Israeli settlers under the protection of Israeli forces stormed Aqraa, set fire to the ground floor of "Abu Bakir Al-Sadiq" Mosque after smashing several of its windows then spray painted anti-Arab slogans on the outer walls of the mosque in Nablus .Israeli forces closed the gates to Al-Ibrahimi mosque in the old city of Hebron in order to allow Israeli settlers to perform Talmudic rituals inside of the mosque.

WEST BANK

• Closure:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to intensify their restrictions at the entrance to Jerusalem city, set up several flying checkpoints on the main road leading to the city and prevented worshipers under the age of 50 from conducting prayers at Al-Aqsa mosque compound.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the 'demarcation area' along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits.
- (iii) The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill between Biddu and Beit Iksa villages.

• Closure of Main Roads:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the entrance to Jaba' village.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to Beit Iksa village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandiya checkpoint.

• Checkpoints:

- (i) Israeli authorities continue to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a "border crossing point" and designate a special crossing lane for holders of Jerusalem IDs and another for those possessing permits to access Jerusalem city and closed the checkpoint at 01:20 and impeded the free flow of traffic until 04:05.
- (ii) On September 19th 2012, Israeli forces closed Ras Khamis checkpoint near Shu'fat camp and impeded the free flow of traffic in order to construct the wall.

• Flying Checkpoint:

- (i) At 07:00 on October 13th 2014, Israeli forces set up 3 checkpoints at the entrance of Silwan, Wadi Hilweh area in Silwan and in Ras Al-Amoud neighbourhood in Jerusalem
- (ii) At 00:15, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the North junction of Al-Ram.

• Raid:

- (i) At 14:30, Israeli forces raided Al-Ram and clashed with its residents.
- (ii) At 20:00, Israeli forces raided Al-Jadeerah village.
- Assault on Places of Worship: At 07:00 on October 13th 2014, Israeli forces closed all the entrance gates leading to the mosque then fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades toward worshipers while they were conducting dawn prayers and forcibly removed them from inside the mosque in order to allow a group of Israeli settlers under the protection of Israeli police to enter the mosque and as a result injured 4 residents and left several others suffocated from tear gas inhalation and detained a resident.

• Detention:

- (i) At 13:00, Israeli forces positioned near Bab Al-Amoud gate which leads to Al-Aqsa mosque compound in the old city of Jerusalem detained Hamza Shaloudi.
- (ii) At 15:30, Israeli forces positioned in Ras Al-Amoud neighbourhood detained 5 residents including a child: Mohammad Al—Rawadi (16

	years old), Majdi Dandis, Mohammad Dandis, Mohammad Nassar Dandis, Karim Al-Shayoukhi and Abdallah Al-Abbassi. (iii) At 19:00, Israeli forces positioned at Qalandiya checkpoint detained Mahmoud Ismail Al-Louzi (A resident of Qalandiya). (iv) Israeli force detained Mohammad Abdel-Latif in Al-Aqsa mosque compound. • Wall Gates: (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the Wall gate in Abu Dis town. (ii) The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate on Al-Shayyah road in the area between Al-Sawahira Al-Sharqiya and Al-Slewahira Al-Gharbiya villages, only allowing civilians holding Jerusalem
	IDs to cross, after subjecting them to thorough searches using electronic devices.

Checkpoint: At 13:25, Israeli forces continue to intensify their restrictions at "Eniv" checkpoint and imped the free flow of traffic until 14:10. Flying Checkpoint: At 18:30, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Quffin until 20:15. Raid: At 02:50, Israeli forces raided Tulkarem, detained a University student after storming his home then withdrew at 03:55.

On January 28th 2014, Israeli forces closed the steel gate at the entrance of (viii) Nihalin { replacing the dirt mounds placed at the entrance since the year 2002} and placed time schedule for opening the gate from 06:00 until 14:00 on a daily bases. **Flying Checkpoint:** (i) At 09:10, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the North entrance of Tagou' until 09:30. (ii) At 16:15, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Jinata until 16:45. (iii)At 20:40, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the West entrance of Beit Fajjar until 21:15.

Raid:

- (i) At 12:35, Israeli forces raided Al-Ma'assra village, clashed with several residents then withdrew at 13:00.
- (ii) At 00:30, Israeli forces raided Al-Faradis village and stormed several homes.
- Settler Violence: At 16:30, Israeli settlers stormed a plot of agricultural land (which under threat of confiscation by the Israeli Military) near the east entrance of Nihalin village, installed several tents and performed Talmudic rituals.

Closure:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close Al-Shuhada' Street, Al-Sahleh and Khuzq Al-Far areas, as well as the old gold market in Hebron's Old City. In addition to closing the entrance to Al-Qeisi neighbourhood, the Israeli army continues to close the entrances to the area of Al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) with an electronic gate; Al-Laban Market also remains closed.
- (ii) Since 05 January 2009, the Israeli army has closed the area located along the Green Line south of the town of Yatta. Having seized land for Wall construction, the Israeli army evicted the Palestinian residents and denied them access to the area.

Closure of Main Roads:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Al-Thahiriya and Al-Samoa' towns, Al-'Arrub refugee camp, and Al-Tuwani and Al-Karmil villages.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to prohibit Palestinian vehicles from travelling along the old Al-Shalala Street leading to Hebron's Old City.
- (iii) The Israeli army continues to close all roads leading to Road # 60 as well as detour roads along the settler bypass road leading to Yatta town.
- (iv) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds a detour road leading to e to Al-Simiya village, the southern entrance of Al-Samou' and the entrance of Beit Annun with cement blocks.
- (v) Since July 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Safa and Al-Dirat and closed the entrance of south Yatta with cement blocks.
- (vi) On September 4th 2014, Israeli forces closed a road in Eiwn Al-Bas and Al-Bayda and

Al-Ras area in Ithna locat6ed near the wall gate.

(vii)At 13:40 on September 16th 2014, Israeli forces closed the main road leading to Al-Ibrahim mosque in the old city of Hebron.

• Flying Checkpoint:

- (i) At 09:30, Israeli forces set up two checkpoints in Wadi Qabuun area located in North Hebron and at the entrance of Beit Kahil.
- (ii) At 14:40, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Beit Einun village.
- (iii)At 16:30, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint in Wadi Qabuun area located in North Hebron.

• Raid:

- (i) At 01:350 on October 13th 2014, Israeli forces raided Sa'ir and detained two residents.
- (ii) At 02:00, Israeli forces raided Al-Urub camp and detained four residents.
- (iii)At 20:00, Israeli forces raided Beit Ummar, stormed several homes and detained four residents.

• Detention:

- (i) At 18:15, Israeli forces detained Ihsan Dababseh (A resident of Ithna) as he was reporting to Israeli intelligence for questioning based on a prior summon.
- (ii) Israeli forces detained two residents: Nada Shalladah and Abdel-Majid Shalladeh in Sa'ir.
- (iii)Israeli forces detained four residents: Wajdi Al-Sharif, Hassan Al-Sharif, Mohammad Al-Sharif and Mohammad Ad'is.
- (iv)Israeli forces detained four residents: Mohammad Abu Ayash, Mohammad KhalilSufyan Khalil and Sami Abu Judat.
- Attack: At 20:00, Israeli forces positioned at Jabal Juhar area in the old city of Hebron fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several resident for alleged stoning.
- Assault on Places of Worship: Since October 12th 2014, Israeli forces closed the gates to Al-Ibrahimi mosque in the old city of Hebron in order to allow Israeli settlers to perform Talmudic rituals inside of the mosque.

ALL DISTRICTS

- At 19:00 on August 26th 2014, Palestinian Gunmen and the Israeli military agreed to a cease fire agreement (brokered by the Arab Republic of Egypt) which includes the opening of border crossings to allow the entry of emergency supplies and humanitarian goods as well as construction material and agreed to increase the fishing limit to 6 nautical miles with possibility of increase to 12 nautical miles by the end of the year and to decrease the Military area to 100 meters, allow freedom of movement and a halt to targeted killings and assassinations and negotiations will be held for discussion on rebuilding the sea port and airports in the coming month.
- Israeli Naval vessels broke the ceasefire agreement by opening fire towards Palestinian fishing boats off the shores of Rafah.

NORTHERN GAZA

• <u>Closure of Crossing Point:</u> Beit Hanun (Erez) is open for the passage of critical patients, journalists, NGO staff, businesspersons and passengers travelling abroad through Al-Karama crossing with previous coordination.

GAZA	Closure of Crossing Points: (i) Al-Muntar (Karni) Crossing is closed. Beginning on 02 March 2011, the Crossing has been effectively closed following a unilateral Israeli decision. (ii) Al-Shija'iya (Nahal 'Oz) Crossing is closed. Beginning on 04 January 2010, the Crossing has closed following a unilateral Israeli decision.
RAFAH	 Closure of Crossing Points: Yasser 'Arafat International Airport remains closed. Rafah (<i>Al 'Awdah</i>) Crossing is open for the entry and exit of residents, students, tourists and businesspersons. Sufa Crossing is closed. Karm Abu Salem (Karem Shalom) Crossing is open for the entry of tourist and foreign diplomats and the entry of Humanitarian assistance and construction material funded by UNRWA. Attack: At dawn on October 14th 2014, Israeli Naval vessels opened fire and launched artillery shells towards several Palestinian-fishing boats off the shores of Rafah beach.
