JERUSALEM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) On October 11th 2015, the Israeli army, continues to intensify their restrictions at the entrance to Jerusalem city, set up several flying checkpoints on the main road leading to the city and prevented worshipers from conducting prayers at Al-Aqsa mosque compound and prevented residents under the age of 50 from entering the mosque. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the ‘demarcation area’ along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits. (iii) The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill between Biddu and Beit Ikksa villages. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the entrance to Jaba’ village. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to Beit Ikksa village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandiya checkpoint. • <u>Checkpoints:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli authorities continue to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a “border crossing point” and designate a special crossing lane for holders of Jerusalem IDs and another for those possessing permits to access Jerusalem city. (ii) On September 19th 2012, Israeli forces closed Ras Khamis checkpoint near Shu’fat camp and impeded the free flow of traffic in order to construct the wall. (iii) On the morning of October 11th 2015, Israeli forces closed Al-Za’im checkpoint and impeded the free flow of traffic (alleging that a woman driving a vehicle was committing a bombing attack when her vehicle set fire) until reopening it later. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 15:30, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Al-Khan Al-Hamra area junction. • <u>Raid:</u> At 19:00, Israeli forces raided Anata and clashed with several residents. • <u>Attack:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 12:15, Israeli forces positioned near Al-Quds University Campus in Abu Dis fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and as a result injured Adnan Salah and left several others suffocated from tear gas inhalation. (ii) At 16:00 and again at 20:30, Israeli forces positioned in Al-Salam neighbourhood fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and as a result injured a residents then detained him.

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> (iii) At 21:30, Israeli forces positioned near Shu'fat camp and fired flash grenades into the sky after alleged assailants opened fire towards "Pisgat Za'iv" settlement. (iv) At 22:15, Israeli forces positioned in Al-Tur neighbourhood fired live ammunition, rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning. (v) At 23:00, Israeli forces positioned in Ras Al-Amoud neighbourhood fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning. (vi) At 23:00, Israeli forces positioned in Al-Sa'aydeh neighbourhood in the old city of Jerusalem fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning. (vii) At 23:00, Israeli forces positioned in Silwan neighbourhood fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning. (viii) At 23:00, Israeli forces positioned at Shu'fat checkpoint fired live ammunition, rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning. (ix) At 23:40, Israeli forces positioned near Hizma village fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning. • <u>Detention:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 18:40, Israeli forces detained 2 residents: Bader Al-Daghamim (15 years old) and Mohammad Ishtayeh in Jerusalem for allegedly carrying knives. (ii) At 23:30, Israeli forces positioned in Ras Al-Amoud neighbourhood detained the child Baker Oweis (17 years old). (iii) At 24:00, Israeli forces positioned in Um Tauba village detained Jihad Al-Bidiq. (iv) At 24:00, Israeli forces detained Yusra Aowayda after storming her home in Beit Hanina. (v) At 03:30, Israeli forces detained 3 residents: A'ed Al-Abbassi, Na'im Hidaya and Ahmad Abu Thiyab in Silwan neighbourhood. • <u>Assault on Places of Worship:</u> At 10:30, a group of Israeli settlers under the protection of Israeli forces stormed Al-Aqsa mosque compound in the old city of Jerusalem and provoked worshippers. • <u>Settler Violence:</u> At 03:20, a group of Israeli settlers positioned near Anata assaulted Qassim Al-Jahalin (a resident of Al-Eizariya) and as a result, left him hospitalised with contusions. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the Wall gate in Abu Dis town. (ii) The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate on Al-Shayyah road in the area between Al-Sawahira Al-Sharqiya and Al-Slewahira Al-Gharbiya villages, only allowing civilians holding Jerusalem IDs to cross, after subjecting them to thorough searches using electronic devices.
<p>RAMALLAH & AL BIREH</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Sinjil village well as the junction to Kafr Malik and 'Ein Samiya villages. (ii) On October 3rd 2015, Israeli forces closed the main road located near "Bet El" settlement and leading to Al-Jalazoun camp with cement blocks. (iii) At 19:10, Israeli forces closed the east and west entrances to Deir Nathim villages with cement blocks. • <u>Checkpoints:</u> Since 23:35 on October 4th 2015, Israeli forces closed Al-Mahakma checkpoint located near "Bet El" settlement in North Al-Bireh city. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 00:30, Israeli forces raided Betin village, clashed with several residents then withdrew at 01:00.

	<p>(ii) At 05:00, Israeli forces raided Silwad, stormed and searched several homes and detained 11 residents.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Attack:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 13:15 and again at 19:30, Israeli forces positioned at Al-Makhakma checkpoint located near “Beit El” settlement in North Al-Bireh city fired live ammunition, rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning as they were protesting against the continued Israeli military and settler assault on Al-Aqsa mosque compound in the old city of Jerusalem and as a result killed a child and injured 7 residents: Yazan Abu Thana, Mohammad Obied, Sanad Karaja, Jihad Jabarin, Layth Yacoub, Mahdi Hamdan and Yusef Husam as well as leaving several others suffocated from tear gas inhalation. (ii) At 16:45, Israeli forces positioned near the entrance of Deir Nathim fired, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning. (iii) At 21:45, Israeli forces positioned at the entrance of Shuqba village stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning. • <u>Killing:</u> Israeli forces positioned at Al-Makhakma checkpoint located near “Beit El” settlement in North Al-Bireh city killed the child Ahmad Sharaqa (15 years old) {A resident of Al-Jalazoun camp}. • <u>Detention:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli forces detained 11 residents: Mohammad Hamad, Oda Hamad, Musa Hamad, Layth Hamad, Ahmad Hamad, Samer Hamad, Adam Hamad, Malik Hamad, Abdallah Hamad, Musa Hamad, Alladin Hamad and Omar Izzat in Silwad. (ii) Israeli forces positioned at Al-Makhakma checkpoint located near “Beit El” settlement in North Al-Bireh city detained Yusef Husam {A resident of Shuqba village} after he was injured. • <u>Settler Violence:</u> At 13:30, a group of Israeli settlers positioned near the entrance of Sinjil opened fire towards several residents for allegedly stoning their vehicle.
<p style="text-align: center;">JENIN</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Road:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the road leading to the town of ‘Arraba east of the illegal settlement Dotan. (ii) Since the evening of November 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the western entrance of Ya’bad. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At dawn on October 11th 2015, Israeli forces raided Barta’a Al-Sharqiya, stormed a gas station and confiscated surveillance camera footage. (ii) At 21:00, Israeli forces raided Silat Al-Thaher. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> Israeli forces continue too close the wall gate and only allow those holding special permits to enter through it.
<p style="text-align: center;">TULKAREM</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Checkpoint:</u> Israeli forces continue to intensify their restrictions at “Eniv” checkpoint located along the main road connecting Tulkarem and Nablus and impeded the free flow of traffic. • <u>Raid:</u> At 02:00, Israeli forces raided Attil, stormed and searched several homes and detained 13 residents including 2 children and a Civil Defence force officer). • <u>Detention:</u> Israeli forces detained 13 residents: Wissam Murad Abu Sinan, 17 years old, Essam Mowaffaq Mohammed Hajja (17 years), Ibrahim Jalal Makhoul, Raed Majid Hajja, Bahaa Rasim Qafaf, Thaer Mohammad Samih Qutaish, Mahmoud Mohammed Naji Attili, Laith Mohammed Mahmoud Qutaish, Khaled Hussein Khalil, Nayef Bassam Abu-Thaher , Ahmed Attia Ahmed Azzam, Ahmad Jamal Abu Khalil, Hammam Attili in Attil. • <u>Attack:</u> At 10:00 and again at 22:45, Israeli forces positioned near Ghishouri industrial plants located in west Tulkarem fired live ammunition, rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and

(ii) At 19:40, Israeli forces closed the wall gate near Al-Shwikiya neighbourhood in Tulkarem and prevented several residents, labourers and farmers from returning to their homes until reopening the gates at 20:00.
<p>QALQILIYA</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli forces continue to close with cement blocks agricultural roads east of Azzun town. (ii) In addition to closing the gate installed since the outbreak the second Intifada, the Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the eastern entrance to Kafr Qaddum village. (iii) Since 10:40 on September 1st 2015, Israeli forces closed an agricultural road leading to Far'ata village which is located near "Gillad" settlement with a steel Gate. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 16:55, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Azzun and detained a resident after forcing him to remove his cloths. • <u>Detention:</u> Israeli forces detained Ameen Majd in Azzun. • <u>Temporary Detention:</u> At 18:35, Israeli forces positioned at the entrance of Azzun temporarily detained Na'im Judeh then released him at 19:10. • <u>Attack:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 16:00, Israeli forces positioned in the area between Al-Fonduq and Immatin villages fired live ammunition, towards several residents for alleged stoning and as a result injured Salah Basalat leaving him hospitalised with contusions (ii) At 18:15, Israeli forces positioned at Al-Jaljoulia gate located in south west Qalqiliya fired live ammunition, rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and as a result injured the child: Aqrama Zamari (17 years old) also left a resident suffocated from tear gas inhalation. (iii) At 20:30, Israeli forces positioned at the entrance of Azzun fired, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning. • <u>Settler Violence:</u> At 21:40, a group of Israeli settlers positioned at the entrance of Kafr Laqif village stoned residents and vehicles passing along the main road connecting Qalqiliya and Nablus. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to restrict access at 'Azzun 'Atma Wall gate and impeded the free flow of traffic. The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the entrance to the village of Wadi Al- Rasha and to deny civilian access. (ii) The Israeli army allows residents to access the village through Gate #109. Having removed the gate at the entrance to the village of Ras Atiya; the Israeli army only allows students to cross to their schools outside the village through the Habla gate.

<p>NABLUS</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> Since December 17th 2013, Israeli forces ordered the closure 500 dunumes of land in Qusra village as a closed military area. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the roads of Til-Burin and Beit Furik-Salem; the settler bypass road connecting the village of Deir al Hatab to the settlement of Alon Moreh; the road connecting the town of ‘Aqraba to the village of Osrin; and the detour road between the town of Qabalan and the village of Osrin. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the northern entrance to Qabalan town; the southern entrances to the town of Jamma’in and the villages of Duma and Qaryut. (iii) At 22:00, Israeli forces closed the North entrance of Awarta with dirt mounds. • <u>Checkpoint:</u> At 09:20, Israeli forces closed Beit Furiq checkpoint until 10:45 and then at 19:15, intensified their restrictions at and impeded the free flow of traffic. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 09:30, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint near Yitsahar settlement junction located in North Huwara and prevented vehicles from using the bypass road leading to Jit village in Qaqliliya. (ii) At 10:45, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Deir Sharaf junction along the main road connecting Nablus and Tulkarem until 11:30. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 18:55, Israeli forces raided Nablus until 19:30. (ii) At 20:35, Israeli force raided Osirin village, clashed with several residents then withdrew at 21:30. (iii) At 03:20, Israeli forces raided Orif village, stormed and searched a home, detained a residents and confiscated a (M-16 Assault Rifle) then withdrew at 05:45. (iv) At 03:20, Israeli forces raided Qaryout village, searched several homes then withdrew at 04:00. <p style="text-align: center;">SALFIT</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the entrance to two detour roads connecting Marda village to its farmland. (ii) On 15.04.2012, the Israeli army has opened the northern entrance to Salfit city to civilian which was closed since the year 2000 and prevented access from 08:00 until 09:20. (iii) Since 11:00 on July 30th 2012, Israeli forces have closed two roads leading to Abu Nasar and Qatan Al-Jama' located in western area of Deir Istiya with cement blocks. • <u>Checkpoint:</u> Israeli forces intensified their restrictions at Za'tara checkpoint and impeded the free flow of traffic. • <u>Raid:</u> At 22:30, Israeli forces raided Deir Istiya and clashed with several residents. • <u>Attack:</u> At 14:50, Israeli forces positioned near the entrance of Yasouf village fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and as a result left several residents suffocated from tear gas inhalation.
<p style="text-align: center;">JERICHO</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Checkpoints:</u> At 21:10, Israeli forces intensified its restrictions at Al-Hamra checkpoint set up along the road connecting Jericho and Nablus District. • <u>Detention:</u> At 22:40, Israeli forces positioned at Allenby bridge detained Ma'moun Hamdan (A resident of Al-Bireh city) as he was returning from Jordan. • <u>Temporary Detention:</u> At 20:50, Israeli forces positioned at Allenby Bridge temporarily detained Hanna Adnan Karakra as she was returning from Jordan then released her at 21:45.
<p style="text-align: center;">BETHLEHEM</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close roads to An Nu'man village, with the exception of the road leading to the Wall gate in the south-eastern area of the village.
