Killing	1	-	1	A 17 year old School girl{A resident of Hebron} was killed after Israeli forces opened fire at her near Al-Ibrahimi mosque checkpoint in the old city of Hebron for allegedly attempting to stab an Israeli soldier (as alleged by the Israeli military).
Injury	6	-	6	1 in Tulkarem and 5 in Hebron including a resident critically injured after he was shot by an Israeli settler and another resident after he was assaulted by Israeli forces.
Physical Assault	2	-	2	Israeli forces assaulted a resident in Salfit and another resident in Bethlehem.

Assault on Places of Worship	1	-	1	Israeli settlers under the protection of Israeli force stormed Al-Aqsa mosque compound in the old city of Jerusalem.
Settler Violence	4	-	4	Israeli settlers assaulted several residents who were collecting Olive harvest in Beit Furiq in Nablus, chanted anti-Arab slogans and slurs towards several residents in the west entrance of Kafr Al-Dik in Salfit and opened fire towards several residents as they were collecting Olive harvests in Hebron.

<b>JERUSALEM</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b><u>Closure:</u></b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) On October 25<sup>th</sup> 2015, the Israeli army, continues to intensify their restrictions at the entrance to Jerusalem city, set up several flying checkpoints on the main road leading to the city and prevented worshippers from conducting prayers at Al-Aqsa mosque compound and prevented residents entering the mosque.</li> <li>(ii) The Israeli army continues to close the 'demarcation area' along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits.</li> <li>(iii) The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill between Biddu and Beit Iksa villages.</li> </ul> </li> <li>• <b><u>Closure of Main Roads:</u></b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the entrance to Jaba' village.</li> <li>(ii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to Beit Iksa village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandiya checkpoint.</li> <li>(iii) On October 14<sup>th</sup> 2015, Israeli forces closed the main road leading to Al-Eisawiya village with cement blocks.</li> <li>(iv) On October 14<sup>th</sup> 2015, Israeli forces closed the entrance of Jabal Al-Mukabir neighbourhood with cement blocks.</li> <li>(v) On October 14<sup>th</sup> 2015, Israeli forces closed the North entrance of Sur Bahar with Cement blocks.</li> <li>(vi) On October 14<sup>th</sup> 2015, Israeli forces closed the entrance of Al-Tur neighbourhood (leading to Al-Za'im village in Jericho and Al-Eizariya) and Suliman French road with cement blocks.</li> <li>(vii) On October 14<sup>th</sup> 2015, Israeli forces closed the entrance of Wadi Al-Rabaybeh area in Silwan neighbourhood in Jerusalem with cement blocks.</li> </ul> </li> <li>• <b><u>Checkpoint:</u></b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) Israeli forces considers Qalandiya checkpoint to be a border crossing point and only allows residents with Jerusalem Identification cards to enter the checkpoint.</li> <li>(ii) Since September 19<sup>th</sup> 2012, Israeli forces closed Ras Khamis and Shu'fat checkpoints and impeded the free flow of traffic in order to complete the construction of the wall.</li> </ul> </li> <li>• <b><u>Flying Checkpoint:</u></b> At 22:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Beit Hanina.</li> <li>• <b><u>Detention:</u></b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) At 13:30, Israeli forces positioned at Shu'fat checkpoint detained Mohammad Jamal Al-Qare' (A resident of Shu'fat camp).</li> <li>(ii) At dawn on October 26<sup>th</sup> 2015, Israeli forces detained two residents: Mu'taz Jaber and Fathi Jaber after storming their homes in Al-Sa'aydeh neighbourhood in the old city of Jerusalem.</li> <li>(iii) At dawn on October 26<sup>th</sup> 2015, Israeli forces detained three residents including a child: Shadi Gharab (17 years old), Tamer Al-Qawasmi and Nader Marwan Nasser in Al-Thuri and Ras Al-Amoud neighbourhoods.</li> </ul> </li> <li>• <b><u>Assault on Places of Worship:</u></b> At 08:00, a group of Israeli settlers under the protection of Israeli military forces stormed Al-Aqsa mosque compound in the old city of Jerusalem and provoked worshippers.</li> <li>• <b><u>Wall Gates:</u></b></li> </ul>

<p><b>QALQILIYA</b></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(ii) In addition to closing the gate installed since the outbreak the second Intifada, the Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the eastern entrance to Kafr Qaddum village.</li> <li>(iii) Since 10:40 on September 1<sup>st</sup> 2015, Israeli forces closed an agricultural road leading to Far'ata village, which is located near "Gillad" settlement with a steel Gate.</li> <li>• <b>Raid:</b> At 03:25, Israeli forces raided Azzun, stormed and searched three homes then withdrew at 05:00.</li> <li>• <b>Wall Gates:</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) The Israeli army continues to restrict access at 'Azzun 'Atma Wall gate and impeded the free flow of traffic. The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the entrance to the village of Wadi Al- Rasha and to deny civilian access.</li> <li>(ii) The Israeli army allows residents to access the village through Gate #109. Having removed the gate at the entrance to the village of Ras Atiya, the Israeli army only allows students to cross to their schools outside the village through the Habla gate.</li> </ul> </li> </ul>

HEBRON

- **Closure:**
  - (i) The Israeli army continues to close Khuzq Al-Far areas, as well as the old gold market in Hebron's Old City. In addition to closing the entrance to Al-Qeisi neighbourhood, the Israeli army continues to close the entrances to the area of Al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) with an electronic gate; Al-Laban Market also remains closed.
  - (ii) Since 05 January 2009, the Israeli army has closed the area located along the Green Line south of the town of Yatta. Having seized land for Wall construction, the Israeli army evicted the Palestinian residents and denied them access to the area.
- **Closure of Main Roads:**
  - (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Al-Karmil villages.
  - (ii) The Israeli army continues to prohibit Palestinian vehicles from travelling along the old Al-Shalala Street leading to Hebron's Old City.
  - (iii) The Israeli army continues to close all roads leading to Road # 60 as well as detour roads along the settler bypass road leading to Yatta town.
  - (iv) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds a detour road leading to e to Al-Simiya village, the southern entrance of Al-Samou' and the entrance of Beit Annun with cement blocks.
  - (v) Since July 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Safa and Al-Dirat and also closed the entrance of south Yatta with cement blocks.
  - (vi) At 11:00 on August 6<sup>th</sup> 2015, Israeli forces closed the entrance of Al-Hajara village located in south Dura with cement blocks.
- **Flying Checkpoint:** At 08:10, Israeli forces set up two checkpoints at the entrance of Wadi Qabbun area located in North Hebron and At Sa'ir junction.
- **Raid:**
  - (i) At 11:50, Israeli forces raided Sa'ir (for the alleged attempted stabbing of a Israeli settler by unidentified assailants in Wadi Sa'ir and Farah area' in Sa'ir as allegedly by the Israeli military), clashed with several resindeets and as a result injured 4 resindets: Samer Mohammad Ali Jabarin (eye injury), Alaa Kayed Badawi Al-Faroukh (eye injury), Loai Mohammad Omar Jarradat and Yusef Mahmoud Warasna.
  - (ii) At 02:45, Israeli forces raided Al-Shiyoukh then stormed and searched several homes.
  - (iii) At 02:45, Israeli forces raided Hebron and detained two residents.
  - (iv) At dawn on October 26<sup>th</sup> 2015, Israeli forces raided Beit Ummar and detained a resident.
- **Detention:**
  - (i) At 02:45, Israeli forces detained Basil Shaker Fakhouri (17 years old) in the old city of Hebron.
  - (ii) Israeli forces detained Ahmad Hamadin Al-Qawasmeh and Mahmoud Hamadin Al-Qawasmeh.
  - (iii) Israeli forces detained Murshid Mohammad Za'ariq in Beit Ummar.
- **Attack:** At 14:20, Israeli forces positioned in Tal'at Abu Hadid area in the old city of Hebron and near Khursa village junction fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.
- **Killing:** At 13:30, Daniya Jihad Hussien Irsheid (17 year old){School girl}{A resident of Hebron} was killed after Israeli forces opened fire at her near Al-Ibrahimi mosque checkpoint in the old city of Hebron for allegedly attempting to stab a Israeli soldier (as alleged by the Israeli military).
- **Settler Violence:** At 10:50, Israeli settlers stormed Wadi Sa'ir area and opened fire towards several resindets and farmers as they were collecting Olive harvest and as a result, critically injured Azem Izzat Shalladat leaving him hospitalised.
