<b>JERUSALEM</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b><u>Closure:</u></b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) The Israeli army continues to intensify its restrictions at checkpoints located at the entrance to Jerusalem city, set up several flying checkpoints on the main road leading to the city entrance and the entrance to the Old City.</li> <li>(ii) The Israeli army continues to close the ‘demarcation area’ along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits.</li> <li>(iii) The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill between Biddu and Beit Ikxa villages.</li> </ul> </li> <li>• <b><u>Closure of Main Roads:</u></b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the entrance to Jaba’ village.</li> <li>(ii) The Israeli army continues to close the gate along the Wall section separating the area of Dahiyat Al-Bareed from Al-Ram town.</li> <li>(iii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to Beit Ikxa village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandiya checkpoint.</li> </ul> </li> <li>• <b><u>Checkpoints:</u></b> Israeli authorities continue to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a “border crossing point” and designate a special crossing lane for holders of Jerusalem IDs and another for those possessing permits to access Jerusalem city.</li> <li>• <b><u>Raid:</u></b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) On the morning of October 25<sup>th</sup> 2011 Israeli forces raided Anata, stormed a poultry farm, and levelled a plot of agricultural land owned by Mohammad Halawa for allegedly not having proper licensing.</li> <li>(ii) At 23:30, Israeli forces raided Mikhmas village and stormed a home.</li> <li>(iii) At dawn on October 26<sup>th</sup> 2011, Israeli forces raided Biet Ikxa, searched 2 homes and detained 2 residents.</li> </ul> </li> <li>• <b><u>Detention:</u></b> Israeli forces detained Motaz Zayed and Munther Muzayed, during their raid into Beit Ikxa.</li> <li>• <b><u>Temporary Detention:</u></b> On October 25<sup>th</sup> 2011, Israeli forces positioned at Al-Zaim checkpoint at the eastern entrance of Jerusalem, detained Samir Al-Esawi, a resident of Al-Esawiya, taking him to “Almaskobia” interrogation centre and releasing him at a later time.</li> <li>• <b><u>Wall Gates:</u></b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the Wall gate in Abu Dis town.</li> <li>(ii) The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate on</li> </ul> </li> </ul>

According to an Israeli High Court decision, the new Wall route will be constructed west of the village.</li> </ul>

	<p>Qaddoum, searching civilians and vehicles.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b><u>Settler Violence:</u></b> At 12:00, an Israeli settler levelled a plot of agricultural land east of Kafr Qaddoum village; the plot belongs to Salim Aishtewi.</li> <li>• <b><u>Wall Gates:</u></b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) The Israeli army continues to restrict access at ‘Azzun ‘Atma Wall gate and to search civilians, including students, using a metal detector.</li> <li>(ii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the entrance to the village of Wadi Al-Rasha and to deny civilian access. The Israeli army allows residents to access the village through Gate #109. Having removed the gate at the entrance to the village of Ras ‘Atiya; the Israeli army only allows students to cross to their schools outside the village through the Habla gate.</li> </ul> </li> <li>• <b><u>Wall Construction:</u></b> Wall construction resumed in Kafr Laqef village north of Karnei Shomron settlement; in Immatin village northeast of Imanuel settlement; and east of Kafr Thulth town near Ma’ale Shomron settlement .</li> </ul>

The entrance had been closed for seven years, and at 11:00, Israeli forces closed the entrance and impeded the free flow of traffic.</li> </ul> </li> <li>• <b>Checkpoints:</b> The Israeli army continues to increase its restrictions on access at Za'tara checkpoint and impeded the free flow of traffic.</li> <li>• <b>Temporary Detention:</b> At 17:50, Israeli forces detained 2 minors from Hares village who were collecting the olive harvest near the main road: Naji Shamlawi (16 years) and Mohammad Obeid (16 years); they were released them at 21:00.</li> <li>• <b>Wall Construction:</b> Wall construction resumed in the area north of Deir Istiya town southeast of the illegal settlement Emmanuel .</li> </ul>
<b>JERICHO</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b>Closure of Main Road:</b> The Israeli army continues to close Road # 90 between Jericho city and Al-Ouja village with cement blocks.</li> <li>• <b>Checkpoints:</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) Israeli forces continue to restrict access through Al-Hamra checkpoint set up along the road connecting Jericho and Nablus Districts, only allowing access to residents of Jericho District and the Jordan Valley area.</li> <li>(ii) Israeli forces continues to intensify its restrictions at the checkpoint set up on the junction to Al-Ouja village, only allowing access to residents of the Jericho District and others with access permits.</li> </ul> </li> <li>• <b>Flying Checkpoints:</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) At 13:30 and again at 18:50, Israeli forces set up a flying checkpoint at the southern entrance of Jericho city, searching civilians and vehicles.</li> <li>(ii) At 16:30, Israeli forces set up a flying checkpoint near Ein Dweik village near the northern entrance of Jericho, searching civilians and vehicles.</li> <li>(iii) At 21:10, Israeli forces set up a flying checkpoint at Al-Nabi Musa junction on the main road connecting Jericho and Jerusalem, searching civilians and vehicles.</li> </ul> </li> <li>• <b>Raid:</b> At 21:10, Israeli forces raided Al-Oja village until 21:30.</li> </ul>
<b>BETHLEHEM</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b>Closure:</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) The Israeli army continues to close roads to An Nu'man village, with the exception of the road leading to the Wall gate in the south-eastern area of the village.</li> <li>(ii) Since 15 September 2007, the Israeli army has prevented civilians from accessing or staying on 22 <i>dunums</i> of confiscated land in Al Mazmuriya area in Beit Sahur and Bethlehem cities.</li> </ul> </li> <li>• <b>Closure of Main Roads:</b> The Israeli army continues to close the Beit Jala-Wadi Ahmed road; a road east of Beit Fajjar town; the road connecting Tuqu' town to Khirbet al Baq'a village; and the detour road connecting Wadi Fukin and Al Jab'a villages.</li> <li>• <b>Checkpoints:</b> At 17:00, Israeli forces intensified its restrictions at "Container" checkpoint and impeded the free flow of traffic.</li> <li>• <b>Flying Checkpoints:</b></li> </ul>

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) At 08:20, Israeli forces set up a flying checkpoint at Al-Nashash junction, searching civilians and vehicles.</li> <li>(ii) At 11:05, Israeli forces set up a flying checkpoint at the entrance of Harmala village, searching civilians and vehicles.</li> <li>(iii) At 11:30, Israeli forces set up a flying checkpoint near Dar Salah village at the eastern entrance of Beit Sahour, searching civilians and vehicles.</li> <li>(iv) At 16:50, Israeli forces set up a flying checkpoint near the Kfar Atzion settlement, searching civilians and vehicles.</li> <li>• <b><u>Raids:</u></b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) At 08:00, Israeli forces raided Beit Fajar and took photos of several quarries then withdrew at 09:00.</li> <li>(ii) At 03:10, Israeli forces raided Bethlehem, fired stun grenades while searching several homes, detained 5 residents and withdrew at 05:30.</li> </ul> </li> <li>• <b><u>Detention:</u></b> Israeli forces detained, Mohammad Rabaa, Mohammad Al-Hreimi, Jamil Rabaa, Rida Sadouk and Muntaser Sudouk.</li> <li>• <b><u>Wall Construction:</u></b> Wall construction resumed in northwest of Beit Jala town .</li> </ul>
<b>Hebron</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b><u>Closure:</u></b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) The Israeli army continues to close Al-Shuhada' Street, Al-Sahleh and Khuzaq Al-Far areas, as well as the old gold market in Hebron's Old City. In addition to closing the entrance to Al-Qeisi neighbourhood, the Israeli army continues to close the entrances to the area of Al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) with an electronic gate; Al-Laban Market also remains closed.</li> <li>(ii) Since 05 January 2009, the Israeli army has closed the area located along the Green Line south of the town of Yatta. Having seized land for Wall construction, the Israeli army evicted the Palestinian residents and denied them access to the area.</li> </ul> </li> <li>• <b><u>Closure of Main Roads:</u></b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Al-Dhahiriya and Al-Samoa' towns, Al-'Arrub refugee camp, and Al-Tuwani and Al-Karmil villages.</li> <li>(ii) The Israeli army continues to prohibit Palestinian vehicles from travelling along the old Al-Shalala Street leading to Hebron's Old City.</li> <li>(iii) The Israeli army continues to close all roads leading to Road # 60 as well as detour roads along the settler bypass road leading to Yatta town.</li> <li>(iv) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds a detour road leading to the entrance to Al-Simiya village.</li> <li>(v) Since October 15<sup>th</sup> 2011, the Israeli army closed two secondary roads leading to Beit Ummar with cement blocks.</li> </ul> </li> <li>• <b><u>Flying Checkpoints:</u></b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) At 08:00, Israeli forces set up a flying checkpoint at the entrance of Al-Fawwar refugee camp, searching civilians and vehicles.</li> <li>(ii) At 08:00, Israeli forces set up a flying checkpoint at Al Huwwar area junction at the northern entrance of Halhoul, searching civilians and vehicles.</li> <li>(iii) At 14:00, Israeli forces set up a flying checkpoint at the entrance of Al-Samou village junction, searching civilian and vehicles.</li> <li>(iv) At 16:50, Israeli forces set up a flying checkpoint at the entrance of Beit Ummar, searching civilians and vehicles.</li> <li>(v) At 17:00, Israeli forces set up a flying checkpoint at Khursa village junction, searching civilians and vehicles.</li> </ul> </li> </ul>
