WEST BANK

• Closure:

- (i) On October 17th 2015, the Israeli army, continues to intensify their restrictions at the entrance to Jerusalem city, set up several flying checkpoints on the main road leading to the city and prevented worshipers from conducting prayers at Al-Aqsa mosque compound and prevented residents entering the mosque.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the 'demarcation area' along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits.
- (iii) The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill between Biddu and Beit Iksa villages.

• Closure of Main Roads:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the entrance to Jaba' village.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to Beit Iksa village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandiya checkpoint.
- (iii) On October 14th 2015, Israeli forces closed the main road leading to Al-Eisawiya village with cement blocks.
- (iv) On October 14th 2015, Israeli forces closed the 4 entrances of Jabal Al-Mukabir neighbourhood with cement blocks.
- (v) On October 14th 2015, Israeli forces closed the three entrances of Sur Bahar with Cement blocks.

(vi) On October 14th 2015, Israeli forces closed the entrance of Al-Tur neighbourhood (leading to Al-Za'im village in Jericho and Al-Eizariya) and Suliman French road with cement blocks.

- (vii) On October 14th 2015, Israeli forces closed the entrance of Wadi Al-Rabaybeh area in Silwan neighbourhood in Jerusalem with cement blocks.
- Flying Checkpoint: At 10:30, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Anata.
- Raid: At 03:00, Israeli forces raided Qalandiya camp and Kafr Aqab village, clashed with several residents as they stormed and searched several homes in both Qalandiya camp and Kafr Aqab village and as a result injured 3 unidentified residents and detained a resident in Qalandiya camp then withdrew at 06:15.
- Attack: At 20:40, Israeli forces positioned at Qalandiya checkpoint rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards residents for alleged stoning and as a result injured Wajdi Masalmeh (A resident of Balata camp in Nablus).

Killing:

- (i) At 08:30, Israeli forces opened fire towards and killed the child Mu'taz Ahmad Owisat (16 years old) {A resident of Jabal Al-Mukabir neighbourhood} near "Armon Hantsiv" settlement located in Jabal Al-Mukabir for allegedly attempting to stab an Israeli soldier.
- (ii) At 20:30, Israeli forces opened fire towards and killed Omar Mohammad Al-Faqieh (23 years old) {A resident of Qatana village} near Qalandiya checkpoint located in North Jerusalem for allegedly attempting to stab an Israeli soldier.

• <u>Detention</u>:

(i) At 08:30, Israeli forces detained Majdi Abdel-Jawad Halaqiya (a resident of Al-Eisawiya village).

JERUSALEM

	 (ii) At 21:05, Israeli forces positioned at Shu'fat checkpoint detained Suhayeb Abu Sa'id (A resident of Shu'fat camp). (iii) Israeli forces detained Ahmad Ibrahim Mohammad Abdallah in Qalandiya camp. Wall Gates: (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the Wall gate in Abu Dis town. (ii) The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate on Al-Shayyah road in the area between Al-Sawahira Al-Sharqiya and Al-Slewahira Al-Gharbiya villages, only allowing civilians holding Jerusalem IDs to cross, after subjecting them to thorough searches using electronic devices.

RAMALLAH & AL BIREH	 (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Sinjil village well as the junction to Kafr Malik and 'Ein Samiya villages. (ii) On October 3rd 2015, Israeli forces closed the main road located near "Bet El" settlement and leading to Al-Jalazoun camp with cement blocks. (iii) At 18:40 on October 16th 2015, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Silwad and Deir Jreir village {Located near Ofrat" settlement} and the road connecting Silwad and Ain Yabroud village with dirt mounds. Flying Checkpoint: At 24:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint near Atarah bridge located in North Bir Ziet. Attack: (i) At 13:30, Israeli forces positioned at Al-Makhakma checkpoint located near "Beit El" settlement in North Al-Bireh city fired live ammunition, rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning as they were protesting against the continued Israeli military and settler assault on Al Agas mosque compound in the old.
	Israeli military and settler assault on Al-Aqsa mosque compound in the old city of Jerusalem and as a result injured 3 children: Ali Khader Abu Daya (17 years old), Ghassan Mohammad Musa (17 years old) and Moath Ahmad Al-Khatib (15 years old) as well as leaving 8 others suffocated from tear gas inhalation. (ii) At 13:45, Israeli forces positioned near the entrance of Silwad fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning. (iii) At 17:10, Israeli forces positioned near Budrus village fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning. • Settler Violence: At 09:35, a group of Israeli settlers positioned near "Halamish" settlement stormed agricultural land and assaulted several residents and farmers as they were collecting Olive harvest and threatened them with weapons forcing them to leave the area then withdrew at 10:20.
JENIN	 Closure of Main Road: (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the road leading to the town of 'Arraba east of the illegal settlement Dotan. (ii) Since the evening of November 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the western entrance of Ya'bad. Wall Gates: Israeli forces continue too close the wall gate and only allow those holding special permits to enter through it.
TUBAS	Physical Assault: At 12:30, Israeli forces positioned in Al-Buqay'a area in east Tammoun assaulted Nabil Aqab Bani Odeh (A resident of Tamoun) as he was working on his buldoser.
TULKAREM	 <u>Checkpoint:</u> At 12:00, Israeli forces continue to intensify their restrictions at "Eniv" checkpoint located along the main road connecting Tulkarem and Nablus and impeded the free flow of traffic.

• Closure of Roads:

- (i) Israeli forces continue to close with cement blocks agricultural roads east of Azzun town.
- (ii) In addition to closing the gate installed since the outbreak the second Intifada, the Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the eastern entrance to Kafr Qaddum village.
- (iii) Since 10:40 on September 1st 2015, Israeli forces closed an agricultural road leading to Far'ata village, which is located near "Gillad" settlement with a steel Gate.
- <u>Temporary Detention:</u> At 18:35, Israeli forces positioned at the entrance of Azzun temporarily detained two children: Oday Jamal Al-Sa'our (16 years old) and Ahmad Jamal Al-Sa'our (14 years old) {Both residents of Ramallah then released them at 02:00.
- <u>Attack:</u> At 17:00, Israeli forces positioned at Al-Jaljoliya gate located in south Qalqiliya fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and as a result injured Ameed Mohammad Zamari and left 6 other suffocated from tear gas inhalation.

QALQILIYA

• <u>Demonstration</u>: At 16:00, a demonstration took place in Kafr Qaddum village protesting against the Israeli militaries closure of the village east entrance during which Israeli forces fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents to prevent them from reaching the demonstration site.

• Wall Gates:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to restrict access at 'Azzun 'Atma Wall gate and impeded the free flow of traffic. The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the entrance to the village of Wadi Al- Rasha and to deny civilian access.
- (ii) The Israeli army allows residents to access the village through Gate #109. Having removed the gate at the entrance to the village of Ras Atiya; the Israeli army only allows students to cross to their schools outside the village through the Habla gate.
- <u>Closure:</u> Since December 17th 2013, Israeli forces ordered the closure 500 dunumes of land in Qusra village as a closed military area.

• Closure of Main Roads:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close the roads of Til-Burin and Beit Furik-Salem; the settler bypass road connecting the village of Deir al Hatab to the settlement of Alon Moreh; the road connecting the town of 'Aqraba to the village of Osrin; and the detour road between the town of Oabalan and the village of Osrin.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the northern entrance to Qabalan town; the southern entrances to the town of Jamma'in and the villages of Duma and Qaryut.
- (iii) At 22:00, Israeli forces closed the North entrance of Awarta with dirt mounds.
- <u>Checkpoints:</u> At 14:55, Israeli forces closed Beit Furiq checkpoint and impeded the free flow of traffic until 18:45.

• Flying Checkpoint:

- (i) At 11:35, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Al-Naqoura village junction until 14:00
- (ii) At 18:55, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Deir Sharaf village junction.
- (iii) At 21:10, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Sabastiya village.
- Raid: At 03:20, Israeli forces raided Nablus and clashed with several residents.
- Attack: At 14:50, Israeli forces positioned near the west entrance of Beit Furiq live ammunition, rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.
- Settler Violence:

NABLUS

	 (i) At 10:00, a group of Israeli settlers stormed the area between Burin and Madma villages and assaulted several residents then withdrew at 10:35. (ii) At 02:00, a group of Israeli settlers riding 5 vehicles stormed Nablus and attempted to enter Joseph's tomb during which Palestinian National Security forces prevented the vehicles from entering the Tomb area and then handed over the settlers to Israeli forces after a group of Palestinian residents set fire to Joseph's tomb at 02:30. (iii) At 03:10, a group of Israeli settlers riding in 2 vehicles stormed the outskirts of Burin village then withdrew at 04:30.
	Closure of Main Roads:
SALFIT	 (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the entrance to two detour roads connecting Marda village to its farmland. (ii) On 15.04.2012, the Israeli army has opened the northern entrance to Salfit city to civilian which was closed since the year 2000 and prevented access from 08:00 until 09:20. (iii) Since 11:00 on July 30th 2012, Israeli forces have closed two roads leading to Abu Nasar and Qatan Al-Jama' located in western area of Deir Istiya with cement blocks. (iv) At 09:20 on October 13th 2015, Israeli forces closed the west entrance of Kafr Al-Dik with cement blocks. • Checkpoint: Israeli forces intensified their restrictions at Za'tara checkpoint and impeded the free flow of traffic. • Raid: (i) At 21:00, Israeli forces raided Kafr Al-Dik, occupied Nabil Wasef Abdel-Majid's home and converted its rooftop into a military post then withdrew at 04:00. (ii) At 00:55, Israeli forces raided Salfit, clashed with several residents as they stormed a home and summoned Ali Khalil Omar Fatouni to report to Israeli Intelligence for questioning then withdrew at 01:50. (iii) At 02:00, Israeli forces raided Harris village, stormed 2 homes and summoned Sharif Waleed Abdel-Azziz Qassim to report to Israeli Intelligence for questioning then withdrew at 02:30. • Detention: (i) At 19:40, Israeli forces positioned at Za'tara junction checkpoint detained 2 National Security Force officers: Amjad Abdel-Raheem Ghanam and Qutayba Khaled Al-Shawish. (ii) At 22:10, Israeli forces positioned at Za'tara junction checkpoint detained Jaffar Mohammad Abdallah Mawal (A resident of Silat Al-Thaher in Jenin District).
JERICHO	 <u>Checkpoints:</u> Israeli forces intensified its restrictions at Al-Hamra checkpoint set up along the road connecting Jericho and Nablus District. <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 23:35, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the south entrance of Jericho until 21:15. <u>Raid:</u> At 17:15, Israeli forces raided Al-Oja village until 17:35.
BETHLEHEM	 Closure: The Israeli army continues to close roads to An Nu'man village, with the exception of the road leading to the Wall gate in the south-eastern area of the village. Since 15 September 2007, the Israel army has prevented civilians from accessing or staying on 22 dunumes of confiscated land in Al Mazmuriya area in Beit Sahur and Bethlehem cities. Closure of Main Roads: The Israeli army continues to close the Beit Jala-Wadi Ahmed road; a road between Um Tuba and Al-Jass; a road between Um Tuba and Khilat Nu'man:

- a road between Um Tuba and the wall; a road between Al-Khas village and the wall; the 2 by pass roads located south of Al-Walaja; a road between Talita Qumi and Nazlat Al-Sider in Beit Jala; the eastern road of Al-Khader; the road between Al-Khader and Beit Jala; Wadi Rahal road near "Ifrat" settlement, the road between Al-Khader and road #60 which lead to the eastern neighbourhoods of Bethlehem; a road leading to Wadi Rahal, and a road east of Beit Fajjar town with dirt mounds.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the road leading to "Newe Daniyyel" settlement and agricultural land in Al-Khader; a road between Um Tuba and Wadi Al-Hums: Wadi Fukin, Al-Jaba, the Green Line; a road between Za'tara and a detour road, and a road between Taqou and Khirbet Al-Deir with cement blocks.
- (iii) Since August 2nd 2012, Israeli forces closed a road leading to Beit Jalla.
- (iv) Since May 8th 2013, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Carmisan area in Beit Jalla and Al-Walaja with a steel gate and barbed wires.
- (v) Since June 3rd 2013, the Israeli army closed the road connecting Nihalin and road 60 with dirt mounds.
- (vi) Since 13:20 on September 29th 2013, the Israeli army closed a road leading to 50 acres of agricultural land in Wadi Salem area in Al-Khadr with dirt mounds.
- (vii) Israeli forces closed the main road connecting Surif and Al-Jub'a village with dirt mounds.
- (viii) On January 28th 2014, Israeli forces closed the steel gate at the entrance of Nihalin { replacing the dirt mounds placed at the entrance since the year 2002} and placed time schedule for opening the gate from 06:00 until 14:00 on a daily bases.
- (ix) At 10:45 on September 8th 2015, Israeli forces closed the agricultural road located in Arab Al-Rashaydeh village located near "Malee Amoush" settlement with dirt mounds.
- (x) At 17:00 on September 8th 2015 Israeli forces closed the North entrance of Tagou'.

• Raid:

- (i) At 18:15, Israeli forces raided Al-Minah village located in south Taqou' until 18:35.
- (ii) At 01:15, Israeli forces raided Taqou', stormed and searched 10 homes and detained 4 residents including 3 children.
- (iii) At 04:20, Israeli forces raided Al-Khader, stormed several homes, detained a resident then withdrew at 04:45.

• Detention:

- (i) Israeli force detained 4 residents including 3 children: Oday Izzat Abdallah Al-Amour (15 years old), Qusay Mohammad Ahmad Al-Amour (17 years old), Muhanad Nimer Al-Amour (15 years old) and Musa Izzat Musa Al-Badan during their raid into Taqou'.
- (ii) Israeli forces detained Qusay Ahmad Issa in Al-Khader.

• Attack:

- (i) At 13:30, Israeli forces positioned in the vicinity of Billal Bin Rabah mosque located in North Bethlehem fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.
- (ii) At 18:30, Israeli forces positioned near "Murad Tourist Resort" located near Dar Salah village near the east entrance of Beit Sahour fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.

• Closure:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close Khuzq Al-Far areas, as well as the old gold market in Hebron's Old City. In addition to closing the entrance to Al-Qeisi neighbourhood, the Israeli army continues to close the entrances to the area of Al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) with an electronic gate; Al-Laban Market also remains closed.
- (ii) Since 05 January 2009, the Israeli army has closed the area located along the Green Line south of the town of Yatta. Having seized land for Wall construction, the Israeli army evicted the Palestinian residents and denied them access to the area.

• Closure of Main Roads:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Al-Karmil villages.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to prohibit Palestinian vehicles from travelling along the old Al-Shalala Street leading to Hebron's Old City.
- (iii) The Israeli army continues to close all roads leading to Road # 60 as well as detour roads along the settler bypass road leading to Yatta town.
- (iv) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds a detour road leading to e to Al-Simiya village, the southern entrance of Al-Samou' and the entrance of Beit Annun with cement blocks.
- (v) Since July 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Safa and Al-Dirat and also closed the entrance of south Yatta with cement blocks.
- (vi) At 11:00 on August 6th 2015, Israeli forces closed the entrance of Al-Hajara village located in south Dura with cement blocks.
- **Raid:** At 03:10, Israeli forces raided Hebron.

• Attack:

- (i) At 09:20, Israeli forces positioned in Bab Al-Zawiya area in Hebron fired live ammunition, rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and as a result injured 5 residents: Shafiq Ayoub Abu Halawa, Musa Zied Al-Natsheh, Nisreen Raed Amro, Mu'taz Haytham Sa'id and Mohammad Ahmad Dandis.
- (ii) At 11:15, Israeli forces positioned in Ras Al-Jurat area located in North Hebron fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning as they were protesting against the Israeli military and settler assault on Al-Aqsa mosque compound in the old city of Jerusalem and as a result injured Ali Aliyan Irziqat.
- (iii) At 12:05, Israeli forces positioned at Halhoul Bridge fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.
- (iv) At 18:50, Israeli forces positioned near the entrance of Beit Awwa fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.
- (v) At 20:50, Israeli forces positioned in Tal'at Abu Hadeed area in the old city of Hebron fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.

Killing:

- (i) At 08:20, Fadil Mohammad Awad Al-Qawasmi (18 years old) {a resident of Hebron} was killed after an Israeli settler opened fire towards him along Al-Shuhada road in the old city of Hebron.
- (ii) At 11:45, the child Bayan Ayman Abdel-Wahab Al-Isseli (16 years old){A resident of Hebron} was killed after Israeli forces opened fire towards her in Wadi Al-Gharous area located east of the old city of Hebron for allegedly attempting to stab an Israeli soldier.
- (iii) At 19:20, Tariq Ziyad Al-Natsheh (18 years old) {A resident of Hebron} was kill after Israeli forces opened fire towards him along Al-Shuhada road in the old city of Hebron for allegedly attempting to stab an Israeli soldier.

• <u>Detention:</u>

HEBRON

- (i) On October 16th 2015, Israeli forces detained 2 residents including a child: Ahmad Jamal Al-Ja'bari (16 years old) and Mohammad Jum'a Al-Ja'brai after storming their homes in the old city of Hebron.
- (ii) At 02:45, Israeli forces detained Sanad Khalifeh Da'na in the old city of Hebron.

• Settler Violence:

- (i) At 23:50, a group of Israeli settlers positioned near "Kiryat Arba" settlement in the old city of Hebron threw stones and glass bottles towards several homes and residents in the villages near the settlement in the old city of Hebron {the home of Sa'id Da'na and Al-Awwawi family home} during which Israeli forces fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents as they attempted to prevent the settler attack and as a result injured 2 residents: Obeida Hussein Murad Al-Ghazawi and Rafiq Suliman Al-Zour.
- (ii) At 02:35, a group of Israeli settlers stormed Al-Hasba area in the in the old city of Hebron and opened fire towards residents and homes.

GAZA STRIP

At 19:00 on August 26th 2014, Palestinian Gunmen and the Israeli military agreed to a cease fire agreement (brokered by the Arab Republic of Egypt) which includes the opening of border crossings to allow the entry of emergency supplies and humanitarian goods as well as construction material and agreed to increase the fishing limit to 6 nautical miles with possibility of increase to 12 nautical miles by the end of the year and to decrease the Military area to 100 meters, allow freedom of movement and a halt to targeted killings and assassinations and negotiations will be ALL held for discussion on rebuilding the sea port and airports in the coming month. DISTRICTS Israeli forces broke the ceasefire agreement by opening fire from their positions behind the Green Line towards Gaza and Central Gaza and as a result injured 4 residents. Israeli Naval vessels broke the cease fire agreement by opening fire towards Palestinian fishing boats off the shores of North Gaza. Palestinian Gunmen broke the cease fire agreement by opening fire towards an Israeli military vehicle behind the border fence as alleged by the Israeli Military.

Closure of Crossing Point: Beit Hanun (Erez) is closed Attack: At 01:30, Israeli Naval vessels opened fire towards Palestinian fishing boats off the shores of Al-Waha area located in North West Beit Lahiya. Palestinian Attack: At 22:30, Palestinian gunmen launched projectiles towards the Green Line as alleged by the Israeli Military. (i) Closure of Crossing Points: (ii) Al-Muntar (Karni) Crossing is closed. Beginning on 02 March 2011, the Crossing has been effectively closed following a unilateral Israeli decision. (iii) Al-Shija'iya (Nahal 'Oz) Crossing is closed. Beginning on 04 January 2010, the Crossing has closed following a unilateral Israeli decision.
