• Raid:

- (i) At dawn on October 21st 2013, Israeli forces raided Abu Dis and detained a resident.
- (ii) At 04:00, Israeli forces raided Abu Dis, demolished a 2 floor home owned by Ashraf Abu Seneneh for allegedly being built without a license, during which residents clashed with Israeli forces and as a result left several residents suffocating from tear gas inhalation and the clashes disrupted classes in Al-Quds University in Abu Dis and 2 local secondary schools.
- <u>Injury:</u> On October 21st 2013, 2 residents: Wajdi Amro and Radwan Amro were injured after falling while being apprehended by Israeli forces in Jerusalem and as a result were hospitalised with contusions.
- Attack: At 20:30, Israeli forces positioned in Silwan neighbourhood in Jerusalem fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents as they stormed homes and as a result injured Lu'ay Siyam (10 years old), detained a resident and temporarily detained 7 residents and released them after assaulting them.

• <u>Detention:</u>

- (i) At 12:30, Israeli forced detained 2 school students: Ayoub Abu Al-Hawa, and Mohammad Abu Sneineh in Jabal Al-Tur neighbourhood in Jerusalem.
- (ii) At 16:00, Israeli forces positioned at Za'im checkpoint detained Munadil Abu Bakr, a resident of Ya'bad.
- (iii) At 20:40, Israeli forces positioned at Qalandiya checkpoint detained 5 residents: Eyad Bazri'e, Mohammad Al-Natsheh, Ali Abdallah, Omran Manasra and Ibrahim Al-Masri.
- (iv) Israeli forces detained Ahmad Muheisin in Abu Dis.
- (v) Israeli forces detained Mohammad Siyam in Silwan neighbourhood in Jerusalem.
- <u>Confiscation of Property:</u> At 09:30, Israeli forces raided Silwan neighbourhood and confiscated a computer and camera owned by Hamza Al-Abbasi's home.
- Assault on Property: On October 21st 2013, Israeli courts ordered the eviction of Khalid Al-Zir from a cave he moved into after Israeli forces demolished his home on August 20th 2013 in order to confiscate the land in the area were his house once stood and turn it over to the Israeli Antiquities Ministry.
- Obstruction on Places of Worship: At 11:00, Israeli settlers under the protection of Israeli forces stormed Al-Aqsa mosque compound in the old city of Jerusalem and provoked worshipers.

• Wall Gates:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the Wall gate in Abu Dis town.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate on Al-Shayyah road in the area between Al-Sawahira Al-Sharqiya and Al-Slewahira Al-Gharbiya villages, only allowing civilians holding Jerusalem IDs to cross, after subjecting them to thorough searches using electronic devices.
- Wall Construction: Wall construction continued in the areas north and south of Qalandiya village; south of Al-Za'ayyem village; and in Wadi Al-Eizariya west of the illegal settlement Ma 'ale Adumim.

(ii) The Israeli army continues to close the road leading to "Newe Daniyyel" settlement and agricultural land in Al-Khader; a road between Um Tuba and Wadi Al-Hums: Wadi Fukin, Al-Jaba, the Green Line; a road between Za'tara and a detour road, and a road between Taqou and Khirbet Al-Deir with cement blocks.

- (iii) Since August 2nd 2012, Israeli forces closed a road leading to Beit Jalla.
- (iv) Since May 8th 2013, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Carmisan area in Beit Jalla and Al-Walaja with a steel gate and barbed wires.
- (v) Since June 3rd 2013, the Israeli army closed the road connecting Nihalin and road 60 with dirt mounds.
- (vi) Since 13:20 on September 29th 2013, the Israeli army closed a road leading to 50 acres of agricultural land in Wadi Salem area in Al-Khadr with dirt mounds
- (vii) Since 14:00 on October 18th 2013, Israeli forces continue to close the road connecting Surif and Al-Jab'a with dirt mounds.
- <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 12:15, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Janata, temporarily detained Salim Mifrij (A preventive Security Officer), released him at a later time then withdrew at 14:45.

• <u>Raid:</u>

- (i) At 08:45, Israeli forces raided Aliyat Ali village until 09:05.
- (ii) At 01:30, Israeli forces raided Al-Doha.
- <u>Confiscation of Property:</u> At 09:00, Israeli forces confiscated a bulldozer owned by Na'im Al-Radi as he was working in land in Abu Nijim village.

• Settler Violence:

- (i) On October 21st 2013, Israeli settlers stormed Jabal Batn Al-Assi area in Al-Khadr, uprooted 80 Olive trees owned by Alla Abu Ghaliyoun.
- (ii) On October 21st2013, Israeli settlers pumped sewage waste onto agricultural land Jabal Batn Al-Assi area in Al-Khadr.

• Wall Construction:

- (i) Wall construction has continued in North West of Beit Jala town.
- (ii)On May 1^{st} 2103, an Israeli court ordered the halt of wall construction near Betar village.
- (iii) On July 21st 2013, Israeli courts ordered the halt of construction of the wall in Al-Carmisan area in the west area of Beit Jalla.

• Closure:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close Al-Shuhada' Street, Al-Sahleh and Khuzq Al-Far areas, as well as the old gold market in Hebron's Old City. In addition to closing the entrance to Al-Qeisi neighbourhood, the Israeli army continues to close the entrances to the area of Al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) with an electronic gate; Al-Laban Market also remains closed.
- (ii) Since 05 January 2009, the Israeli army has closed the area located along the Green Line south of the town of Yatta. Having seized land for Wall construction, the Israeli army evicted the Palestinian residents and denied them access to the area.

• Closure of Main Roads:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Al-Thahiriya and Al-Samoa' towns, Al-'Arrub refugee camp, and Al-Tuwani and Al-Karmil villages.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to prohibit Palestinian vehicles from travelling along the old Al-Shalala Street leading to Hebron's Old City.
- (iii) The Israeli army continues to close all roads leading to Road # 60 as well as detour roads along the settler bypass road leading to Yatta town.
- (iv) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds a detour road leading to e to Al-Simiya village, the southern entrance of Al-Samou' and the entrance of Beit Annun with cement blocks.
- (v) Since July 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Safa and Al-Dirat and also closed the entrance of south Yatta with cement blocks.
- (vi) Since December 27th 2012, Israeli forces closed the west entrance of Swiesiya village

which connects Yatta and Al-Samou' village with cement blocks.

(vii) Since 09:45 on September 23rd 2013, Israeli forces closed the main road leading to "Haji" settlement and impeded the free flow of traffic

• Flying Checkpoint:

- (i) At 08:40, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Beit Einun village junction.
- (ii) At 17:15, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Kharsa village junction.

• Raid:

- (i) At 17:00, Israeli forces raided Deir Sammit village, stormed and searched a home, served demolition order for 3 homes owned by Hassan Al-Sharha, Salameh Al-Sharha and Nayef Al-Rjoub for allegedly being built without proper licencing because of its location in area C which is under Israeli Military and Administrative control.
- (ii) On the evening of October 21st 2013, Israeli forces raided Um Al-Khayer village located in east Yatta served a demolition order to demolish a bakery owned by Suliman Akl-Hathib alleging the smoke from the bakery is hazardous to "Karmil" settlement.
- (iii)At 18:35, Israeli forces raided Hebron, surrounded Abdel Yahay Shahin mosque, searched several residents Identification cards as they left the mosque them withdrew at 19:30.
- <u>Injury:</u> At 12:40, 6 residents: Mamoud Irziqat, Amir Irziqat, Mohammad Irziqat, Jamil Samamra, Abdel Fatah Al-Nimsi and Fadi Abu Saleem were injured after the vehicle they occupied flipped over and crashed while being apprehended by Israeli military vehicles in Al-Ramadin village leaving them hospitalised with contusions.
- Obstruction of Education Sector: At 08:40, Israeli forces positioned near the old city of Hebron fired tear gas grenades towards Al-Hajriya school and as a result forced students to vacate the school after classes were disrupted as a result.
- <u>Wall Construction:</u> Wall construction continued in the area surrounding the illegal settlement Eshkolot, west of Al-Thahriya town.

GAZA STRIP

ALL DISTRICTS

- At 21:00 on November 21st 2012, the unilateral ceasefire declared by Israel came into effect. At a later time on the same day, armed Palestinian groups announced an agreement to cease fire.
- On November 14th 2011 Israeli forces placed floating marks 3 miles from Gaza's seashore and warned fishermen against passing beyond the mark and on November 24th 2012, Israeli forces imposed floating marks of 6 miles and on March 21st 2013 re imposed fishing restrictions of 3 miles.
- Israeli forces broke the ceasefire agreement by raiding and opening fire towards North Gaza, Gaza, Khan Yunis and Rafah.
- Israeli forces broke the cease fire agreement by opening fire towards Khan Yunis.

NORTHERN GAZA

- <u>Closure of Crossing Point:</u> Beit Hanun (Erez) is open for the passage of critical patients, journalists, NGO staff, businessmen and passengers travelling abroad through Al-Karama crossing with previous coordination.
- Raid: On the morning of October 22nd 2013, Israeli forces escorting several bulldozers stormed Beit Hanun and opened fire as they levelled a plot of agricultural land.

	• Closure of Crossing Points:
	(i) Al-Muntar (Karni) Crossing is closed. Beginning on 02 March 2011, the
	Crossing has been effectively closed following a unilateral Israeli decision.
