JERUSALEM	 Closure: Since October 12th 2012, the Israeli army continue to increase its restrictions at checkpoints located at the entrance to Jerusalem city, set up several flying checkpoints on the main road leading to the city entrance and the entrance to the Old City for Friday prayers. The Israeli army continues to close the 'demarcation area' along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits. The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill between Biddu and Beit Iksa villages. Closure of Main Roads: The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the entrance to Jaba' village. The Israeli army continues to close the gate along the Wall section separating the area of Dahiyat Al-Bareed from Al-Ram town. The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to Beit Iksa village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandia checkpoint. Checkpoints: Israeli authorities continue to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a "border crossing point" and designate a special crossing lane for holders of Jerusalem IDs and another for those possessing permits to access Jerusalem city. Raid: On the evening of October 12th 2012, Israeli forces raided Al-Isawiya village, stormed a home and detained a child for alleged stoning. Detention: On the evening of October 10th 2012, Israeli forces detained Khaldoun Sarhan and Sarhan Sarhan from their home in Silwan neighbourhood in Jerusalem. On the morning of October 13th 2012, Israeli forces positioned at Shu'fat checkpoint detained 6 residents: Mohammad Jaber, Ahmad Sandouqa, 		

	 Mamdouh Al-Natsha, Mahmoud Salaymeh and Mohammad Salaymeh. (iii) Israeli forces detained Amin Darwish (10 years old) in Al-Isawiya village. Attack: At 13:20, Israeli forces positioned at Qalandiya checkpoint fired tear gas grenades towards several children for alleged stoning.
	 Demonstration: (i) At 12:30, a demonstration took place after Friday prayers near Al-Salasla gate in the old city of Jerusalem against Israeli settler continues storming of Al-Aqsa mosque compound during which Israeli forces detained 7 residents including a child. (ii) On the evening of October 12th 2012, a several children demonstrated in
	front of Bab-AlAmoud gate in the old city of Jerusalem and lit candles in solidarity with Palestinian detainees and demanding their release from Israeli prisons. Wall Gates:
	(i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the Wall gate in Abu Dis town.
	(ii) The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate on Al-Shayyah road in the area between Al-Sawahira Al-Sharqiya and Al-Sleavawahira Al-Gharbiya villages, only allowing civilians holding Jerusalem IDs to cross, after subjecting them to thorough searches using electronic devices.
	• Wall Construction: Wall construction continued in the areas north and south of Qalandiya village; south of Al-Za'ayyem village; and in Wadi Al-Eizariya west of the illegal settlement Ma 'ale Adumim.
	• Closure of Main Roads: The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to
	Sinjil village well as the junction to Kafr Malik and 'Ein Samiya villages.Demonstration:
RAMALLAH & AL BIREH	(i) At 12:30, a demonstration took place in Al Nabi Saleh village against settler violence and land confiscation, during which Israeli forces clashed with the protestors and fired tear gas grenades leaving Fadel Al-Tamimi injured and several protestors suffocated from tear gas inhalation.
	 (ii) At 12:40, a demonstration took place in Ni'lin and Bil'in villages against the construction of the wall, clashed with Israeli forces that fired tear gas grenades leaving several protestors suffocating from tear gas inhalation. (iii) At 16:15, a demonstration took place at the entrance of Ofar prison in Beituniya in solidarity with Palestinian detainees and demanding their release from Israeli prisons during which Israeli forces fired tear gas grenades leaving several demonstrators suffocating from tear gas inhalation.

	and tear gas grenades towards demonstrators leaving them suffocated from tear gas

 Demonstration: At 12:20, a demonstration took place in Al-Ma'sara village against the construction of the wall.
 Wall Construction: Wall construction continued northwest of Beit Jala town.

• Closure:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close Al-Shuhada' Street, Al-Sahleh and Khuzq Al-Far areas, as well as the old gold market in Hebron's Old City. In addition to closing the entrance to Al-Qeisi neighbourhood, the Israeli army continues to close the entrances to the area of Al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) with an electronic gate; Al-Laban Market also remains closed.
- (ii) Since 05 January 2009, the Israeli army has closed the area located along the Green Line south of the town of Yatta. Having seized land for Wall construction, the Israeli army evicted the Palestinian residents and denied them access to the area.

• Closure of Main Roads:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Al-Thahiriya and Al-Samoa' towns, Al-'Arrub refugee camp, and Al-Tuwani and Al-Karmil villages.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to prohibit Palestinian vehicles from travelling along the old Al-Shalala Street leading to Hebron's Old City.
- (iii) The Israeli army continues to close all roads leading to Road # 60 as well as detour roads along the settler bypass road leading to Yatta town.
- (iv) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds a detour road leading to the entrance to Al-Simiya village, the southern entrance of Al-Samou' and the entrance of Beit Annun with cement blocks.
- (v) On July 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Safa and Al-Dirat and also closed the entrance of south Yatta with cement blocks.
- <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 09:55, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Beit Annun village junction.

• Raid:

- (i) At 22:55, Israeli forces raided Hebron; summoned Abdel Rahman Sultan to report to Israeli intelligence for questioning then withdrew at 00:30.
- (ii) At 02:00, Israeli forces raided Dura, stormed a home then withdrew at 06:00.

• Settler Violence:

- (i) At 11:30, Israeli settlers stormed agricultural land in Al-Thahriya and assaulted several residents as they were collecting olive harvests.
- (ii) At 12:40, Israeli settlers stormed agricultural land in Tel Al-Rumayda neighbourhood in the old city of Hebron and assaulted Wajid Abu-Aysheh as he was collecting olive harvests leaving him hospitalised with contusions.
- (iii) At 15:20, Israeli settlers provoked and chased away several residents as they were collecting olive harvest in the area between Al-Thahriya and Al-Samuo'.
- (iv) On October 12th 2012, Israeli settlers stormed agricultural land in Beit Ummar and chased away several residents as they were collecting olive harvest.
- <u>Wall Construction:</u> Wall construction continued in the area surrounding the illegal settlement Eshkolot, west of Al-Thahiriya town.

ALL DISTRITS	 At 02:00 on 18 January 2009, the unilateral ceasefire declared by Israel came into effect. At a later time on the same day, armed Palestinian groups announced an agreement to cease fire. The ceasefire has been further renewed on 23 June 2012 at 24:00. On 14.12.2011, Israeli forces placed floating marks 3 miles from Gaza's seashore and warned fishermen against passing beyond the mark. Israeli forces broke the cease fire agreement by opening fire from their positions behind the Green Line towards Rafah. Israeli military Jets broke the ceasefire agreement by launching 3 consecutive air strikes towards Gaza and Central Gaza. Palestinian gunmen broke the cease fire agreement by launching 3 projectiles towards the Green Line.
