<p>JERUSALEM</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 09:30, the Israeli army continues to intensify their restrictions at the entrance to Jerusalem city, set up several flying checkpoints on the main road leading to the city and prevented worshipers under the age of 50 from conducting prayers at Al-Aqsa mosque compound. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the ‘demarcation area’ along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits. (iii) The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill between Biddu and Beit Ikksa villages. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the entrance to Jaba’ village. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to Beit Ikksa village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandiya checkpoint. • <u>Checkpoints:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli authorities continue to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a “border crossing point” and designate a special crossing lane for holders of Jerusalem IDs and another for those possessing permits to access Jerusalem city and closed the checkpoint at 01:20 and impeded the free flow of traffic until 04:05. (ii) On September 19th 2012, Israeli forces closed Ras Khamis checkpoint near Shu’fat camp and impeded the free flow of traffic in order to construct the wall. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 13:30, Israeli forces raided Al-Sawahra village, clashed with several residents then withdrew at 14:20. (ii) At 01:30, Israeli forces raided Hizma, clashed with several residents then withdrew at 02:00. • <u>Temporary Detention:</u> On October 15th 2014, Israeli forces positioned in Shu’fat neighbourhood temporarily detained Mu’tasim Al-Ja’bari then released him after imposing a 500 NIS fine and sentencing him to house arrest for a period of 5 days. • <u>Physical Assault:</u> At 01:15, Israeli forces positioned at Jaba’ checkpoint assaulted and injured Mohammad Dar Abed (A resident of Al-Bireh City) and as a result left him hospitalised with contusions.. • <u>Attack:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 09:30, Israeli forces positioned near Bab Al-Amoud, near Al-Hisbeh area, near Bab Hata in the old city, Wadi Al-Juz neighbourhood in Jerusalem fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning. (ii) At 12:10, Israeli forces positioned at the entrance of Al-Eizariya fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning. (iii) At 13:30, Israeli forces positioned near Salah Al-Din road in Jerusalem fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning after preventing worshipers from entering Al-Aqsa mosque. (iv) On the evening of October 15th 2014, Israeli forces positioned near Al-Wad road area, near Al-Majlis gate (An entrance gate leading to Al-Aqsa

	<p>mosque compound) in the old city of Jerusalem fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and as a result injured 10 residents including a woman: Marwa Idris, and assaulted Mahmoud Idris and as a result broke his foot leaving him hospitalised with contusions and detained a resident near Bab Al-Majlis.</p> <p>(v) On the evening of October 15th 2014, Israeli forces positioned in Shu'fat neighbourhood fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and as a result injured a resident and left several others suffocated from tear gas inhalation.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Detention:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) On October 14th 2014, Israeli forces positioned at Beit Iksa checkpoint detained Shadi Al-Faqiya (A resident of Qutna village). (ii) At 12:00, Israeli forces detained Faris Shamasneh (A resident of Dahiyat Al-Salam neighbourhood in Jerusalem) for allegedly attempting to assault an Israeli settler in Ras Al-Amoud area in Jerusalem. (iii) At 20:30, Israeli forces detained Mohammad Sayaj in the old city of Jerusalem after assaulting him. (iv) On October 10th 2014, Israeli forces detained Nasser Abbassi (A resident of Silwan). (v) Israeli forces detained Mohammad Abu Sneneh (A Aqsa mosque guard) near Al-Majlis gate. • <u>Assault on Places of Worship:</u> At 09:30, Israeli forces prevented residents below the age of 50 from entering Al-Aqsa mosque compound to allow a group of Israeli settlers under the protection of Israeli police to enter the mosque. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the Wall gate in Abu Dis town. (ii) The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate on Al-Shayyah road in the area between Al-Sawahira Al-Sharqiya and Al-Slewahira Al-Gharbiya villages, only allowing civilians holding Jerusalem IDs to cross, after subjecting them to thorough searches using electronic devices.

(ii) On 15.04.2012, the Israeli army has opened the northern entrance to Salfit city to civilian, which was closed since the year 2000 and prevented access from 08:00 until 09:20. (iii) Since 11:00 on July 30th 2012, Israeli forces have closed two roads leading to Abu Nasar and Qatan Al-Jama' located in western area of Deir Istiya with cement blocks. • <u>Checkpoints:</u> Israeli forces intensified their restrictions at Za'tara checkpoint and impeded the free flow of traffic. • <u>Checkpoint:</u> At 18:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Za'tara village junction and impeded the free flow of traffic. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 15:20, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the east entrance of Marda village, impeded the free flow of traffic after closing the main steel entrance gate then reopened it at 05:50. (ii) At 19:30, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint near Ein Dweik village located in North Jericho until 19:50. • <u>Raid:</u> At 17:30, Israeli forces raided Al-Jiftlik village, stormed two homes then withdrew at 18:00.

(ii) Since 15 September 2007, the Israel army has prevented civilians from accessing or staying on 22 dunumes of confiscated land in Al Mazmuriya area in Beit Sahur and Bethlehem cities. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the Beit Jala-Wadi Ahmed road; a road between Um Tuba and Al-Jass ; a road between Um Tuba and Khilat Nu'man: a road between Um Tuba and the wall; a road between Al-Khas village and the wall; the 2 by pass roads located south of Al-Walaja; a road between Talita Qumi and Nazlat Al-Sider in Beit Jala; the eastern road of Al-Khader; the road between Al-Khader and Beit Jala ; Wadi Rahal road near "Ifrat" settlement ,the road between Al-Khader and road #60 which lead to the eastern neighbourhoods of Bethlehem; a road leading to Wadi Rahal, and a road east of Beit Fajjar town with dirt mounds. (iii) At 18:15, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint near Dar Salah village (located at the east entrance of Beit Sahur), temporarily detained Yusef Al-Eisawi then released them at 22:10. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 02:00 on October 15th 2014, Israeli forces raided Al-Eibat area in Bethlehem, detained a resident after storming and searching his home. (ii) At 18:00, Israeli forces raided Al-Obidiya until 11:05. • <u>Detention:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 21:05, Israeli forces positioned at checkpoint 300 detained Mohammad Fanoun (A residents of Nahalin). <p style="text-align: center;">HEBRON</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close Al-Shuhada' Street, Al-Sahleh and Khuzq Al-Far areas, as well as the old gold market in Hebron's Old City. In addition to closing the entrance to Al-Qeisi neighbourhood, the Israeli army continues to close the entrances to the area of Al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) with an electronic gate; Al-Laban Market also remains closed. (ii) Since 05 January 2009, the Israeli army has closed the area located along the Green Line south of the town of Yatta. Having seized land for Wall construction, the Israeli army evicted the Palestinian residents and denied them access to the area. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Al-Thahiriya and Al-Samoa' towns, Al-'Arrub refugee camp, and Al-Tuwani and Al-Karmil villages. (ii) The Israeli army continues to prohibit Palestinian vehicles from travelling along the old Al-Shalala Street leading to Hebron's Old City. (iii) The Israeli army continues to close all roads leading to Road # 60 as well as detour roads along the settler bypass road leading to Yatta town. (iv) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds a detour road leading to e to Al-Simiya village, the southern entrance of Al-Samou' and the entrance of Beit Annun with cement blocks. (v) Since July 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Safa and Al-Dirat and closed the entrance of south Yatta with cement blocks. (vi) On September 4th 2014, Israeli forces closed a road in Eiw Al-Bas and Al-Bayda and Al-Ras area in Ithna located near the wall gate.

<p>ALL DISTRICTS</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • At 19:00 on August 26th 2014, Palestinian Gunmen and the Israeli military agreed to a cease fire agreement (brokered by the Arab Republic of Egypt) which includes the opening of border crossings to allow the entry of emergency supplies and humanitarian goods as well as construction material and agreed to increase the fishing limit to 6 nautical miles with possibility of increase to 12 nautical miles by the end of the year and to decrease the Military area to 100 meters, allow freedom of movement and a halt to targeted killings and assassinations and negotiations will be held for discussion on rebuilding the sea port and airports in the coming month. • Israeli forces broke the cease-fire agreement by opening fire from their positions behind the Green line towards North Gaza and as a result injured a resident.
