### **WEST BANK**

### • Closure:

- (i) Israeli army continues to intensify their restrictions at the entrance to Jerusalem city, set up several flying checkpoints on the main road leading to the city and prevented worshipers under the age of 50 from conducting prayers at Al-Aqsa mosque compound.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the 'demarcation area' along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits.
- (iii) The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill between Biddu and Beit Iksa villages.

### • Closure of Main Roads:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the entrance to Jaba' village.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to Beit Iksa village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandiya checkpoint.

### • Checkpoints:

- (i) Israeli authorities continue to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a "border crossing point" and designate a special crossing lane for holders of Jerusalem IDs and another for those possessing permits to access Jerusalem city and at 06:00, Israeli forces closed the checkpoint impeded the free flow of traffic.
- (ii) On September 19<sup>th</sup> 2012, Israeli forces closed Ras Khamis checkpoint near Shu'fat camp and impeded the free flow of traffic in order to construct the wall.

### • Detention:

- (i) At 11:30, Israeli forces detained Khalid Abbassi in Silwan neighbourhood in Jerusalem.
- (ii) At 12:30, Israeli forces detained 2 residents: Hamza Al-Abbassi and Amar Al-Abbassi in Silwan neighbourhood in Jerusalem.
- (iii) At 15:40, Israeli forces detained 2 children: Islam Sarour (14 years old) and Alaa Obdeh (14 years old) in Jabal Mukabbir neighbourhood in Jerusalem.

### Attack:

- (i) At 20:30, Israeli forces positioned near the wall Gate in Abu Dis, fired rubber coated steel bullets and tear gas grenades towards several residents as they allegedly attempted to puncture the wall gate.
- (ii) On the evening of October 22<sup>nd</sup> 2013, Israeli forces positioned at

(ii) Since September 3 <sup>rd</sup> 2013, Israeli forces closed the north east entrance of Al-Mughier village with dirt mounds.  • Raid: At 20:45, Israeli forces raided Bir Zeit, clashed with its residents then withdrew at 22:00.  • Attack: At 15:25, Israeli forces positioned near the wall gate in Beit Liqya, fired rubber coated steel bullets and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.  • Injury: At 06:00 on October 22 <sup>rd</sup> 2013, Israeli forces stormed Bil'in and Kafr Ni'ma villages, clashed with residents and as a result injured Amjad Shouman (journalist) and Mohammad Abu Rahmeh.  • Settler Violence: At 19:20, Israeli settlers stormed Al-Nabi Saleh village, set fire to several tires then withdrew under the protection of Israeli forces.  • Wall Construction: Wall construction continued in the area west of 'Abud town in the area surrounding the illegal settlement 'Ofarim

## **Flying Checkpoint:** (i) At 12:10, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Beita until 13:00. (ii) At 18:30, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint Beita junction, prevented residents from entering or exiting the area, fired stun grenades towards residents located near the checkpoint waiting for movement access then withdrew at 01:00. (iii) At 20:35, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint between Al-Bithan and Al-Nasiriya villages. Raid: At 09:30, Israeli forces raided Asira Al-Shamaliya, stormed 2 homes, temporarily detained several residents and released them after questioning then withdrew at 11:30. **Temporary Detention:** (i) At 12:00, Israeli forces temporarily detained Islam Hussein (15 years old) and released him at a later time (ii) At 17:15, Israeli forces temporarily detained 2 residents: Sami Obidat and Saher Obidat as they were collecting olive harvests in Awarta village and released them at 02:00. **Settler Violence:** (i) At 23:55, Israeli settlers stormed Burin village, stoned 2 homes and as a result injured Sima Eid (8 years old) and lost consciousness after Israeli settlers attempted to assault her home leaving her hospitalised during which Israeli settlers withdrew under the protection of Israeli forces. (ii) On October 22<sup>nd</sup> 2013, Israeli settlers stormed Burin village and assaulted Mohammad Al-Zaban as he was farming his land and as a result leaving him hospitalised with contusions. **Closure of Main Roads:** (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the entrance to two detour roads connecting Marda village to its farmland. On 15.04.2012, the Israeli army has opened the northern entrance to Salfit city (ii) to civilian which was closed since the year 2000 and prevented access from 08:00 until 09:20. Since 11:00 on July 30<sup>th</sup> 2012, Israeli forces have closed two roads leading to (iii) Abu Nasar and Oatan Al-Jama' located in western area of Deir Istiya with cement blocks. Checkpoints: At 15:45, Israeli forces continue to intensify their restrictions at Za'tara Al-checkpoint, impeded the free flow of traffic until 17:30. **SALFIT** Raid: At 01:00, Israeli forces raided Yasuf village, stormed several homes, detained a resident and confiscated the identification cards of 3 residents: Ali Aliyan, Muslih Salah and Ahmad Salah. **Detention:** Israeli forces detained Yusef Salah in Yasuf village. Temporary Detention: At 15:50, Israeli forces positioned at Za'tara checkpoint temporarily detained 3 residents: Azam Al-Sus, Salameh Barahmeh and Du'a Assam. **Provocation of Palestinian Forces:** At 15:45, Israeli forces positioned at Za'tara checkpoint temporarily seized a Palestinian Security force vehicle and allowed it to pass through at 16:30. Wall Construction: Wall construction continued in the area north of Deir Istiya town southeast of the illegal settlement. Checkpoints: At 13:00, Israeli forces continue to intensify its restrictions at Al-Hamra checkpoint set up along the road connecting Jericho and Nablus District **JERICHO** until 15:00. Flying Checkpoint: At 21:35, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Fasayil village.

### • Closure:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close roads to An Nu'man village, with the exception of the road leading to the Wall gate in the south-eastern area of the village.
- (ii) Since 15 September 2007, the Israel army has prevented civilians from accessing or staying on 22 dunumes of confiscated land in Al Mazmuriya area in Beit Sahur and Bethlehem cities.

### • Closure of Main Roads:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close the Beit Jala-Wadi Ahmed road; a road between Um Tuba and Al-Jass; a road between Um Tuba and Khilat Nu'man: a road between Um Tuba and the wall; a road between Al-Khas village and the wall; the 2 by pass roads located south of Al-Walaja; a road between Talita Qumi and Nazlat Al-Sider in Beit Jala; the eastern road of Al-Khader; the road between Al-Khader and Beit Jala; the road between Al-Khader and road #60 which lead to the eastern neighbourhoods of Bethlehem; a road leading to Wadi Rahal, and a road east of Beit Fajjar town with dirt mounds.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the road leading to "Newe Daniyyel" settlement and agricultural land in Al-Khader; a road between Um Tuba and Wadi Al-Hums: Wadi Fukin, Al-Jaba, the Green Line; a road between Za'tara and a detour road, and a road between Taqou and Khirbet Al-Deir with cement blocks.
- (iii) Since August 2<sup>nd</sup> 2012, Israeli forces closed a road leading to Beit Jalla.
- (iv) Since May 8<sup>th</sup> 2013, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Carmisan area in Beit Jalla and Al-Walaja with a steel gate and barbed wires.
- (v) Since June 3<sup>rd</sup> 2013, the Israeli army closed the road connecting Nihalin and road 60 with dirt mounds.

# (vi) Since 13:20 on September 29<sup>th</sup> 2013, the Israeli army closed a road leading to 50 acres of agricultural land in Wadi Salem area in Al-Khadr with dirt mounds.

- (vii) Since 14:00 on October 18<sup>th</sup> 2013, Israeli forces continue to close the road connecting Surif and Al-Jab'a with dirt mounds.
- <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 09:50, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint near Al-Faradise village.

### • <u>Raid:</u>

- (i) At 09:50, Israeli forces raided Dar Salah village.
- (ii) At 13:30, Israeli forces raided Taqou', clashed with residents then withdrew at 14:20.
- <u>Attack:</u> At 08:10, Israeli forces positioned near Dar Salah village t junction in east Beit Sahur fired tear gas grenades towards residents for alleged stoning.

### • Settler Violence:

- (i) At 16:35, an Israeli settler ran over Nidal Sabatin with his vehicle along the main road near "Betar Eliyat" settlement and as a result left he hospitalised with contusions.
- (ii) 17:40, Israeli settlers stormed Dar Salah village located in east Beit Sahur under the protection of Israeli forces, stoned several residents and vehicles during which Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the village entrance and impeded the free flow of traffic.

### • Wall Construction:

- (i) Wall construction has continued in North West of Beit Jala town.
- (ii)On May 1<sup>st</sup> 2103, an Israeli court ordered the halt of wall construction near Betar village.
- (iii) On July 21<sup>st</sup> 2013, Israeli courts ordered the halt of construction of the wall in Al-Carmisan area in the west area of Beit Jalla.

# **BETHLEHEM**

### • Closure:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close Al-Shuhada' Street, Al-Sahleh and Khuzq Al-Far areas, as well as the old gold market in Hebron's Old City. In addition to closing the entrance to Al-Qeisi neighbourhood, the Israeli army continues to close the entrances to the area of Al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) with an electronic gate; Al-Laban Market also remains closed.
- (ii) Since 05 January 2009, the Israeli army has closed the area located along the Green Line south of the town of Yatta. Having seized land for Wall construction, the Israeli army evicted the Palestinian residents and denied them access to the area. .

### **Closure of Main Roads:**

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Al-Thahiriya and Al-Samoa' towns, Al-'Arrub refugee camp, and Al-Tuwani and Al-Karmil villages.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to prohibit Palestinian vehicles from travelling along the old Al-Shalala Street leading to Hebron's Old City.
- (iii) The Israeli army continues to close all roads leading to Road # 60 as well as detour roads along the settler bypass road leading to Yatta town.
- (iv) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds a detour road leading to e to Al-Simiya village, the southern entrance of Al-Samou' and the entrance of Beit Annun with cement blocks.
- (v) Since July 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Safa and Al-Dirat and also closed the entrance of south Yatta with cement blocks.
- (vi) Since December 27<sup>th</sup> 2012, Israeli forces closed the west entrance of Swiesiya village which connects Yatta and Al-Samou' village with cement blocks.
- (vii) Since 09:45 on September 23<sup>rd</sup> 2013, Israeli forces closed the main road leading to "Haji" settlement and impeded the free flow of traffic

### **Flying Checkpoint:**

- (i) At 09:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the north entrance of
- (ii) At 01:05, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Deir Sammat village.

### Raid:

- (i) At 22:00, Israeli forces raided Deir Sammit village and detained 2
- (ii) At 03:50, Israeli forces raided Al-Urub camp and detained a resident.

### **Detention:**

- (i) At 17:00, Israeli forces positioned near Al-Ibrahimi mosque in the old city of Hebron detained Muntaha Al-Hih, a resident of Surif.
- (ii) At 19:10, Israeli forces positioned near Al-Ibrahimi mosque in the old city of Hebron detained Ahmad Salaymeh.
- (iii) Israeli forces detained Iz Al-Din Al-Hourub and Mohammad Al-Hourub in Deir Sammat village.
- (iv)Israeli forces detained Mohammad Al-Qasas in Al-Urub camp.
- Attack: At 15:00, Israeli forces positioned near Al-Shuhada road in the old city of Hebron fired stun and tear gas grenades towards residents for alleged stoning and as a result injured the child Saher Salhab.
- Physical Assault: At 14:45, Israeli forces positioned in Tel Al-Rumayda neighbourhood in the old city of Hebron assaulted the child Hamdan Sha'ban (15 years old), a resident of Jerusalem leaving him hospitalised with contusions.
- Wall Construction: Wall construction continued in the area surrounding the illegal settlement Eshkolot, west of Al-Thahriya town.

### **GAZA STRIP**

# At 21:00 on November 21<sup>st</sup> 2012, the unilateral ceasefire declared by Israel came into effect. At a later time on the same day, armed Palestinian groups announced an agreement to cease fire. On November 14<sup>th</sup> 2011 Israeli forces placed floating marks 3 miles from Gaza's seashore and warned fishermen against passing beyond the mark and on November 24<sup>th</sup> 2012, Israeli forces imposed floating marks of 6 miles and on March 21<sup>st</sup> 2013 re imposed fishing restrictions of 3 miles.
