Closure of Crossings	-	5	5	Beit Hanun (Erez) is open for the passage of critical patients, journalists, NGO staff, businessmen and passengers travelling abroad through Al-Karama crossing with previous coordination & Karm Abu Salem (Karem Shalom) Crossing is partially open for the entry of tourist and foreign diplomats and the entry of Humanitarian assistance and construction material funded by UNRWA.
Assault on Medical Sector	3	-	3	Israeli forces opened fire towards and damaged 3 ambulances as they near Halhoul checkpoint in Nablus.
Assault on Places of Worship	1	-	1	Israeli forces stormed Al-Aqsa mosque compound in the old city of Jerusalem and provoked worshippers.
Settler Violence	12	-	12	Israeli settlers assaulted residents, ran over a resident with a vehicle, stoned residents and vehicles , attempted to storm a village, opened fire towards residents and homes in Jerusalem, Ramallah, Qalqiliya, Nablus, Salfit, Bethlehem and Hebron.
Palestinian Attack	-	1	1	Palestinian gunmen opened fire towards an Israeli Military vehicle located behind the border fence in Khan Yunis as alleged by the Israeli Military.

JERUSALEM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) On October 13th 2015, the Israeli army, continues to intensify their restrictions at the entrance to Jerusalem city, set up several flying checkpoints on the main road leading to the city and prevented worshipers from conducting prayers at Al-Aqsa mosque compound and prevented residents entering the mosque. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the ‘demarcation area’ along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits. (iii) The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill between Biddu and Beit Ikksa villages. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the entrance to Jaba’ village. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to Beit Ikksa village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandiya checkpoint. • <u>Checkpoints:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli authorities continue to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a “border crossing point” and designate a special crossing lane for holders of Jerusalem IDs and another for those possessing permits to access Jerusalem city. (ii) On September 19th 2012, Israeli forces closed Ras Khamis checkpoint near Shu’fat camp and impeded the free flow of traffic in order to construct the wall. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 10:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint in Al-Suwaneh neighbourhood in Jerusalem. (ii) At 11:30, Israeli forces set up three checkpoints at the entrances of Al-Eisawiya, Sur Bahar villages and Shu’fat neighbourhood. • <u>Raid:</u>

- (i) At 05:00 on October 13th 2015, Israeli forces raided Abu Dis and detained a resident.
- (ii) At 20:20, Israeli forces raided Hizma village and clashed with several residents.
- (iii) At 22:00, Israeli forces raided Al-Ram, clashed with several residents as they stormed a home and a merchant shop and as a result set fire to a home owned by Yusef Julwa after firing stun and tear gas grenades and detained two residents.
- (iv) At 23:00, Israeli forces raided Beit Ijza village and detained a resident.

- **Attack:**

- (i) At 10:40, Israeli forces positioned near Qtana village fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards residents for alleged stoning.
- (ii) At 12:55, Israeli forces positioned in Ras Kabsa area in Abu Dis fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards residents for alleged stoning.
- (iii) At 13:00, Israeli forces positioned at the wall gate near Al-Quds University in Abu Dis rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards residents for alleged stoning and again at 14:00 stormed Al-Quds University campus, clashed with several University students and as a result injured Osama Afana.
- (iv) At 13:25, Israeli forces positioned at Qalandiya checkpoint fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards residents for alleged stoning and as a result injured 2 residents including a child and an Elderly residents: Ahmad Mazen Hussien Shihadeh (16 years old) and Ihsan Kamel Abdel-Rahman Salem (70 years old)
- (v) At 14:20, Israeli forces positioned near Al-Ram and Al-Eisawiya village junctions fired stun and tear gas grenades towards residents for alleged stoning.
- (vi) At 21:30, Israeli forces positioned in Beit Hanina , Bab Huta area and Al-Sa'diya neighbourhood in the old city of Jerusalem fired stun and tear gas grenades towards residents for alleged stoning.
- (vii) At 21:30, Israeli forces positioned in Ras Al-Amoud neighbourhood fired stun and tear gas grenades towards residents for alleged stoning.
- (viii) At 23:30, Israeli forces positioned in Beit Hanina fired stun and tear gas grenades towards residents for alleged stoning.

- **Killing:**

- (i) At 11:30, Israeli forces killed Baha Mohammad Khalil Aliyan (22 years old) {A resident of Jabal Al-Mukabir} after opened fire towards him and another residents (for allegedly opening fire towards and stabbing Israeli settlers inside a bus and as a result killed 2 Israeli settlers and injured 15 others) in Jerusalem and as a result left a resident critically injured then detained him.
- (ii) At 13:00, Israeli forces opened fire towards and killed Ala Abu Jamal ({A resident of Jabal Al-Mukabir} after he allegedly ran over several Israeli settlers with his vehicle.

- **Injury:** At 08:00 Israeli forces assaulted the child Mohammad Hatem Mohammad Ali (13 years old) {A resident of Abu Dis} and as a result left him hospitalised with contusions.

- **Detention:**

- (i) At 04:00 on October 13th 2015, Israeli forces detained five residents: Rami Abu Ramoz, Marwan Abu Maialeh, Ammar Abu Maialeh, Anas Abu Maialeh, and Ibrahim Dandis in Silwan neighbourhood.
- (ii) At 09:30, Israeli forces detained Mohammad Sarhan {A member of Al-Quds Athletic club} in Jerusalem.

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> (iii) At 10:00, Israeli forces detained Shadi Mohammad Omar Khowis. (iv) At 12:40, Israeli forces detained Tarik Khalil Dweik (A resident of Al-Ram) who was critically injured after Israeli forces opened fire towards him in Ra'nan area in Israel for allegedly stabbing an Israeli settler. (v) At 18:20, Israeli forces detained Sufiyan Abu Jamal in Jabal Al-Mukabir neighbourhood. (vi) On October 13th 2015, Israeli forces positioned near Al-Ram junction detained Hamoudeh Yusef Ghazawneh. (vii) At 00:15, Israeli forces detained Ibrahim Al-Hedrah and Mahmoud Abu Al-Hawa in Al-Tur neighbourhood in Jerusalem. (viii) At 00:30, Israeli forces detained Abdel-Hameed Atiyah Ahmad Badawi {A resident of Al-Oroub camp in Hebron} in Abu Dis. (ix) At 04:40, Israeli forces detained three residents: Ramzi Ahmad Owisat, Iyad Ata Owisat and Nader Naji Owisat in Jabal Al-Mukabir neighbourhood. (x) Israeli forces detained Billal Ghanm (who was critically injured after Israeli forces opened fire towards him for allegedly opening fire towards and stabbing Israeli settlers inside a bus and as a result killed two Israeli settlers and injured 15 others). (xi) Israeli forces detained Mohammad Iban Mohammad Abdel-Dik in Abu Dis. (xii) Israeli forces detained Ahmad Al-Dweik and Mohamad Abu Gharbiya in Al-Ram. (xiii) Israeli forces detained Ahmad Hani Saber Khoudari (A resident of Biddo) in Beit Ijza village. • <u>Temporary Detention:</u> At 22:30, Israeli forces positioned near Bab Al-Amoud area in Jerusalem temporarily detained 2 children: Wafa' Maher Al-Majd (13 years old) and Abeer Maher Al-Majd (16 years old) from Al-Sa'diya neighbourhood in the old city of Jerusalem then released them at a later time. • <u>Assault on Places of Worship:</u> At 08:30, a group of Israeli settlers under the protection of Israeli forces stormed Al-Aqsa mosque compound in the old city of Jerusalem and provoked worshipers. • <u>Settler Violence:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 10:50, a group of Israeli settlers assaulted several residents near Road (1) in Jerusalem city. (ii) At 12:00, a group of Israeli settlers assaulted several residents (Labourers) in Al-Mosrara neighbourhood. (iii) At 12:20, an Israeli settler vehicle ran over Hamdi Yahya Mustafa Samhoudi along the main road in Khan Al-Ahmar area and as a result, left him hospitalised with contusions. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the Wall gate in Abu Dis town. (ii) The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate on Al-Shayyah road in the area between Al-Sawahira Al-Sharqiya and Al-Slewahira Al-Gharbiya villages, only allowing civilians holding Jerusalem IDs to cross, after subjecting them to thorough searches using electronic devices.

(ii) On October 3rd 2015, Israeli forces closed the main road located near "Bet El" settlement and leading to Al-Jalazoun camp with cement blocks. (iii) At 19:10, Israeli forces closed the east and west entrances to Deir Nathim villages with cement blocks.

(ii) At 10:30, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Al-Nabi Saleh village and impeded the free flow of traffic after closing the steel gate village entrance. (iii) At 21:50, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Atarah until 22:35. (iv) At 21:55, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Deir Al-Sudan village until 22:35. (v) At 22:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Kafr Ein until 23:00. • <u>Raid:</u> At 00:55, Israeli forces raided Awarta and Kafr Ein village until 05:00. • <u>Attack:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 09:00 and again at 22:20, Israeli forces positioned near Atara Bridge located in North Bir Ziet fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several children for alleged stoning and as a result injured the child: Firas Khaled Al-Khatib (16 years old) {A resident of Bir Ziet}. (ii) At 09:20, Israeli forces positioned near the entrance of Silwad fired live ammunition; rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and as a result injured the child: Mohammad Ayman Mohammad Hamad (15 years old). (iii) At 09:30, Israeli forces positioned near Beit Illo village fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning. (iv) At 13:30, Israeli forces positioned near “Pesagout” settlement located in east Al-Bireh city fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning. (v) At 16:00, Israeli forces positioned at Al-Mahkama checkpoint located near “Beit El” settlement in North Al-Bireh city fired live ammunition, rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning as they were protesting against the continued Israeli military and settler assault on Al-Aqsa mosque compound in the old city of Jerusalem and as a result injured 7 residents including 3 children: Taha Mahmoud Al-Khatib (17 years old), Amir Faraj Zayoud (16 years old), Hussien Jamal Abu Radwan (16 years old), Ibrahim Mohammad Khalil Odeh, Akramam Ahmad Jadallah, Anhar Awad, and Ansar Mahmoud Awad as well as leaving several others suffocated from tear gas inhalation. (vi) At 18:20, Israeli forces positioned near the entrance of Al-Nabi Saleh village fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning. (vii) At 21:20, Israeli forces positioned near Shuqba village fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning. (viii) At 22:10, Israeli forces positioned near the entrance of Turmu’saya fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning. • <u>Detention:</u> Israeli forces detained Mo’ayad Radi Hassan near Shuqba village. • <u>Settler Violence:</u> At 11:00, a group of Israeli settlers positioned near “Shilo” settlement junction stoned residents and vehicles travelling along the main road connecting Ramallah and Nablus and as a result, injured Mohammad Hilmi Abdel-Haleem Qutob leaving him hospitalised with contusions and damaged his vehicle.

	<p>(ii) Since the evening of November 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the western entrance of Ya'bad.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Physical Assault: At 17:10, Israeli forces positioned at Al-Jalma crossing in North Jenin assaulted Mohammad Husam Hantouli leaving him hospitalised with contusions. • Attack: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 13:30, Israeli forces positioned near the wall gate in Al-Taybeh village fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several school children for alleged stoning. (ii) At 14:10, Israeli forces positioned near Al-Jalma crossing in North Jenin fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several children for alleged stoning and as a result left two children suffocated from tear gas inhalation. • Wall Gates: Israeli forces continue to close the wall gate and only allow those holding special permits to enter through it.

<p style="text-align: center;">TULKAREM</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Checkpoint: At 20:00, Israeli forces continue to intensify their restrictions at “Eniv” checkpoint located along the main road connecting Tulkarem and Nablus and impeded the free flow of traffic until 22:35. • Flying Checkpoint: At 16:20, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint in the area between Shufa and Izbet Shufa villages. • Raid: At 03:10, Israeli forces raided Tulkarem, detained 2 residents then withdrew at 04:30. • Detention: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) On October 9th 2015, Israeli forces positioned near the wall gate in Nazlat Issa village detained two residents: Samah Mowafaq Najeeb Khalil (25 years old) {A resident of Nazlat Issa village} and Mowafaq Samih Khalil Jaber (21 years old) {A resident of Baqa Al-Sharqiya}. (ii) Israeli forces detained two residents: Muhanad Jihad Khader Hamshiri and Mohammad Ziyad Abu Zant in Tulkarem. • Wall Gate: At 18:20, Israeli forces closed wall gate (708) in Far'oun village and impeded the free flow of traffic and forced farmers to travel home through Al Taybeh Gate road.

(ii) In addition to closing the gate installed since the outbreak the second Intifada, the Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the eastern entrance to Kafr Qaddum village. (iii) Since 10:40 on September 1st 2015, Israeli forces closed an agricultural road leading to Far'ata village which is located near “Gillad” settlement with a steel Gate. • Flying Checkpoint: At 21:55, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint between Al-Fanduq and Jinsafout villages until 22:30. • Attack: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 12:40, Israeli forces positioned near the entrance of Azzon fired rubber coated steel bullets, fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several school children for alleged stoning and as a result injured Billal Ibrahim Qatish leaving him hospitalised with contusions. (ii) At 21:05, Israeli forces positioned at Al-Jaljoliya gate located in south Qalqiliya fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Settler Violence:</u> At 11:20, a group of Israeli settlers stoned residents and vehicle travelling along the main road connecting Qalqiliya and Nablus then withdrew at 13:35. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to restrict access at ‘Azzun ‘Atma Wall gate and impeded the free flow of traffic. The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the entrance to the village of Wadi Al- Rasha and to deny civilian access. (ii) The Israeli army allows residents to access the village through Gate #109. Having removed the gate at the entrance to the village of Ras Atiya; the Israeli army only allows students to cross to their schools outside the village through the Habla gate.
<p style="text-align: center;">NABLUS</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> Since December 17th 2013, Israeli forces ordered the closure 500 dunumes of land in Qusra village as a closed military area. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the roads of Til-Burin and Beit Furik-Salem; the settler bypass road connecting the village of Deir al Hatab to the settlement of Alon Moreh; the road connecting the town of ‘Aqraba to the village of Osrin; and the detour road between the town of Qabalan and the village of Osrin. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the northern entrance to Qabalan town; the southern entrances to the town of Jamma’in and the villages of Duma and Qaryut. (iii) At 22:00, Israeli forces closed the North entrance of Awarta with dirt mounds. • <u>Checkpoints:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 14:55, Israeli forces closed Beit Furiq checkpoint and impeded the free flow of traffic until 19:30. (iii) At 02:25, Israeli forces raided Beit Furiq, stormed and searched five homes and summoned three residents: Abdallah Yasser Muhammad, Abdallah Jamal Hanani and Najeh Sabti Khatatbah to report to Israeli Intelligence for questioning then withdrew at 06:30. (iv) At 03:10, Israeli forces raided Beit Dajjan village until 04:10. (v) At 04:30, Israeli forces raided Nablus, stormed and searched a home then withdrew at 05:50. • <u>Attack:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 14:35, Israeli forces positioned near “Barghat” settlement located near Huwara checkpoint fired live ammunition, rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and as a result injured 4 residents including a child: Loai Ibrahim Hassan Abu Mustafa (15 years old), Ahmad Mohammad Aref, Abdel-Hadi Qandil and Yahya Abdel-Mu’ ti Qaddumi and also damaged 3 Ambulances after firing live ammunition towards them. (ii) At 15:40, Israeli forces positioned near the west entrance of Beit Furiq live ammunition, rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and as a result injured 2 children: Qassim Mahmoud Hanni (14 years old) and Ahmad Adli Hanni (15 years
