#### **WEST BANK**

#### • <u>Closure:</u>

- On October 12<sup>th</sup> 2015, the Israeli army, continues to intensify their restrictions at the entrance to Jerusalem city, set up several flying checkpoints on the main road leading to the city and prevented worshipers from conducting prayers at Al-Aqsa mosque compound and prevented residents entering the mosque.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the 'demarcation area' along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits.
- (iii) The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill between Biddu and Beit Iksa villages.

#### • Closure of Main Roads:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the entrance to Jaba' village.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to Beit Iksa village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandiya checkpoint.

### • Checkpoints:

- (i) Israeli authorities continue to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a "border crossing point" and designate a special crossing lane for holders of Jerusalem IDs and another for those possessing permits to access Jerusalem city.
- (ii) On September 19<sup>th</sup> 2012, Israeli forces closed Ras Khamis checkpoint near Shu'fat camp and impeded the free flow of traffic in order to construct the wall.
- Raid: At 20:00, Israeli forces raided Al-Isawiya village and clashed with several residents.

#### • Attack:

- (i) At 10:30, Israeli forces positioned near Bab Al-Absat gate (A main gate entrance leading to Al-Aqsa mosque compound) in the old city of Jerusalem opened fire towards and killed a child.
- (ii) At 10:30, Israeli forces positioned in Beit Hanina opened fire towards 2 children and as a result killed 1 child and injured another: Ahmad Manasra (13 years old) {critically injured) then detained.
- (iii) At 11:30 and again at 20:20, Israeli forces positioned in Jabal Al-Mukabir neighbourhood fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning as they stormed the home of Mustafa Al-Khatib (17 years old) {the child killed by Israeli forces near Bab Al-Absat gate (A main gate entrance leading to Al-Aqsa mosque compound) in the old city of Jerusalem and detained his father and again at 20:20 as they stormed the condolence home of the child killed.
- (iv) At 13:20, Israeli forces positioned near Al-Quds University in Abu Dis fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.

#### JERUSALEM

- (v) At 15:00, Israeli forces positioned near Al-Ram junction fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.
- (vi) At 15:10, Israeli forces positioned in Al-Shiekh Jarrah neighbourhood in Jerusalem opened fire towards the child: Marah Al-Bakri (A school girl) {A resident of Beit Hanina} and as a result left her critically injured then detained her for allegedly attempting to stab an Israeli soldier.
- (vii)At 17:30, Israeli forces positioned in Al-Shiekh Sa'ed village fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.
- (viii) At 19:40, Israeli forces positioned in Al-Jabal area junction in Abu Dis fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.
- (ix) At 19:40, Israeli forces positioned in Beit Hanina fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.
- (x) At 20:20, Israeli forces positioned in Al-Tur and Dahiyat Al-Salam neighbourhoods fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.
- (xi) At 20:20, Israeli forces positioned near the entrance of Hizma village fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.
- (xii)At 21:20, Israeli forces positioned near the entrance of Beit Ijza village fired live ammunition towards several residents for allegedly stoning.

#### • Killing:

- (i) At 21:00, Mohammad Nathmi Shamasnah (23 years old){A resident of Qtana village} was killed after Israeli settlers opened fire towards him for allegedly attempting to stab and take a gun from an Israeli settler near the Central Bus station in Jerusalem.
- (ii) Israeli forces positioned near Bab Al-Absat gate (A main gate entrance leading to Al-Aqsa mosque compound) in the old city of Jerusalem opened fire towards and killed the child Mustafa Adel Al-Khatib (17 years old) {A resident of Jabal Al-Mukabir Neighbourhood}.
- (iii) Israeli forces positioned in Beit Hanina opened fire towards and killed the child Hassan Manasrah (15 years old).

#### • Detention:

- (i) At 21:30, Israeli forces detained two residents: Mohammad Al-Shalabi and Yasser Al-Bassti in the old city of Jerusalem.
- (ii) Israeli forces detained Ahmad Saleh Manasra (13 years old) {critically injured after Israeli forces opened fire towards him in Beit Hanina.
- (iii) Israeli forces detained Adel Al-Khatib {the father of Mustafa Al-Khatib who was killed by Israeli forces near Bab Al-Absat gate (A main gate entrance leading to Al-Aqsa mosque compound) in the old city of Jerusalem}.
- (iv) Israeli forces detained Marah Al-Bakri {A school girl critically wounded after Israeli forces opened fire towards her} in Al-Shiekh Jarrah neighbourhood.
- <u>Temporary Detention:</u> At 09:40, Israeli forces temporarily detained 3 children: Mohammad Ahmad Al-Abbassi (15 years old), Ahmad Sabri Al-Abbassi (17 years old) and Baha Ahmad Al-Abbassi (15 years old) in Silwan neighbourhood in Jerusalem then released them at a later time.
- **Expulsion:** At 10:30, Israeli forces stormed Shorouq Dowiyat's {who was injured for an allegedly ramming her vehicle near Al-Za'im checkpoint} home in Sur Bahar village and served a Military order expelling all members of her family and confiscated their Jerusalem Identification Cards.

• Assault on Places of Worship: At 10:00, a group of Israeli settlers under the protection of Israeli forces stormed Al-Aqsa mosque compound in the old city of Jerusalem and provoked worshipers.

#### • Settler Violence:

- (i) At 13:20, an Israeli settler vehicle travelling along the main road in Khan Al-Hamra area ran over Jamal Ahmad Jahalin and as a result, left him hospitalized with contusions.
- (ii) At 21:00, a group of Israeli settlers assaulted Fahed Jum'a Abu Rrmeleh as he was returning from work and as a result left him hospitalized with contusions.

#### • Wall Gates:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the Wall gate in Abu Dis town.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate on Al-Shayyah road in the area between Al-Sawahira Al-Sharqiya and Al-Slewahira Al-Gharbiya villages, only allowing civilians holding Jerusalem IDs to cross, after subjecting them to thorough searches using electronic devices.

#### • Closure of Main Roads:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Sinjil village well as the junction to Kafr Malik and 'Ein Samiya villages.
- (ii) On October 3<sup>rd</sup> 2015, Israeli forces closed the main road located near "Bet El" settlement and leading to Al-Jalazoun camp with cement blocks.
- (iii) At 19:10, Israeli forces closed the east and west entrances to Deir Nathim villages with cement blocks.
- <u>Checkpoints:</u> At 09:35 on October 12<sup>th</sup> 2015, Israeli forces closed Al-Mahakma checkpoint located near "Bet El" settlement in North Al-Bireh city.

#### • Flying Checkpoint:

- (i) At 20:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint along Al-Taybeh junction located along the main road connecting Ramallah and Jericho.
- (ii) At 20:20, Israeli forces set up 3 checkpoints at the entrances of Abboud, Um Safa and Beit Illo villages until 24:00.
- (iii) At 20:25, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Atarah until 24:00.
- (iv) At 21:25, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Ein Sinya village until 22:00.
- (v) At 21:50, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint beneath Ein Yabroud Village Bridge until 22:10.

#### Raid:

- (i) At 03:30 on October 12<sup>th</sup> 2015, Israeli forces raided Al-Mazra'a Al-Qibliya village and detained 3 residents.
- (ii) At 20:15, Israeli forces raided Al-Nabi Saleh and Deir Nathim villages {after unidentified assailants opened fire towards a military watch tower near "Halamis" settlement} during which they clashed with several residents as they stormed and searched 2 homes and as a result injured the child Wa'ed Al-Tamimi (12 years old) then withdrew at 21:35.
- (iii) At 05:40, Israeli forces raided Silwad and detained two residents.

#### • Attack:

- At 08:50, Israeli forces positioned near Atara Bridge located in North Bir Ziet fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several children for alleged stoning.
- (ii) At 10:35, Israeli forces positioned at the entrance of Deir Nathim village fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.

# RAMALLAH & AL BIREH

- (iii) At 12:50, Israeli forces positioned at Al-Makhakma checkpoint located near "Beit El" settlement in North Al-Bireh city fired live ammunition, rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning as they were protesting against the continued Israeli military and settler assault on Al-Aqsa mosque compound in the old city of Jerusalem and as a result injured 10 residents including 3 children: Mohammad Khaled Jalouli (10 years old), Mahmoud Najib Mohammad (15 years old), Ahmad Subhi Mustafa(16 years old), Qutayba Jamil Attah, Malik Hisham Abu Khadija, Ayman Jamil Al-Jamal, Mujahid Basil Abdel-Mu'ti, Majdi Abdel-Nasser Al-Barghouthi, Hisham Khamis Abu Al-Lafh, Ahmad Aj'aj Faroukh as well as leaving several others suffocated from tear gas inhalation.
- (iv) At 13:30, Israeli forces positioned in the vicinity of "Pesagout" settlement located in east Al-Bireh city fired live ammunition, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.
- (v) At 14:25, Israeli forces positioned in the vicinity of Ni'lin checkpoint fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.
- (vi) At 15:15, Israeli forces positioned near the entrance of Al-Jalazoun camp fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and as a result injured Mohammad Najib Mohammad.

#### • Detention:

- (i) At 20:00, Israeli forces positioned beneath Ain Yabroud village Bridge detained the child Suliyaman Salem Abdel-Rahman (13 years old) {A resident of Ain Yabroud village}.
- (ii) Israeli forces detained three residents: Mahdi Mahmoud Omar Sharita, Mohammad Hisham Abdel-Hafith Shartih and Khalil Akram Al-Dadowat in Al-Mazra'a Al-Qibliya village.
- (iii) Israeli forces detained 2 residents: Wael Musa Hamed and Mahdi Faris Issa in Silwad.
- <u>Killing:</u> Israeli forces positioned at Al-Makhakma checkpoint located near "Beit El" settlement in North Al-Bireh city killed the child Ahmad Sharaqa (15 years old) {A resident of Al-Jalazoun camp}.
- <u>Demonstration:</u> At 11:30, a demonstration took place with the participation of local Attornies near Al-Mahakma checkpoint located near "Bet El" settlement in North Al-Bireh city in solidarity with the attorney Al-Harimi {whose home is near the checkpoint} during which Israeli forces fired stun and tear gas grenades towards them.

#### • Closure of Main Road:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the road leading to the town of 'Arraba east of the illegal settlement Dotan.
- (ii) Since the evening of November 25<sup>th</sup> 2012, Israeli forces closed the western entrance of Ya'bad.

#### • <u>Raid:</u>

- (i) At 00:55, Israeli forces raided Al-Arqa village, stormed the home of Tarik Abdel-Fattah Yahya {A resident who is detained for an alleged stabbing incident in Al-Afola city} and temporarily detained several of his family members is a single room while they were questioned by Israeli Intelligence officers then proceeded to survey the home and took photographs of the home and then withdrew at 02:30.
- (ii) At 02:30, Israeli forces raided Al-Jabriat area in Jenin city.
- (iii) At 04:50, Israeli forces raided Barta'a Al-Sharqiya village and detained 2 residents after storming their homes.

#### **Wall Gates:** (i) The Israeli army continues to restrict access at 'Azzun 'Atma Wall gate and impeded the free flow of traffic. The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the entrance to the village of Wadi Al-Rasha and to deny civilian access. (ii) The Israeli army allows residents to access the village through Gate #109. Having removed the gate at the entrance to the village of Ras Atiya; the Israeli army only allows students to cross to their schools outside the village through the Habla gate. Closure: Since December 17<sup>th</sup> 2013, Israeli forces ordered the closure 500 dunumes of land in Qusra village as a closed military area. **Closure of Main Roads:** The Israeli army continues to close the roads of Til-Burin and Beit Furik-Salem; (i) the settler bypass road connecting the village of Deir al Hatab to the settlement of Alon Moreh; the road connecting the town of 'Agraba to the village of Osrin; and the detour road between the town of Qabalan and the village of Osrin. The Israeli army continues to close the northern entrance to Qabalan town; the (ii) southern entrances to the town of Jamma'in and the villages of Duma and At 22:00, Israeli forces closed the North entrance of Awarta with dirt mounds. (iii) Flying Checkpoint: (i) At 09:30 on October 11<sup>th</sup> 2015, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint near Yitzhar settlement junction located in North Huwara and prevented vehicles from using the bypass road leading to Jit village in Qalqilya. (ii) At 16:10, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Deir Sharaf junction along the main road connecting Nablus and Tulkarem until 17:00. (iii) At 16:30, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Taluza village. Raid: (i) At 03:30 on October 12<sup>th</sup> 2015, Israeli forces raided Burin village, stormed and searched four homes, detained a resident then withdrew at 07:00. (ii) At 23:15, Israeli forces raided Beit Dajjan village. **Detention:** Israeli forces detained Muntasir Nafiq Mansour in Burin village **Temporary Detention:** At 18:00, Israeli forces positioned along the bypass road **NABLUS** near "Yitsahar" settlement temporarily detained three residents: Abdallah Abdel-Kareem Ramadan, Maqdad Ahmad Zidan and Ahmad Navef Al-Hindi {a resident of Tel village} as they were traveling home from Olive harvesting then released them at 20:35. Attack: At 13:15, Israeli forces positioned in the vicinity of Huwara checkpoint fired live ammunition, rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and as a result injured 13 residents including 3 children: Muhanad Izhiman (17 years old), Diya Mohammad Towiqat (16 years old), Sayef Mohammad Al-Hindi (16 years old), Mus'ab Saleh Zarba, Mohammad Jihad Bakri, Ayman Najah Odeh, Riyad Khader Tubasi, Ahmad Husam Abu Salha, Abdel-Halim Ghazi Al-Dawi, , Ashraf Jamil Abu Assab, Jihad Hassan Hindi, Alaa Omar Al-Najar and Yazan Munir Abu Laymoun as well as leaving several others suffocated from tear gas inhalation **Settler Violence:** At 15:05, a group of Israeli settlers positioned near "Yitsahar" settlement opened fire towards a woman and her children as they were collecting Olive harvest. **Closure of Main Roads: SALFIT** The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the entrance to two detour (i) roads connecting Marda village to its farmland.

- (ii) Since 15 September 2007, the Israel army has prevented civilians from accessing or staying on 22 dunumes of confiscated land in Al Mazmuriya area in Beit Sahur and Bethlehem cities.

#### • Closure of Main Roads:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close the Beit Jala-Wadi Ahmed road; a road between Um Tuba and Al-Jass; a road between Um Tuba and Khilat Nu'man: a road between Um Tuba and the wall; a road between Al-Khas village and the wall; the 2 by pass roads located south of Al-Walaja; a road between Talita Qumi and Nazlat Al-Sider in Beit Jala; the eastern road of Al-Khader; the road between Al-Khader and Beit Jala; Wadi Rahal road near "Ifrat" settlement, the road between Al-Khader and road #60 which lead to the eastern neighbourhoods of Bethlehem; a road leading to Wadi Rahal, and a road east of Beit Fajjar town with dirt mounds.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the road leading to "Newe Daniyyel" settlement and agricultural land in Al-Khader; a road between Um Tuba and Wadi Al-Hums: Wadi Fukin, Al-Jaba, the Green Line; a road between Za'tara and a detour road, and a road between Taqou and Khirbet Al-Deir with cement blocks
- (iii) Since August 2<sup>nd</sup> 2012, Israeli forces closed a road leading to Beit Jalla.
- (iv) Since May 8<sup>th</sup> 2013, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Carmisan area in Beit Jalla and Al-Walaja with a steel gate and barbed wires.

# (v) Since June 3<sup>rd</sup> 2013, the Israeli army closed the road connecting Nihalin and road 60 with dirt mounds.

- (vi) Since 13:20 on September 29<sup>th</sup> 2013, the Israeli army closed a road leading to 50 acres of agricultural land in Wadi Salem area in Al-Khadr with dirt mounds.
- (vii) Israeli forces closed the main road connecting Surif and Al-Jub'a village with dirt mounds.
- (viii) On January 28<sup>th</sup> 2014, Israeli forces closed the steel gate at the entrance of Nihalin { replacing the dirt mounds placed at the entrance since the year 2002} and placed time schedule for opening the gate from 06:00 until 14:00 on a daily bases.
- (ix) At 10:45 on September 8<sup>th</sup> 2015, Israeli forces closed the agricultural road located in Arab Al-Rashaydeh village located near "Malee Amoush" settlement with dirt mounds.
- (x) At 17:00 on September 8<sup>th</sup> 2015 Israeli forces closed the North entrance of Tagou'.
- **Flying Checkpoint:** At 19:30, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the west entrance of Taqou' until 20:00.

#### • <u>Raid:</u>

- (i) At 09:15, Israeli forces raided Al-Obiedeh
- (ii) At 00:45, Israeli forces raided Taqou', stormed several homes, detained 4 children then withdrew at 02:40.

#### Attack:

- (i) At 14:30, Israeli forces positioned in the vicinity of Billal Bin Rabah mosque located in North Bethlehem fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and as a result injured 2 residents including a child and detained a resident.
- (ii) At 17:20, Israeli forces positioned at the west entrance of Taqou' fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.

#### **BETHLEHEM**

(iii) At 18:20, Israeli forces positioned a near Dar Salah village bridge located at the east entrance of Beit Sahour fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.

#### • <u>Detention:</u>

- (i) On October 11<sup>th</sup> 2015, Israeli forces detained the child: Harith Nayef Khalil Hamaydeh (14 years old) during confrontations near the entrance of Taqou.
- (ii) Israeli forces detained 4 residents: Muhyi Ahmad Al-Amour (16 years old), Mahmoud Khalil Abu Mifrih (16 years old), Atef Arif Al-Amour (17 years old) and Mohammad Thiyab Sabah (17 years old) in Taqou'.
- (iii) Israeli forces positioned in the vicinity of Billal Bin Rabah mosque located in North Bethlehem detained an unidentified resident.
- <u>Settler Violence:</u> At 01:45, a group of Israeli settlers positioned near "Ghoush Itsiyon" settlement junction located in south Bethlehem assaulted Bassam Abdallah Al-Huor (A resident of Surif) and as a result left him hospitalised with contusions.

#### • Closure:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close Khuzq Al-Far areas, as well as the old gold market in Hebron's Old City. In addition to closing the entrance to Al-Qeisi neighbourhood, the Israeli army continues to close the entrances to the area of Al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) with an electronic gate; Al-Laban Market also remains closed.
- (ii) Since 05 January 2009, the Israeli army has closed the area located along the Green Line south of the town of Yatta. Having seized land for Wall construction, the Israeli army evicted the Palestinian residents and denied them access to the area.

#### • Closure of Main Roads:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Al-Karmil villages.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to prohibit Palestinian vehicles from travelling along the old Al-Shalala Street leading to Hebron's Old City.
- (iii) The Israeli army continues to close all roads leading to Road # 60 as well as detour roads along the settler bypass road leading to Yatta town.
- (iv) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds a detour road leading to e to Al-Simiya village, the southern entrance of Al-Samou' and the entrance of Beit Annun with cement blocks.
- (v) Since July 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Safa and Al-Dirat and also closed the entrance of south Yatta with cement blocks.
- (vi) At 11:00 on August 6<sup>th</sup> 2015, Israeli forces closed the entrance of Al-Hajara village located in south Dura with cement blocks.
- **Flying Checkpoint:** At 21:55, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint in Khilat Khadour area in the old city of Hebron.

#### • Raid:

- (i) At dawn on October 12<sup>th</sup> 2015 and again at 02:40 on October 13<sup>th</sup> 2015, Israeli forces raided Hebron and detained four residents.
- (ii) At dawn on October 12<sup>th</sup> 2015, Israeli forces raided Al-Tabaqa village and detained a resident.
- (iii) At dawn on October 12<sup>th</sup> 2015, Israeli forces raided Beit Ummar and detained a resident.
- (iv) At dawn on October 12<sup>th</sup> 2015, Israeli forces raided Surif and detained a resident.
- (v) At 22:00, Israeli forces raided Al-Simiya village located in North West of Al-Samou'.
- (vi) At 02:15, Israeli forces raided Dura, clashed with several residents then withdrew at 04:00.
- (vii)At 05:05, Israeli forces raided Beit Awa and detained a resident.

- (i) At 21:50, Israeli forces positioned near Al-Ibrahimi mosque in the old city of Hebron detained Mohammad Mukhlis Al-Salaymeh.
- (ii) Israeli forces detained 4 resinedts: Islam Nader Sha'ban, Shadi Mahmoud Oufisha, Kifah Khader Iskafi and Murad Yacoub Al-Ajlouni in Hebron.
- (iii) Israeli forces detained Yusef Haytham Abu Awan in Al-Tabaqa village.
- (iv) Israeli forces detained Muslih Ali Awad in Beit Ummar.
- (v) Israeli forces detained Ibrahim Mahmoud Abed in Surif.
- (vi) Israeli forces detained Karam Fayez Al-Salaymeh in Beit Awwa.

#### • Attack:

- (i) At 08:45, Israeli forces positioned near Tariq Bin Zied School in the old city of Hebron fired tear gas grenades towards the school.
- (ii) At 09:30, Israeli forces positioned in Al-Manarat area in Beit Ummar and Al-Oroub camp fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.

#### **HEBRON**

- (iii) At 10:45, Israeli forces positioned near Al-Oroub camp fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.
- (iv) At 14:40, Israeli forces positioned near Tariq Bin Zied school junction in the old city of Hebron fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several children for alleged stoning.
- (v) At 15:10, Israeli forces positioned near the wall gate in Beit Awwa fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several children for alleged stoning.
- (vi) At 16:25, Israeli forces positioned near the entrance of Al-Fuwar camp fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and as a result injured the child: Usayed Haytham Al-Qawasmi (12 years old).
- (vii)At 16:25, Israeli forces positioned near Al-Baraka area located in south east Yatta fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.
- (viii) At 19:00, Israeli forces positioned near Al-Fuwar camp junction and Khursa and Al-Tabaqa village junctions fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and as result injured the child: Atallah Al-Teeti (10 years old){A resident of Al-Fuwar camp} during which an Israeli Military Jeep ran over Waleed Yusef Al-Namoura near Khursa village junction and as a result left him hospitalised with contusions and fractures.

#### • <u>Settler Violence:</u>

- (i) At 21:20, a group of Israeli settlers positioned near Al-Tuwani village located in east Yatta assaulted Fadel Al-Amour.
- (ii) At 22:30, a group of Israeli settlers positioned near "Kiryat Arba" settlement in the old city of Hebron attacked several homes in the old city of Hebron.

#### **GAZA STRIP**

# At 19:00 on August 26<sup>th</sup> 2014, Palestinian Gunmen and the Israeli military agreed to a cease fire agreement (brokered by the Arab Republic of Egypt) which includes the opening of border crossings to allow the entry of emergency supplies and humanitarian goods as well as construction material and agreed to increase the fishing limit to 6 nautical miles with possibility of increase to 12 nautical miles by the end of the year and to decrease the Military area to 100 meters, allow freedom of movement and a halt to targeted killings and assassinations and negotiations will be held for discussion on rebuilding the sea port and airports in the coming month. Israeli forces broke the ceasefire agreement by opening fire from their positions behind the Green Line towards Central Gaza and as a result injured three residents.
