nabi Musa area junction located along the main road connecting Jericho and Jerusalem until 02:50. • <u>Detention:</u> On October 1st 2014, Israeli forces positioned at Allenby Bridge detained Mohammad Shuruji (A resident of Tulkarem) as he was returning from Jordan.

(ii) Since 15 September 2007, the Israel army has prevented civilians from accessing or staying on 22 dunumes of confiscated land in Al Mazmuriya area in Beit Sahur and Bethlehem cities. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the Beit Jala-Wadi Ahmed road; a road between Um Tuba and Al-Jass ; a road between Um Tuba and Khilat Nu'man: a road between Um Tuba and the wall; a road between Al-Khas village and

In addition to closing the entrance to Al-Qeisi neighbourhood, the Israeli army continues to close the entrances to the area of Al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) with an electronic gate; Al-Laban Market also remains closed. (ii) Since 05 January 2009, the Israeli army has closed the area located along the Green Line south of the town of Yatta. Having seized land for Wall construction, the Israeli army evicted the Palestinian residents and denied them access to the area. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Al-Thahiriya and Al-Samoa’ towns, Al-‘Arrub refugee camp, and Al-Tuwani and Al-Karmil villages. (ii) The Israeli army continues to prohibit Palestinian vehicles from travelling along the old Al-Shalala Street leading to Hebron’s Old City. (iii) The Israeli army continues to close all roads leading to Road # 60 as well as detour roads along the settler bypass road leading to Yatta town. (iv) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds a detour road leading to e to Al-Simiya village, the southern entrance of Al-Samou’ and the entrance of Beit

<p>ALL DISTRICTS</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • At 19:00 on August 26th 2014, Palestinian Gunmen and the Israeli military agreed to a cease fire agreement (brokered by the Arab Republic of Egypt) which includes the opening of border crossings to allow the entry of emergency supplies and humanitarian goods as well as construction material and agreed to increase the fishing limit to 6 nautical miles with possibility of increase to 12 nautical miles by the end of the year and to decrease the Military area to 100 meters, allow freedom of movement and a halt to targeted killings and assassinations and negotiations will be held for discussion on rebuilding the sea port and airports in the coming month.
