Killing	2	-	2	A University student was killed after Israeli forces opened fire towards him for allegedly attempting to tab 2 Israeli soldiers in Jerusalem and an Elderly resident (65 years old) after he suffocated from tear gas fired by Israeli forces in Hebron.

Closure of Crossings	-	5	5	Beit Hanun (Erez) is open for the passage of critical patients, journalists, NGO staff, businesspersons and passengers travelling abroad through Al-Karama crossing with previous coordination.
Closure of Main Roads	75	-	75	Including 9 in Jerusalem, 4 in Ramallah, 3 in Jenin, 3 in Tulkarem, 3 in Qalqiliya, 5 in Nablus, 6 in Salfit, 25 in Bethlehem and 20 in Hebron.
Assault on Medical Sector	1	-	1	Israeli forces attacked an Ambulance and shattered its windshield.
Assault on Places of Worship	1	-	1	Israeli settlers under the protection of Israeli force stormed Al-Aqsa mosque compound in the old city of Jerusalem.

Settler Violence	8	-	8	Israeli settlers stoned residents, vehicles and homes, prevented residents from entering agricultural land to collect Olive harvest, stormed the entrance of Beit Furiq, opened fire towards homes in Jerusalem, Jenin, Nablus and Hebron.

<b>JERUSALEM</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b><u>Closure:</u></b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) On October 21<sup>st</sup> 2015, the Israeli army, continues to intensify their restrictions at the entrance to Jerusalem city, set up several flying checkpoints on the main road leading to the city and prevented worshippers from conducting prayers at Al-Aqsa mosque compound and prevented residents entering the mosque.</li> <li>(ii) The Israeli army continues to close the ‘demarcation area’ along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits.</li> <li>(iii) The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill between Biddu and Beit Ikksa villages.</li> </ul> </li> <li>• <b><u>Closure of Main Roads:</u></b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the entrance to Jaba’ village.</li> <li>(ii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to Beit Ikksa village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandiya checkpoint.</li> <li>(iii) On October 14<sup>th</sup> 2015, Israeli forces closed the main road leading to Al-Eisawiya village with cement blocks.</li> <li>(iv) On October 14<sup>th</sup> 2015, Israeli forces closed the entrance of Jabal Al-Mukabir neighbourhood with cement blocks.</li> <li>(v) On October 14<sup>th</sup> 2015, Israeli forces closed the North entrance of Sur Bahar with Cement blocks.</li> <li>(vi) On October 14<sup>th</sup> 2015, Israeli forces closed the entrance of Al-Tur neighbourhood (leading to Al-Za’im village in Jericho and Al-Eizariya) and Suliman French road with cement blocks.</li> <li>(vii) On October 14<sup>th</sup> 2015, Israeli forces closed the entrance of Wadi Al-Rabaybeh area in Silwan neighbourhood in Jerusalem with cement blocks.</li> </ul> </li> <li>• <b><u>Checkpoint:</u></b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) Israeli forces considers Qalandiya checkpoint to be a border crossing point and only allows residents with Jerusalem Identification cards to enter the checkpoint.</li> <li>(ii) Since September 19<sup>th</sup> 2012, Israeli forces closed Ras Khamis and Shu’fat checkpoints and impeded the free flow of traffic in order to complete the construction of the wall.</li> <li>(iii) At 16:00, Israeli forces closed Jaba’ checkpoint located along the main road connecting Jerusalem, Ramallah and Jericho and impeded the free flow of traffic until reopening it later.</li> </ul> </li> <li>• <b><u>Flying Checkpoint:</u></b> At 11:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint in the area between Duqqu and Beit Anan villages.</li> <li>• <b><u>Raid:</u></b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) At 14:20, Israeli forces raided Abu Dis.</li> </ul> </li> </ul>

- (ii) At 19:10, Israeli forces raided Al-Eisawiya village and clashed with several residents.
- (iii) At 20:00, Israeli forces raided Abu Dis and Al-Eizariya until 01:50.
- (iv) At 20:45, Israeli forces raided Beit Annan village, clashed with several residents and detained a resident.
- (v) At 04:15, Israeli forces raided Qalandiya camp, clashed with several residents as they stormed several homes and detained two residents.
- (vi) At 04:30, Israeli forces raided Kafr Aqab village and Samir Amis area in North Jerusalem during which Israeli military helicopters surveyed the area.

- **Attack:**

- (i) At 08:00, Israeli forces positioned in Ras Al-Amoud neighbourhood in Jerusalem fired stun and tear gas grenades towards residents for alleged stoning.
- (ii) At 12:30, Israeli forces positioned near Al-Quds University in Abu Dis fired stun and tear gas grenades towards residents for alleged stoning.
- (iii) At 17:00, Israeli forces positioned in Al-Eizariya fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards residents for alleged stoning.
- (iv) At 17:20, Israeli forces positioned near the entrance of Al-Ram fired stun and tear gas grenades towards residents for alleged stoning.
- (v) At 18:00, Israeli forces positioned near Qalandiya camp fired stun and tear gas grenades towards residents for alleged stoning.
- (vi) At 19:50, Israeli forces positioned in Ras Kabsa area located in Abu Dis fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards residents for alleged stoning.
- (vii) At 20:25, Israeli forces positioned near the entrance of Anata fired stun and tear gas grenades towards residents for alleged stoning.
- (viii) At 22:00, Israeli forces positioned at the entrance of Al-Eizariya fired stun and tear gas grenades towards residents for alleged stoning.

- **Killing:** At 15:00, Mu'taz Atallah Qassim (22 years old) {A University student} {A resident of Al-Eizariya} was killed after Israeli forces opened fire towards him near Jaba' roundabout located in North Jerusalem for attempting to stab two Israeli soldiers {Female soldiers} as alleged by the Israeli military.

- **Detention:**

- (i) At 04:00 on October 21<sup>st</sup> 2015, Israeli forces detained six residents including two children: Mohamad Karkor (17 years old), Firas Karkor (16 years old), Tamer Khalfawi, Bahjat Al-Razem, Mohammad Taryaqi and Ma'moun Al-Razem in Jerusalem.
- (ii) At 10:30, Israeli forces detained Neveen Al-Razem (A resident of the old city of Jerusalem) as she was exiting Al-Aqsa mosque compound.
- (iii) At 16:00, Israeli forces detained Samer Shaloodi (A resident of Bi'r Ayoub area in Silwan neighbourhood).
- (iv) At 18:00, Israeli forces detained four residents including three children: Ahmad Al-Rajabi (17 years old), Mohammad Yassin Shaloudi (17 years old), Mohammad Mahdi Shaloudi (17 years old) and Hamada Nader Odeh in Silwan neighbourhood.
- (v) At 18:00, Israeli forces positioned at Shu'fat checkpoint detained Shawkat Mohammad Abdel-Rahman.
- (vi) At 18:00, Israeli forces detained Rami Othman Darwish (A resident of Al-Eisawiyya village).
- (vii) At 18:00, Israeli forces detained Mohammad Akram Barjis (A resident of Al-Judiera village).
- (viii) At 21:40, Israeli forces detained Mohammad Adnan Ghazawneh (A resident of Al-Ram).

TULKAREM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b>Checkpoint:</b> Israeli forces continue to intensify their restrictions at “Eniv” checkpoint located along the main road connecting Tulkarem and Nablus and impeded the free flow of traffic.</li> <li>• <b>Flying Checkpoint:</b> At 21:45, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Shufa village.</li> <li>• <b>Raid:</b> At 02:30 on October 21<sup>st</sup> 2015, Israeli forces raided Safarin village, stormed and searched 3 homes, detained a resident and confiscated 3 Identification cards owned by: Alaa Sameh Abdel-Latif Salem, Mohammad Sameh Abdel-Latif Salem,</li> <li>• <b>Detention:</b> Israeli forces detained Rami Sameh Abdel-Latif Salem during their raid into Safarin village.</li> <li>• <b>Attack:</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) At 10:00, Israeli forces positioned near Ghishori industrial plant located in west Tulkarem fired live ammunition, rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards residents for alleged stoning and as result injured four residents and left several others suffocated from tear gas inhalation.</li> <li>(ii) At 14:40, Israeli forces positioned at a military watch tower located in east Far’un village opened fire towards several farmers as they were collecting Olive harvest on their agricultural land in the area.</li> </ul> </li> <li>• <b>Wall Gates:</b> At 18:35, Israeli forces closed wall gate (708) located in Far’un village and prevented farmers from entering through the wall gate until reopening it at 19:10.</li> </ul>
QALQILIYA	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b>Closure of Roads:</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) Israeli forces continue to close with cement blocks agricultural roads east of Azzun town.</li> <li>(ii) In addition to closing the gate installed since the outbreak the second Intifada, the Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the eastern entrance to Kafr Qaddum village.</li> <li>(iii) Since 10:40 on September 1<sup>st</sup> 2015, Israeli forces closed an agricultural road leading to Far’ata village, which is located near “Gillad” settlement with a steel Gate.</li> </ul> </li> <li>• <b>Flying Checkpoint:</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) At 16:30, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the eastern entrance of Qalqiliya.</li> <li>(ii) At 16:45, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint near the entrance of Izbit Al-Tabib village.</li> <li>(iii) At 18:50, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Falimiya village.</li> </ul> </li> <li>• <b>Raid:</b> At 04:10, Israeli forces raided Hajja village, stormed and searched a home and detained a resident.</li> <li>• <b>Detention:</b> Israeli forces detained Mohammad Khaled Anis Basalat during their raid into Hajja village.</li> <li>• <b>Attack:</b> At 20:50, Israeli forces positioned at Al-Jaljoliya gate located in south Qalqiliya fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and as a result left several residents suffocated from tear gas inhalation.</li> <li>• <b>Wall Gates:</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) The Israeli army continues to restrict access at ‘Azzun ‘Atma Wall gate and impeded the free flow of traffic. The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the entrance to the village of Wadi Al- Rasha and to deny civilian access.</li> <li>(ii) The Israeli army allows residents to access the village through Gate #109. Having removed the gate at the entrance to the village of Ras Atiya, the Israeli army only allows students to cross to their schools outside the village through the Habla gate.</li> </ul> </li> </ul>
