JERUSALEM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) On October 25th 2013 Israeli army, intensified their restrictions at the entrance to Jerusalem city, set up several flying checkpoints on the main road leading to the city and prevented worshipers under the age of 50 from conducting prayers at Al-Aqsa mosque compound. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the ‘demarcation area’ along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits. (iii) The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill between Biddu and Beit Iksa villages. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the entrance to Jaba’ village. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to Beit Iksa village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandiya checkpoint. • <u>Checkpoints:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli authorities continue to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a “border crossing point” and designate a special crossing lane for holders of Jerusalem IDs and another for those possessing permits to access Jerusalem city and at 06:00, Israeli forces closed the checkpoint impeded the free flow of traffic. (ii) On September 19th 2012, Israeli forces closed Ras Khamis checkpoint near Shu’fat camp and impeded the free flow of traffic in order to construct the wall. • <u>Detention:</u> At 18:00, Israeli forces positioned at Al-Zaytoun checkpoint detained Bassam Al-Halabi, a resident of Beit Ummar Hebron. • <u>Attack:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 14:20, Israeli forces positioned at Anata junction fired stun and tear gas grenades towards residents for alleged stoning. (ii) At 14:30, Israeli forces positioned at Al-Ram junction fired stun and tear gas grenades towards residents for alleged stoning. (iii) At 14:30, Israeli forces positioned at the vicinity of Qalandiya checkpoint fired stun and tear gas grenades towards residents for alleged stoning. (iv) At 18:30, Israeli forces positioned near the wall gate in Abu Dis fired stun and tear gas grenades towards residents for alleged stoning. • <u>Demonstration:</u> At 17:20, a demonstration took place in Al-Sheikh Jarah neighbourhood in Jerusalem protesting against settlement construction and settler violence. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the Wall gate in Abu Dis town.

	<p>(ii) The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate on Al-Shayyah road in the area between Al-Sawahira Al-Sharqiya and Al-Slewahira Al-Gharbiya villages, only allowing civilians holding Jerusalem IDs to cross, after subjecting them to thorough searches using electronic devices.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Wall Construction: Wall construction continued in the areas north and south of Qalandiya village; south of Al-Za'ayyem village; and in Wadi Al-Eizariya west of the illegal settlement Ma 'ale Adumim.

(ii) Since September 3rd 2013, Israeli forces closed the north east entrance of Al-Mughier village with dirt mounds. • Attack: At 15:45, Israeli forces positioned near the wall gate in Beit Liqya fired rubber coated steel bullets and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning. • Demonstration: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 13:30, a demonstration took place in Al-Nabi Saleh village protesting against land confiscation for the purpose of settlement construction, demonstrators clashed with Israeli forces and left several demonstrators suffocating from tear gas inhalation (ii) At 12:30, a demonstration took place in Bil'in village protesting against the construction of the wall, clashed with demonstrators injured 2 residents Mohammad Yassin (Photo Journalist) and Abdel Qadder Abu Rahmeh and left several demonstrators suffocated from tear gas inhalation. (iii) At 12:35, a demonstration took place in Nil'in village protesting against the construction of the wall, clashed with demonstrators and left several demonstrators suffocated from tear gas inhalation • Wall Construction: Wall construction continued in the area west of 'Abud town in the area surrounding the illegal settlement 'Ofarim and north of Al-Lubban Al-Gharbi and Rantis villages.

(ii) Since the evening of November 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the western entrance of Ya'bad. • Raid: At 09:30 and again at 23:20, Israeli forces raided Ya'bad, occupied Atef Abu Bakers home and converted its roof top into a military post, clashed with residents then withdrew at 01:00. • Assault on Property: On October 25th 2013, Israeli forces prevented several residents from collecting Olive harvest in Ya'bad. • Wall Gates: Passage through the Wall gates is restricted to civilians granted special Israeli permits, which undercuts the access to education and health services for civilians living behind the Wall.
TUBAS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Checkpoint: At 14:35, Israeli forces intensified its restrictions at Tayasir checkpoint and impeded the free flow of traffic. • Flying Checkpoint: At 19:50, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Bardala and impeded the free flow of traffic until 22:10. • Raid: At 20:00, Israeli forces raided Ein Al-Bayda village, stormed and searched 3 homes.
TULKAREM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure of Main Roads: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the road connecting Kafr Al-Labad town to Shufa village.

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the detour road leading to Ramin village along the Tulkarem-Nablus main road. • <u>Checkpoint:</u> At 09:00, Israeli forces continue to intensify their restrictions at “Eniv: checkpoint and impeded the free flow of traffic until 11:00. • <u>Temporary Detention:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 08:00, Israeli forces positioned near Khirbit Al-Jabra village temporarily detained 6 residents including a woman (All residents of Far’un village): Ayisha Rajab, Amjad Suliman, Usayed Ibrahim, Ibrahim Ibrahim, Ghndi Ibrahim and Al-Motawakil Ibrahim as they were collecting Olive harvest then released them at 13:15. (ii) At 20:30, Israeli forces positioned near the wall gate near Zita village temporarily detained 2 residents: Hantahs Hantash and Nu’aman Awad and released them at 02:00. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> Passage through the Wall gates is restricted to civilians granted special Israeli permits, which undercuts the access to education and health services for civilians living behind the Wall.
QALQILIYA	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli forces continue to close with cement blocks agricultural roads east of Azzun town. (ii) In addition to closing the gate installed since the outbreak the second Intifada, the Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the eastern entrance to Kafr Qaddum village. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 15:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Azzun and impeded the free flow of traffic. (ii) At 16:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Hajja village. • <u>Attack:</u> At 15:50, Israeli forces positioned near the wall gate in South Qalqiliya fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents as they were collecting live harvests. • <u>Assault on Property:</u> At 12:25, Israeli forces forcibly removed several residents as they were collecting olive harvests in Jit village. • <u>Demonstration:</u> At 12:30, a demonstration took place in Kafr Qaddum against the closure of the east entrance, clashed with Israeli forces as they attempted to disrupt demonstrators, injured 2 residents: Mu’in Barhoum and Mo’ayad Ishtawi after being struck with tear gas grenade canisters and as a result left several demonstrators suffocating from tear gas inhalation. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to restrict access at ‘Azzun ‘Atma Wall gate closed the steel gate at 11:55 and to search civilians, including students, using a metal detector. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the entrance to the village of Wadi Al- Rasha and to deny civilian access. The Israeli army allows residents to access the village through Gate #109. Having removed the gate at the entrance to the village of Ras Atiya; the Israeli army only allows students to cross to their schools outside the village through the Habla gate. • <u>Wall Construction:</u> Wall construction was continued in Kafr Laqif village north of Karnei Shomron settlement; in Immatin village northeast of Immanuel settlement; and east of Kafr Thulth town near Ma ’ale Shomron settlement.

(iii) At 19:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at "Shave Shomron" at settlement junction until 19:20. (iv) At 22:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Sarah village until 23:40. • <u>Settler Violence:</u> At 14:10, Israeli settlers stormed agricultural land in Huwara and uprooted 30 Olive trees owned by Daoud Odeh.

(ii) On 15.04.2012, the Israeli army has opened the northern entrance to Salfit city to civilian which was closed since the year 2000 and prevented access from 08:00 until 09:20. (iii) Since 11:00 on July 30th 2012, Israeli forces have closed two roads leading to Abu Nasar and Qatan Al-Jama' located in western area of Deir Istiya with cement blocks. • <u>Checkpoints:</u> Israeli forces continue to intensify their restrictions at Za'tara Al-checkpoint and impeded the free flow of traffic. • <u>Raid:</u> At 00:45, Israeli forces raided Kafr Al-Dik, detained a resident then withdrew at 04:00. • <u>Detention:</u> Israeli forces detained Sabr Al-Dik in Kafr Al-Dik. • <u>Wall Construction:</u> Wall construction continued in the area north of Deir Istiya town southeast of the illegal settlement.
<p style="text-align: center;">JERICHO</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Checkpoints:</u> Israeli forces continue to intensify its restrictions at Al-Hamra checkpoint set up along the road connecting Jericho and Nablus District. • <u>Detention:</u> On October 25th 2013, Israeli forces positioned at Allenby bridge detained Mus'ab Ghanimat , a resident of Hebron as he was returning from Jordan. • <u>Temporary Detention:</u> At 10:30, Israeli forces positioned at Allenby bridge temporarily detained Abdel Latif Al-Qaddumi (A Palestinian Police officer) as he was returning from Jordan and released him at 10:50.

(ii) Since 15 September 2007, the Israel army has prevented civilians from accessing or staying on 22 dunumes of confiscated land in Al Mazmuriya area in Beit Sahur and Bethlehem cities. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the Beit Jala-Wadi Ahmed road; a road between Um Tuba and Al-Jass ; a road between Um Tuba and Khilat Nu'man: a road between Um Tuba and the wall; a road between Al-Khas village and the wall; the 2 by pass roads located south of Al-Walaja; a road between Talita Qumi and Nazlat Al-Sider in Beit Jala; the eastern road of Al-Khader; the road between Al-Khader and Beit Jala ; Wadi Rahal road near "Ifrat" settlement

(ii) At 19:50, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint in Ush Al-Ghurab area in east Beit Sahur. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At dawn on October 25th 2013, Israeli forces raided Al-Ayda camp in Bethlehem, stormed a home and summoned Ayman Abdel Rahman to report to Israeli intelligence for questioning. (ii) At 01:30, Israeli force raided, Al-Ubidiya , stormed a home and summoned Adnan Shanatiya to report to Israeli intelligence for questioning then withdrew at 03:20. • <u>Demonstration:</u> At 12:15, a demonstration took place in Al-Ma’sara village protesting against the construction of the wall during which Israeli forces prevented them from reaching the demonstration site, during which they fired tear gas grenades towards demonstrators and as a result left several demonstrators suffocating from tear gas inhalation. • <u>Wall Construction:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Wall construction has continued in North West of Beit Jala town. (ii) On May 1st 2103, an Israeli court ordered the halt of wall construction near Betar village. (iii) On July 21st 2013, Israeli courts ordered the halt of construction of the wall in Al-Carmisan area in the west area of Beit Jalla.
HEBRON	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close Al-Shuhada’ Street, Al-Sahleh and Khuzq Al-Far areas, as well as the old gold market in Hebron’s Old City. In addition to closing the entrance to Al-Qeisi neighbourhood, the Israeli army continues to close the entrances to the area of Al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) with an electronic gate; Al-Laban Market also remains closed. (ii) Since 05 January 2009, the Israeli army has closed the area located along the Green Line south of the town of Yatta. Having seized land for Wall construction, the Israeli army evicted the Palestinian residents and denied them access to the area. . • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Al-Thahiriya and Al-Samoa’

- towns, Al-‘Arrub refugee camp, and Al-Tuwani and Al-Karmil villages.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to prohibit Palestinian vehicles from travelling along the old Al-Shalala Street leading to Hebron’s Old City.
 - (iii) The Israeli army continues to close all roads leading to Road # 60 as well as detour roads along the settler bypass road leading to Yatta town.
 - (iv) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds a detour road leading to e to Al-Simiya village, the southern entrance of Al-Samou’ and the entrance of Beit Annun with cement blocks.
 - (v) Since July 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Safa and Al-Dirat and also closed the entrance of south Yatta with cement blocks.
 - (vi) Since December 27th 2012, Israeli forces closed the west entrance of Swiesiya village which connects Yatta and Al-Samou’ village with cement blocks.
 - (vii) Since 09:45 on September 23rd 2013, Israeli forces closed the main road leading to “Haji” settlement and impeded the free flow of traffic
- **Flying checkpoint:**
 - (i) At 08:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Tarqumiya.
 - (ii) At 22:10, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Halhul bridge.
 - **Raid:** At 10:25 and again at 00:50, Israeli forces raided Al-Thahriya until 03:15.
 - **Attack:**
 - (i) At 17:15, Israeli forces positioned near Huwwara junction located in north Hebron fired tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning, temporarily detained 3 residents including 2 children: Qusay Al-Qawasmi (11 years old) , Rabi’ Zamar’a (11 years old) and Alla Al-Arja.
 - (ii) At 13:00, Israeli forces positioned at the entrance of Beit Ummar, fired rubber coated steel bullets , stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents participating in a funeral for alleged stoning, injured 5 residents and left several others suffocating from tear gas inhalation.
 - **Settler Violence:** At 18:30, Israeli settlers stormed the old city of Hebron, assaulted Mohammad Al-Qamiri and his wife Ramizya Al-Kamiri leaving them hospitalised with contusions.
 - **Assault on Places of Worship:** On October 25th 2013, Israeli forces closed Al-Ibrahimi mosque and prevented the call for prayer from the afternoon of October 25th 2013 until 21:00 on October 26th 2013 for alleged Israeli celebration of Jewish holiday.
 - **Wall Construction:** Wall construction continued in the area surrounding the illegal settlement Eshkolot, west of Al-Thahriya town.

At a later time on the same day, armed Palestinian groups announced an agreement to cease fire. • On November 14th 2011 Israeli forces placed floating marks 3 miles from Gaza's seashore and warned fishermen against passing beyond the mark and on November 24th 2012, Israeli forces imposed floating marks of 6 miles and on March 21st 2013 re imposed fishing restrictions of 3 miles.
<p style="text-align: center;">NORTHERN GAZA</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Crossing Point:</u> Beit Hanun (Erez) is open for the passage of critical patients, journalists, NGO staff, businessmen and passengers travelling abroad through Al-Karama crossing with previous coordination.
<p style="text-align: center;">GAZA</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Crossing Points:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Al-Muntar (Karni) Crossing is closed. Beginning on 02 March 2011, the Crossing has been effectively closed following a unilateral Israeli decision. (ii) Al-Shija'iya (Nahal 'Oz) Crossing is closed. Beginning on 04 January 2010, the Crossing has been closed following a unilateral Israeli decision.
