WEST BANK

Closure:

- (i) The Israeli army, intensified their restrictions at the entrance to Jerusalem city, set up several flying checkpoints on the main road leading to the city and prevented worshipers under the age of 40 from conducting prayers at Al-Aqsa mosque compound.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the 'demarcation area' along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits.
- The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a (iii) hill between Biddu and Beit Iksa villages.

Closure of Main Roads:

- The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the (i) entrance to Jaba' village.
- The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to (ii) Beit Iksa village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandiya checkpoint.

Checkpoints:

- (i) Israeli authorities continue to consider Oalandiya checkpoint a "border crossing point" and designate a special crossing lane for holders of Jerusalem IDs and another for those possessing permits to access Jerusalem city and closed the checkpoint at 01:20 and impeded the free flow of traffic until 04:05.
- (ii) On September 19th 2012, Israeli forces closed Ras Khamis checkpoint near Shu'fat camp and impeded the free flow of traffic in order to construct the wall.
- (iii) At 15:20, Israeli forces intensified their restrictions at Jaba' checkpoint which connects Jerusalem, Ramallah and Jericho and impeded the free flow of traffic until 18:40 and again at 20:15, Israeli Authorities ordered the closure of the checkpoint for 1 day for residents travelling to Ramallah from 06:00 until 09:00 and again from 15:00 until 19:00 for alleged stoning.

Attack:

- (i) At 08:00, Israeli forces positioned in Al-Tur neighbourhood fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.
- (ii) At 10:00, Israeli forces positioned near Al-Eisawiya village fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.
- (iii) At 11:00, Israeli forces positioned near Al-Amoud neighbourhood in Silwan neighbourhood fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and as a result suffocated 12 residents from tear gas inhalation.
- (iv) At 16:25, Israeli forces positioned near Qalandiya airport located in North Jerusalem fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.
- (v) At 18:00, Israeli forces positioned at the entrance of Al-Eisawiya, Beit

(ii) At 21:40, Israeli forces detained Hazim Assadiya after storming his home in Wadi Al-Juz neighbourhood. • Assault on Places of Worship: On the morning of October 23 rd 2014, Israeli settlers under the protection of Israeli forces stormed Al-Aqsa mosque compound in the old city of Jerusalem and provoked worshipers. • Wall Gates: (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the Wall gate in Abu Dis town. (ii) The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate on Al-Shayyah road in the area between Al-Sawahira Al-Sharqiya and Al-Slewahira Al-Gharbiya villages, only allowing civilians holding Jerusalem IDs to cross, after subjecting them to thorough searches using electronic devices.

SALFIT	 Closure of Main Roads: The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the entrance to two detour roads connecting Marda village to its farmland. On 15.04.2012, the Israeli army has opened the northern entrance to Salfit city to civilian, which was closed since the year 2000 and prevented access from 08:00 until 09:20. Since 11:00 on July 30th 2012, Israeli forces have closed two roads leading to Abu Nasar and Qatan Al-Jama' located in western area of Deir Istiya with cement blocks. Checkpoints: Israeli forces continue to intensify their restrictions at Za'tara checkpoint and imped the free flow of traffic. Flying Checkpoint: At 22:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Al-Zawiya village until 01:30. Raid: At 01:00, Israeli forces raided Marda village until 01:20. Settler Violence: On October 23rd 2014, a group of Israeli settlers stormed Harris village palced barbed wire fence around and began levelling approximately 20 dunumes of agricultural land owned by Ali Suf in an attempt to confiscate the land. At 00:35, Israeli settlers stormed Kafil Harris as they visited "Bosheh Ban Nuns Tomb) then withdrew at a later time.
JERICHO	 Checkpoints: Israeli forces intensified its restrictions at Al-Hamra checkpoint set up along the road connecting Jericho and Nablus District. Flying Checkpoint: At 19:30, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the Dead Sea junction until 20:25. At 22:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Al-Nabi Musa area junction located along the main road connecting Jericho and Jerusalem until 23:20 At 23:55, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Al-Oja village junction until 00:10. Detention: At 11:20, Israeli force positioned at Allenby Bridge detained Omar Ghanam (A resident of Hebron) as he was returning from Jordan.
BETHLEHEM	 Closure: The Israeli army continues to close roads to An Nu'man village, with the exception of the road leading to the Wall gate in the south-eastern area of the village. Since 15 September 2007, the Israel army has prevented civilians from accessing or staying on 22 dunumes of confiscated land in Al Mazmuriya area in Beit Sahur and Bethlehem cities. Closure of Main Roads:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close the Beit Jala-Wadi Ahmed road; a road between Um Tuba and Al-Jass; a road between Um Tuba and Khilat Nu'man: a road between Um Tuba and the wall; a road between Al-Khas village and the wall; the 2 by pass roads located south of Al-Walaja; a road between Talita Qumi and Nazlat Al-Sider in Beit Jala; the eastern road of Al-Khader; the road between Al-Khader and Beit Jala; Wadi Rahal road near "Ifrat" settlement ,the road between Al-Khader and road #60 which lead to the eastern neighbourhoods of Bethlehem; a road leading to Wadi Rahal, and a road east of Beit Fajjar town with dirt mounds.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the road leading to "Newe Daniyyel" settlement and agricultural land in Al-Khader; a road between Um Tuba and Wadi Al-Hums: Wadi Fukin, Al-Jaba, the Green Line; a road between Za'tara and a detour road, and a road between Taqou and Khirbet Al-Deir with cement blocks.
- (iii) Since August 2nd 2012, Israeli forces closed a road leading to Beit Jalla.
- (iv) Since May 8th 2013, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Carmisan area in Beit Jalla and Al-Walaja with a steel gate and barbed wires.
- (v) Since June 3rd 2013, the Israeli army closed the road connecting Nihalin and road 60 with dirt mounds.
- (vi) Since 13:20 on September 29th 2013, the Israeli army closed a road leading to 50 acres of agricultural land in Wadi Salem area in Al-Khadr with dirt mounds.
- (vii) Israeli forces closed the main road connecting Surif and Al-Jub'a village with dirt mounds
- (viii) On January 28th 2014, Israeli forces closed the steel gate at the entrance of Nihalin { replacing the dirt mounds placed at the entrance since the year 2002} and placed time schedule for opening the gate from 06:00 until 14:00 on a daily bases.

• Detention:

- (i) At 02:25 on October 23rd 2014, Israeli forces detained Omar Zaghoul during their raid into Husan village as mentioned in the previous report.
- (ii) At 22:00, Israeli forces detained Usayed Hamarat (A resident of Husan village).
- <u>Temporary Detention:</u> At 22:00, Israeli forces positioned near Husan village temporarily detained Ahmad Za'oul then released him at 22:15.

• Attack:

- (i) At 11:50, Israeli forces positioned in Al-Khadr fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.
- (ii) At 16:05₂ Israeli forces positioned near Al-Ayda camp fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.

• Closure:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close Al-Shuhada' Street, Al-Sahleh and Khuzq Al-Far areas, as well as the old gold market in Hebron's Old City. In addition to closing the entrance to Al-Qeisi neighbourhood, the Israeli army continues to close the entrances to the area of Al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) with an electronic gate; Al-Laban Market also remains closed.
- (ii) Since 05 January 2009, the Israeli army has closed the area located along the Green Line south of the town of Yatta. Having seized land for Wall construction, the Israeli army evicted the Palestinian residents and denied them access to the area.

• Closure of Main Roads:

HEBRON

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Al-Thahiriya and Al-Samoa' towns, Al-'Arrub refugee camp, and Al-Tuwani and Al-Karmil villages.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to prohibit Palestinian vehicles from travelling along

- the old Al-Shalala Street leading to Hebron's Old City.
- (iii) The Israeli army continues to close all roads leading to Road # 60 as well as detour roads along the settler bypass road leading to Yatta town.
- (iv) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds a detour road leading to e to Al-Simiya village, the southern entrance of Al-Samou' and the entrance of Beit Annun with cement blocks.
- (v) Since July 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Safa and Al-Dirat and closed the entrance of south Yatta with cement blocks.
- (vi) On September 4th 2014, Israeli forces closed a road in Eiwn Al-Bas and Al-Bayda and Al-Ras area in Ithna locat6ed near the wall gate.
- (vii)At 13:40 on September 16th 2014, Israeli forces closed the main road leading to Al-Ibrahim mosque in the old city of Hebron.

• Flying Checkpoint:

- (i) At 08:40, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Ithna until
- (ii) At 15:15, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Beit Kahil until 16:00.

• Raid:

- (i) At 18:20, Israeli forces raided Al-Da'asiya village, stormed a home then withdrew at 19:00.
- (ii) At 01:30, Israeli forces raided Yatta, stormed a home summoned Nabil Abu Qabtiya (A National Security Force Officer) to report to Israeli Intelligence for questioning.
- (iii) At 02:00, Israeli forces raided Al-Thahriya.
- (iv)At 04:40, Israeli forces raided Hebron until 05:10.
- <u>Detention:</u> At 13:00, Israeli forces detained Nael Abu Shaykhiya (A resident of Dura) as they apprehended him near Al-Fuwar junction.
- <u>Temporary Detention:</u> At 11:10, Israeli forces temporarily detained Munir Mohammad near the old city of Hebron then released him at 14:10.

- At 19:00 on August 26th 2014, Palestinian Gunmen and the Israeli military agreed to a cease fire agreement (brokered by the Arab Republic of Egypt) which includes the opening of border crossings to allow the entry of emergency supplies and humanitarian goods as well as construction material and agreed to increase the fishing limit to 6 nautical miles with possibility of increase to 12 nautical miles by the end of the year and to decrease the Military area to 100 meters, allow freedom of movement and a halt to targeted killings and assassinations and negotiations will be held for discussion on rebuilding the sea port and airports in the coming month.
- Israeli Naval vessels opened fire towards Palestinian fishing boats off the shores of North Gaza and Rafah.

NORTHERN GAZA

- <u>Closure of Crossing Point:</u> Beit Hanun (Erez) is open for the passage of critical patients, journalists, NGO staff, businesspersons and passengers travelling abroad through Al-Karama crossing with previous coordination.
- Attack: At 08:30 October 22nd 2014, Israeli Naval vessels opened fire towards
