JERUSALEM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army, intensified their restrictions at the entrance to Jerusalem city, set up several flying checkpoints on the main road leading to the city and prevented worshippers under the age of 50 from conducting prayers at Al-Aqsa mosque compound. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the ‘demarcation area’ along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits. (iii) The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill between Biddu and Beit Ikksa villages. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the entrance to Jaba’ village. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to Beit Ikksa village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandiya checkpoint. • <u>Checkpoints:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli authorities continue to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a “border crossing point” and designate a special crossing lane for holders of Jerusalem IDs and another for those possessing permits to access Jerusalem city and closed the checkpoint at 01:20 and impeded the free flow of traffic until 04:05. (ii) On September 19th 2012, Israeli forces closed Ras Khamis checkpoint near Shu’fat camp and impeded the free flow of traffic in order to construct the wall. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 08:00, Israeli forces raided Al-Jib village, stormed a gas station and confiscated surveillance camera footage. (ii) At 11:30, Israeli forces raided Beit Duqu village as they escorted several archaeologist from Israeli Institute of Archaeology as they were near the village. (iii) At 14:45, Israeli forces raided Al-Ram until 15:00. (iv) At 16:30, Israeli forces raided Bir Nabala. • <u>Killing:</u> At 18:00, Adel-Rahman Al-Shaludi (a resident of Silwan) was killed after Israeli security forces after he ran over several Israeli settlers and injured nine settler in Shu’fat neighbourhood in Jerusalem. • <u>Attack:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 19:00, Israeli forces positioned near the entrance of Anata and Ras Khamis area fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning. (ii) At 20:40, Israeli forces positioned near the wall gate in Beit Ijza village, fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning. (iii) At 21:35, Israeli forces positioned near the entrance of Al-Eisawiya and in Al-Tur neighbourhood, fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas

	<p>grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.</p> <p>(iv) At 21:40, Israeli forces positioned in Shufat neighbourhood fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.</p> <p>(v) At 22:10, Israeli forces positioned near the north junction of Al-Ram fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.</p> <p>(vi) At 22:30, Israeli forces positioned in Silwan neighbourhood fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning as they surrounded the home of Adel-Rahman Al-Shaludi (a resident of Silwan) { who was killed by Israeli security forces after he ran over several Israeli settlers } and as a result injured the child Fatima Al-Raji (11 years old) and detained his brother.</p> <p>(vii) At 23:00, Israeli forces positioned in Qalandiya checkpoint fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Detention:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 02:00 on October 22nd 2014, Israeli forces detained three residents: Ali Al-Joulani, Jihad Al-Baytuoni and Khaled Abu Hadid in Al-Qarami neighbourhood in the old city of Jerusalem. (ii) At 00:15, Israeli forces detained five children: Mus'ab Al-Khayat (12 years old), Mahdi Khayat (12 years old), Mohammad Abu Sneineh (12 years old), Mahdi Hijazi (15 years old) and Mohammad Manasrah (15 years old). (iii) Israeli forces detained Izz-Al-Din Al-Shaloudi (15 years old) in Silwan neighbourhood in Jerusalem. • <u>Assault on Places of Worship:</u> At 08:00, Israeli settlers under the protection of Israeli forces stormed Al-Aqsa mosque compound and provoked worshippers. • <u>Settler Violence:</u> At 21:15, Israeli settlers stormed Al-Shiekh Jarrah neighbourhood, attacked a home , chanted anti-Arab slogans • <u>Wall Gates:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the Wall gate in Abu Dis town. (ii) The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate on Al-Shayyah road in the area between Al-Sawahira Al-Sharqiya and Al-Slewahira Al-Gharbiya villages, only allowing civilians holding Jerusalem IDs to cross, after subjecting them to thorough searches using electronic devices.

(ii) Since September 3rd 2013, Israeli forces closed the north east entrance of Al-Mughier village with dirt mounds. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 10:40, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Sinjil until 12:20. (ii) At 14:20, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Deir Abu Mash'al village, detained a child then withdrew at 15:15. (iii) At 22:50, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Shuqba village and opened fire towards a vehicle. • <u>Detention:</u> Israeli forces positioned at the entrance of Deir Abu Mash'al village detained Issam Al-Bargjouthi (17 years old). • <u>Settler Violence:</u> At 19:45, Israeli settlers positioned near "Bet El" settlement stoned residents and vehicles on the main road near the entrance of Al-Jalazoun

JENIN	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Road:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the road leading to the town of ‘Arraba east of the illegal settlement Dotan. (ii) Since the evening of November 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the western entrance of Ya’bad. • <u>Checkpoint:</u> At 17:00, Israeli forces closed “Movo Dotan” checkpoint located in south Ya’bad along the main road connecting Jenin and Tulkarem and impeded the free flow of traffic. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 22:20, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint between Zabada and Thaher Al-Abd until 22:40. (ii) At 07:30, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Ya’bad. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 18:50, Israeli forces raided Ya’bad, clashed with its residents then withdrew at 23:40. (ii) At 02:45, Israeli forces raided Al-Yamoun, detained a resident after searching his home then withdrew at 03:30. • <u>Detention:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 01:30 on October 22nd 2014, Israeli forces detained Issam Hamad during their raid into Arraba as mentioned in the previous report. (ii) At dawn on October 22nd 2014, Israeli forces detained two residents: Ahmad Abu Zied and Bashar Qasrawi during their raid into Jenin. (iii) At dawn on October 22nd 2014, Israeli forces detained Mohammad Fayyad in Jenin. (iv) Israeli forces detained Jamil Khamsiya in Al-Yamoun.
TUBAS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Raid:</u> At 11:30, Israeli forces raided Khirbeit Samara village in the north Jordan valley and served a demolition order for two storage rooms owned by the local village council for allegedly being built without proper licencing.
TULKAREM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the road connecting Kafr Al-Labad town to Shufa village. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the detour road leading to Ramin village along the Tulkarem-Nablus main road. • <u>Checkpoint:</u> The Israeli Military continues to intensify their restrictions at “Eniv” checkpoint. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 11:00, Israeli forces raided Far’oun village until 12:40. (ii) At 00:35, Israeli forces raided Allar until 06:00.
QALQILIYA	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli forces continue to close with cement blocks agricultural roads east of Azzun town. (ii) In addition to closing the gate installed since the outbreak the second Intifada, the Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the eastern entrance to Kafr Qaddum village. (iii) At 12:10 on September 2nd 2014, Israeli forces closed the main road connecting Qalqiliya and Nablus near Al-Nabi Eliyas village with cement blocks. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to restrict access at ‘Azzun ‘Atma Wall gate and impeded the free flow of traffic. The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the entrance to the village of Wadi Al- Rasha and to deny civilian access.

	<p>(ii) The Israeli army allows residents to access the village through Gate #109. Having removed the gate at the entrance to the village of Ras Atiya; the Israeli army only allows students to cross to their schools outside the village through the Habla gate.</p>
NABLUS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure: Since December 17th 2013, Israeli forces ordered the closure 500 dunumes of land in Qusra village as a closed military area. • Closure of Main Roads: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the roads of Til-Burin and Beit Furik-Salem; the settler bypass road connecting the village of Deir al Hatab to the settlement of Alon Moreh; the road connecting the town of ‘Aqraba to the village of Osrin; and the detour road between the town of Qabalan and the village of Osrin. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the northern entrance to Qabalan town; the southern entrances to the town of Jamma’in and the villages of Duma and Qaryut. • Flying Checkpoint: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 16:40, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint along the junction road leading Qabalan and Yatma villages. (ii) At 20:55, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint near “Yitsahar” settlement located in North Huwara and impeded the free flow of traffic for alleged Molotov bomb thrown towards an Israeli military jeep then withdrew at 23:00. • Raid: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 09:30, Israeli forces raided Huwara until 10:15. (ii) At 02:00, Israeli forces raided Orif village, stormed and searched three homes then withdrew at 05:35. • Settler Violence: At 10:55, Israeli settler stormed agricultural land in Huwara and set fire to approximately 100 Olive trees during which Palestinian Civil defence forces were able to put out the fire.
SALFIT	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure of Main Roads: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the entrance to two detour roads connecting Marda village to its farmland. (ii) On 15.04.2012, the Israeli army has opened the northern entrance to Salfit city to civilian, which was closed since the year 2000 and prevented access from 08:00 until 09:20. (iii) Since 11:00 on July 30th 2012, Israeli forces have closed two roads leading to Abu Nasar and Qatan Al-Jama’ located in western area of Deir Istiya with cement blocks. • Checkpoints: At 15:50, Israeli forces intensified their restrictions at Za’tara checkpoint and impeded the free flow of traffic. • Flying Checkpoint: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 09:40, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Al-Zawiya until 13:30. (ii) At 14:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the east entrance of Yasuf village. • Raid: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 18:00, Israeli forces raided Al-Zawiya and stormed two homes. (ii) At 01:45, Israeli forces raided Qarwat Bani Hassan, stormed several homes, detained six residents then withdrew at 04:00. • Detention: Israeli forces detained six residents: Ahmad Rayan, Wahbi Rayan, Raed Rayan, Adam Rayan, Ibrahim Assi and Aysar Assi.
JERICHO	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Checkpoints: Israeli forces intensified its restrictions at Al-Hamra checkpoint set up along the road connecting Jericho and Nablus District.

<p style="text-align: center;">BETHLEHEM</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close roads to An Nu'man village, with the exception of the road leading to the Wall gate in the south-eastern area of the village. (ii) Since 15 September 2007, the Israel army has prevented civilians from accessing or staying on 22 dunums of confiscated land in Al Mazmuriya area in Beit Sahur and Bethlehem cities. • Closure of Main Roads: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the Beit Jala-Wadi Ahmed road; a road between Um Tuba and Al-Jass ; a road between Um Tuba and Khilat Nu'man: a road between Um Tuba and the wall; a road between Al-Khas village and the wall; the 2 by pass roads located south of Al-Walaja; a road between Talita Qumi and Nazlat Al-Sider in Beit Jala; the eastern road of Al-Khader; the road between Al-Khader and Beit Jala ; Wadi Rahal road near "Ifrat" settlement ,the road between Al-Khader and road #60 which lead to the eastern neighbourhoods of Bethlehem; a road leading to Wadi Rahal, and a road east of Beit Fajjar town with dirt mounds. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the road leading to "Newe Daniyyel" settlement and agricultural land in Al-Khader; a road between Um Tuba and Wadi Al-Hums: Wadi Fukin, Al-Jaba, the Green Line; a road between Za'tara and a detour road, and a road between Taqou and Khirbet Al-Deir with cement blocks. (iii) Since August 2nd 2012, Israeli forces closed a road leading to Beit Jalla. (iv) Since May 8th 2013, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Carmisan area in Beit Jalla and Al-Walaja with a steel gate and barbed wires. (v) Since June 3rd 2013, the Israeli army closed the road connecting Nihalin and road 60 with dirt mounds. (vi) Since 13:20 on September 29th 2013, the Israeli army closed a road leading to 50 acres of agricultural land in Wadi Salem area in Al-Khadr with dirt mounds. (vii) Israeli forces closed the main road connecting Surif and Al-Jub'a village with dirt mounds. (viii) On January 28th 2014, Israeli forces closed the steel gate at the entrance of Nihalin { replacing the dirt mounds placed at the entrance since the year 2002} and placed time schedule for opening the gate from 06:00 until 14:00 on a daily bases. • Raid: At 02:35, Israeli forces raided Husan village and detained a resident. • Detention: Israeli forces detained Ramadan Al-Sabatin in Husan village • Attack: At 16:45, Israeli forces positioned near Al-Ayda camp in Bethlehem fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning. • Settler Violence: At 21:25, Israeli settlers stoned residents and vehicles near the entrances of Nihalin and Husan villages.
<p style="text-align: center;">HEBRON</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close Al-Shuhada' Street, Al-Sahleh and Khuzq Al-Far areas, as well as the old gold market in Hebron's Old City. In addition to closing the entrance to Al-Qeisi neighbourhood, the Israeli army continues to close the entrances to the area of Al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) with an electronic gate; Al-Laban Market also remains closed. (ii) Since 05 January 2009, the Israeli army has closed the area located along the Green Line south of the town of Yatta. Having seized land for Wall construction, the Israeli army evicted the Palestinian residents and denied them access to the area. • Closure of Main Roads: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Al-Thahiriya and Al-Samoa' towns, Al-'Arrub refugee camp, and Al-Tuwani and Al-Karmil villages.

- (ii) The Israeli army continues to prohibit Palestinian vehicles from travelling along the old Al-Shalala Street leading to Hebron's Old City.
- (iii) The Israeli army continues to close all roads leading to Road # 60 as well as detour roads along the settler bypass road leading to Yatta town.
- (iv) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds a detour road leading to e to Al-Simiya village, the southern entrance of Al-Samou' and the entrance of Beit Annun with cement blocks.
- (v) Since July 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Safa and Al-Dirat and closed the entrance of south Yatta with cement blocks.

- (vi) On September 4th 2014, Israeli forces closed a road in Eiwn Al-Bas and Al-Bayda and Al-Ras area in Ithna locat6ed near the wall gate.

- (vii) At 13:40 on September 16th 2014, Israeli forces closed the main road leading to Al-Ibrahim mosque in the old city of Hebron.

- **Flying Checkpoint:**
 - (i) At 17:20, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Khursa village junction until 17:50.
 - (ii) At 23:30, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Halhul Bridge until 00:30.
- **Raid:**
 - (i) At 21:30, Israeli forces raided Dura and stormed a home.
 - (ii) At 21:40, Israeli forces raided Al-Tabaqa village, stormed Khaled Al-Fasfouses home and opened fire towards him, as he was able to flee capture.
 - (iii) At 07:00, Israeli forces raided Hebron until 08:00.
 - (iv) At dawn on October 23rd 2014, Israeli forces raided Beit Ummar, detained 2 residents as they stormed their homes.
- **Detention:** Israeli forces detained two residents: Imad Abu Mariya and Mohammad Baragith in Beit Ummar.
- **Temporary Detention:**
 - (i) At 14:20, Israeli forces positioned near the entrance of Al-Urub camp temporarily detained Ziyad Jawabrat then released him later.
 - (ii) At 16:30, Israeli forces positioned in the old city of Hebron temporarily detained two children: Adnan Abu Odeg (12 years old) and Mohammad Jabr (11 years old) and released them at 18:20.
 - (iii) At 20:30, Israeli forces positioned in the old city of Hebron temporarily detained the child Mohammad Abu Sneieneh then released him at 22:00.
- **Attack:** At 18:00, Israeli forces positioned near Al-Tabaqa village junction fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.

<p>ALL DISTRICTS</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> At 19:00 on August 26th 2014, Palestinian Gunmen and the Israeli military agreed to a cease fire agreement (brokered by the Arab Republic of Egypt) which includes the opening of border crossings to allow the entry of emergency supplies and humanitarian goods as well as construction material and agreed to increase the fishing limit to 6 nautical miles with possibility of increase to 12 nautical miles by the end of the year and to decrease the Military area to 100 meters, allow freedom of movement and a halt to targeted killings and assassinations and negotiations will be held for discussion on rebuilding the sea port and airports in the coming month.
<p>NORTHERN GAZA</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Closure of Crossing Point: Beit Hanun (Erez) is open for the passage of critical patients, journalists, NGO staff, businesspersons and passengers travelling abroad through Al-Karama crossing with previous coordination.
<p>GAZA</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Closure of Crossing Points: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Al-Muntar (Karni) Crossing is closed. Beginning on 02 March 2011, the Crossing has been effectively closed following a unilateral Israeli decision. (ii) Al-Shija'ya (Nahal 'Oz) Crossing is closed. Beginning on 04 January 2010, the Crossing has closed following a unilateral Israeli decision.
<p>RAFAH</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Closure of Crossing Points : <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Yasser 'Arafat International Airport remains closed. (ii) Rafah (<i>Al 'Awdah</i>) Crossing is open for the entry and exit of residents, students, tourists and businesspersons. (iii) Sufa Crossing is closed. (iv) Karm Abu Salem (Karem Shalom) Crossing is open for the entry of tourist and foreign diplomats and the entry of Humanitarian assistance as well as construction material funded by UNRWA.
