<p>JERUSALEM</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army, intensified their restrictions at the entrance to Jerusalem city, set up several flying checkpoints on the main road leading to the city and prevented worshippers under the age of 50 from conducting prayers at Al-Aqsa mosque compound. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the ‘demarcation area’ along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits. (iii) The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill between Biddu and Beit Ikksa villages. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the entrance to Jaba’ village. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to Beit Ikksa village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandiya checkpoint. • <u>Checkpoints:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli authorities continue to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a “border crossing point” and designate a special crossing lane for holders of Jerusalem IDs and another for those possessing permits to access Jerusalem city and closed the checkpoint at 01:20 and impeded the free flow of traffic until 04:05. (ii) On September 19th 2012, Israeli forces closed Ras Khamis checkpoint near Shu’fat camp and impeded the free flow of traffic in order to construct the wall. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 08:00, Israeli forces raided Qutna village and detained a resident after storming his home. (ii) At 01:25, Israeli forces raided Al-Jib village, stormed a Gas Station, confiscated surveillance camera footage then withdrew at 02:00. • <u>Detention:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) On October 19th 2014, Israeli forces positioned near Al-Absat gate (a main gate entrance leading to Al-Aqsa mosque compound detained Mus’ab Sinokrot (A resident of Jerusalem) as he was leaving from Al-Aqsa mosque. (ii) At 08:00, Israeli forces detained Thaer Asaliya in the old city of Jerusalem. (iii) At 08:00, Israeli forces detained Ehab Al-Hadarat in Al-Tur neighbourhood in Jerusalem. (iv) Israeli forces detained Ra’uf Hushah in Qutna village. • <u>Attack:</u> On the evening of October 20th 2014, Israeli forces positioned in Silwan neighbourhood in Jerusalem fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents as they stoned a home seized by Israeli settlers. • <u>Assault on Places of Worship:</u> At 09:00, Israeli settlers under the protection of Israeli forces stormed Al-Aqsa mosque compound and provoked worshippers.

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Wall Gates:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the Wall gate in Abu Dis town. (ii) The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate on Al-Shayyah road in the area between Al-Sawahira Al-Sharqiya and Al-Slewahira Al-Gharbiya villages, only allowing civilians holding Jerusalem IDs to cross, after subjecting them to thorough searches using electronic devices.
<p style="text-align: center;">RAMALLAH & AL BIREH</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Sinjil village well as the junction to Kafr Malik and ‘Ein Samiya villages. (ii) Since September 3rd 2013, Israeli forces closed the north east entrance of Al-Mughier village with dirt mounds. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 20:10, Israeli forces raided Dura Al-Qare’ village, surveyed land near Beit El settlement for alleged infiltration into the settlement and hurling fire bombs inside it. (ii) At 03:30, Israeli forces raided Budrus village, stormed three homes then withdrew at 05:00. • <u>Attack:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 14:00, Israeli forces positioned at the entrance of Sinjil fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades for alleged stoning and firebombing. (ii) At 16:25, Israeli forces positioned near “Pesagout” settlement located in east Al-Bireh city fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades for alleged stoning.

(ii) Since the evening of November 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the western entrance of Ya’bad.

(ii) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the detour road leading to Ramin village along the Tulkarem-Nablus main road. (iii) On August 5th 2014, Israeli forces closed the main steel gate and placed cement block along the road connecting Shufa and Izbit Shufa villages near “Aveni Hivits”. • <u>Checkpoint:</u> The Israeli Military continues to intensify their restrictions at “Eniv” checkpoint. • <u>Raid:</u> At 12:10, Israeli forces raided Far’un village until 13:00.

(ii) In addition to closing the gate installed since the outbreak the second Intifada, the Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the eastern entrance to Kafr Qaddum village. (iii) At 12:10 on September 2nd 2014, Israeli forces closed the main road connecting Qalqiliya and Nablus near Al-Nabi Eliyas village with cement blocks. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 15:50, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the east entrance of Qalqiliya. • <u>Raid:</u>

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 10:40, Israeli forces raided the area between Hajja and Al-Faduq villages, took photographs of the area, and served a halt to construction order for the expansion of a barracks owned by Yasser Salameh for allegedly being built without proper licencing because of its location in area C. (ii) At 04:20, Israeli forces raided Qalqiliya, stormed two homes, detained a resident then withdrew at 06:40. • <u>Detention:</u> Israeli forces detained Ibrahim Shana'a in Qalqiliya. • <u>Settler Violence:</u> At 18:00, a group of Israeli settlers stormed the main road near Al-Nabi Eliyas village then withdrew at 18:20. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to restrict access at 'Azzun 'Atma Wall gate and impeded the free flow of traffic. The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the entrance to the village of Wadi Al- Rasha and to deny civilian access. (ii) The Israeli army allows residents to access the village through Gate #109. Having removed the gate at the entrance to the village of Ras Atiya; the Israeli army only allows students to cross to their schools outside the village through the Habla gate.
<p style="text-align: center;">NABLUS</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> Since December 17th 2013, Israeli forces ordered the closure 500 dunumes of land in Qusra village as a closed military area. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the roads of Til-Burin and Beit Furik-Salem; the settler bypass road connecting the village of Deir al Hatab to the settlement of Alon Moreh; the road connecting the town of 'Aqraba to the village of Osrin; and the detour road between the town of Qabalan and the village of Osrin. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the northern entrance to Qabalan town; the southern entrances to the town of Jamma'in and the villages of Duma and Qaryut. • <u>Checkpoint:</u> At 19:50, Israeli forces intensified their restrictions at Huwara checkpoint and impeded the free flow of traffic until 20:30. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 18:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint near the entrance of Beit Dajan village until 22:50. (ii) At 18:50, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Burin village until 20:30. (iii) At 07:20, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Awarta. (iv) At 07:40, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint in the area between Burin and Badma villages and prevented residents from entering Madma village. • <u>Raid:</u> At 19:00, Israeli forces raided Burin village, for an alleged firebombing of an Israeli Military vehicle, then stormed a home and assaulted Ahmad Al-Terwai then withdrew at 20:30. • <u>Attack:</u> At 18:00, Israeli forces positioned along the main road connecting Nablus and Assira Al-Shimaliya, opened fire near Burqa village, took photographs of the area then withdrew later. • <u>Settler Violence:</u> At 13:05, Israeli settlers stormed Al-Masaudiya village located near Burqa, took photographs near Burqa village, took photographs of the area then withdrew at 14:00.
<p style="text-align: center;">SALFIT</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the entrance to two detour roads connecting Marda village to its farmland. (ii) On 15.04.2012, the Israeli army has opened the northern entrance to Salfit city to civilian, which was closed since the year 2000 and prevented access from

	<p>08:00 until 09:20.</p> <p>(iii) Since 11:00 on July 30th 2012, Israeli forces have closed two roads leading to Abu Nasar and Qatan Al-Jama' located in western area of Deir Istiya with cement blocks.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Checkpoints:</u> At 08:30 and again at 20:15, Israeli forces intensified their restrictions at Za'tara checkpoint and impeded the free flow of traffic and temporarily detained Mohammad Marshoud (A resident of Balata camp) for allegedly carrying a knife then released him at 22:00. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 17:50, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the West entrance of Bruqin until 19:15. (ii) At 18:20, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the West entrance of Deir Istiya until 19:30. • <u>Settler Violence:</u> At 15:15, a group of Israeli settlers stormed agricultural land in Al-Zawiya and chopped off 100 Olive trees.
<p style="text-align: center;">JERICHO</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Checkpoints:</u> Israeli forces intensified its restrictions at Al-Hamra checkpoint set up along the road connecting Jericho and Nablus District. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 08:05, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Al-Oja village junction until 19:15. (ii) At 20:10, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the Dead Sea junction, temporarily detained Mohammad Abu Eid (A National Security Force Officer) then released him at 22:10. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 07:00 on October 20th 2014, Israeli forces raided Khirbiet Abu Allan area near Al-Jiftlik village, demolished 5 Barracks and 1 livestock den owned by Mohammad Al-Masri, Wadi' Daraghmeh, Mohammad Abu Aram and Qadri Bani Odeh for allegedly being built in Area C without a proper licence temporarily. (ii) At 08:00, Israeli forces raided Fasayil village demolished two barracks owned by Abed Rashaydeh for allegedly being built in Area C without a proper licence temporarily.
<p style="text-align: center;">BETHLEHEM</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close roads to An Nu'man village, with the exception of the road leading to the Wall gate in the south-eastern area of the village. (ii) Since 15 September 2007, the Israel army has prevented civilians from accessing or staying on 22 dunumes of confiscated land in Al Mazmuriya area in Beit Sahur and Bethlehem cities. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the Beit Jala-Wadi Ahmed road; a road between Um Tuba and Al-Jass ; a road between Um Tuba and Khilat Nu'man: a road between Um Tuba and the wall; a road between Al-Khas village and the wall; the 2 by pass roads located south of Al-Walaja; a road between Talita Qumi and Nazlat Al-Sider in Beit Jala; the eastern road of Al-Khader; the road between Al-Khader and Beit Jala ; Wadi Rahal road near "Ifrat" settlement ,the road between Al-Khader and road #60 which lead to the eastern neighbourhoods of Bethlehem; a road leading to Wadi Rahal, and a road east of Beit Fajjar town with dirt mounds. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the road leading to "Newe Daniyyel" settlement and agricultural land in Al-Khader; a road between Um Tuba and Wadi Al-Hums: Wadi Fukin, Al-Jaba, the Green Line; a road between Za'tara and a detour road, and a road between Taqou and Khirbet Al-Deir with cement blocks. (iii) Since August 2nd 2012, Israeli forces closed a road leading to Beit Jalla.

(vi) Since 13:20 on September 29th 2013, the Israeli army closed a road leading to 50 acres of agricultural land in Wadi Salem area in Al-Khadr with dirt mounds. (vii) Israeli forces closed the main road connecting Surif and Al-Jub'a village with dirt mounds. (ii) At 16:20, Israeli forces raided Taqou', occupied the rooftop Samir Al-Amours home and converted it into a military post and clashed with residents then withdrew at 17:30. • <u>Attack:</u> At 17:30, Israeli forces positioned near Al-Ayda camp in Bethlehem fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.
<p style="text-align: center;">HEBRON</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close Al-Shuhada' Street, Al-Sahleh and Khuzq Al-Far areas, as well as the old gold market in Hebron's Old City. In addition to closing the entrance to Al-Qeisi neighbourhood, the Israeli army continues to close the entrances to the area of Al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) with an electronic gate; Al-Laban Market also remains closed. (ii) Since 05 January 2009, the Israeli army has closed the area located along the Green Line south of the town of Yatta. Having seized land for Wall construction, the Israeli army evicted the Palestinian residents and denied them access to the area. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Al-Thahiriya and Al-Samoa' towns, Al-'Arrub refugee camp, and Al-Tuwani and Al-Karmil villages. (ii) The Israeli army continues to prohibit Palestinian vehicles from travelling along the old Al-Shalala Street leading to Hebron's Old City. (iii) The Israeli army continues to close all roads leading to Road # 60 as well as detour roads along the settler bypass road leading to Yatta town. (iv) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds a detour road leading to e to Al-Simiya village, the southern entrance of Al-Samou' and the entrance of Beit Annun with cement blocks. (v) Since July 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Safa and Al-Dirat and closed the entrance of south Yatta with cement blocks. (vi) On September 4th 2014, Israeli forces closed a road in Eiwn Al-Bas and Al-Bayda and Al-Ras area in Ithna locat6ed near the wall gate. (vii) At 13:40 on September 16th 2014, Israeli forces closed the main road leading to Al-Ibrahim mosque in the old city of Hebron. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 18:25, Israeli forces raided Al-Tabaqa village until 19:00. (ii) At 02:00, Israeli forces raided Al-Thahriya, stormed and searched a home then withdrew at 05:30.

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Detention:</u> At 18:20, Israeli forces positioned near “Karmi Itsur” located in south Beit Ummar detained the child Amir Odeh (16 years old) after he was bit by a Israeli Military dog who was unleashed towards alleged stoning. • <u>Attack:</u> At 16:50, Israeli forces positioned near Al-Tabaqa village junction fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.

<p>ALL DISTRICTS</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • At 19:00 on August 26th 2014, Palestinian Gunmen and the Israeli military agreed to a cease fire agreement (brokered by the Arab Republic of Egypt) which includes the opening of border crossings to allow the entry of emergency supplies and humanitarian goods as well as construction material and agreed to increase the fishing limit to 6 nautical miles with possibility of increase to 12 nautical miles by the end of the year and to decrease the Military area to 100 meters, allow freedom of movement and a halt to targeted killings and assassinations and negotiations will be held for discussion on rebuilding the sea port and airports in the coming month.

<p>GAZA</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Crossing Points:</u> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Al-Muntar (Karni) Crossing is closed. Beginning on 02 March 2011, the Crossing has been effectively closed following a unilateral Israeli decision. (ii) Al-Shija’iya (Nahal ‘Oz) Crossing is closed. Beginning on 04 January 2010, the Crossing has closed following a unilateral Israeli decision.
<p>RAFAH</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Crossing Points :</u> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Yasser ‘Arafat International Airport remains closed. (ii) Rafah (<i>Al ‘Awdah</i>) Crossing is open for the entry and exit of residents, students, tourists and businesspersons. (iii) Sufa Crossing is closed. (iv) Karm Abu Salem (Karem Shalom) Crossing is open for the entry of tourist and foreign diplomats and the entry of Humanitarian assistance as well as construction material funded by UNRWA.
