Assault on Places of Worship	2	—	2	Israeli forces fired stun and tear gas grenades towards worshipers in Al-Aqsa mosque compound, Israeli forces prevented residents below the age of 50 from entering Al-Aqsa mosque compound and at 06:15, Israeli forces stormed Al-Aqsa mosque after closing all the entrance gates leading to the mosque and forcibly removed worshiper from inside the mosque in order to allow a group of Israeli settlers under the protection of Israeli police to enter the mosque. Israeli forces closed the gates to Al-Ibrahimi mosque in the old city of Hebron in order to allow Israeli settlers to perform Talmudic rituals inside of the mosque.

<b>JERUSALEM</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b><u>Closure:</u></b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) The Israeli army continues to intensify their restrictions at the entrance to Jerusalem city, set up several flying checkpoints on the main road leading to the city and prevented worshipers under the age of 50 from conducting prayers at Al-Aqsa mosque compound.</li> <li>(ii) The Israeli army continues to close the ‘demarcation area’ along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits.</li> <li>(iii) The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill between Biddu and Beit Iksa villages.</li> </ul> </li> <li>• <b><u>Closure of Main Roads:</u></b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the entrance to Jaba’ village.</li> <li>(ii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to Beit Iksa village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandiya checkpoint.</li> </ul> </li> <li>• <b><u>Checkpoints:</u></b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) Israeli authorities continue to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a “border crossing point” and designate a special crossing lane for holders of Jerusalem IDs and another for those possessing permits to access Jerusalem city and closed the checkpoint at 01:20 and impeded the free flow of traffic until 04:05.</li> <li>(ii) On September 19<sup>th</sup> 2012, Israeli forces closed Ras Khamis checkpoint near Shu’fat camp and impeded the free flow of traffic in order to construct the wall.</li> <li>(iii) At 17:00, Israeli forces intensified their restrictions at Jaba’ checkpoint located along the main road connecting Ramallah, Jericho and Jerusalem.</li> </ul> </li> <li>• <b><u>Flying Checkpoint:</u></b> At 09:50, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Wadi Al-Juz neighbourhood in Jerusalem.</li> <li>• <b><u>Raid:</u></b> At 10:40, Israeli forces raided Abu Dis, clashed with several residents, detained a resident, stormed a school and fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several school children for alleged stoning then withdrew at 11:20.</li> <li>• <b><u>Detention:</u></b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) At 07:00 on October 12<sup>th</sup> 2014, Israeli forces detained Rami Al-Fakhouri after storming his home in the old city of Jerusalem.</li> <li>(ii) At 09:40, Israeli forces positioned near Al-Aqsa mosque compound gate detained Nihad Al-Saghier (A resident of the old city of Jerusalem).</li> <li>(iii) At evening of October 12<sup>th</sup> 2014, Israeli forces detained four residents including two children: Hakam Abu Khdeir (16 years old), Mu’tasim Al-Ja’bari (16 years old), Ahmad Abu Khdeir and Qusay Abu Khdeir in Shu’fat neighbourhood in Jerusalem.</li> <li>(iv) At 20:00, Israeli forces detained Ahmad Khalaf in Silwan neighbourhood.</li> <li>(v) Israeli forces positioned in Abu Dis detained Sayf-Al-Islam Sabah (A resident of Al-Jalazoun camp in Ramallah)</li> </ul> </li> </ul>

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b><u>Temporary Detention:</u></b> On the evening of October 11<sup>th</sup> 2014, Israeli forces positioned in Silwan neighbourhood temporarily detained two children: Ashraf Burqan (13 years old) and Fayeze Burqan (13 years old) then released them later.</li> <li>• <b><u>Attack:</u></b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) At 17:40, Israeli forces positioned near Beit Hanina fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.</li> <li>(ii) At 19:35, Israeli forces positioned in Shu'fat camp in Jerusalem fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.</li> <li>(iii) At 20:00, Israeli forces positioned near Ras Al-Amoud neighbourhood in Jerusalem fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.</li> </ul> </li> <li>• <b><u>Settler Violence:</u></b> On the evening of October 12<sup>th</sup> 2014, an Israeli settler positioned in Al-Sa'diya neighbourhood in Jerusalem attempted to abduct the child Majd Huzina (4 years old) outside of his family home during which two residents were able to free the child from the settlers grip and rescue the child.</li> <li>• <b><u>Assault on Places of Worship:</u></b> At 05:00, Israeli forces prevented residents below the age of 50 from entering Al-Aqsa mosque compound and at 06:15, Israeli forces stormed Al-Aqsa mosque after closing all the entrance gates leading to the mosque then fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades toward worshipers while they were conducting dawn prayers and forcibly removed them from inside the mosque in order to allow a group of Israeli settlers under the protection of Israeli police to enter the mosque.</li> <li>• <b><u>Wall Gates:</u></b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the Wall gate in Abu Dis town.</li> <li>(ii) The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate on Al-Shayyah road in the area between Al-Sawahira Al-Sharqiya and Al-Slewahira Al-Gharbiya villages, only allowing civilians holding Jerusalem IDs to cross, after subjecting them to thorough searches using electronic devices.</li> </ul> </li> </ul>
