<p style="text-align: center;"><b>SALFIT</b></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b><u>Closure of Main Roads:</u></b></li> <li>(i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the entrance to two detour roads connecting Marda village to its farmland.</li> <li>(ii) On 15.04.2012, the Israeli army has opened the northern entrance to Salfit city to civilian, which was closed since the year 2000 and prevented access from 08:00 until 09:20.</li> <li>(iii) Since 11:00 on July 30<sup>th</sup> 2012, Israeli forces have closed two roads leading to Abu Nasar and Qatan Al-Jama' located in western area of Deir Istiya with cement blocks.</li> <li>(iv) At 09:20 on October 13<sup>th</sup> 2015, Israeli forces closed the West entrance of Kafr Al-Dik with cement blocks.</li> <li>• <b><u>Checkpoint:</u></b> Israeli forces intensified their restrictions at Za'tara checkpoint and impeded the free flow of traffic.</li> <li>• <b><u>Assault on Property:</u></b> At 11:25, Israeli forces prevented Khalid Aibied and Atta Odeh from entering their agricultural land located near "Kafr Tabouh" settlement.</li> <li>• <b><u>Settler Violence:</u></b> At 13:30, a group of Israeli settlers stormed agricultural land located between Yasouf and Al-Sawiya villages and set fire to agricultural land during which Palestinian civil defence forces were able to extinguish the flames.</li> </ul>

**BETHLEHEM**

- **Closure:**
  - (i) The Israeli army continues to close roads to An Nu'man village, with the exception of the road leading to the Wall gate in the south-eastern area of the village.
  - (ii) Since 15 September 2007, the Israel army has prevented civilians from accessing or staying on 22 dunumes of confiscated land in Al Mazmuriya area in Beit Sahur and Bethlehem cities.
- **Closure of Main Roads:**
  - (i) The Israeli army continues to close the Beit Jala-Wadi Ahmed road; a road between Um Tuba and Al-Jass ; a road between Um Tuba and Khilat Nu'man: a road between Um Tuba and the wall; a road between Al-Khas village and the wall; the 2 by pass roads located south of Al-Walaja; a road between Talita Qumi and Nazlat Al-Sider in Beit Jala; the eastern road of Al-Khader; the road between Al-Khader and Beit Jala ; Wadi Rahal road near "Ifrat" settlement ,the road between Al-Khader and road #60 which lead to the eastern neighbourhoods of Bethlehem; a road leading to Wadi Rahal, and a road east of Beit Fajjar town with dirt mounds.
  - (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the road leading to "Newe Daniyyel" settlement and agricultural land in Al-Khader; a road between Um Tuba and Wadi Al-Hums: Wadi Fukin, Al-Jaba, the Green Line; a road between Za'tara and a detour road, and a road between Taqou and Khirbet Al-Deir with cement blocks.
  - (iii) Since August 2<sup>nd</sup> 2012, Israeli forces closed a road leading to Beit Jalla.
  - (iv) Since May 8<sup>th</sup> 2013, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Carmisan area in Beit Jalla and Al-Walaja with a steel gate and barbed wires.
  - (v) Since June 3<sup>rd</sup> 2013, the Israeli army closed the road connecting Nihalin and road 60 with dirt mounds.
  - (vi) Since 13:20 on September 29<sup>th</sup> 2013, the Israeli army closed a road leading to 50 acres of agricultural land in Wadi Salem area in Al-Khadr with dirt mounds.
  - (vii) Israeli forces closed the main road connecting Surif and Al-Jub'a village with dirt mounds.
  - (viii) On January 28<sup>th</sup> 2014, Israeli forces closed the steel gate at the entrance of Nihalin { replacing the dirt mounds placed at the entrance since the year 2002 } and placed time schedule for opening the gate from 06:00 until 14:00 on a daily bases.
  - (ix) Since 10:45 on September 8<sup>th</sup> 2015, Israeli forces closed the agricultural road located in Arab Al-Rashaydeh village located near "Malee Amous" settlement with dirt mounds.
  - (x) At 17:00 on October 8<sup>th</sup> 2015, Israeli forces closed the North entrance of Taqou'.
- **Flying Checkpoint:**
  - (i) At 13:40, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the North entrance of Taqou' until 15:40.
  - (ii) At 18:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Jinata until 19:05.
- **Raid:** at 02:10, Israeli forces raided Bethlehem, Ayda camp, detained a resident after storming, and searching a home in the camp then withdrew at 03:00.
- **Detention:** Israeli forces detained Hazim Mustafa Abu Akr in Ayda camp.
- **Attack:**
  - (i) At 15:00, Israeli forces positioned in the vicinity of Billal Bin Rabah mosque located in North Bethlehem fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and as a result injured 3 residents: Bashar Samir Al-Mi'awi, Ismail Al-Akhras and Basil Waleed Da'asnah and also and left Mahmoud Samer Al-Nashash suffocated from tear gas inhalation.

- (ii) At 17:35, Israeli forces positioned near the entrance of Taqou' fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.
- (iii) At 19:00, Israeli forces positioned near "Murad Tourist resort" located near Dar Salah village (located at the east entrance of Beit Sahour) fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.
- (iv) At 23:05, Israeli forces positioned near the entrance of Husan village fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.

- **Settler Violence:**

- (i) At 13:20, Israeli settlers positioned near "Irfat" settlement stoned residents and vehicles travelling near the area then withdrew at 16:00.
- (ii) At 13:50, Israeli settlers positioned near "Kafar Itsiyon" settlement junction and closed off the main road connecting Bethlehem and Hebron then withdrew at 15:30.



HEBRON

- **Closure:**
  - (i) The Israeli army continues to close
  - (ii) Khuzq Al-Far areas, as well as the old gold market in Hebron's Old City. In addition to closing the entrance to Al-Qeisi neighbourhood, the Israeli army continues to close the entrances to the area of Al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) with an electronic gate; Al-Laban Market also remains closed.
  - (iii) Since 05 January 2009, the Israeli army has closed the area located along the Green Line south of the town of Yatta. Having seized land for Wall construction, the Israeli army evicted the Palestinian residents and denied them access to the area.
- **Closure of Main Roads:**
  - (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances Al-Karmil villages.
  - (ii) The Israeli army continues to prohibit Palestinian vehicles from travelling along the old Al-Shalala Street leading to Hebron's Old City.
  - (iii) The Israeli army continues to close all roads leading to Road # 60 as well as detour roads along the settler bypass road leading to Yatta town.
  - (iv) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds a detour road leading to e to Al-Simiya village, the southern entrance of Al-Samou' and the entrance of Beit Annun with cement blocks.
  - (v) Since July 25<sup>th</sup> 2012, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Safa and Al-Dirat and closed the entrance of south Yatta with cement blocks.
  - (vi) At 11:00 on August 6<sup>th</sup> 2015, Israeli forces closed the entrance of Al-Hajara village located in south Dura with cement blocks.
- **Raid:** At 00:50, Israeli forces raided Khursa village stormed and searched two homes and summoned Abdel-Rahman Halahla to report to Israeli Intelligence for questioning then withdrew at 06:00.
- **Temporary Detention:** At 15:35, Israeli forces positioned near Tafouh temporarily detained two residents including a child: Hamza Musa Al-Tarda (16 years old) and Mustafa Musa Al-Tard {both residents of Tafouh}.
- **Attack:**
  - (i) At 18:35, Israeli forces positioned near Al-Oroub camp fired live ammunition; rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents at the entrance of the camp for alleged stoning.
  - (ii) At 20:45, Israeli forces positioned near Khursa village junction fired, rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.
- **Detention:**
  - (i) At 02:00 on October 15<sup>th</sup> 2015, Israeli forces detained two residents including a child: Khaled Marwan Abu Aisha (16 years old) and Sharif Nasser Al-Haymouni during their raid into Hebron as mentioned in the previous report.
  - (ii) At 14:35, Israeli forces positioned near "Ador" settlement detained the child Abdel-Rahman Abu Sbieh (17 years old) {A resident of Al-Thahriya} for allegedly finding a knife in his possession.
- **Settler Violence:**
  - (i) At 15:40, a group of Israeli settlers positioned near Al-Fah's area located in south Hebron assaulted the child Firaf Ayyad Jimad (15 years old) and as a result, left him hospitalised with a fractured foot.
  - (ii) At 16:05, an Israeli settler positioned near Khursa village junction opened fire towards several children in the area.
