JERUSALEM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) On October 23rd 2015, the Israeli army, intensified their restrictions at the entrance to Jerusalem city, set up several flying checkpoints on the main road leading to the city and prevented worshippers under the age of 50 from conducting prayers at Al-Aqsa mosque compound, which forced residents to conduct prayers near checkpoints located outside Al-Aqsa mosque compound. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the ‘demarcation area’ along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits. (iii) The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill between Biddu and Beit Iksa villages. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the entrance to Jaba’ village. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to Beit Iksa village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandiya checkpoint. (iii) On October 14th 2015, Israeli forces closed the main road leading to Al-Eisawiya village with cement blocks. (iv) On October 14th 2015, Israeli forces closed the four entrances of Jabal Al-Mukabir neighbourhood with cement blocks. (v) On October 14th 2015, Israeli forces closed the three entrances of Sur Bahar with Cement blocks. (vi) On October 14th 2015, Israeli forces closed the entrance of Al-Tur neighbourhood (leading to Al-Za’im village in Jericho and Al-Eizariya) and Suliman French road with cement blocks. (vii) On October 14th 2015, Israeli forces closed the entrance of Wadi Al-Rabaybeh area in Silwan neighbourhood in Jerusalem with cement blocks. • <u>Checkpoints:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli authorities continue to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a “border crossing point” and designate a special crossing lane for holders of Jerusalem IDs and another for those possessing permits to access Jerusalem city. (ii) On September 19th 2012, Israeli forces closed Ras Khamis checkpoint near Shu’fat camp and impeded the free flow of traffic in order to construct the wall. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 16:30, Israeli forces raided Al-Eizariya, clashed with several residents as they assaulted a Medical unite for the Palestinian Red Crescent society. (ii) At 20:30, Israeli forces raided Abu Dis, clashed with several residents and as a result injured 27 residents and detained a resident as well as damaging two Ambulances owned by the Palestinian Red Crescent society and set fire to a vehicle after a tear gas grenade canister exploded inside it and left several others suffocated from tear gas inhalation. (iii) At dawn on October 24th 2015, Israeli forces raided Al-Eisawiya village, stormed and searched several homes and detained four residents. • <u>Detention:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli forces detained Awni Jallal Saqer in Abu Dis. (ii) Israeli forces detained four residents: Abed Dari, Mohammad Ali Nasser, Wajdi Mahmoud and Daoud Yusef Attiteh in Al-Eisawiya village. • <u>Attack:</u>

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 14:20, Israeli forces positioned near the entrance of Anata fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning. (ii) At 17:05, Israeli forces positioned near the North junction of Al-Ram fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning. (iii) At 21:20, Israeli forces positioned in Al-Eizariya fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning. (iv) At 21:20, Israeli forces positioned near the entrance of Hizma village fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and as a result set fire to a merchant shop owned by Mutliq family after a tear gas grenade exploded inside the shop. (v) At 21:20, Israeli forces positioned near Beit Ijza village fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning. (vi) On the evening of October 23rd 2015, Israeli forces positioned in Shu'fat camp fired live ammunition; rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Wall Gates:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the Wall gate in Abu Dis town. (ii) The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate on Al-Shayyah road in the area between Al-Sawahira Al-Sharqiya and Al-Slewahira Al-Gharbiya villages, only allowing civilians holding Jerusalem IDs to cross, after subjecting them to thorough searches using electronic devices.

On October 3rd 2015, Israeli forces closed the main road located near "Bet El" settlement and leading to Al-Jalazoun camp with cement blocks. (iii) Since 18:40 on October 16th 2015, Israeli forces closed the road between Silwad and Deir Jreir village located near "Ofra" settlement and closed the road connecting Silwad and Ain Yabrod with dirt mounds. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 13:25, Israeli forces set up two checkpoints at the entrances of Turmus'aya and Sinjil until 17:40. (ii) At 21:30, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint near Atarah bridge located in North Bir Ziet until 23:30. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 20:30, Israeli forces raided Al-Bireh city, stormed "Hassuneh" steel mill and confiscated surveillance camera footage then withdrew at 22:30. (ii) At 23:40, Israeli forces raided Beit Rima, clashed with several residents as they stormed a home then withdrew at 03:25. (iii) At 01:20, Israeli forces raided Silwad, stormed a home, summoned Mustafa Attallah Hamad to report to Israeli Intelligence for questioning then withdrew at 03:25. (iv) At 02:15, Israeli forces raided Abu Skhedium village stormed a home and summoned Abdel-Hamid Mohammad Abdel-Hamid to report to Israeli Intelligence for questioning then withdrew at 03:25. • <u>Attack:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 12:25, Israeli forces positioned near "Pesagout" settlement located in east Al-Bireh city fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning. (ii) At 12:55, Israeli forces positioned in the vicinity Al-Mahakma checkpoint located near "Bet El" settlement in North Al-Bireh city fired live ammunition, rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents (who were protesting against the continued Israeli Military and Settler assault on Al-Aqsa mosque compound)for alleged

	<p>stoning and as a result injured 7 residents including 3 children: Mohammad Saher Dabour (14 years old), Abdel-Rahman Musabah Elawi (17 years old), Sa'ed Mahmoud Zied (17 years old), Tariq Moqafaq Abu Shaqra, Omar Jaber Tumayzi, Ahmad Jamil Al-Ostath and Ibrahim Ahmad Samiya as well as leaving several others suffocating due to inhaling tear gas during which Israeli forces damaged a Ambulance after firing rubber coated steel bullets towards it.</p> <p>(iii) At 15:05, Israeli forces positioned in the vicinity of “Ofar” Military base/Prison fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.</p> <p>(iv) At 15:30, Israeli forces positioned near the entrance of Deir Nathim village fired live ammunition; rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and as a result injured two residents including a child: Abdallah Khier Mahmoud Al-Tamimi (17 years old) and Majdi Faraj Yahya Al-Tamimi.</p> <p>(v) At 16:10, Israeli forces positioned near the entrance of Silwad fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Temporary Detention:</u> At 15:55, Israeli forces positioned at Ni’lin military checkpoint temporarily detained Hadi Al-Dibis (A Journalist) and a Palestine Television News crew then released them at 16:30. • <u>Settler Violence:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 15:10, a group of Israeli settler positioned near the north area of Al-Bireh city opened fire in the area then withdrew under the protection of Israeli forces. (ii) At 15:50, a group of Israeli settlers positioned near Ain Yabroud village smashed the windows of a vehicle owned by Mazen Abdel-Qadder Dahaber. • <u>Demonstrations:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 12:15, a demonstration took place in Ni’lin protesting against the construction of the wall during which they clashed with Israeli forces and as a result injured Issah Muhieb Sarour and left several residents suffocated from tear gas inhalation. (ii) At 12:40, a demonstration took place in Bil’in protesting against the construction of the wall during which they clashed with Israeli forces and as a result and left, several residents suffocated from tear gas inhalation. (iii) At 16:40, a demonstration took place in Al-Nabi Saleh village protesting against land confiscation for the purpose of settlement construction and expansion during which they clashed with Israeli forces and as a result left several residents suffocated from tear gas inhalation.

(ii) Since the evening of November 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the western entrance of Ya’bad. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 19:20, Israeli forces raided Turat Al-Gharbiya (West Turat) village, clashed with several residents then withdrew at 19:55. (ii) At 02:20, Israeli forces raided Jenin and its camps, stormed and searched two homes, detained a resident in the camp then withdrew at 05:15. (iii) At dawn on October 24th 2015, Israeli forces raided Qabatiya and stormed several homes. • <u>Attack:</u>

(ii) At 16:20, Israeli forces positioned near the entrance of Al-Jamalah checkpoint located in North Jenin fired live ammunition, rubber coated steel bullets, and stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and as a result injured Ehab Mohammad Fathi Assas’a after he was run over by an Israeli military vehicle leaving him hospitalized and detained three residents. • <u>Detention:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli forces detained Yahya Turkman in Jenin camp. (ii) Israeli forces detained three residents: Majdi Rafiq Saba’neh (A resident of Qabatiya), Adham Abdel-Fatah Abu Raya (A resident of Jenin) and Islam Bassam Balbisi (A resident of Tulkarem) near the entrance of Al-Jamalah checkpoint located in North Jenin. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> Israeli forces continue too close the wall gate and only allow those holding special permits to enter through it.

TULKAREM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Checkpoint:</u> Israeli forces continue to intensify their restrictions at “Eniv” checkpoint located along the main road connecting Tulkarem and Nablus and impeded the free flow of traffic. • <u>Raid:</u> At 01:30, Israeli forces raided Zieta then stormed and searched several homes. • <u>Detention:</u> At 15:50, Israeli forces positioned near Ghashouri factories located in west Tulkarem detained Islam Bassam Jamil Balbis (A resident of Tulkarem) after assaulting him. • <u>Attack:</u> At 19:25, Israeli forces positioned near the wall gate in Shwikiya neighbourhood in Tulkarem fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.

(ii) In addition to closing the gate installed since the outbreak the second Intifada, the Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the eastern entrance to Kafr Qaddum village. (iii) Since 16:55 on December 18th 2014, Israeli forces closed an agricultural road leading to Far’ata village which is located near “Gillad” settlement with dirt mounds (iv) Since 10:40 on September 1st 2015, Israeli forces closed an agricultural road leading to Far’ata village which is located near “Gillad” settlement with a steel Gate • <u>Attack:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 11:30, Israeli forces positioned near the wall gate near Al-Naqqar neighbourhood in Qalqiliya fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and temporarily detained Hakeem Ibtali (8 years old) then released him at 13:00. (ii) At 15:30, Israeli forces positioned near Al-Jaljoliya gate located in south west Qalqiliya fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and as a result injured eight residents and left several others suffocated from tear gas inhalation. (iii) At 18:00, Israeli forces positioned near the entrance of Jayyous fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for allegedly stoning.

Having removed the gate at the entrance to the village of Ras Atiya; the Israeli army only allows students to cross to their schools outside the village through the Habla gate.

(ii) The Israeli army continues to close the northern entrance to Qabalan town; the southern entrances to the town of Jamma’in and the villages of Duma and Qaryut. (iii) At 22:00 on October 3rd 2015, Israeli forces closed the North entrance of Awarta village with dirt mounds. • Checkpoint: At 15:00, Israeli forces closed Huwara checkpoint and impeded the free flow of traffic until 16:20. • Flying Checkpoint: At 20:05, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Qabalan until 20:50. • Raid: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 19:05, Israeli forces raided Nablus city until 19:30. (ii) At 21:30, a group of Israeli settlers positioned near the entrance of Madma village attempted to storm the village and clashed with residents who attempted to prevent the settler attack.

(ii) On 15.04.2012, the Israeli army has opened the northern entrance to Salfit city to civilian, which was closed since the year 2000 and prevented access from 08:00 until 09:20. (iii) Since 11:00 on July 30th 2012, Israeli forces have closed two roads leading to Abu Nasar and Qatan Al-Jama' located in western area of Deir Istiya with cement blocks. • Checkpoint: Israeli forces intensified their restrictions at Za'tara checkpoint and impeded the free flow of traffic. • Flying Checkpoint: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 07:25, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the North entrance of Salfit. (ii) Since 15 September 2007, the Israel army has prevented civilians from accessing or staying on 22 dunumes of confiscated land in Al Mazmuriya area in Beit Sahur and Bethlehem cities. • Closure of Main Roads: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the Beit Jala-Wadi Ahmed road; a road between Um Tuba and Al-Jass ; a road between Um Tuba and Khilat Nu'man: a road between Um Tuba and the wall; a road between Al-Khas village and the wall; the 2 by pass roads located south of Al-Walaja; a road between Talita Qumi and Nazlat Al-Sider in Beit Jala; the eastern road of Al-Khader; the road between Al-Khader and Beit Jala ; Wadi Rahal road near "Ifrat" settlement ,the road between Al-Khader and road #60 which lead to the eastern neighbourhoods of Bethlehem; a road leading to Wadi Rahal, and a road east of Beit Fajjar town with dirt mounds. (iii) Since August 2nd 2012, Israeli forces closed a road leading to Beit Jalla.

HEBRON

- **Closure:**
 - (i) The Israeli army continues to close Khuzq Al-Far areas, as well as the old gold market in Hebron's Old City. In addition to closing the entrance to Al-Qeisi neighbourhood, the Israeli army continues to close the entrances to the area of Al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) with an electronic gate; Al-Laban Market also remains closed.
 - (ii) Since 05 January 2009, the Israeli army has closed the area located along the Green Line south of the town of Yatta. Having seized land for Wall construction, the Israeli army evicted the Palestinian residents and denied them access to the area.
- **Closure of Main Roads:**
 - (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Al-Karmil villages.
 - (ii) The Israeli army continues to prohibit Palestinian vehicles from travelling along the old Al-Shalala Street leading to Hebron's Old City.
 - (iii) The Israeli army continues to close all roads leading to Road # 60 as well as detour roads along the settler bypass road leading to Yatta town.
 - (iv) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds a detour road leading to e to Al-Simiya village, the southern entrance of Al-Samou' and the entrance of Beit Annun with cement blocks.
 - (v) Since July 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Safa and Al-Dirat and also closed the entrance of south Yatta with cement blocks.

- **Settler Violence:** At 15:35, a group of Israeli settlers positioned near the entrance of Beit Ummar assaulted two residents including a woman: Jamlia Hassan Al-Turk and Abdel-Haleem Abu Ayash.
