### **SUMMARY OF EVENTS**

Closure of Crossings	-	7	7	All border crossings are closed.

#### **WEST BANK**

#### • Closure:

- (i) On October 24<sup>th</sup> 2015, the Israeli army, continues to intensify their restrictions at the entrance to Jerusalem city, set up several flying checkpoints on the main road leading to the city and prevented worshipers from conducting prayers at Al-Aqsa mosque compound and prevented residents entering the mosque.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the 'demarcation area' along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits.
- (iii) The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill between Biddu and Beit Iksa villages.

#### Closure of Main Roads:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the entrance to Jaba' village.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to Beit Iksa village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandiya checkpoint.
- (iii) On October 14<sup>th</sup> 2015, Israeli forces closed the main road leading to Al-Eisawiya village with cement blocks.
- (iv) On October 14<sup>th</sup> 2015, Israeli forces closed the entrance of Jabal Al-Mukabir neighbourhood with cement blocks.

## (v) On October 14<sup>th</sup> 2015, Israeli forces closed the North entrance of Sur Bahar with Cement blocks.

- (vi) On October 14<sup>th</sup> 2015, Israeli forces closed the entrance of Al-Tur neighbourhood (leading to Al-Za'im village in Jericho and Al-Eizariya) and Suliman French road with cement blocks.
- (vii) On October 14<sup>th</sup> 2015, Israeli forces closed the entrance of Wadi Al-Rabaybeh area in Silwan neighbourhood in Jerusalem with cement blocks.

#### • Checkpoint:

- (i) Israeli forces considers Qalandiya checkpoint to be a border crossing point and only allows residents with Jerusalem Identification cards to enter the checkpoint.
- (ii) Since September 19<sup>th</sup> 2012, Israeli forces closed Ras Khamis and Shu'fat checkpoints and impeded the free flow of traffic in order to complete the construction of the wall.

#### • Raid:

- (i) At 18:35, Israeli forces raided Abu Dis.
- (ii) At dawn on October 25<sup>th</sup> 2015, Israeli forces raided Al-Eisawiya and detained a resident.

#### • Attack:

- (i) At 20:00, Israeli forces positioned at the entrance of Al-Eisawiya village and Al-Tur neighbourhood fired stun and tear gas grenades towards residents for alleged stoning.
- (ii) At 20:15, Israeli forces positioned in Ras Al-Amoud neighbourhood fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.

#### JERUSALEM

(iii) At 20:40, Israeli forces positioned near Hizma village fired live ammunition, rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several children for alleged stoning and as a result injured the child Ward Eyad Ahmad Al-Khatib (15 years old) leaving her hospitalised with contusions.

#### • Detention:

- (i) At dawn on October 24<sup>th</sup> 2015, Israeli forces detained Sufiyan Naser Mahmoud during their raid into Al-Eisawiya village.
- (ii) At 05:30, Israeli forces detained two residents: Mohammad Rakan and Faraj Al-Joulani in Ras Al-Amoud neighbourhood in Jerusalem.
- (iii) At 11:30, Israeli forces detained 4 resident: Akram Al-Ghazawi, Sameh Al-Ghazawi, Nidal Al-Bazlamit and Radwan Ahmad Abdel-Rahman in Al-Thuri neighbourhood.
- (iv) On October 24<sup>th</sup> 2015, Israeli forces detained Mohammad Ma'moun Al-Razim in Wadi Qaddum area in Silwan.
- (v) On October 24<sup>th</sup> 2015, Israeli forces detained Tawfiq Abu Adham in Jabal Al-Mukabir neighbourhood.
- (vi) At dawn on October 25<sup>th</sup> 2015, Israeli forces detained 3 residents: Amjad Al-Awar, Mansour Abu Gharbiya and Ahmad Abu Gharbiya in Silwan neighbourhood.
- (vii)Israeli force detained Yusef Obied in Al-Eisawiya village
- **Home Demolition:** On October 24<sup>th</sup> 2015, Israeli forces forced Abeer Eliyas Al-Rajabi to demolish her 100m<sup>2</sup> home in Beit Hanina and imposed a financial penalty for allegedly being built without a licence.

#### • Settler Violence:

- (i) At dawn on October 24<sup>th</sup> 2015, Israeli settlers stormed Um Tuba village and set fire to a vehicle and spray painted anti-Arab slogans on it.
- (ii) At 19:30, Israeli settlers stormed Sur Bahar and chased several residents as they attempted to assault and stab them with knives then withdrew under the protection of Israeli forces.
- (iii) At 20:00, Israeli settlers stormed Al-Thuri neighbourhood and assaulted several residents.

#### • Wall Gates:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the Wall gate in Abu
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate on Al-Shayyah road in the area between Al-Sawahira Al-Sharqiya and Al-Slewahira Al-Gharbiya villages, only allowing civilians holding Jerusalem IDs to cross, after subjecting them to thorough searches using electronic devices.

#### • Closure of Main Roads:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Sinjil village well as the junction to Kafr Malik and 'Ein Samiya villages.
- (ii) On October 3<sup>rd</sup> 2015, Israeli forces closed the main road located near "Bet El" settlement and leading to Al-Jalazoun camp with cement blocks.
- (iii) At 23:30 on October 20<sup>th</sup> 2015, Israeli forces closed the entrance to Ni'lin with cement blocks.
- <u>Checkpoint:</u> Since October 24<sup>th</sup> 2015, Israeli forces closed Al-Mahkama checkpoint located near "Bet El" settlement located in North Al-Bireh city and impeded the free flow of traffic (for the firebombing of an Israeli settler vehicle as alleged by the Israeli Military).

#### • Flying Checkpoint:

(i) At 09:25, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint in Eyoun Al-Haramiya junction located along the road connecting Ramallah and Nablus, detained a resident then withdrew at 15:45.

- <u>Checkpoint:</u> At 10:15 on October 22<sup>nd</sup> 2015, Israeli forces closed checkpoint (300), restricted access and impeded the free flow of traffic until October 26<sup>th</sup> 2015.

#### • Flying Checkpoint:

- (i) At 11:30, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the North West entrance of Beit Jallah until 13:55.
- (ii) At 18:10, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Al-Nashash area junction (located at the south entrance of Bethlehem) until 19:55.
- (iii) At 19:45, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint near Al-Khader until 20:20.
- (iv) At 20:15, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Za'tara until 21:00.

#### • Raid:

- (i) At 00:30, Israeli forces raided Al-Obidiya, searched several homes, detained 3 residents including a child and summoned two residents including a child: Wassim Mohamamd Al-Assa (17 years old) and Mohammad Munir Shantiya to report to Israeli Intelligence for questioning and then withdrew at 03:55.
- (ii) At 01:00, Israeli forces raided Bethlehem, clashed with several residents as they stormed a steel mill owned by Al-Sayih family and summoned Issam Atta Al-Sha'er to report to Israeli Intelligence for questioning then withdrew at 05:00.
- Attack: At 16:00, Israeli forces positioned near Billal Bin Rabah mosque located in North Bethlehem fired live ammunition; rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and as a result injured Islam Mahmoud Ahmad Qanis as well as leaving several others suffocated from tear gas inhalation.
- <u>Detention:</u> Israeli forces detained three residents: Zidan Ahmad Abed Radaydeh (16 years old), Ahmad Mohammad Radaydeh and Hisham Nabil Ahmad Radaydeh in Al-Obidiya.

#### • Closure:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close Khuzq Al-Far areas, as well as the old gold market in Hebron's Old City. In addition to closing the entrance to Al-Qeisi neighbourhood, the Israeli army continues to close the entrances to the area of Al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) with an electronic gate; Al-Laban Market also remains closed.
- (ii) Since 05 January 2009, the Israeli army has closed the area located along the Green Line south of the town of Yatta. Having seized land for Wall construction, the Israeli army evicted the Palestinian residents and denied them access to the area.

#### • Closure of Main Roads:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Al-Karmil villages.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to prohibit Palestinian vehicles from travelling along the old Al-Shalala Street leading to Hebron's Old City.
- (iii) The Israeli army continues to close all roads leading to Road # 60 as well as detour roads along the settler bypass road leading to Yatta town.
- (iv) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds a detour road leading to e to Al-Simiya village, the southern entrance of Al-Samou' and the entrance of Beit Annun with cement blocks.
- (v) Since July 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Safa and Al-Dirat and also closed the entrance of south Yatta with cement blocks.
- (vi) At 11:00 on August 6<sup>th</sup> 2015, Israeli forces closed the entrance of Al-Hajara village located in south Dura with cement blocks.

#### **HEBRON**

#### • Flying Checkpoint:

- (i) At 10:40, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Al-Fuwar camp junction and detained a resident.
- (ii) At 19:20, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Sa'ir.
- (iii) At 22:30, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Bani Na'im.

#### Attack:

- At 16:35, Israeli forces positioned near Al-Fuwar junction fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.
- (ii) At 21:25, Israeli forces positioned at the entrance of Al-Aroub camp fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several homes and residents inside the camp for alleged stoning and as a result injured a child: Ibrahim Mohammad Al-Aqrabiya (8 years old).
- <u>Detention:</u> Israeli forces detained Ahmad Mahmoud Ismail Al-Turat (A resident of Tafuh).
- <u>Settler Violence:</u> At 23:00, Israeli settlers positioned in the old city of Hebron attacked Al-Rajabi family home and then stormed Al-Kayel mosque and attempted to break the main entrance gate.

At 19:00 on August 26<sup>th</sup> 2014, Palestinian Gunmen and the Israeli military agreed to a cease fire agreement (brokered by the Arab Republic of Egypt) which includes the opening of border crossings to allow the entry of emergency supplies and humanitarian goods as well as construction material and agreed to increase the fishing limit to 6 nautical miles with possibility of increase to 12 nautical miles by the end of the year and to decrease the Military area to 100 meters, allow freedom of movement and a halt to targeted killings and assassinations and negotiations will be held for discussion on rebuilding the sea port and airports in the coming month.
